



July 2015:

Daytime highs and overnight lows averaged below normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days were higher than 2014 values across the appellation. Colchester and Kingsville remained below 2013 values while Cedar Springs was slightly above 2013 values. July rainfall averaged 95 % of normal across the appellation. Areas across the appellation received at least 30 mm of precipitation over July 7 through July 9 and areas around Cedar Springs received an additional 30 mm of rainfall on July 14.

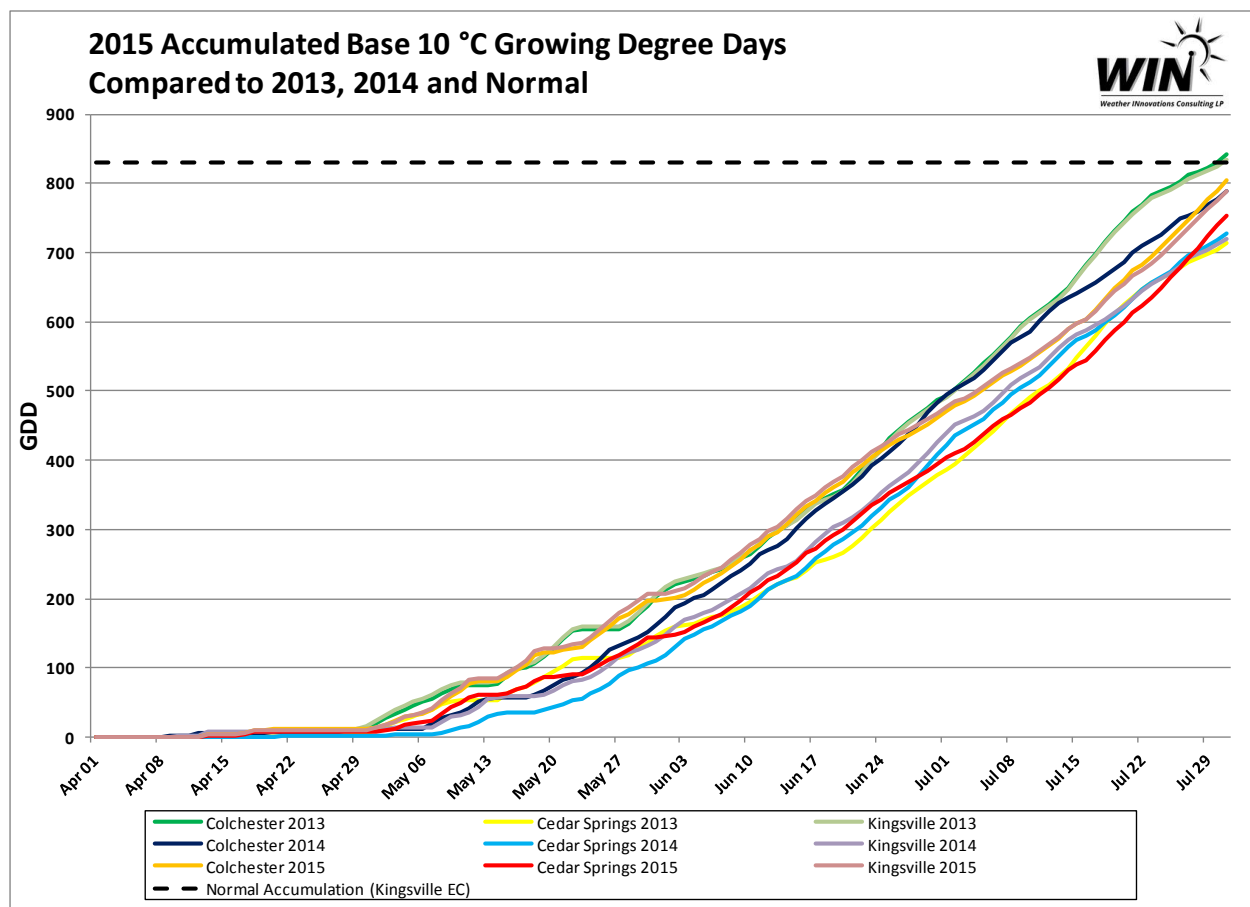


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

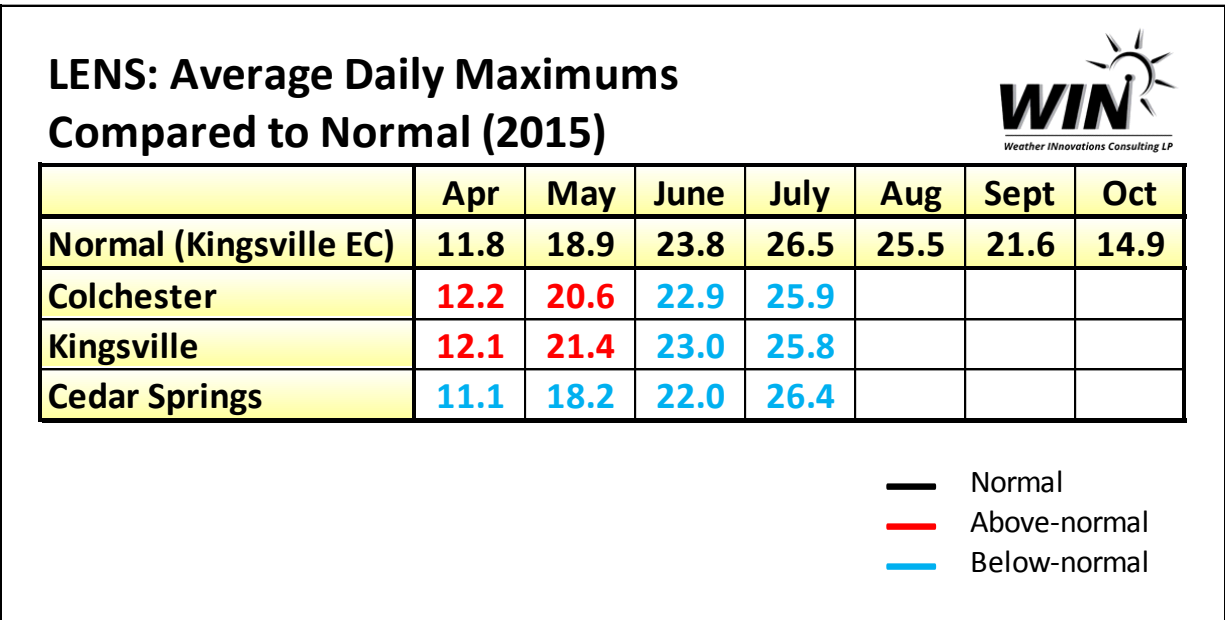


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

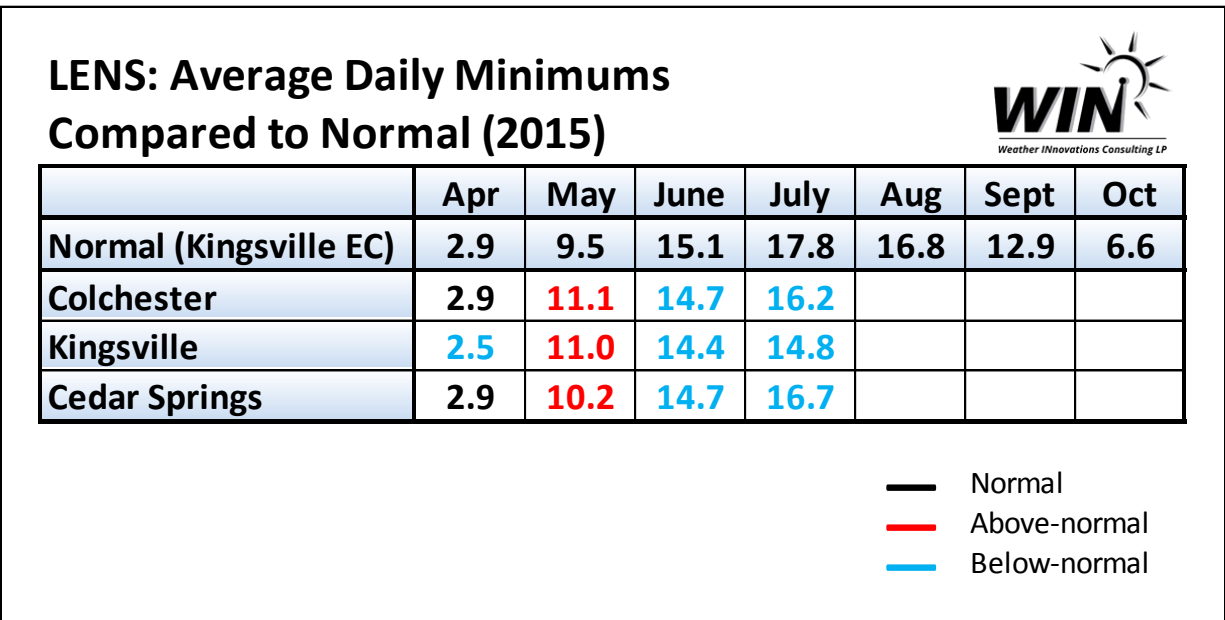


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

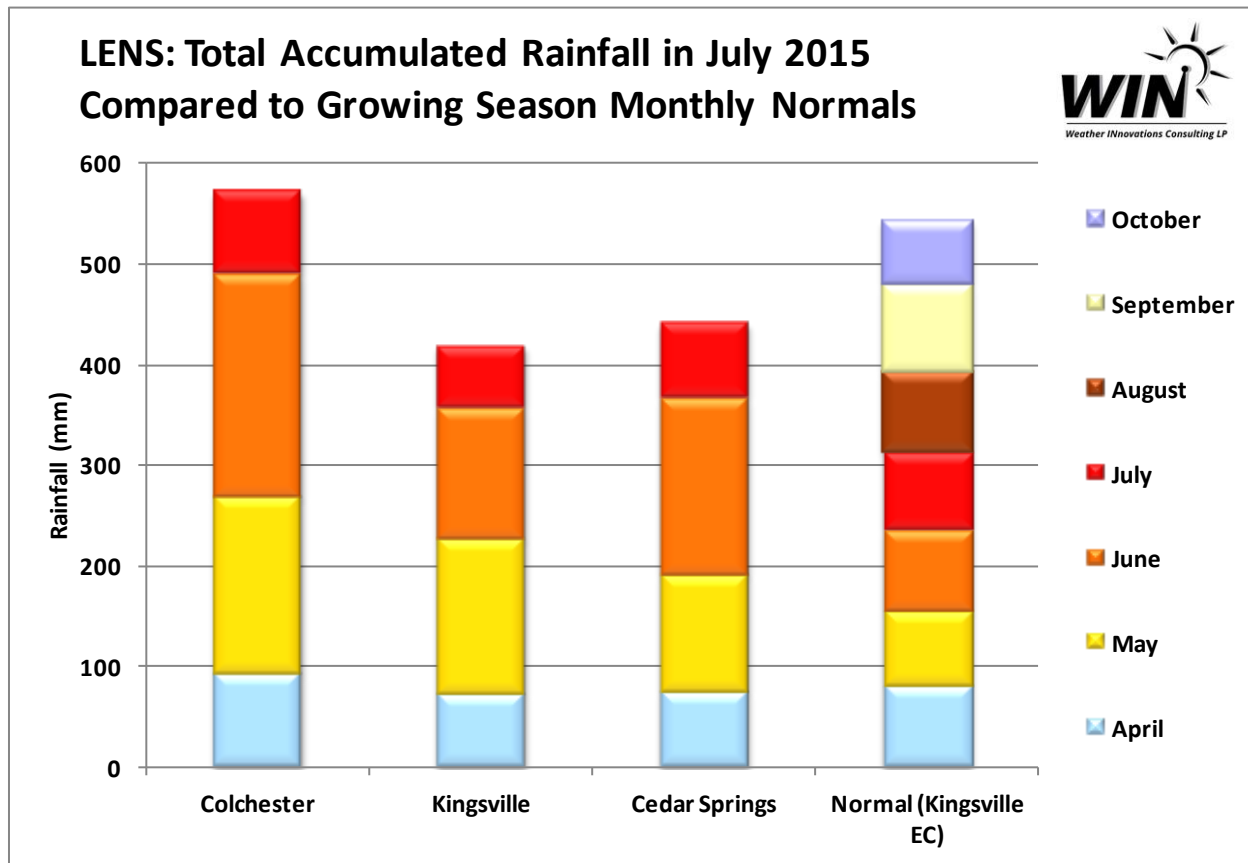


Figure 4: Rainfall
