



### May 2017:

Daytime high temperatures and overnight low temperatures were below normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were near normal at Colchester and Kingsville while Cedar Springs was below normal. Season accumulated growing degree days were below 2015 values and above 2016 values at Colchester and Kingsville. Cedar Spring remained below 2016 accumulated growing degree day values. May rainfall averaged 143 % of normal across the appellation. Up to 57.8 mm of rain fell over May 4 and May 5.

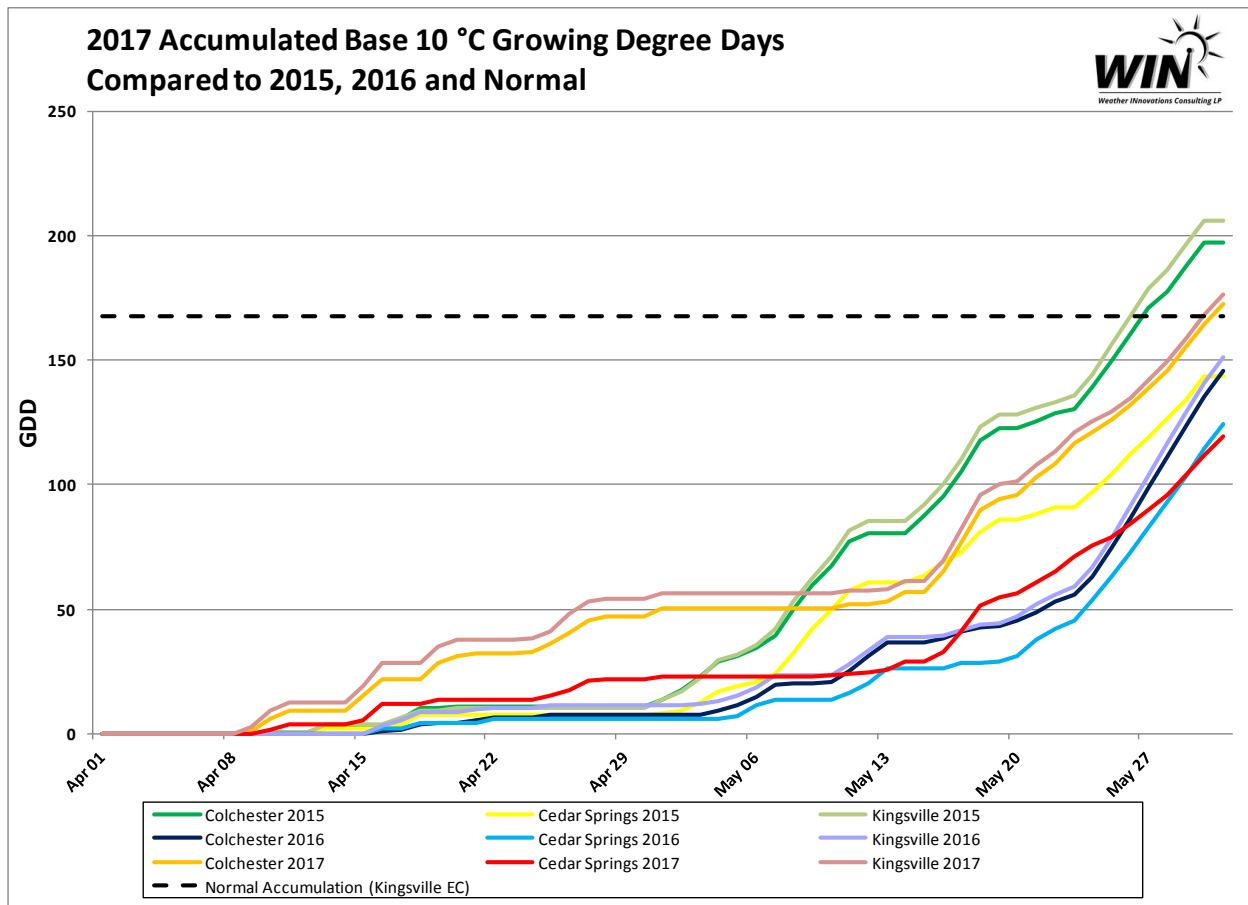


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

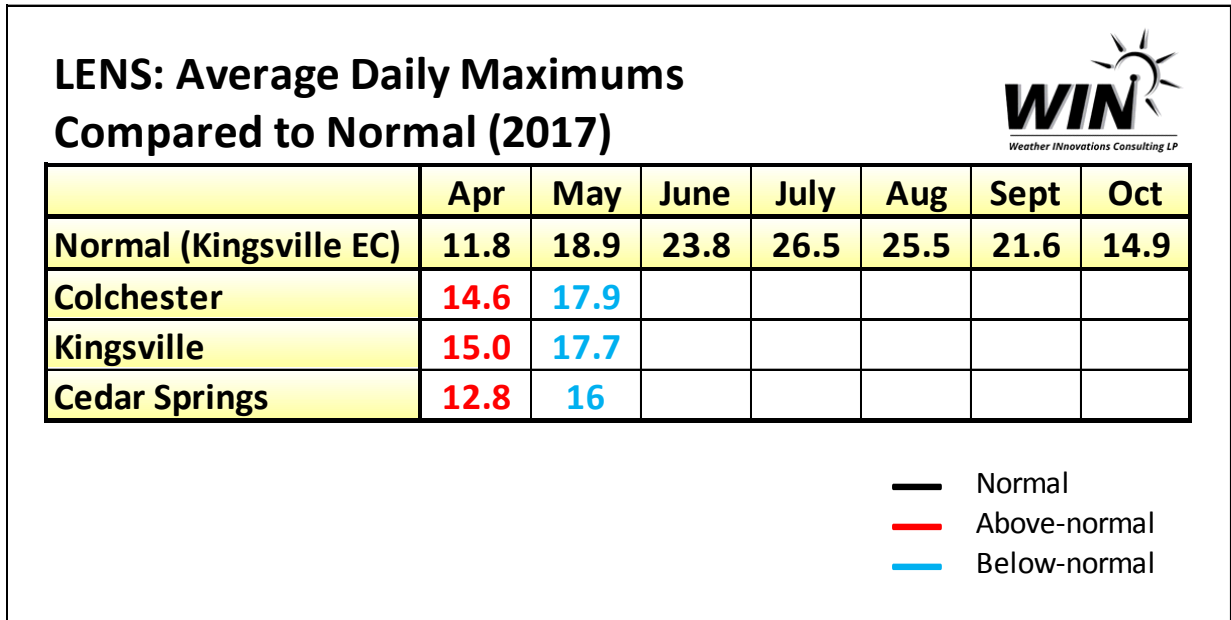


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

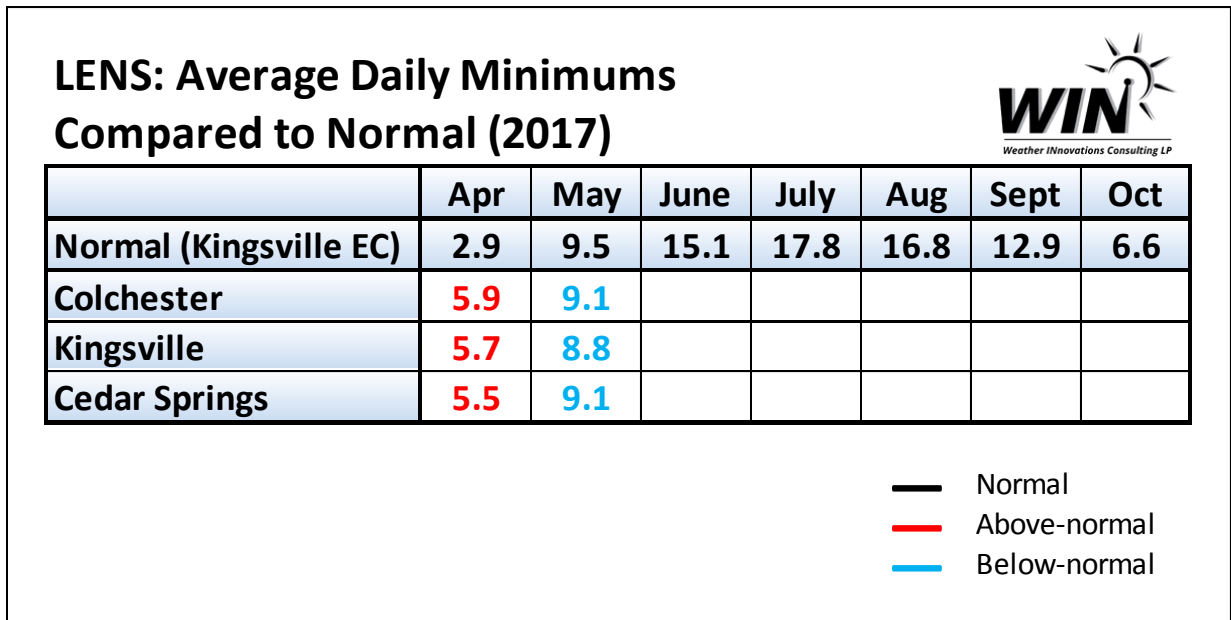


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

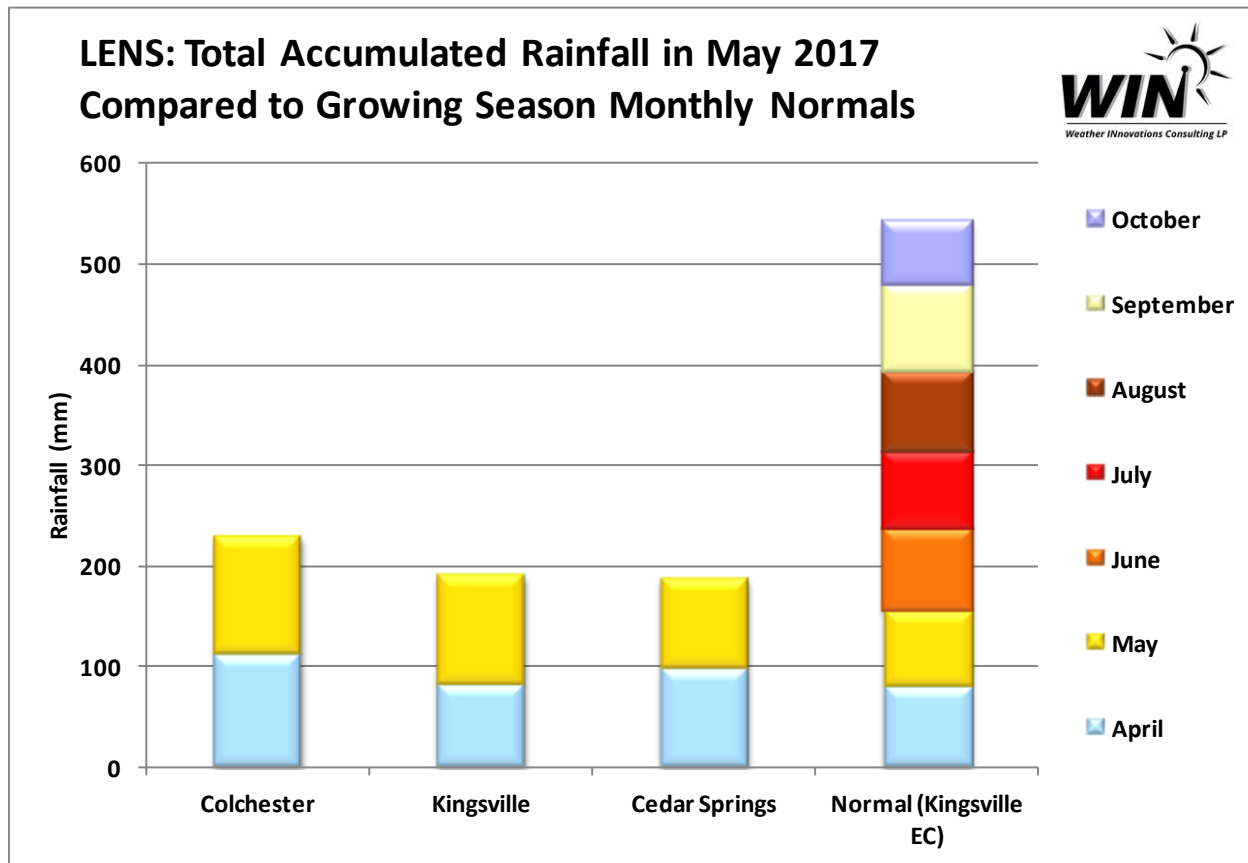


Figure 4: Rainfall
