



### May 2015:

Daytime highs averaged above normal at Colchester and Kingsville while daytime highs at Cedar Springs averaged slightly below normal. Overnight lows averaged above normal values for May across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal at Colchester and Kingsville for the month, while Cedar Springs was below normal. Season accumulated growing degree days were above 2013 and 2014 values at Colchester and Cedar Springs, and lower than 2013 but near 2014 values at Kingsville. May rainfall averaged 200 % of normal across the appellation. Areas recorded 60 – 100 mm of rain over May 29 – 31.

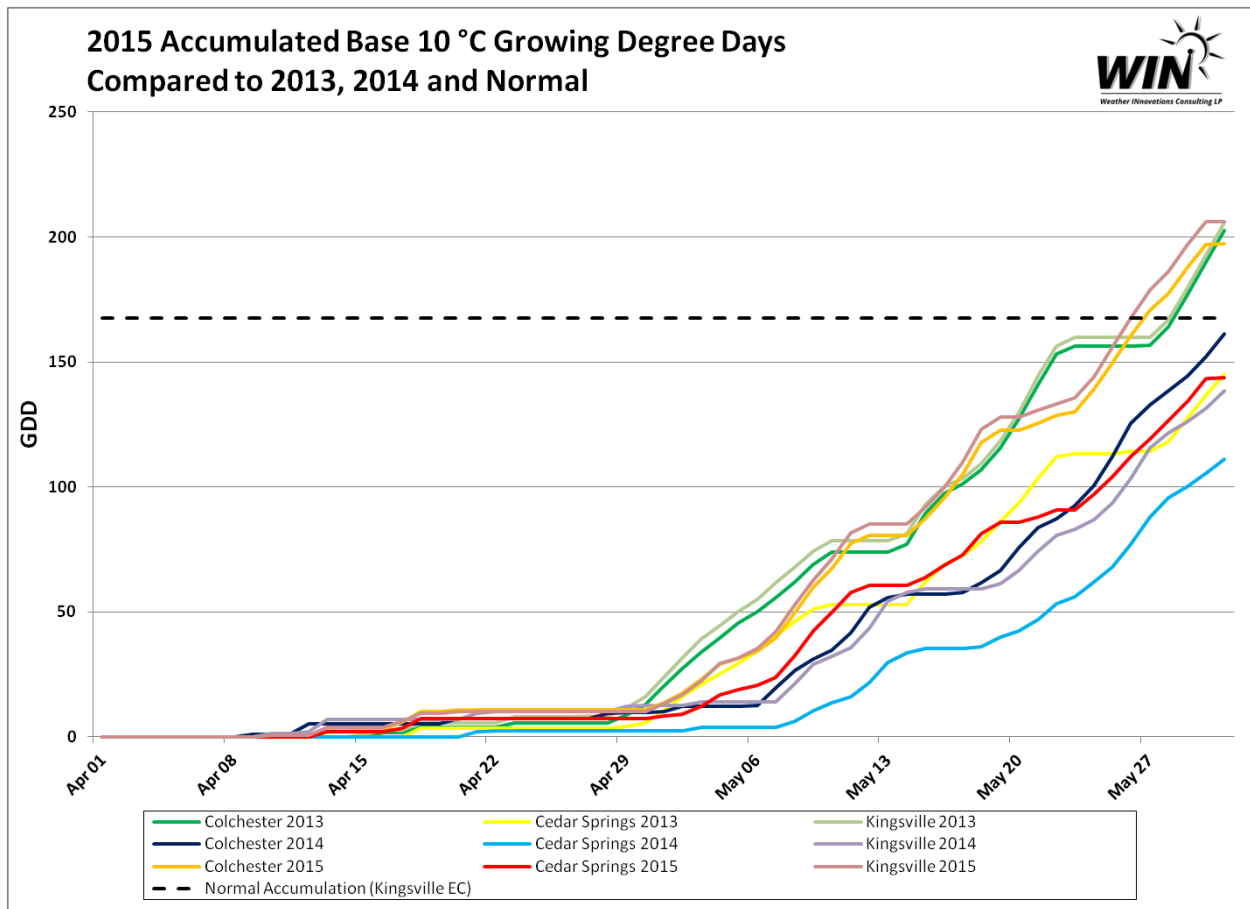


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

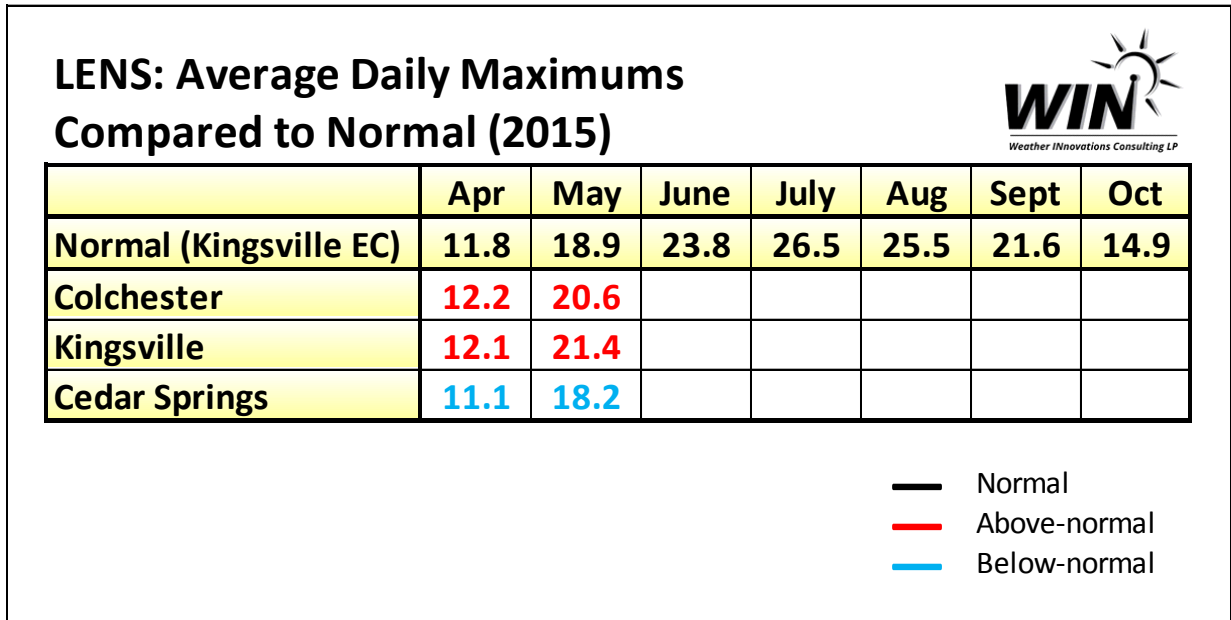


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

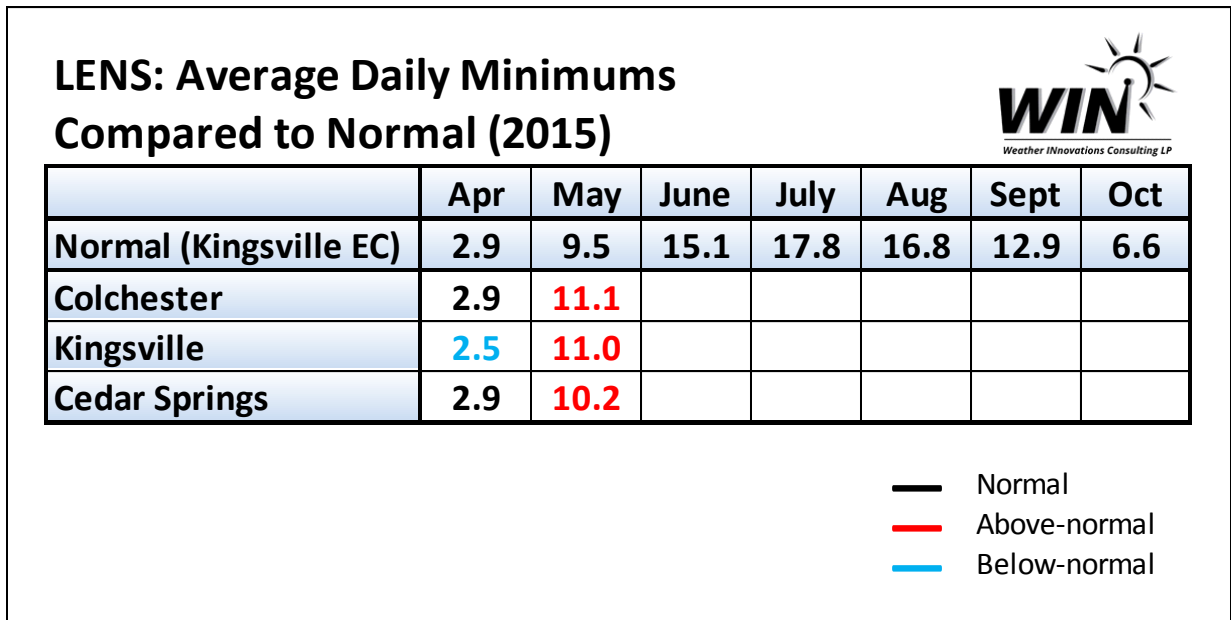


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

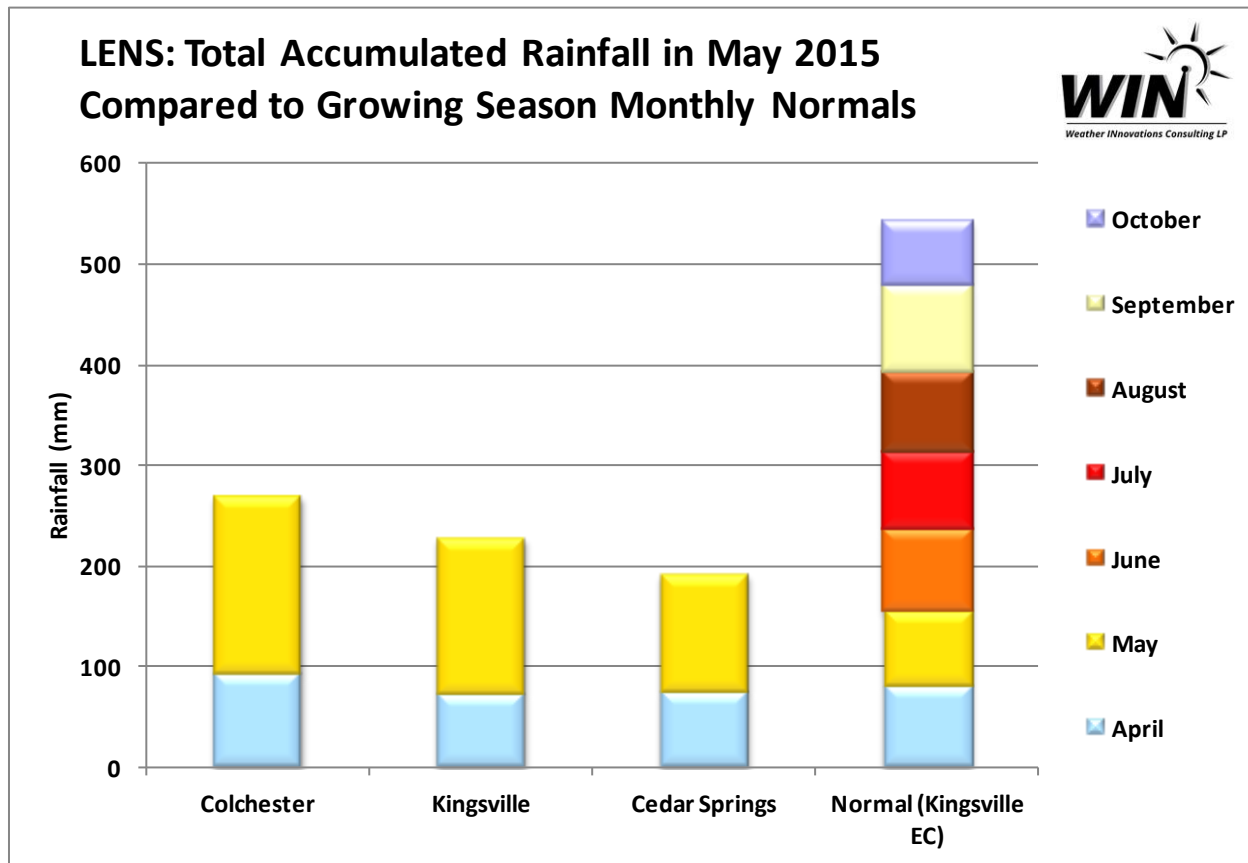


Figure 4: Rainfall
