



August 2017:

August daytime high temperatures were near-to-above normal across the appellation. Overnight low temperatures were below normal. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for August. The growing degree day accumulation is below 2016 and near 2015 values at Vineland and Virgil. Niagara west received an average of 104 % of normal precipitation in August while Niagara East received 101 % of normal precipitation. Up to 52.6 mm of rainfall fell over August 3 to 4.

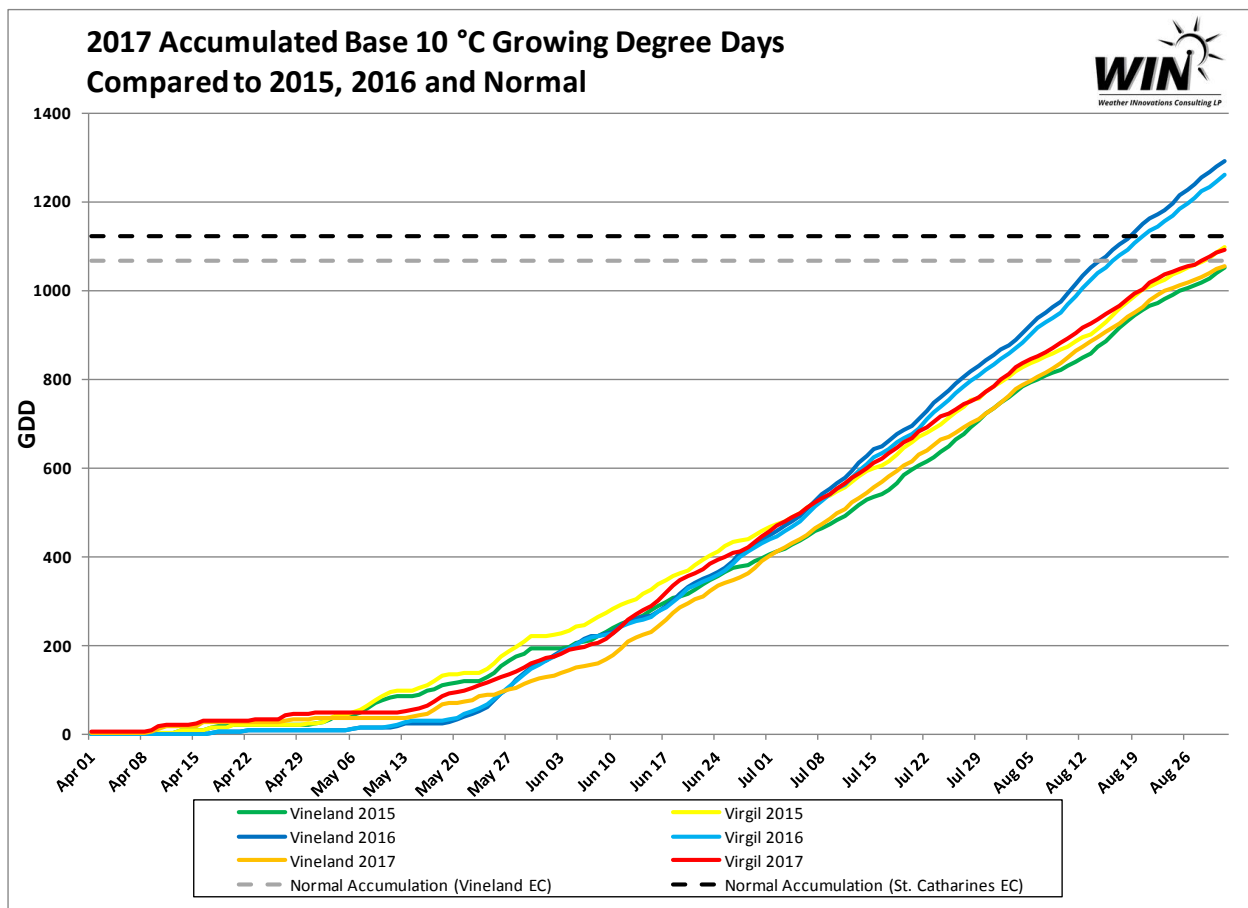


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

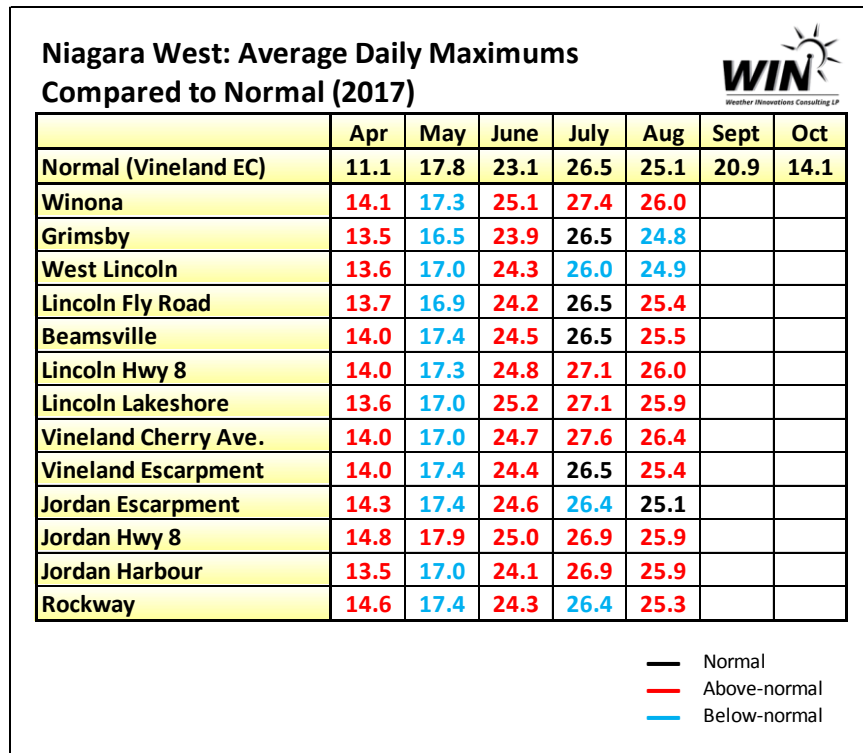


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

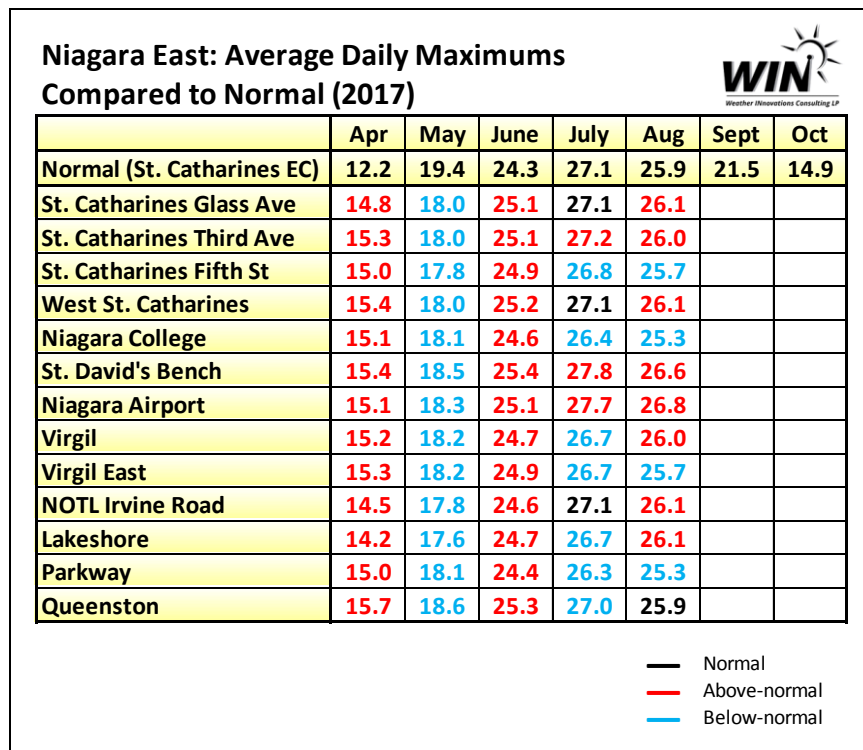


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

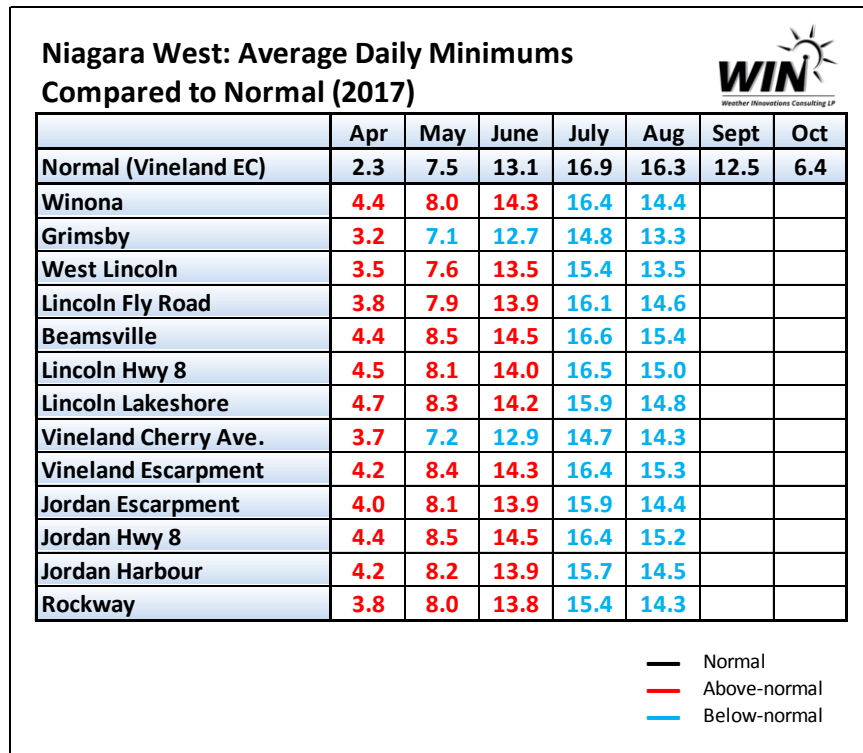


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

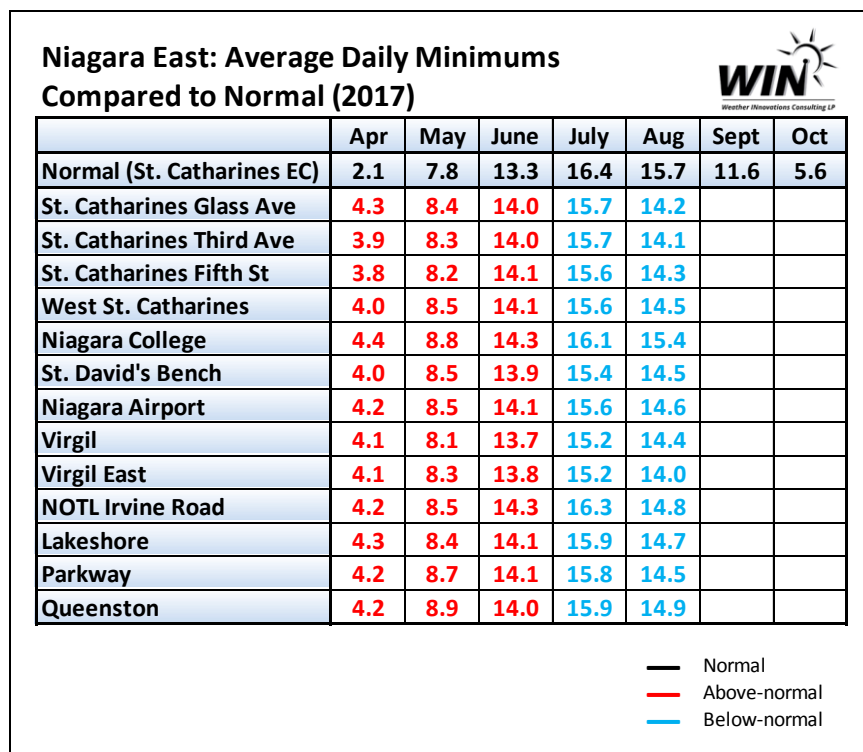


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

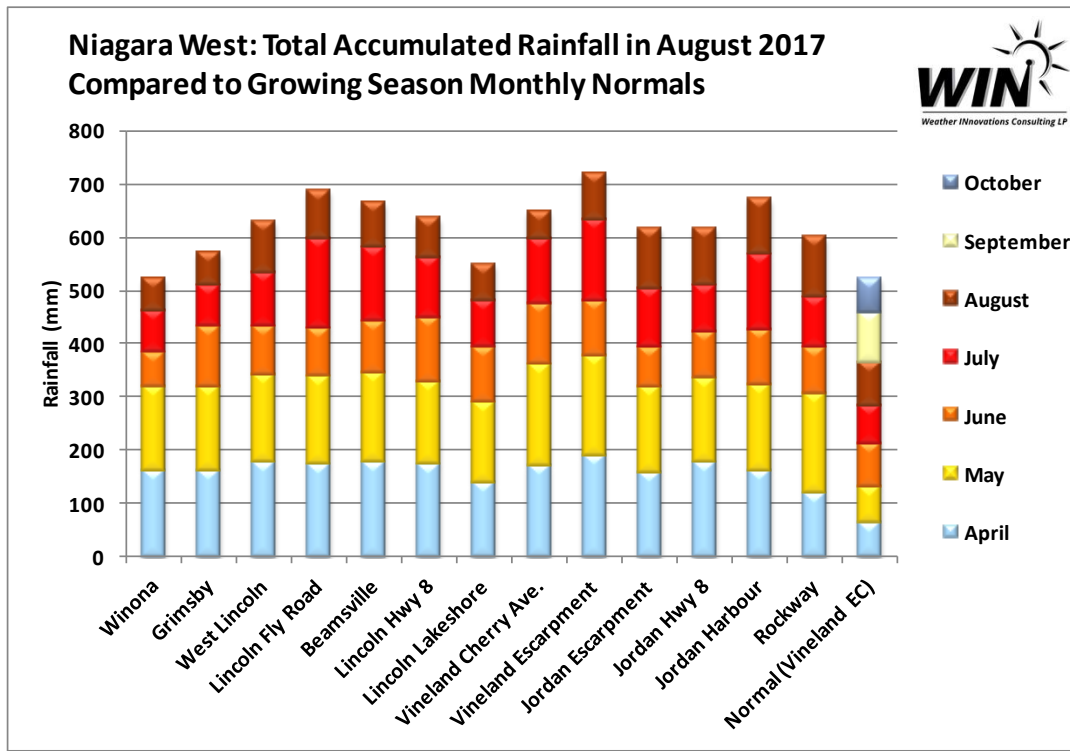


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

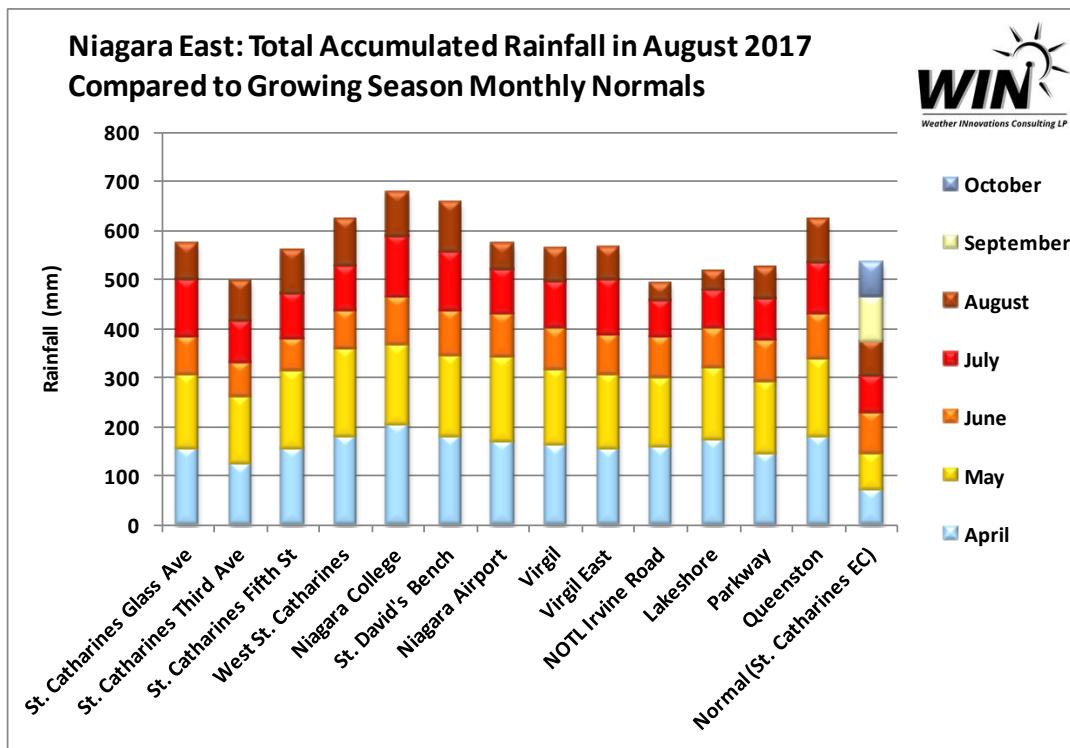


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
