



## June 2018:

In June, daytime high temperatures and overnight lows were near to above normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days were above 2016 and 2017 values. June rainfall averaged 78 % of normal across the appellation. Kingsville and Cedar Springs received 68 % and 50 % of normal rainfall, respectively. Up to 52 mm of rainfall fell across the appellation on June 18.

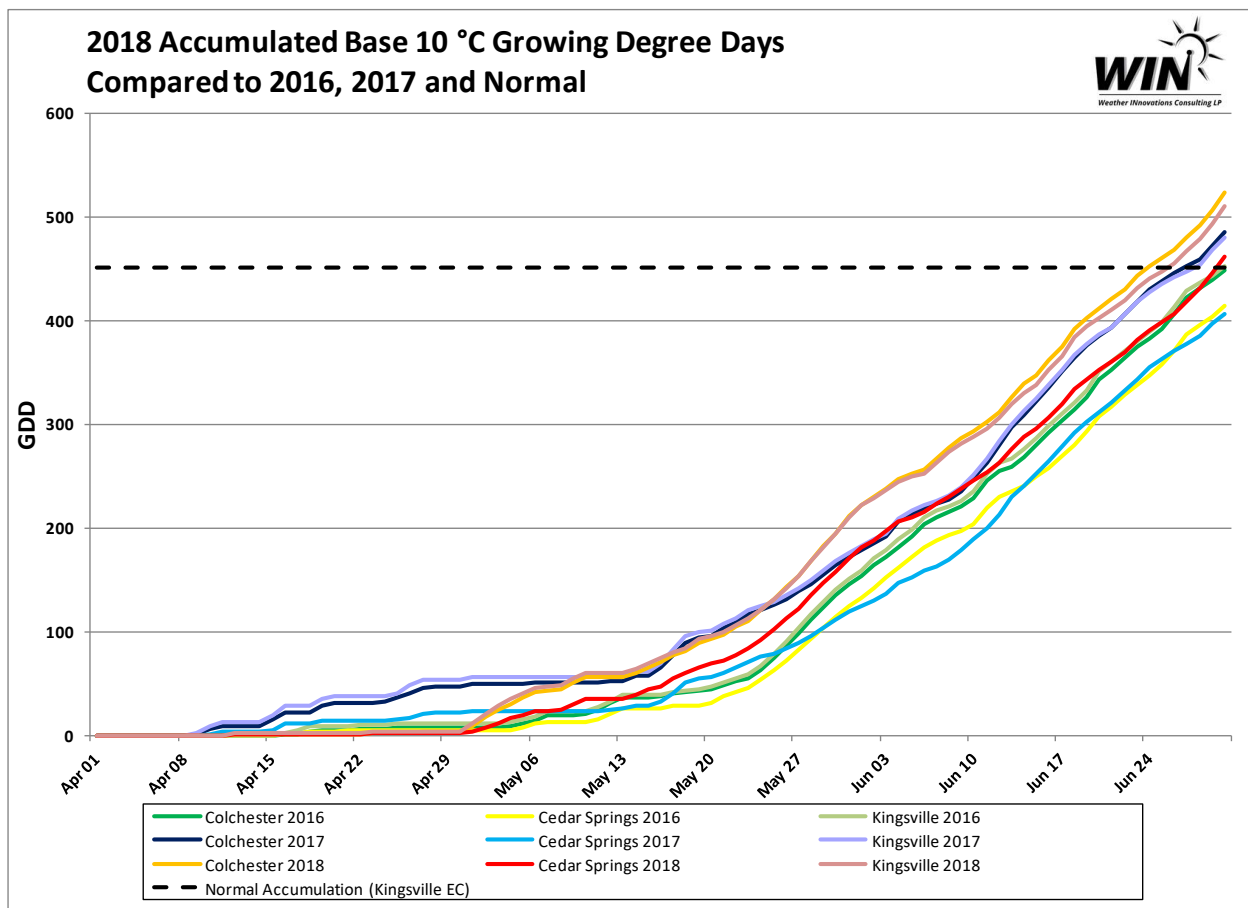


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

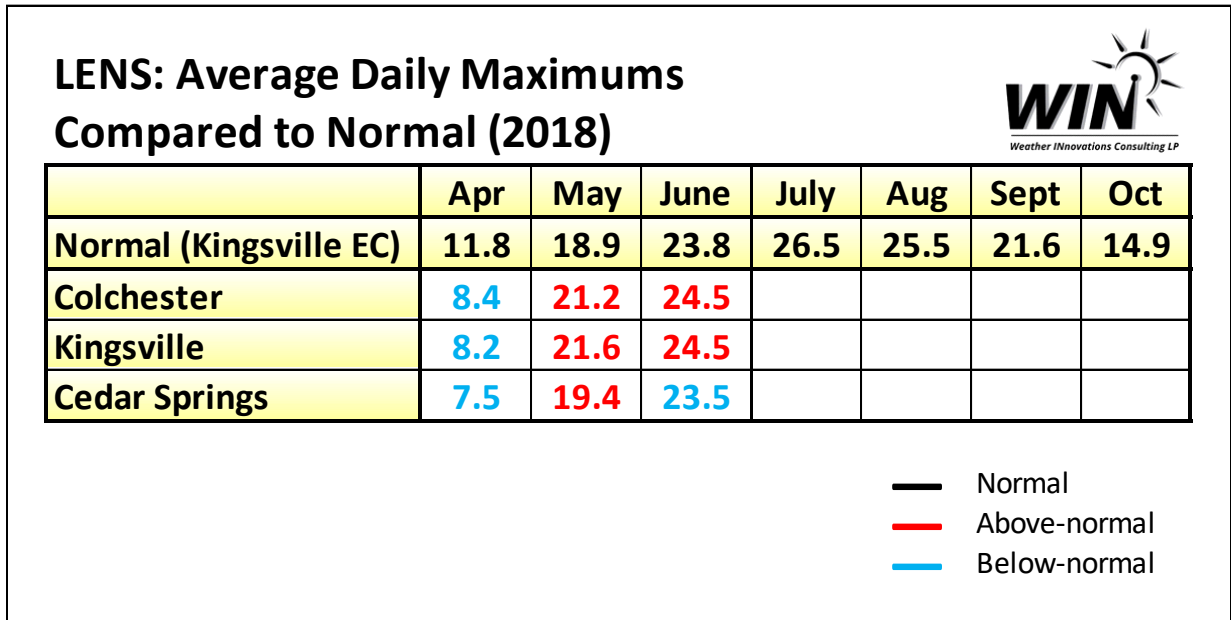


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

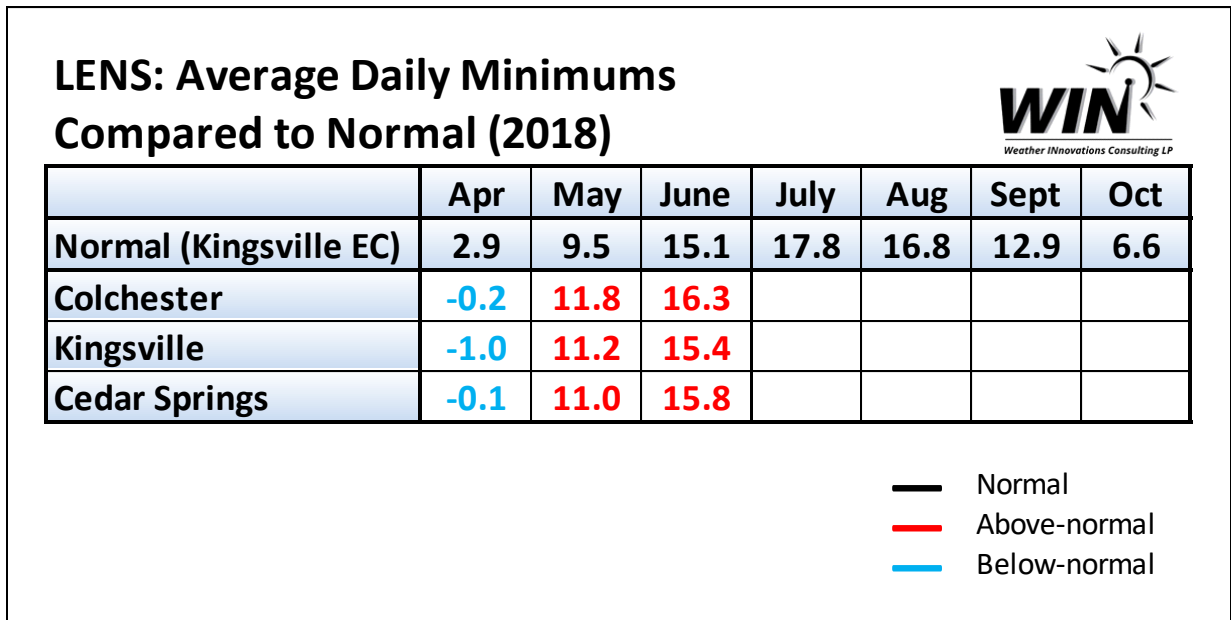


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

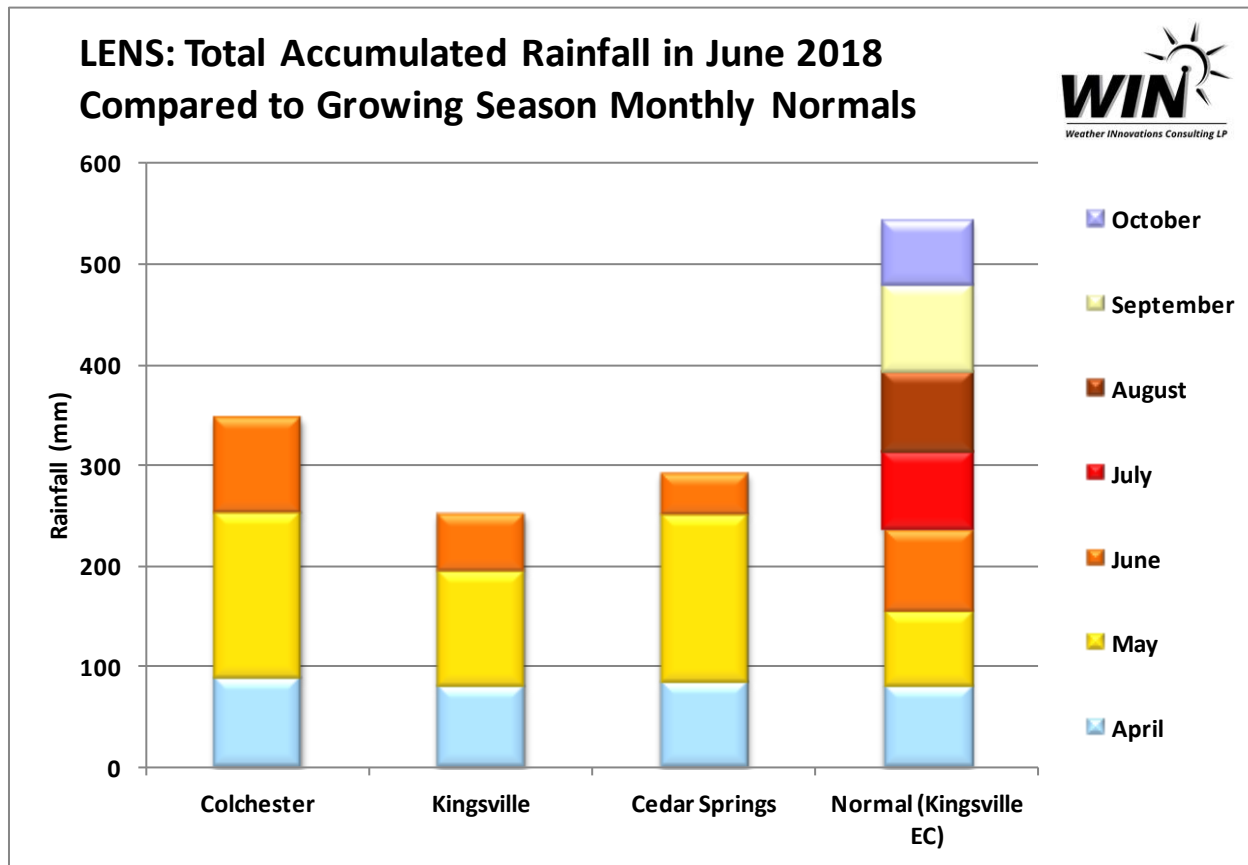


Figure 4: Rainfall
