



May 2016:

Daytime high temperatures were above normal at Colchester and Kingsville while Cedar Springs was below normal. Overnight lows remained below normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days were below 2014 and 2015 values at Colchester, between 2014 and 2015 values at Kingsville and Cedar Springs. While, May rainfall averaged 66 % of normal across the appellation, Cedar Springs received only 46 % of normal rainfall. Rainfall events of less than 14 mm were typical for the month.

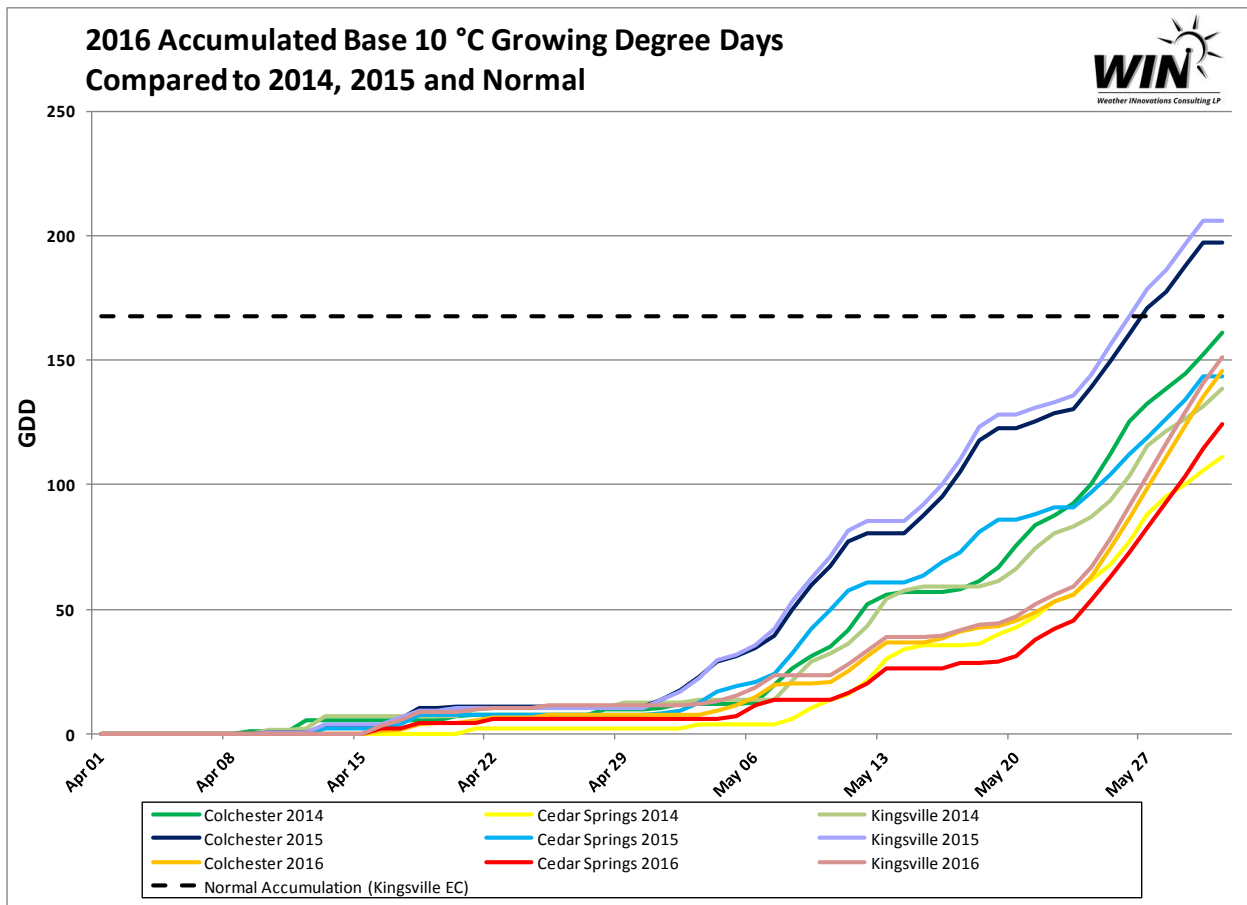


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

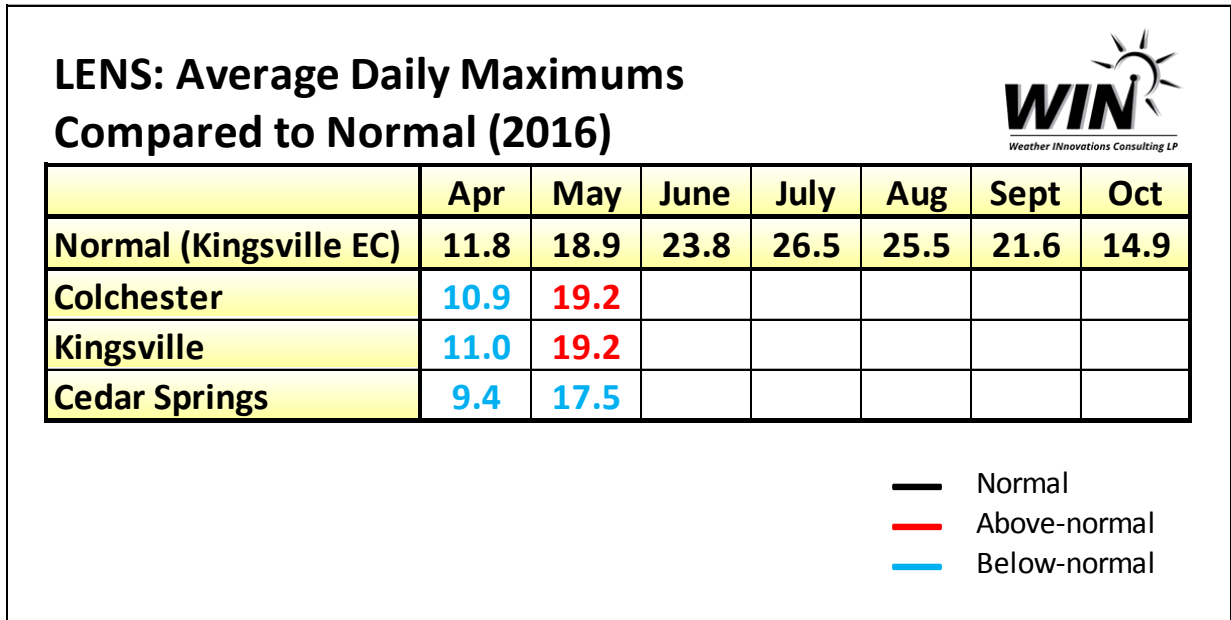


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

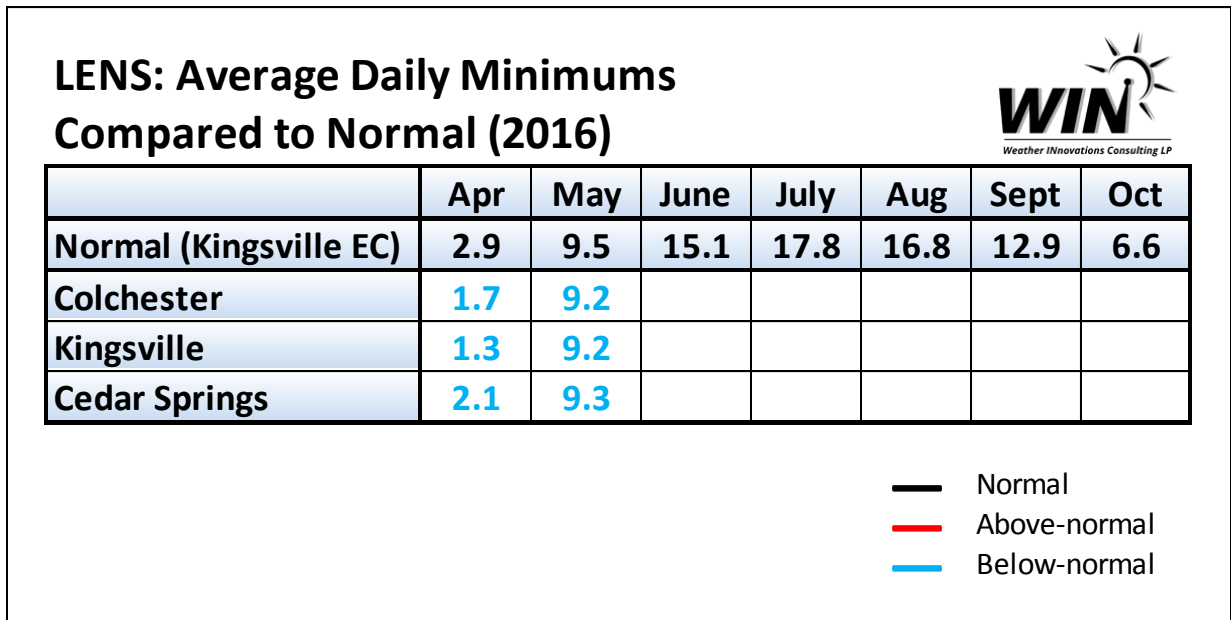


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

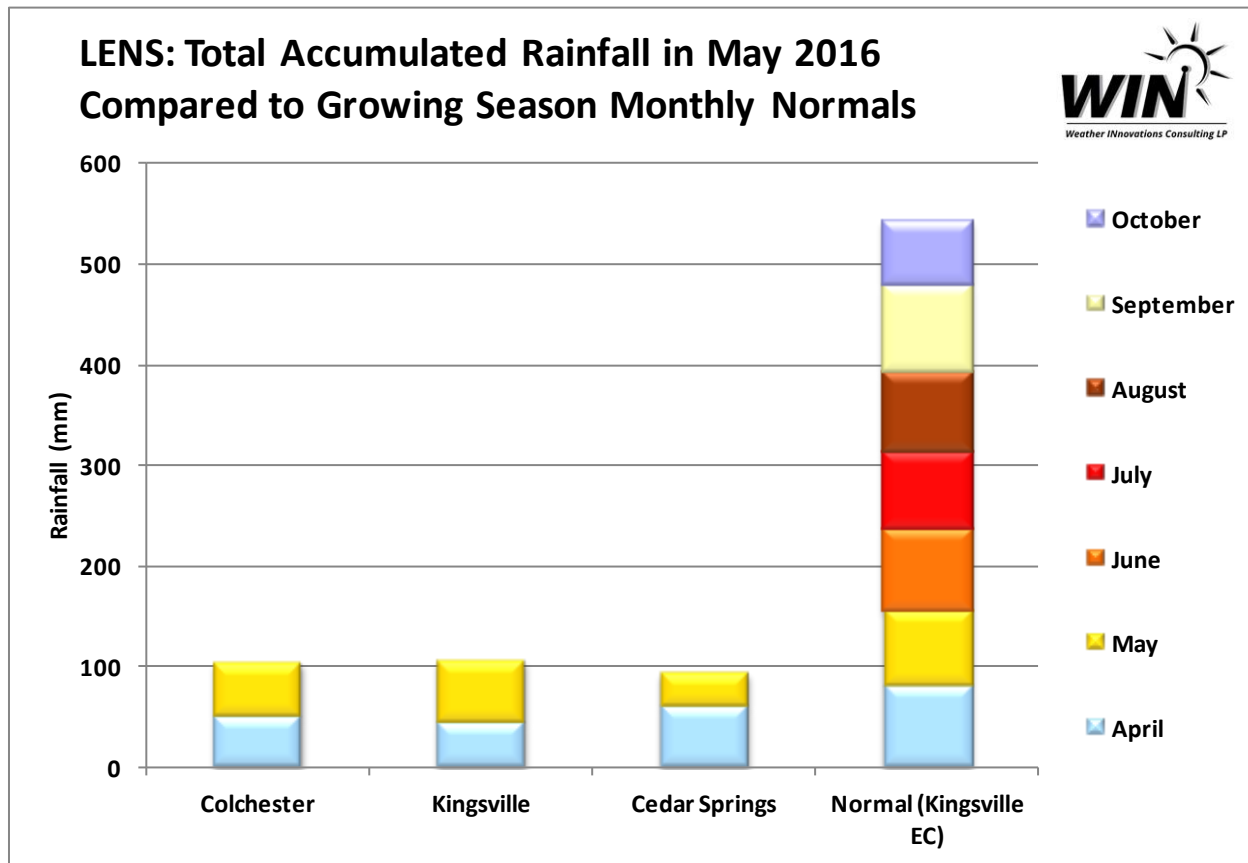


Figure 4: Rainfall
