



May 2018:

Daytime high temperatures and overnight low temperatures were above normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for May. Season accumulated growing degree days were above 2016 and 2017 values, ending near normal for Cedar Springs and above normal at Colchester and Kingsville. May rainfall averaged 202 % of normal across the appellation. Up to 106 mm of rain fell from May 8 through May 15. Cedar Springs recorded 50 mm of rainfall on May 12.

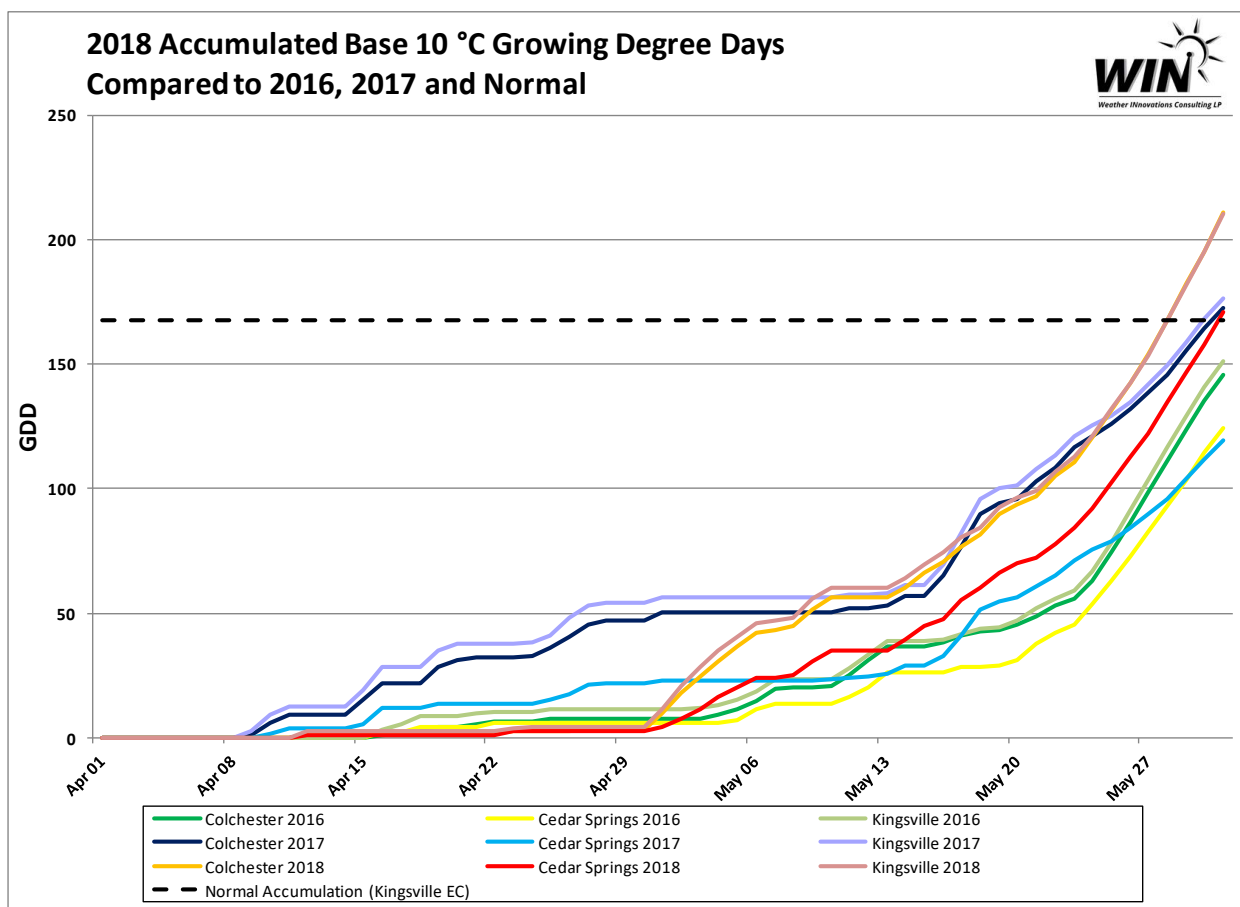


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

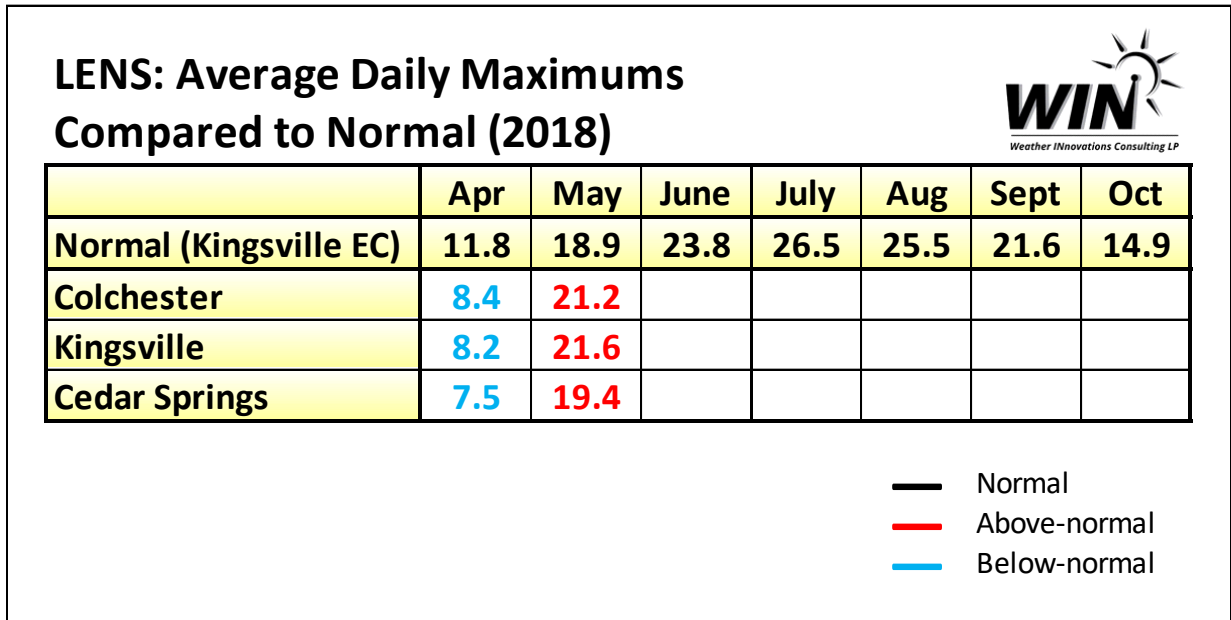


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

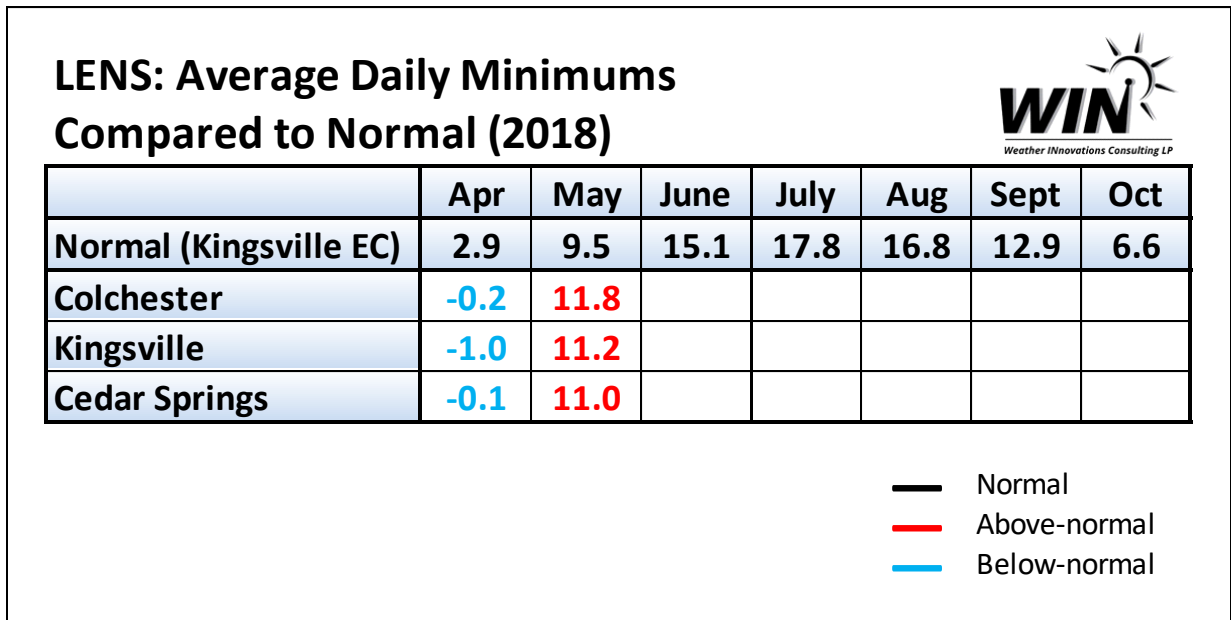


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

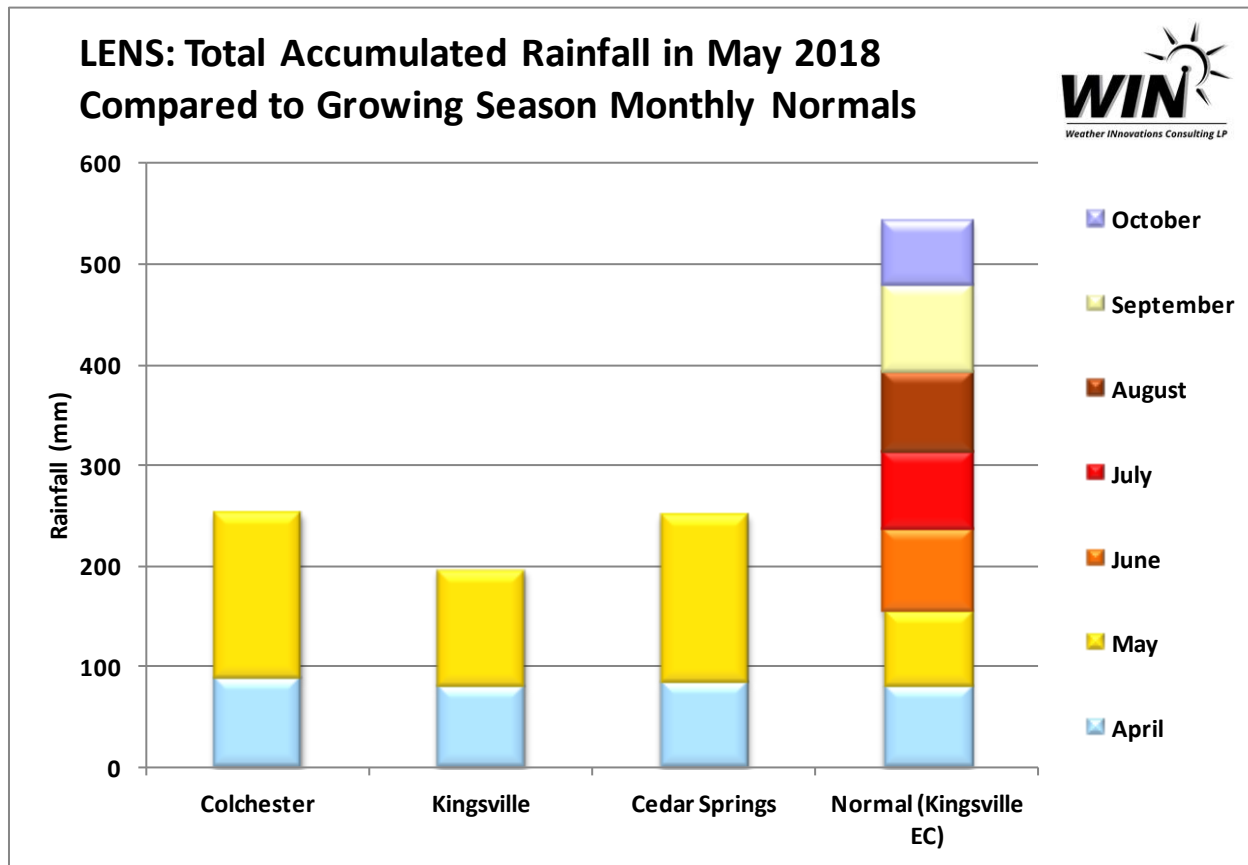


Figure 4: Rainfall
