



September 2017:

In September, daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation. Overnight low temperatures were below normal at Colchester and Kingsville and above normal at Cedar Springs. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were near normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days were below 2016 and near 2015 values across the appellation. September rainfall averaged 72 % of normal. Up to 56 mm of rain fell during September 18-19.

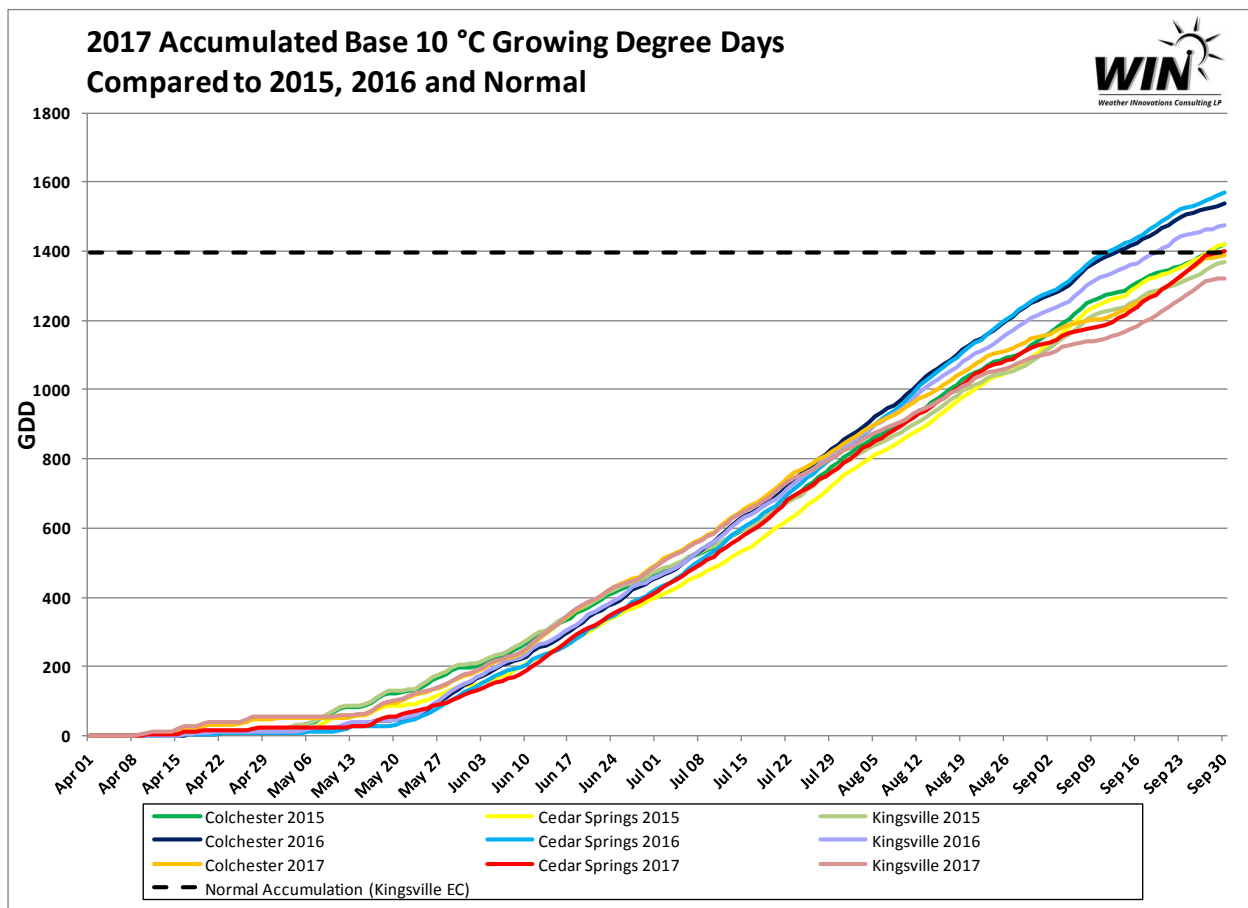


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

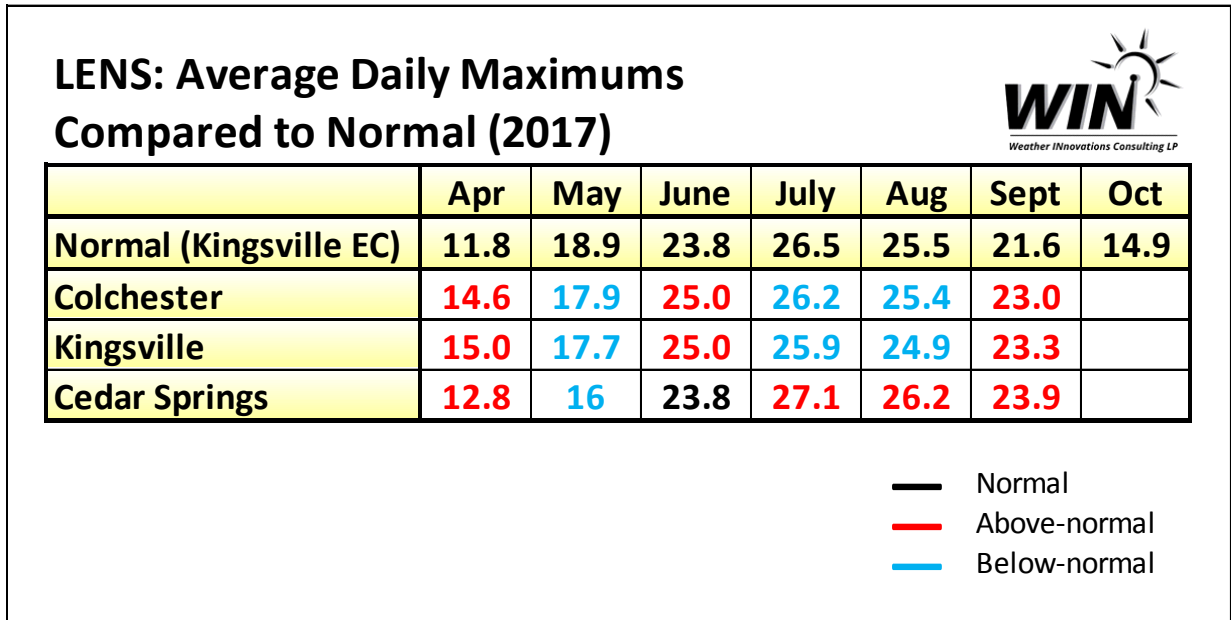


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

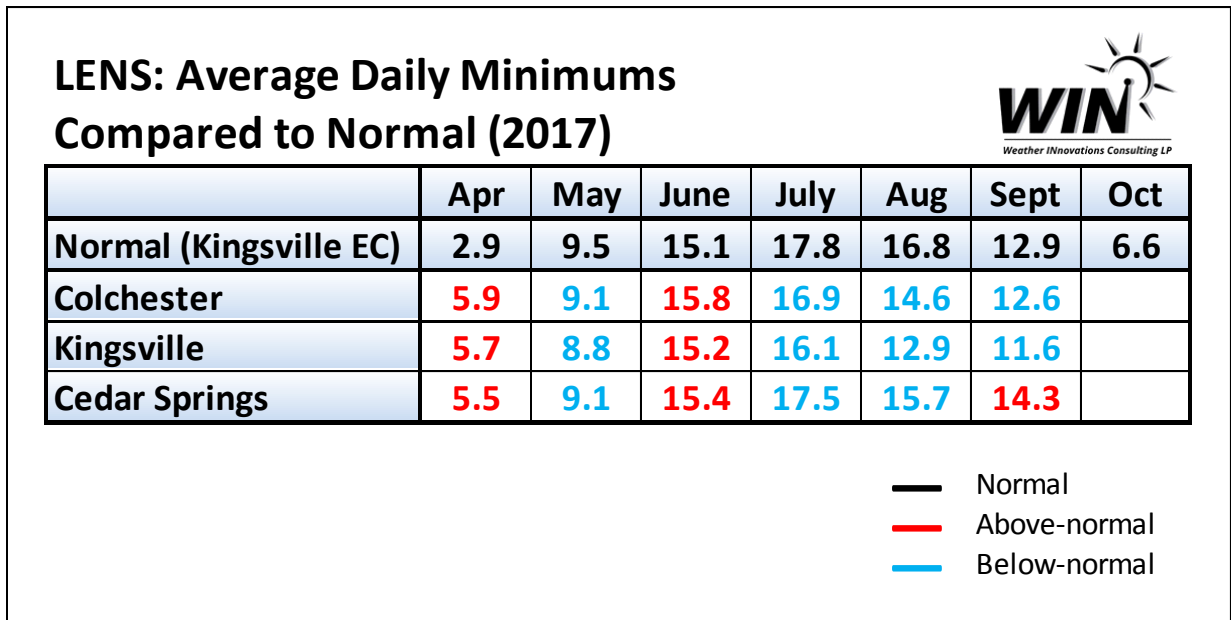


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

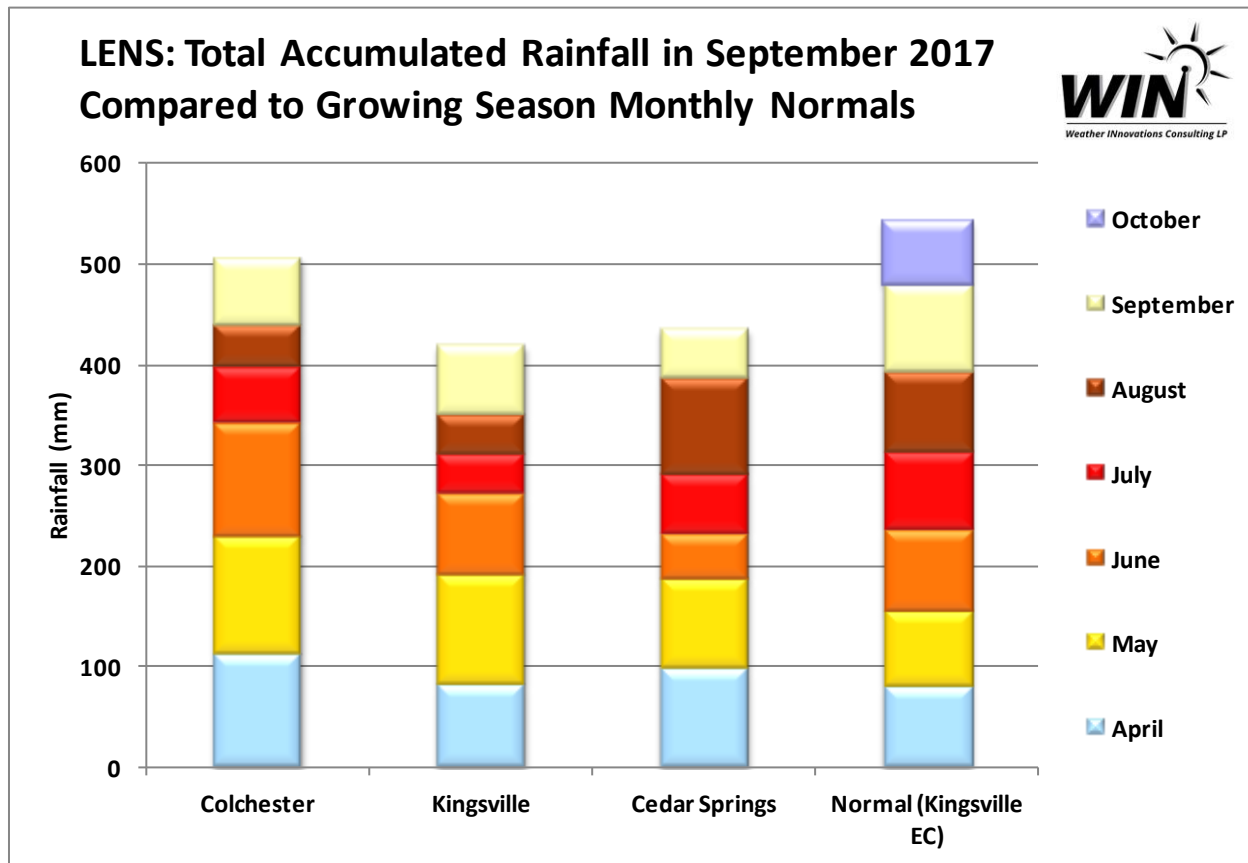


Figure 4: Rainfall
