



April 2017:

Daytime high and overnight low temperatures were above normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for the month at Colchester and Kingsville and near normal at Cedar Springs. Season accumulated growing degree days were above 2015 and 2016 values across the appellation. April rainfall averaged 119 % of normal across the appellation. Areas received up to 47 mm of rain over April 19 and 20.

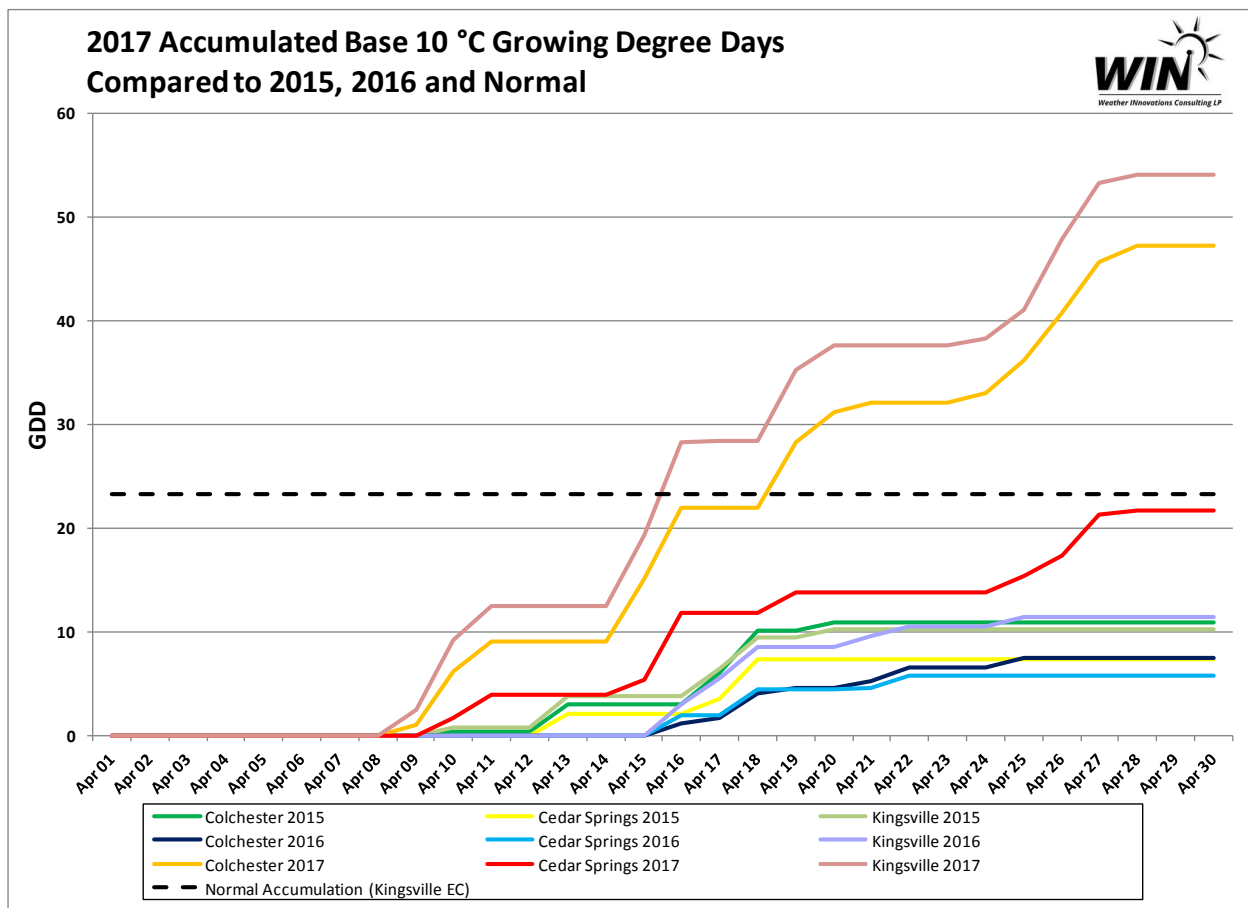


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

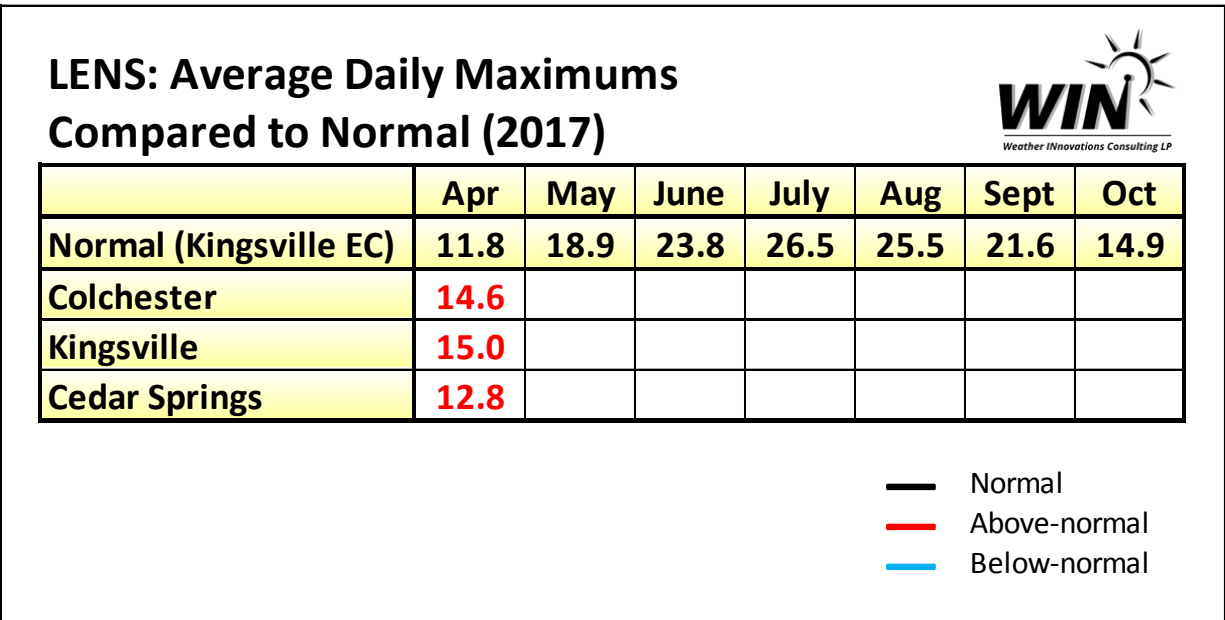


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

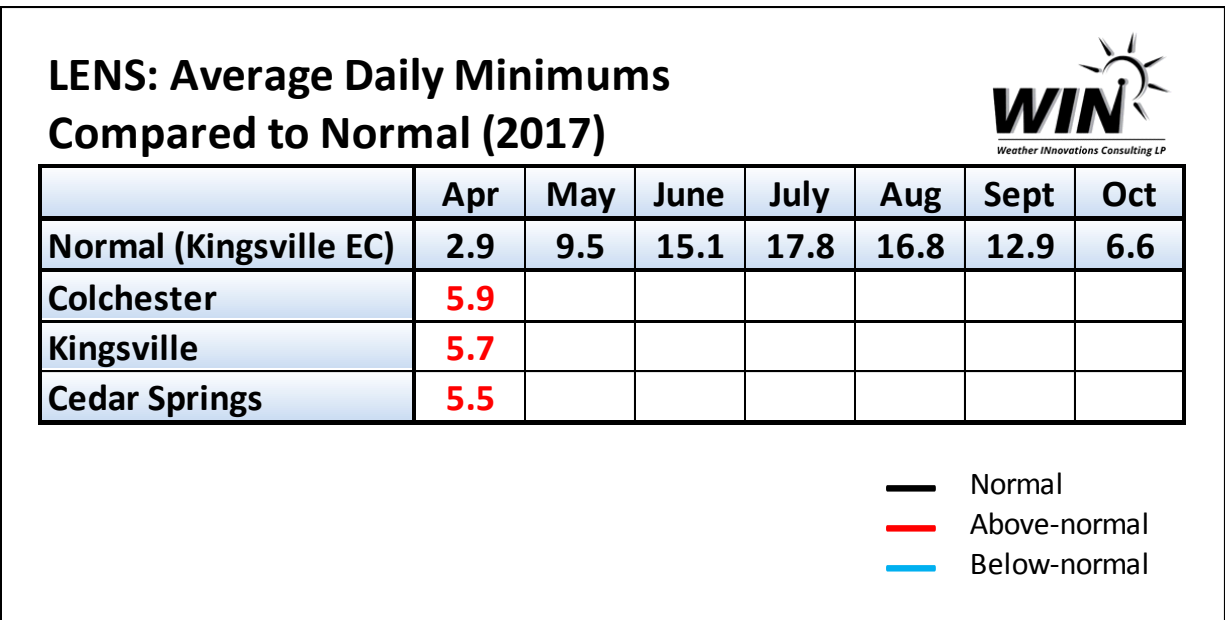


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

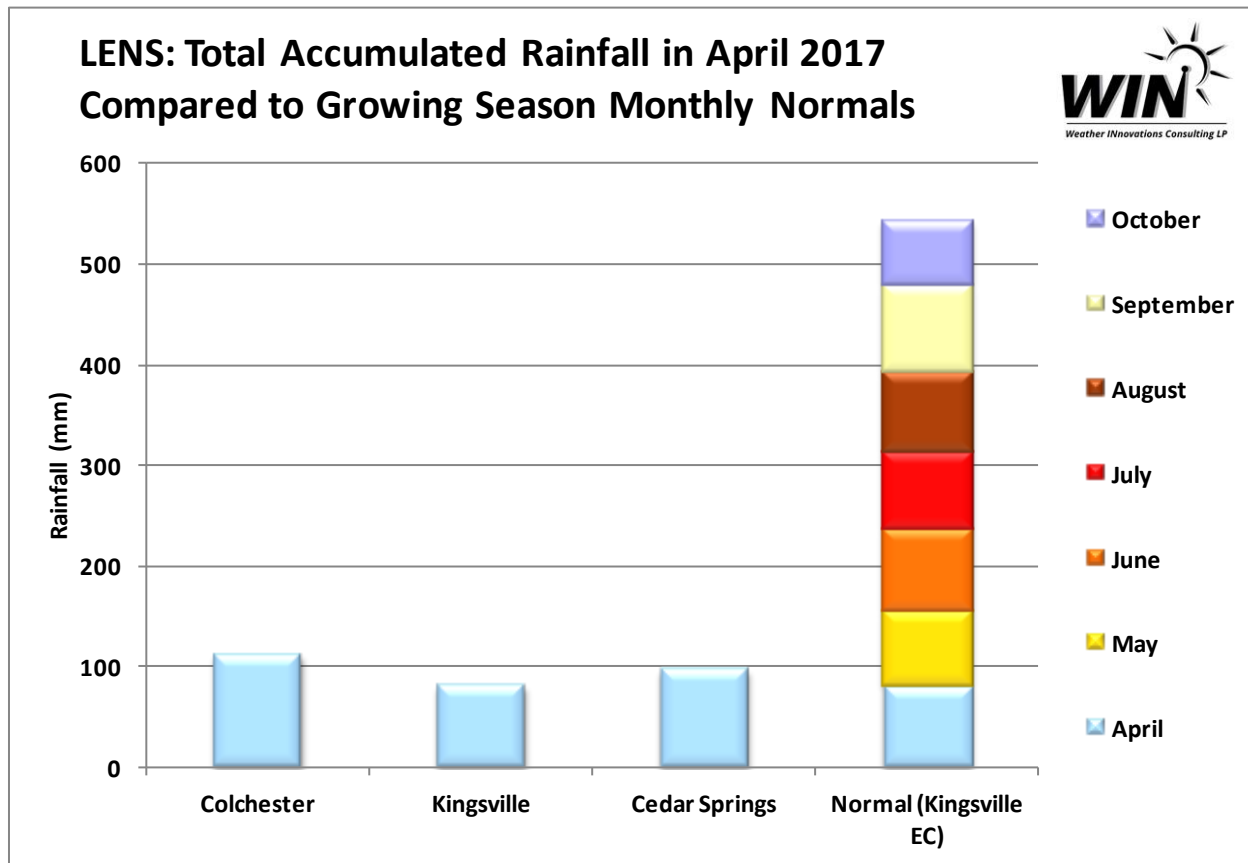


Figure 4: Rainfall
