



## June 2017:

In June, daytime high temperatures and overnight lows were at or above normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days were above 2015 and 2016 values. June rainfall averaged 97 % of normal across the appellation with Colchester and Cedar Springs receiving 136 % and 56 % of normal rainfall, respectively. Up to 54 mm of rainfall fell across the appellation on June 30.

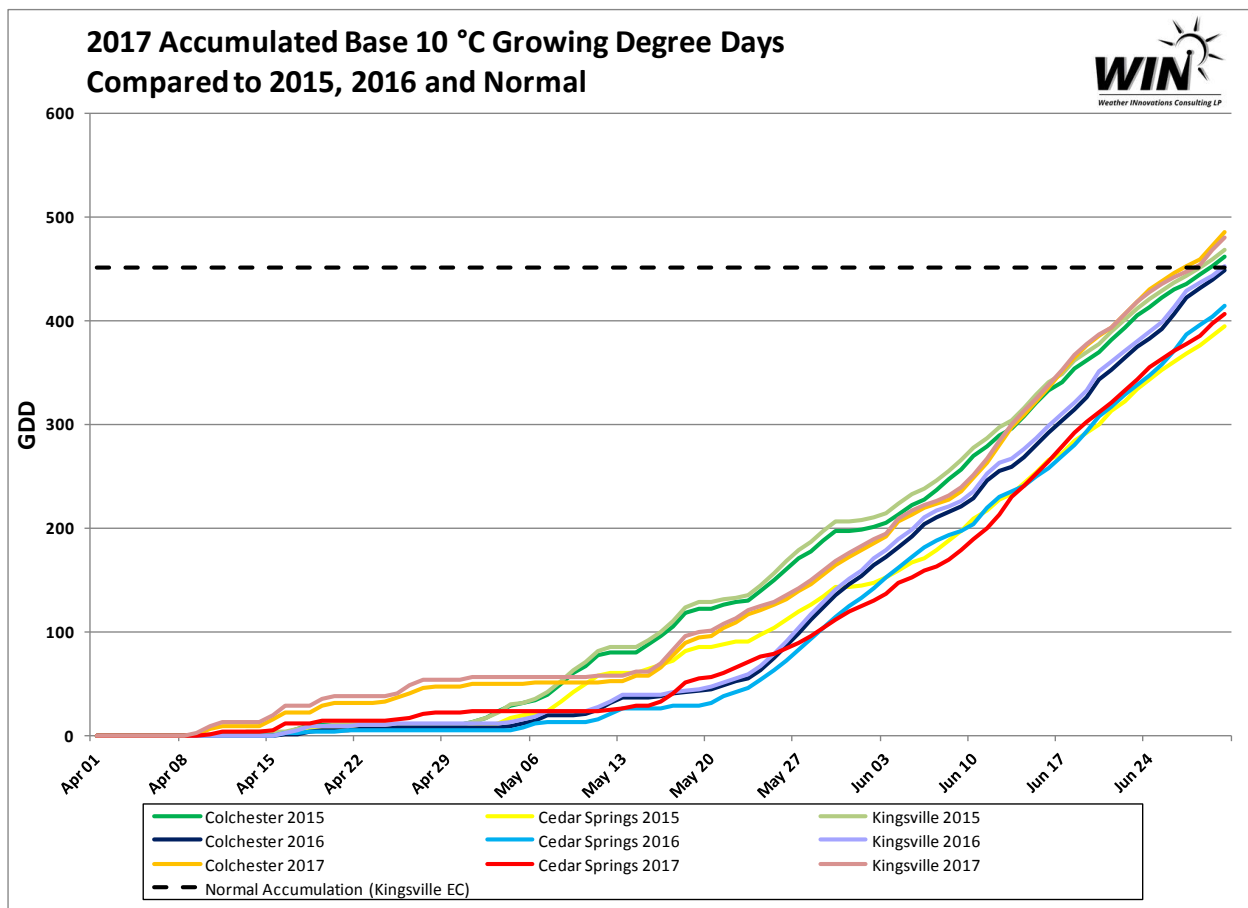


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

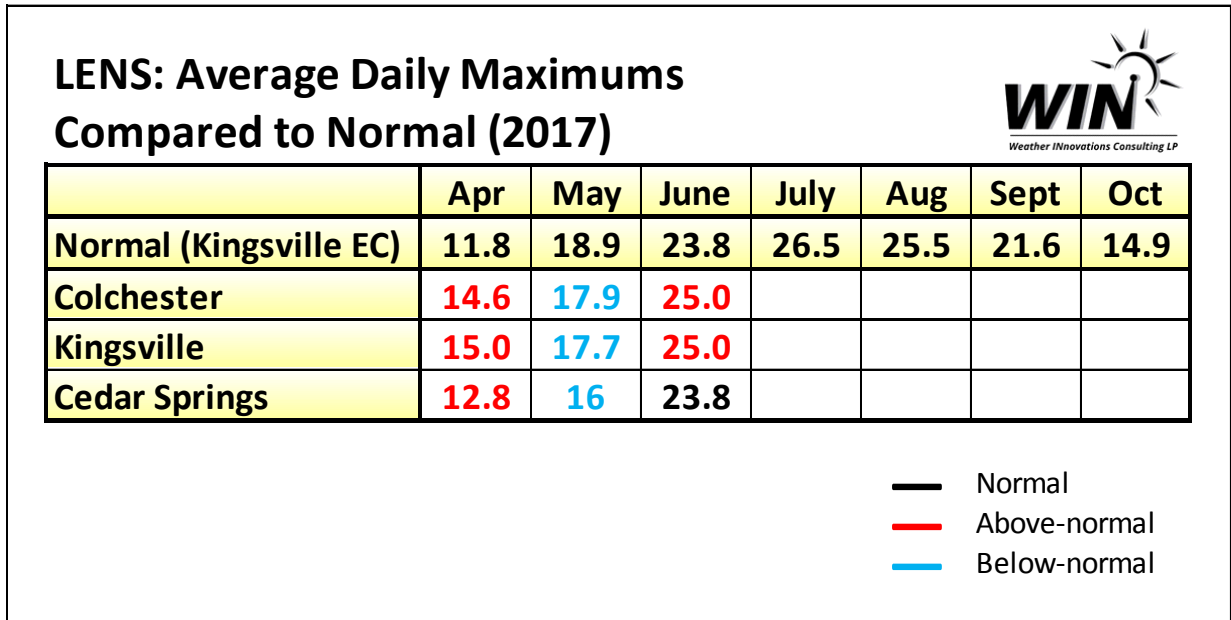


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

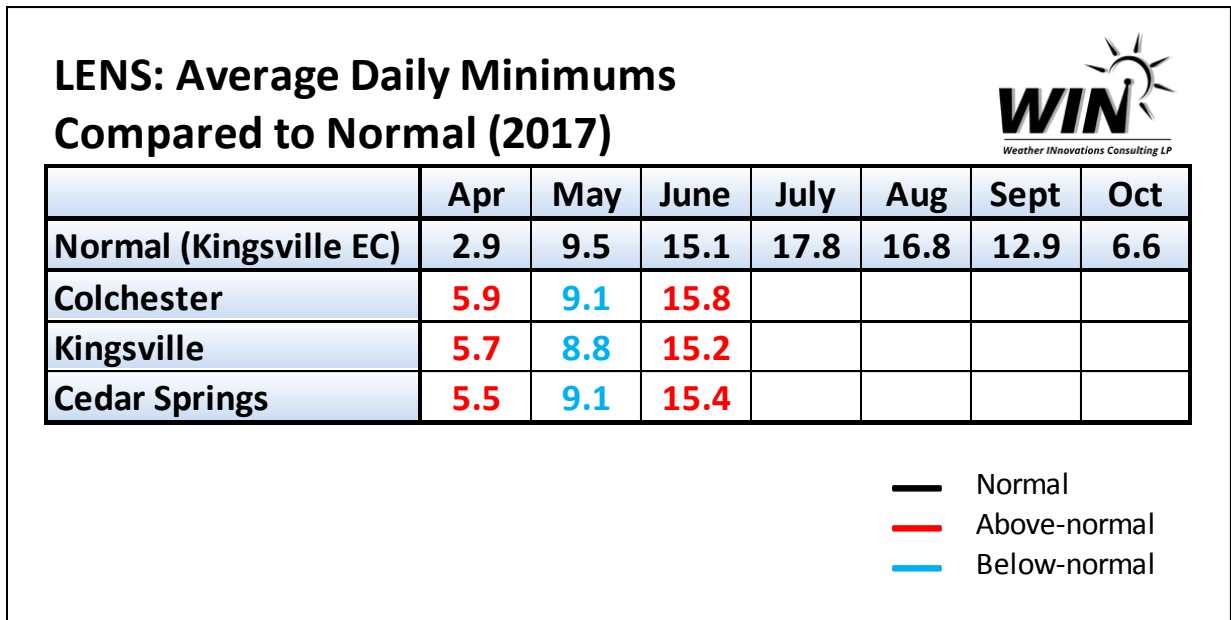


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

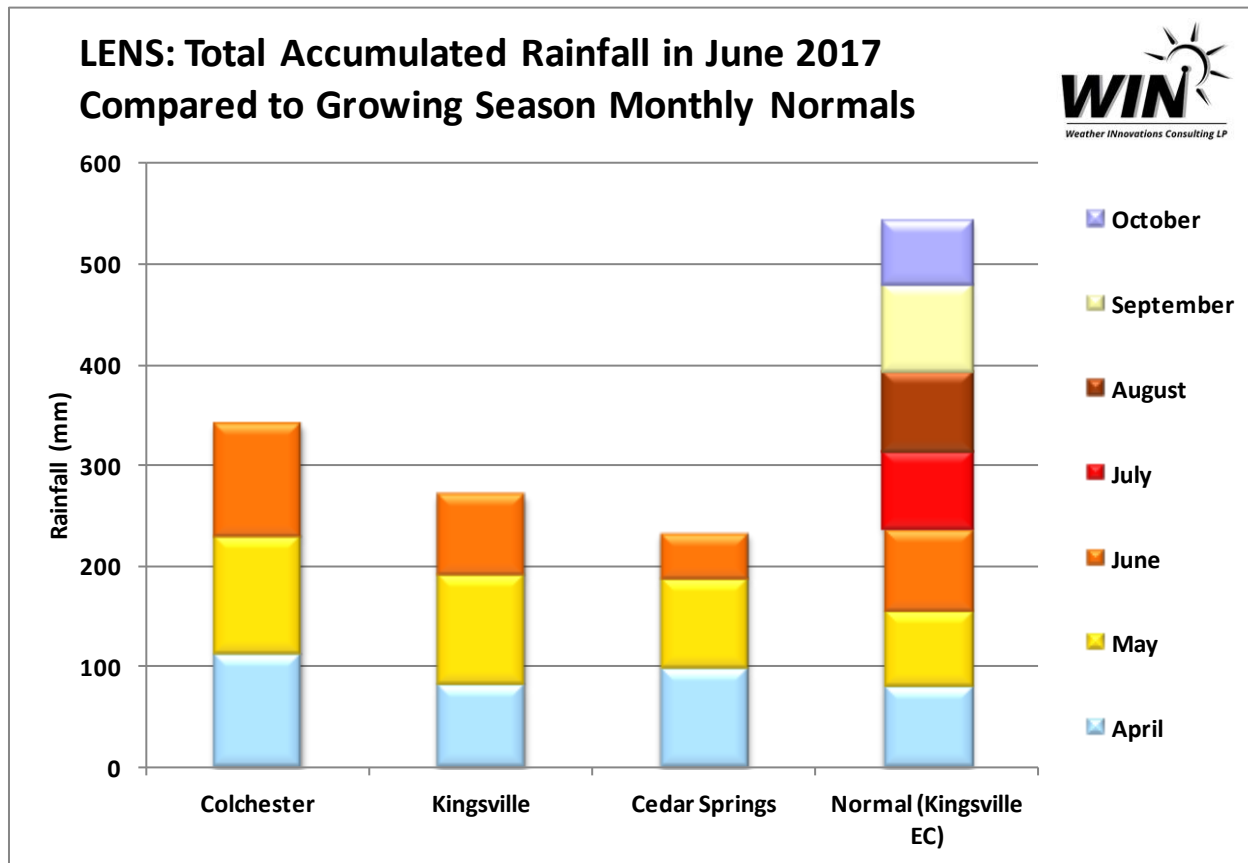


Figure 4: Rainfall
