



June 2015:

Daytime highs and overnight lows averaged below normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days were higher than 2014 values but lower than 2013 values at Kingsville, higher than 2013 values but lower than 2014 values at Cedar Springs, and lower than both 2013 and 2014 values at Colchester. June rainfall averaged 223 % of normal across the appellation. Areas across the appellation received at least 50 mm of precipitation on June 27 and areas around Colchester and Cedar Springs received an additional 50 mm of rainfall over June 14 and 15.

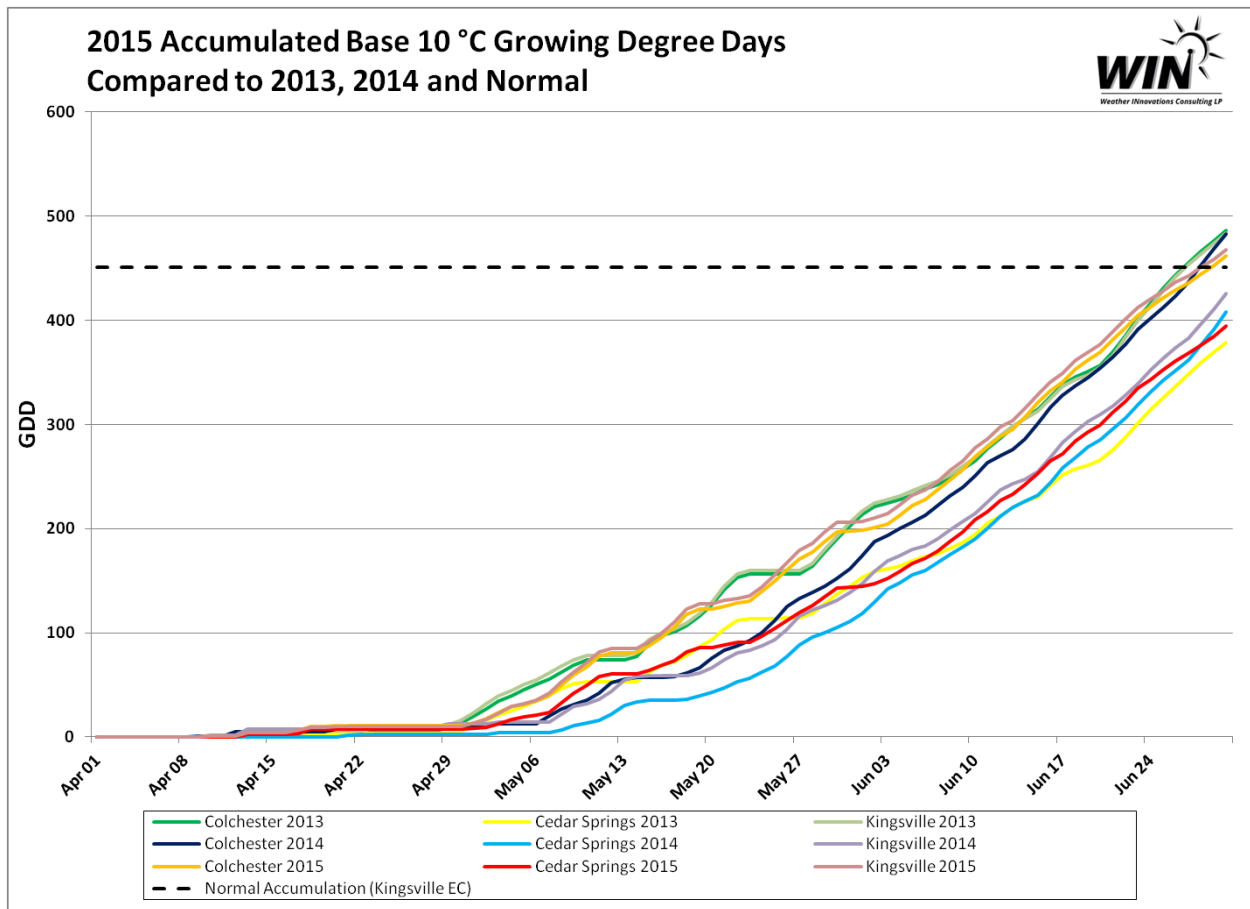


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

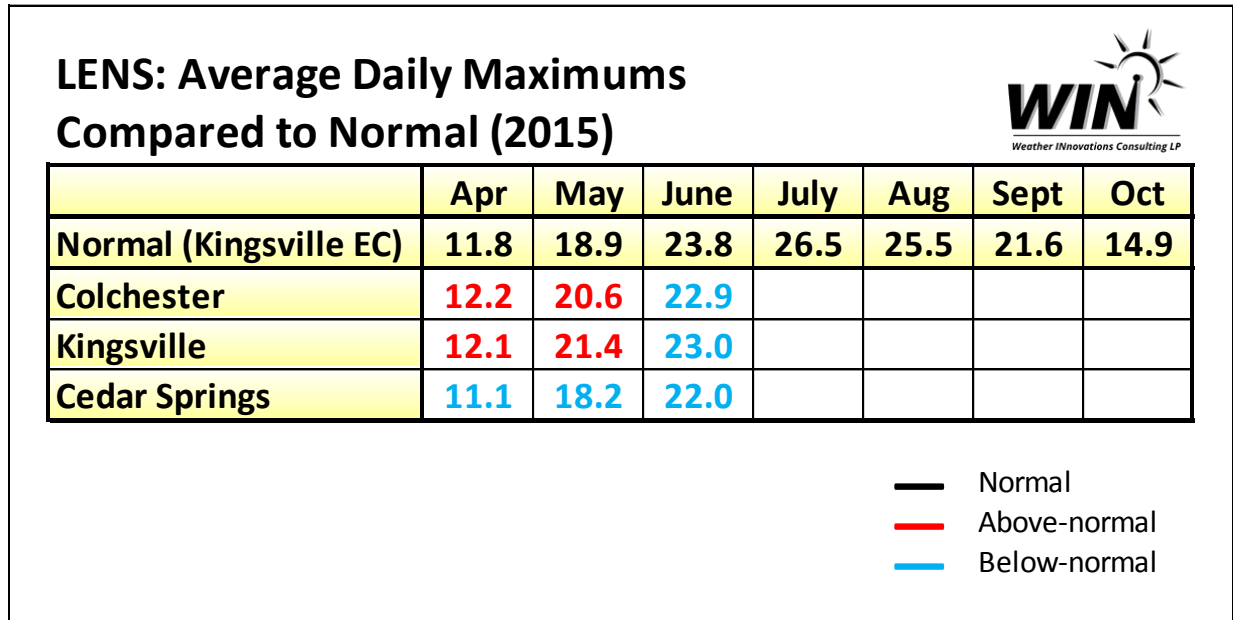


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

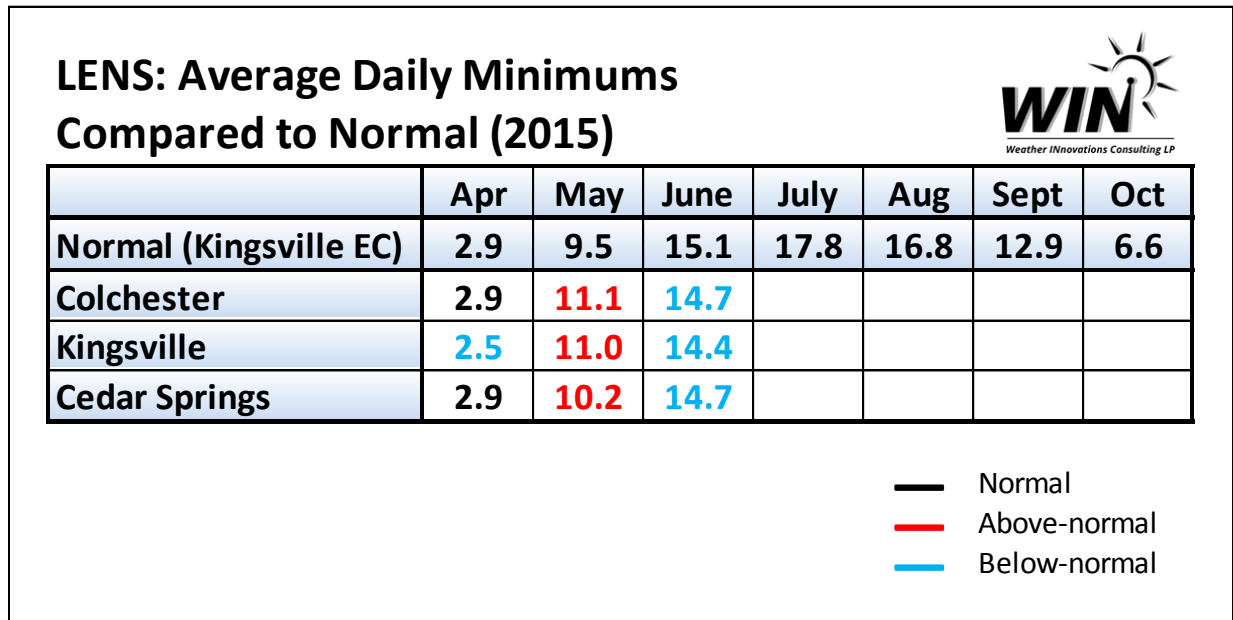


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

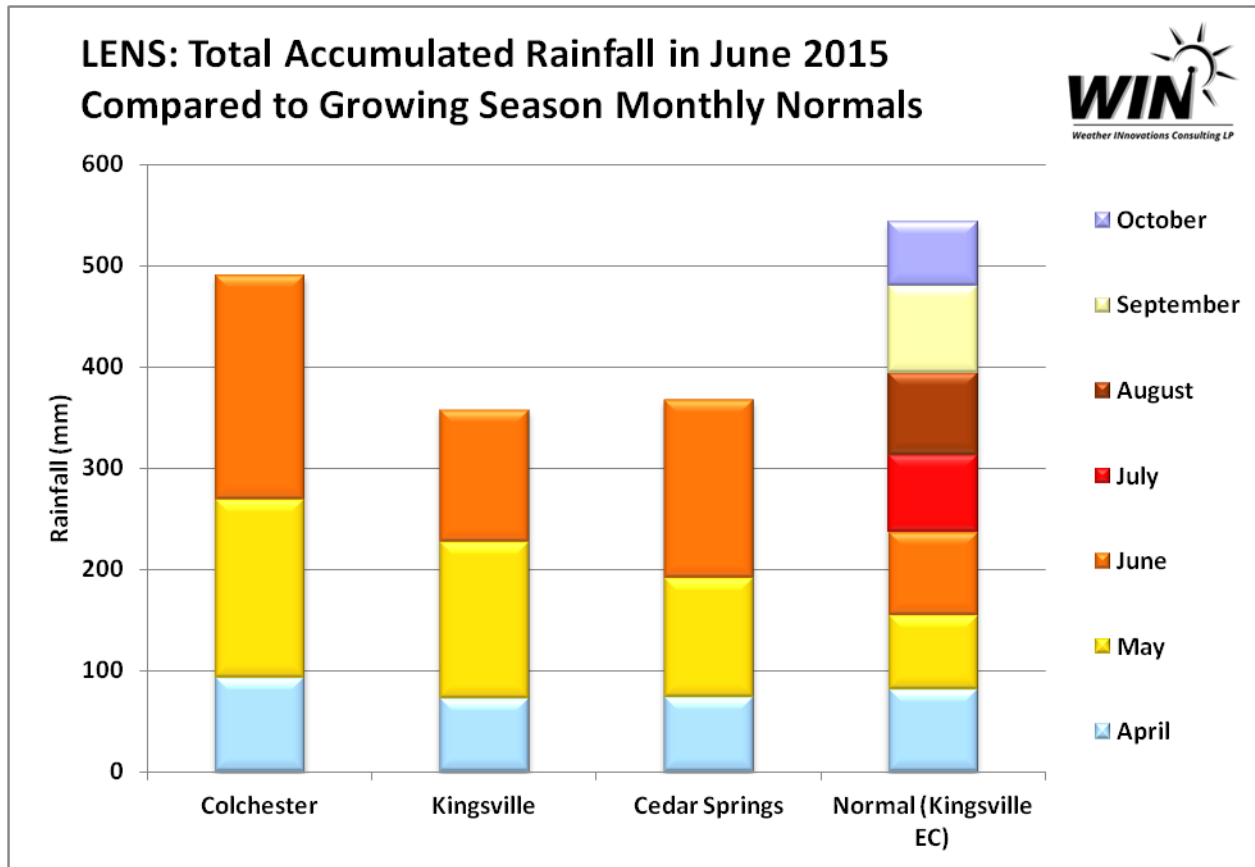


Figure 4: Rainfall
