



July 2018:

In July, daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation. Overnight lows were above normal at Cedar Springs and below normal at Colchester and Kingsville. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for the month at Cedar Springs and Colchester. Kingsville had below normal growing degree days in July. Season accumulated growing degree days were above 2016 and 2017 values across the appellation. July rainfall averaged 71 % of normal. Up to 55 mm of rain fell across the appellation over July 20-26.

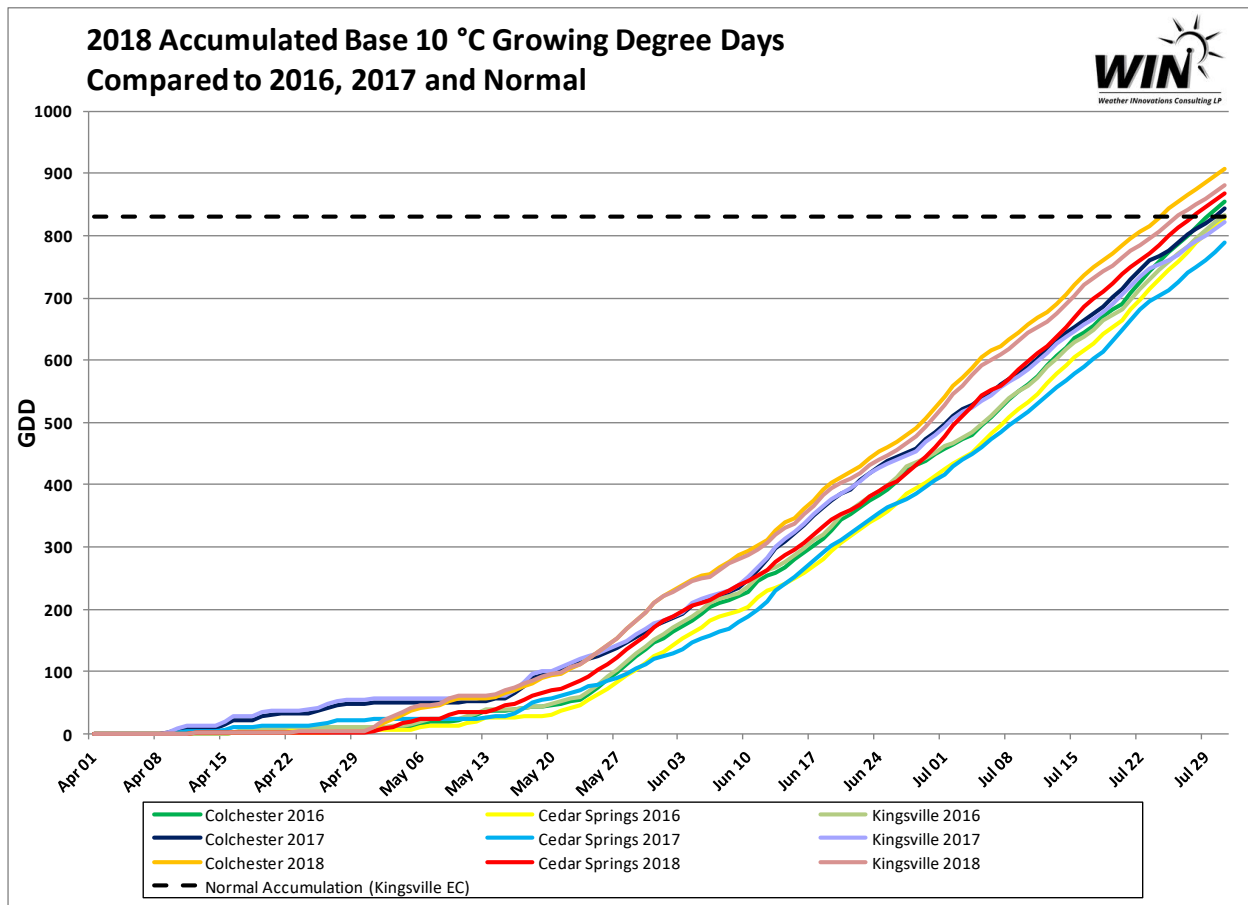


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

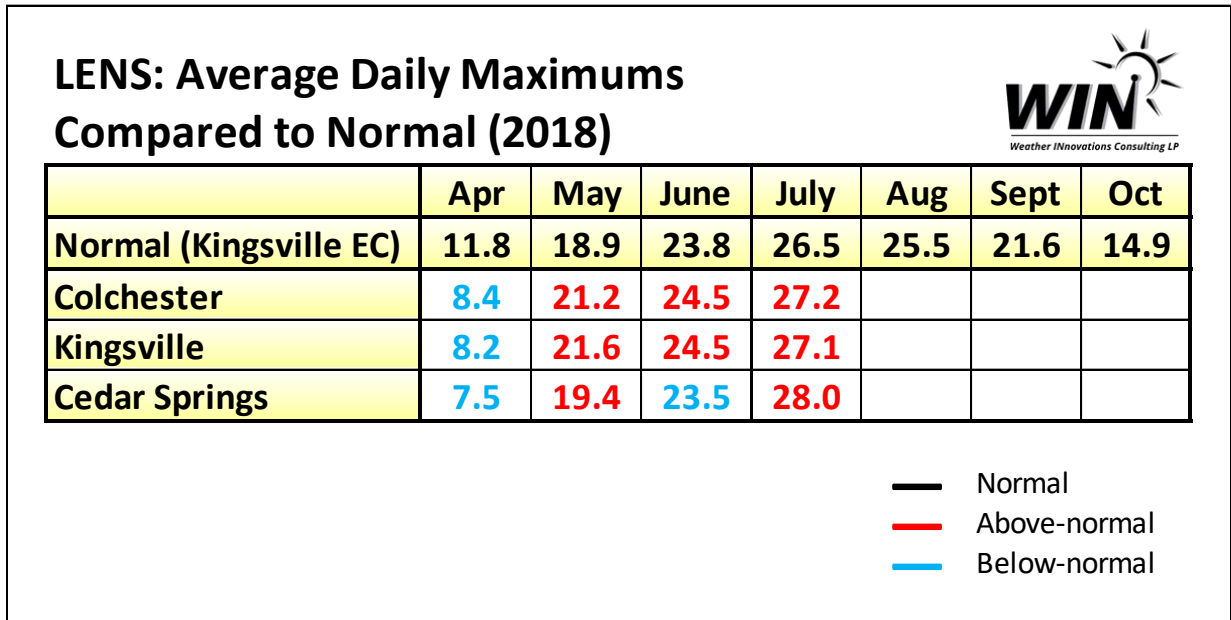


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

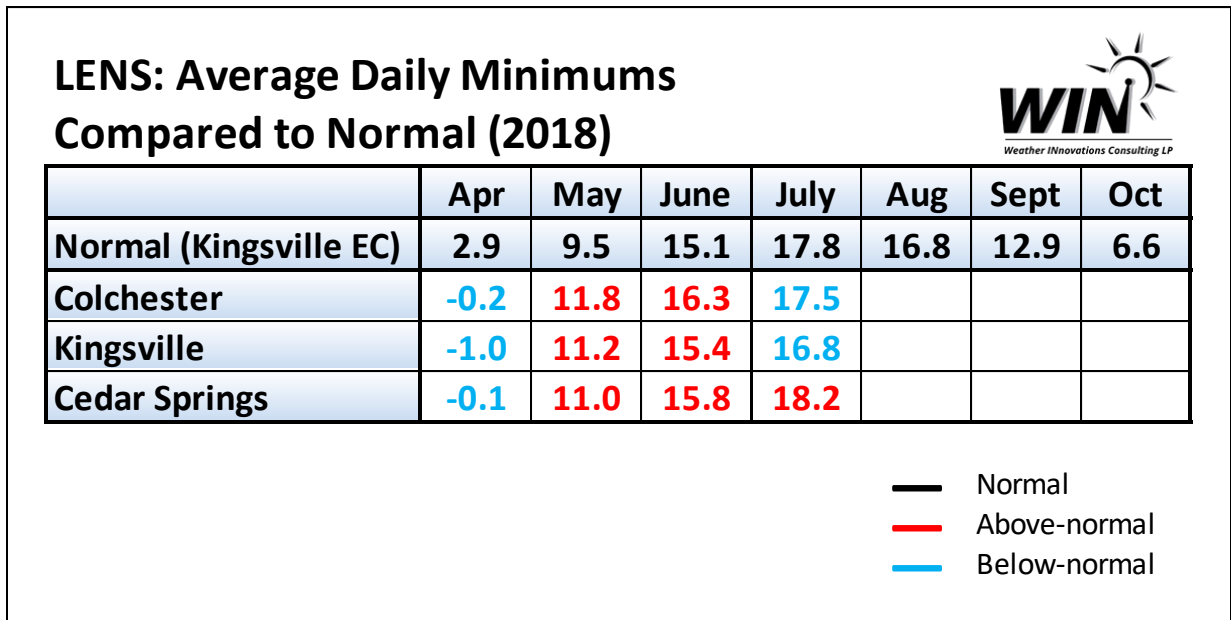


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

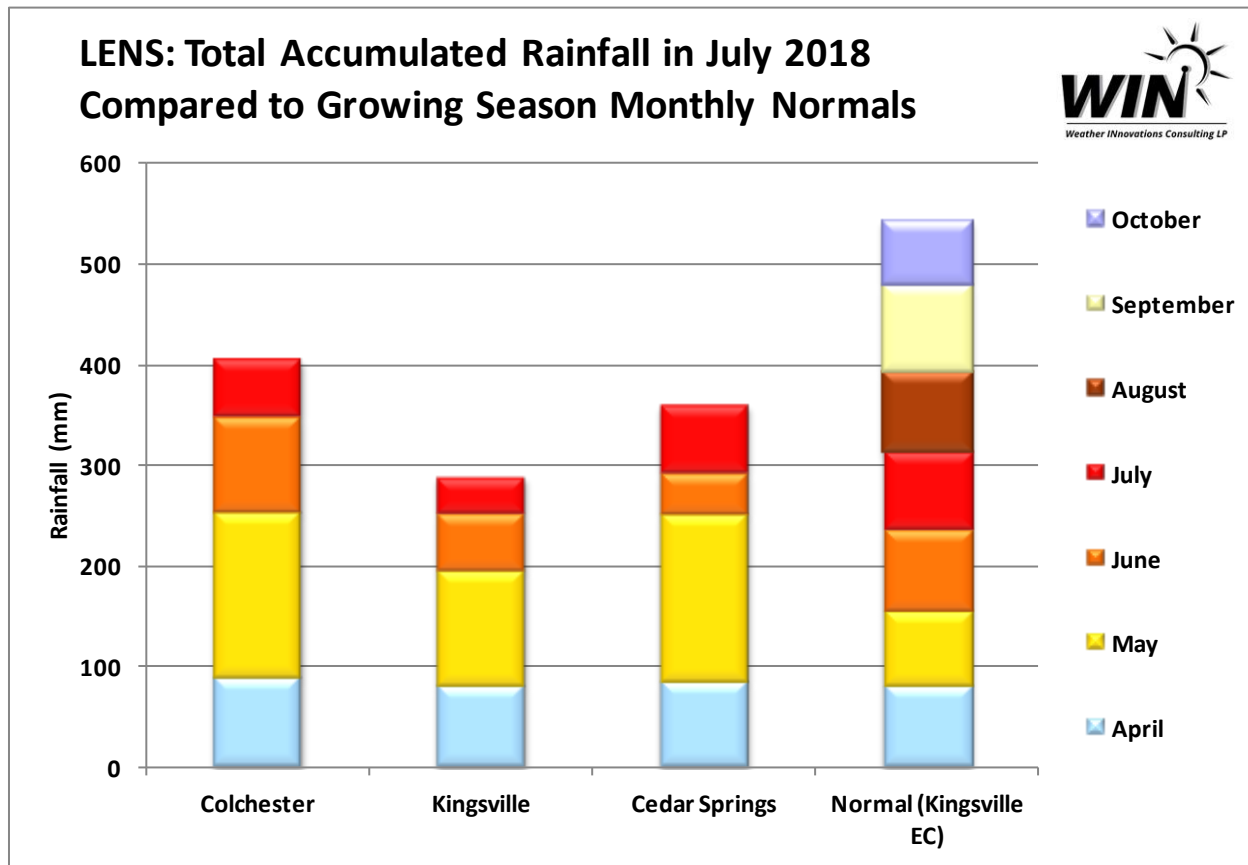


Figure 4: Rainfall
