



August 2014:

August daytime high temperatures returned to near-normal values. Overnight low temperatures remained below normal across the appellation. As a result, July accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days remained below normal. Seasonal growing degree days accumulation continued to remain below normal values and lag behind accumulated values from 2012 and 2013. August was relatively dry across the Niagara Appellation as Niagara West received on average 23 % normal rainfall. Niagara East on average received 37 % normal rainfall.

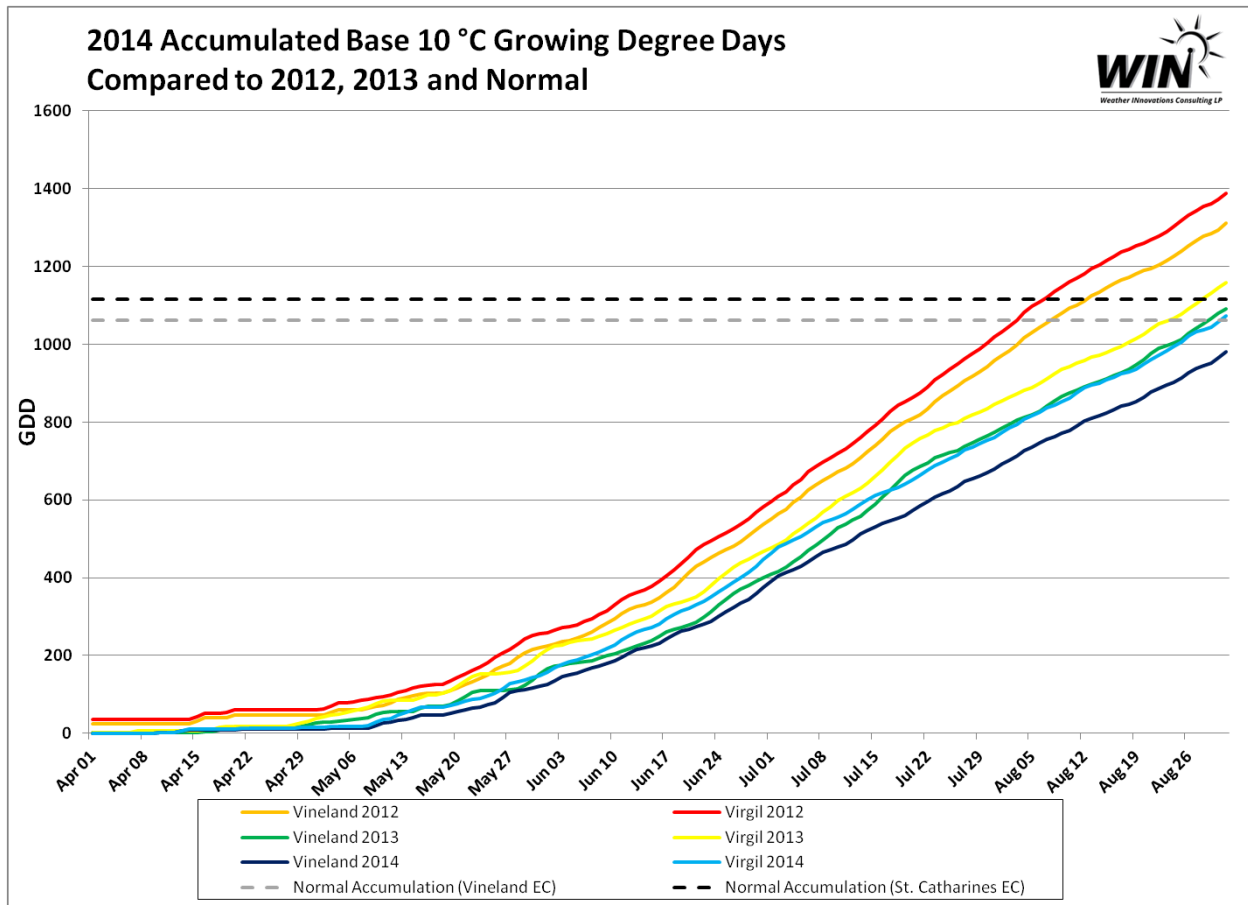


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

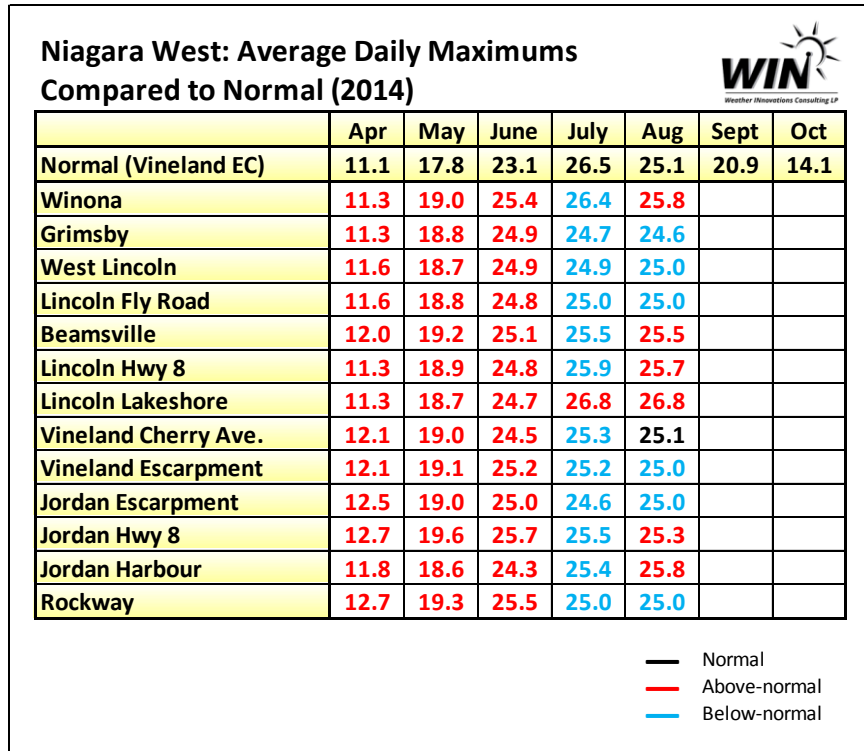


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

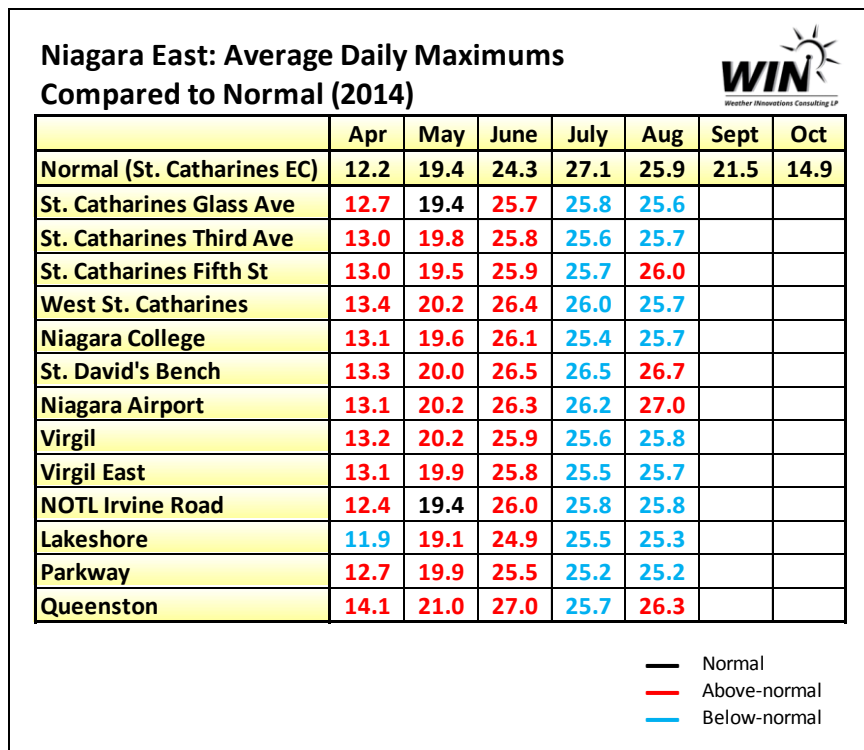


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

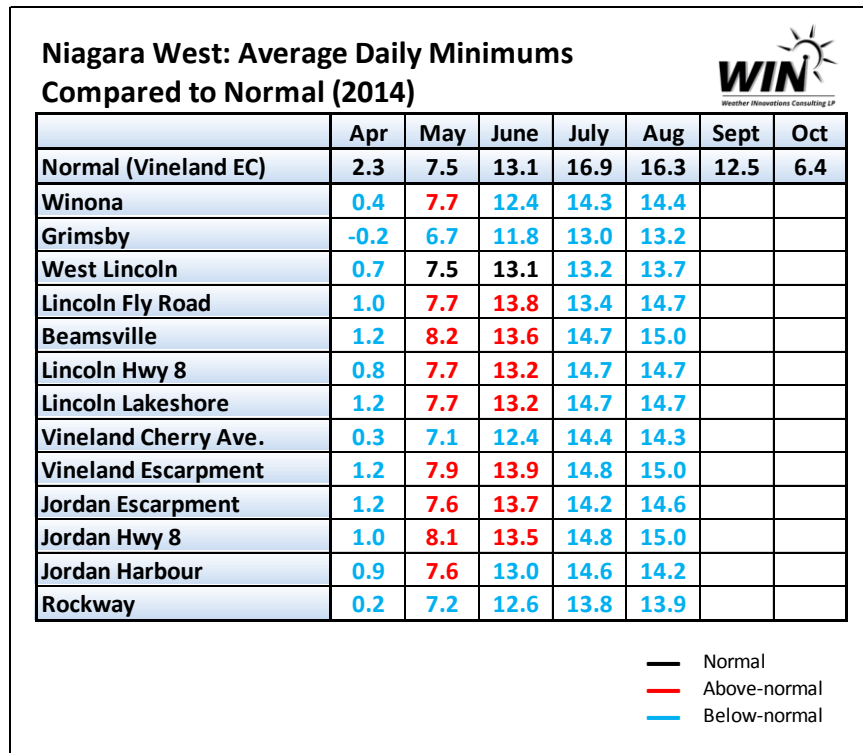


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

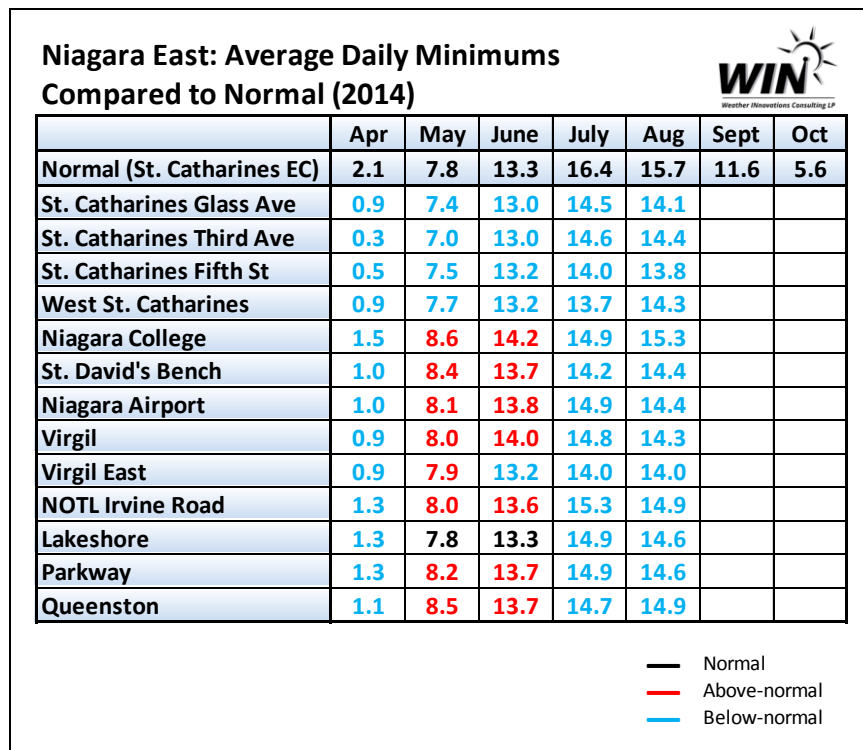


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

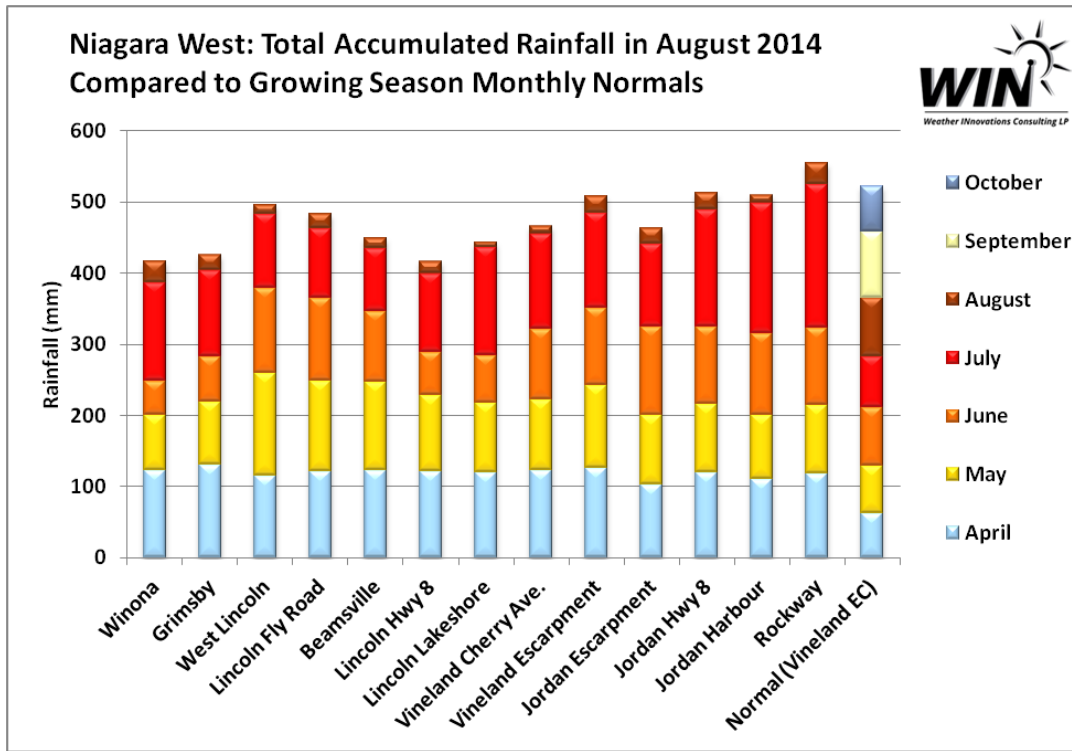


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

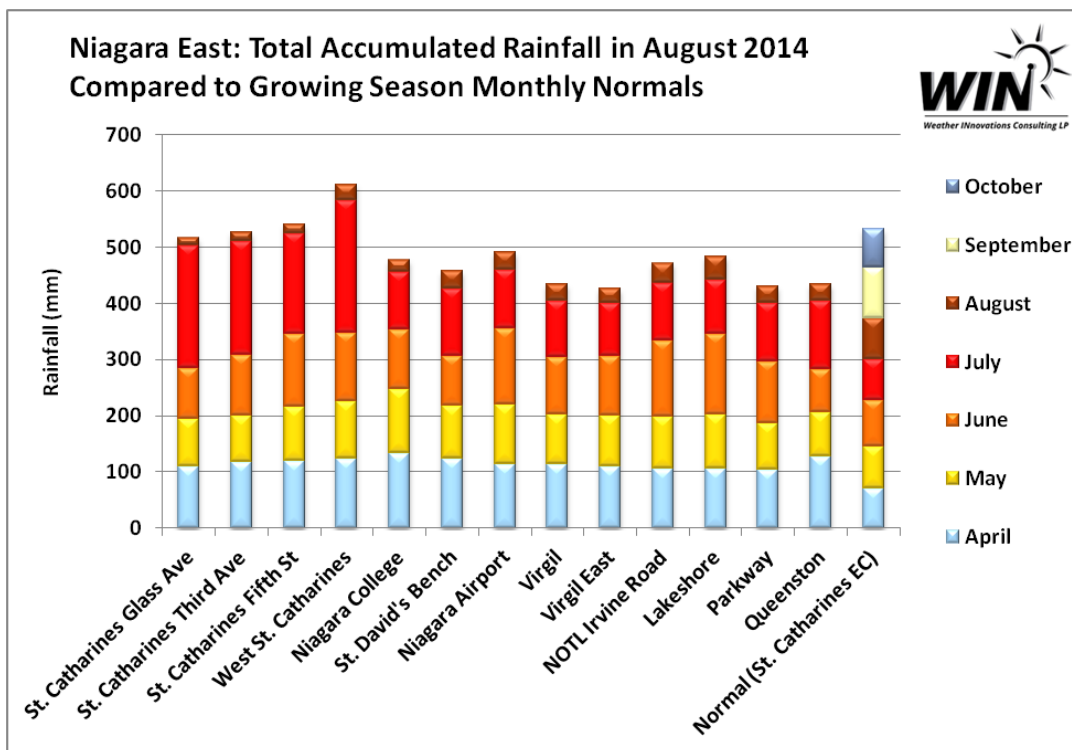


Figure 6: Niagara East - Rainfall
