



August 2016:

August daytime high and overnight low temperatures were above normal across the appellation. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for August. The growing degree day accumulation is above both 2014 and 2015 values at Vineland and Virgil. Niagara west received an average of 88 % of normal precipitation in August while Niagara East received 103 % of normal precipitation. Up to 57 mm of rainfall fell over August 12 to 13.

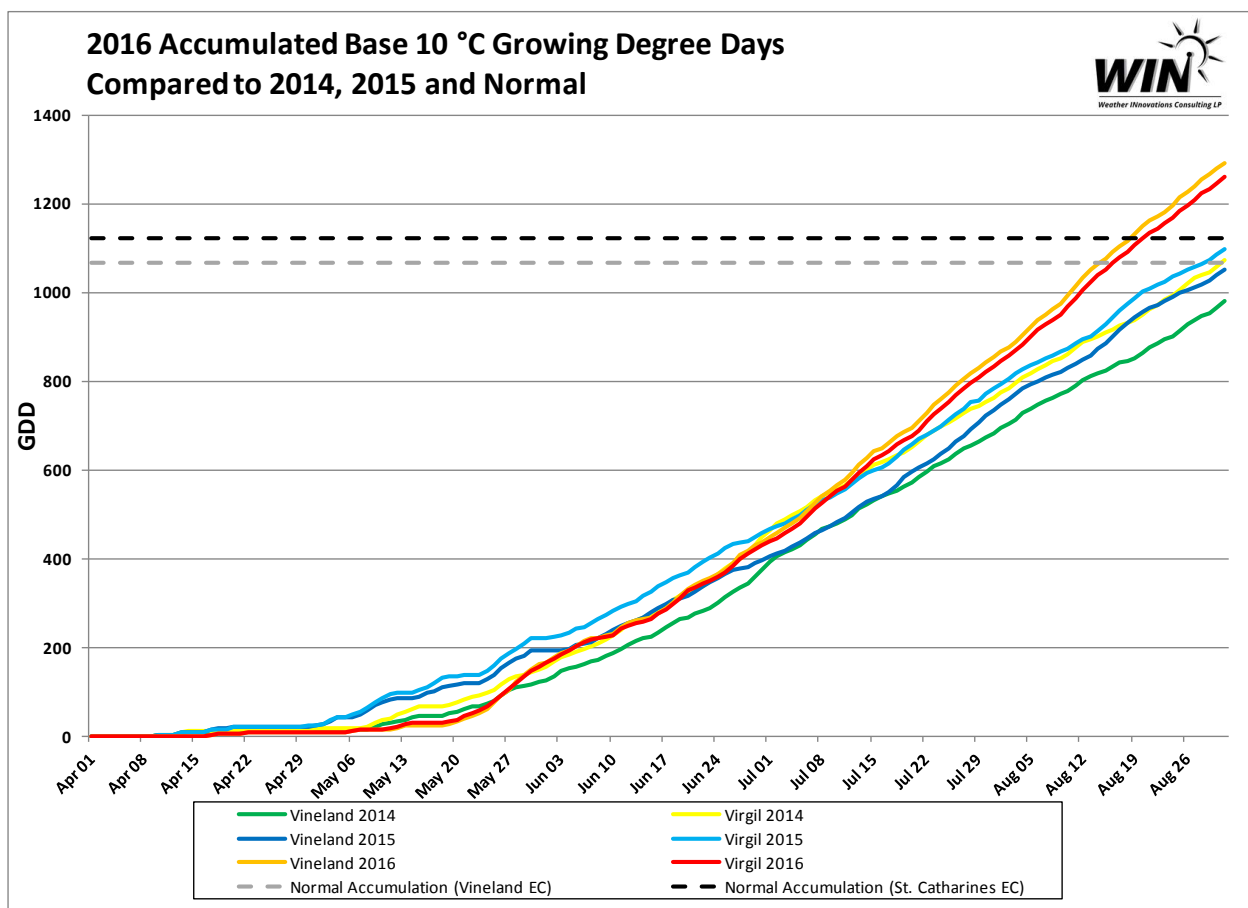


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

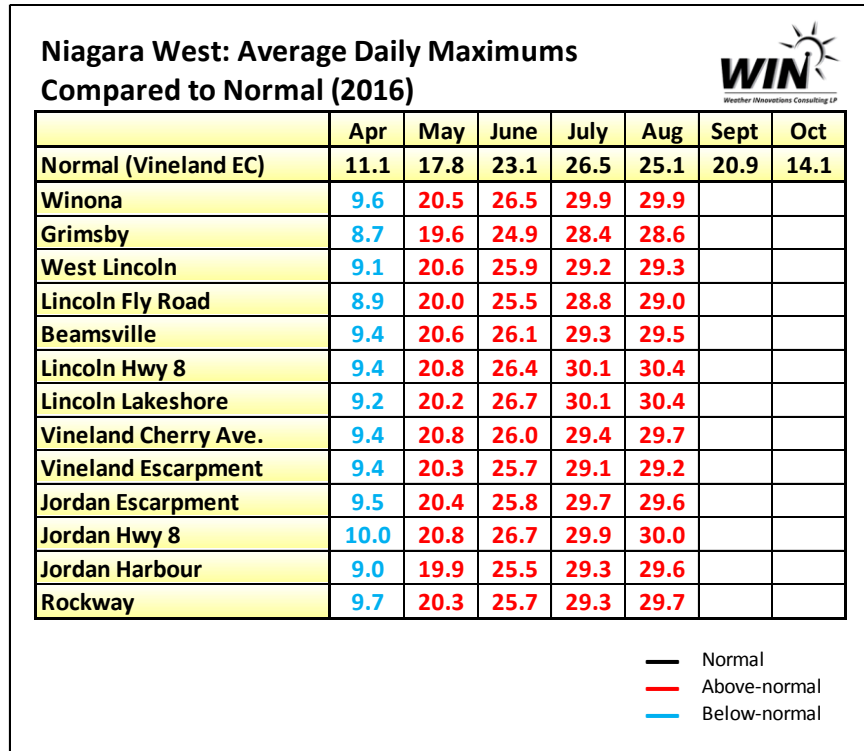


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

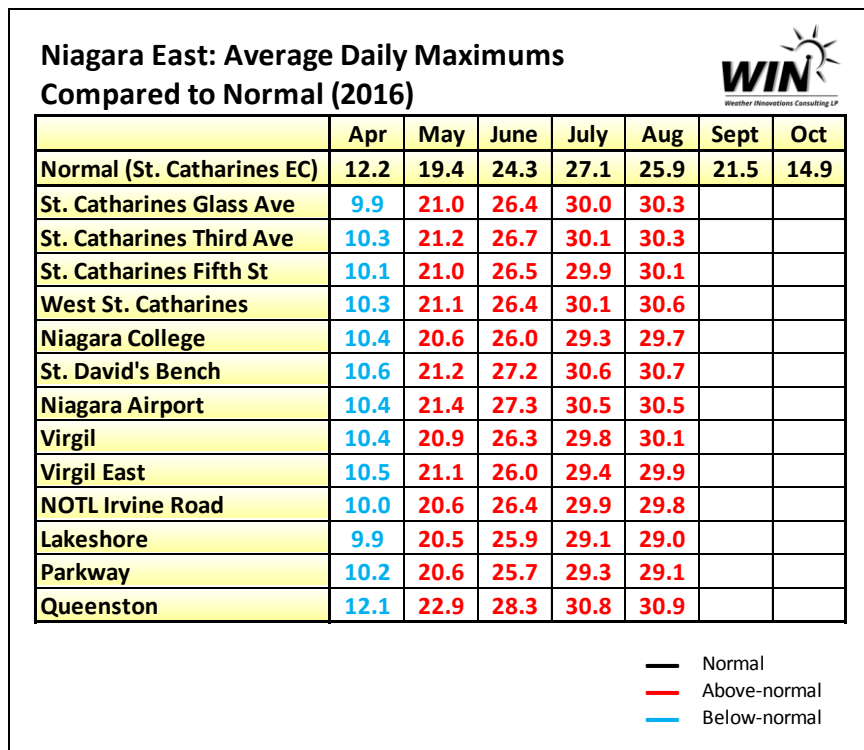


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

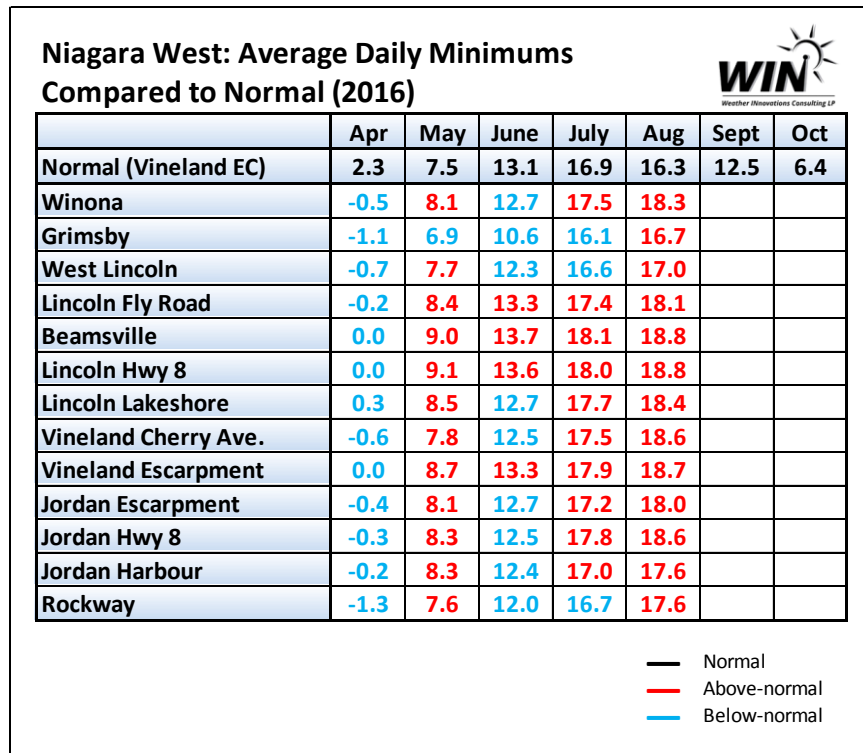


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

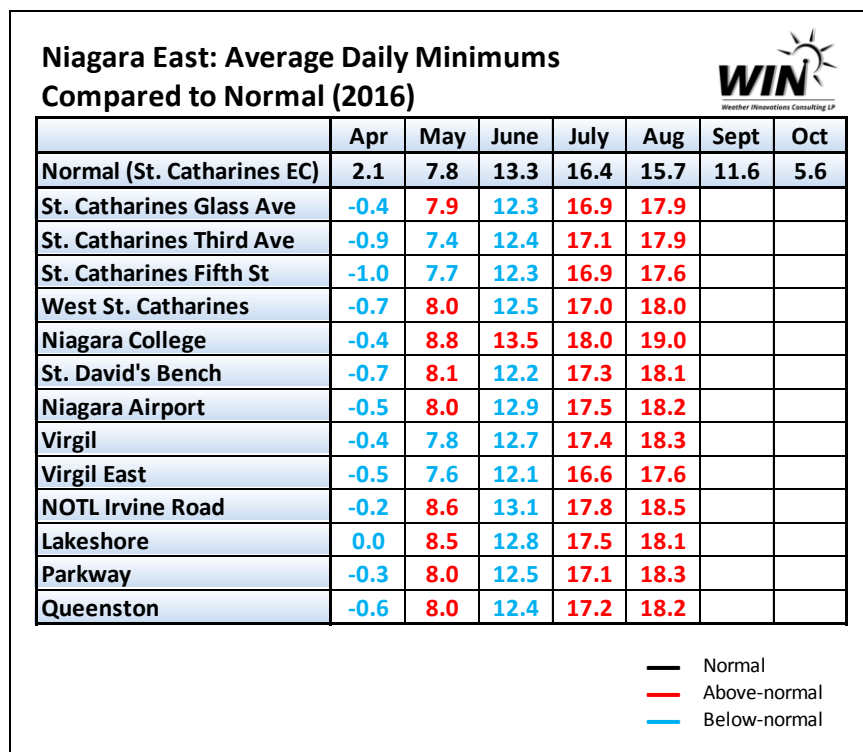


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

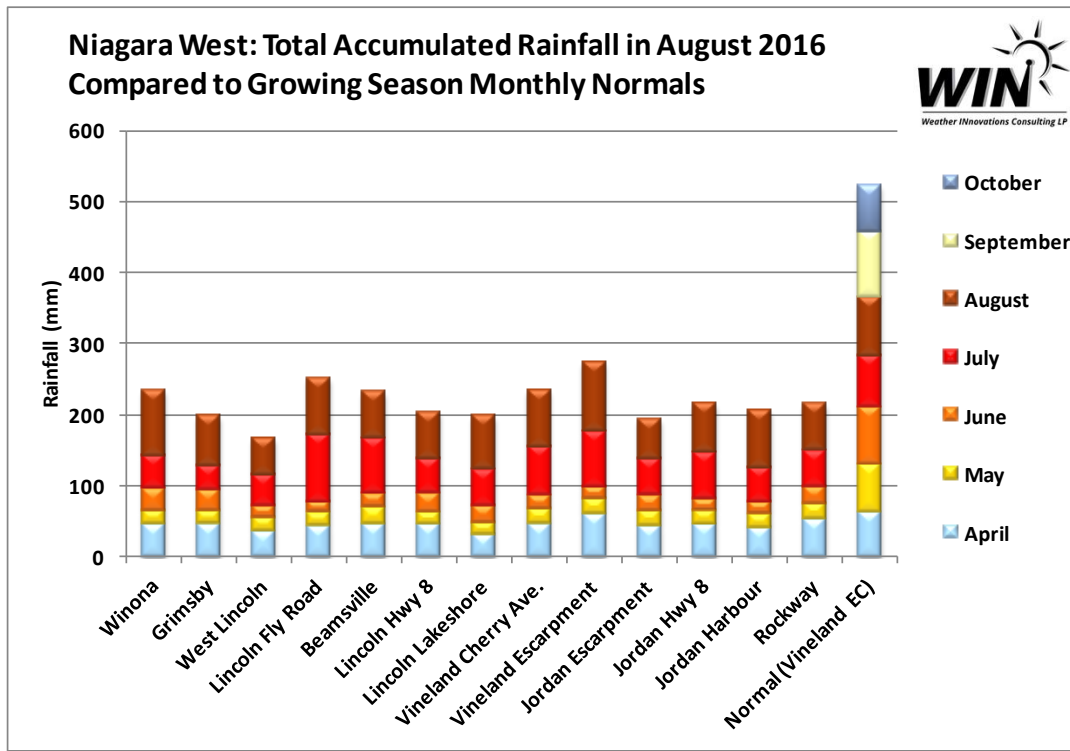


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

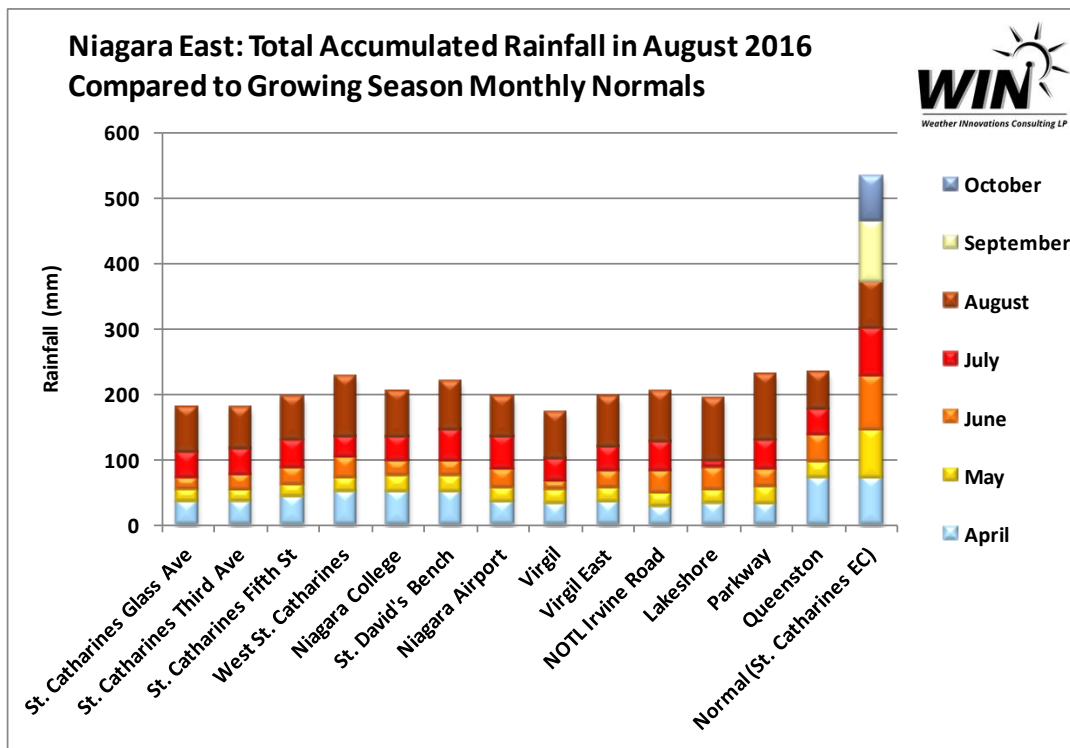


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
