



### July 2017:

July daytime high and overnight low temperatures were near normal across the appellation. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were near normal for July. The growing degree day accumulation is above 2015 values and below 2016 values at Vineland and Virgil. Niagara west received an average of 158 % of normal precipitation in July while Niagara East received 132 % of normal precipitation. Up to 44 mm of localized rainfall fell over July 12 - 13.

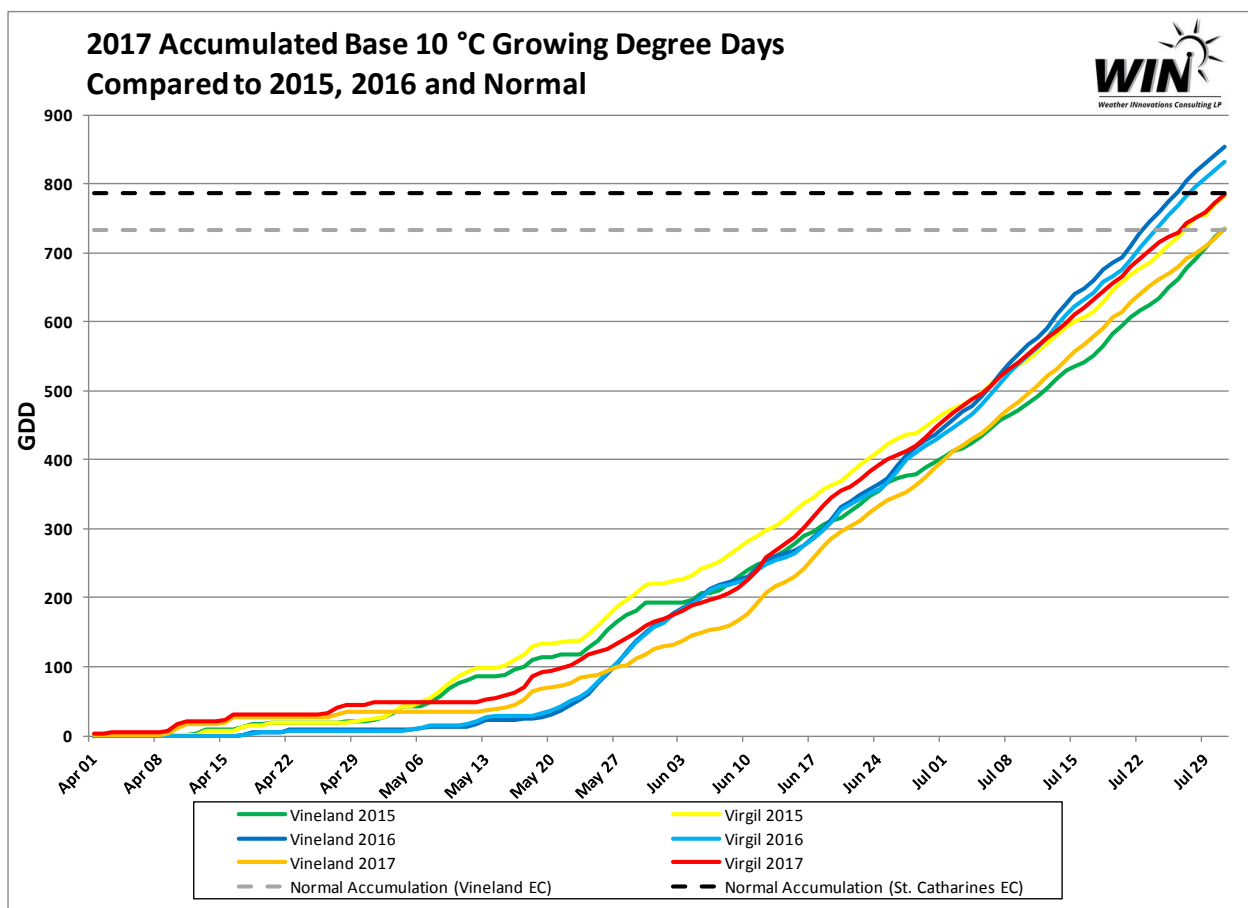


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

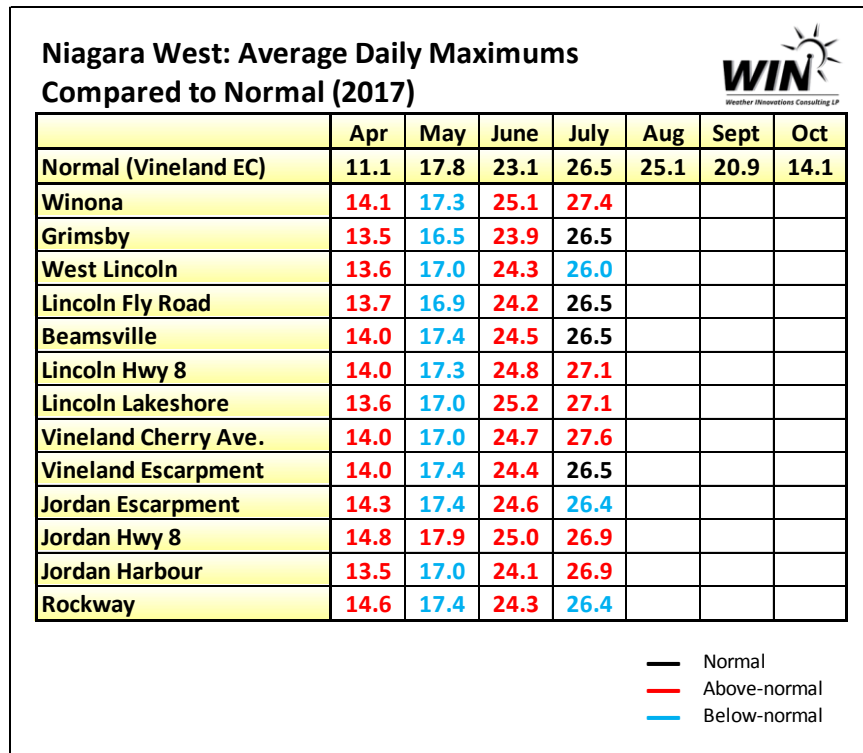


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

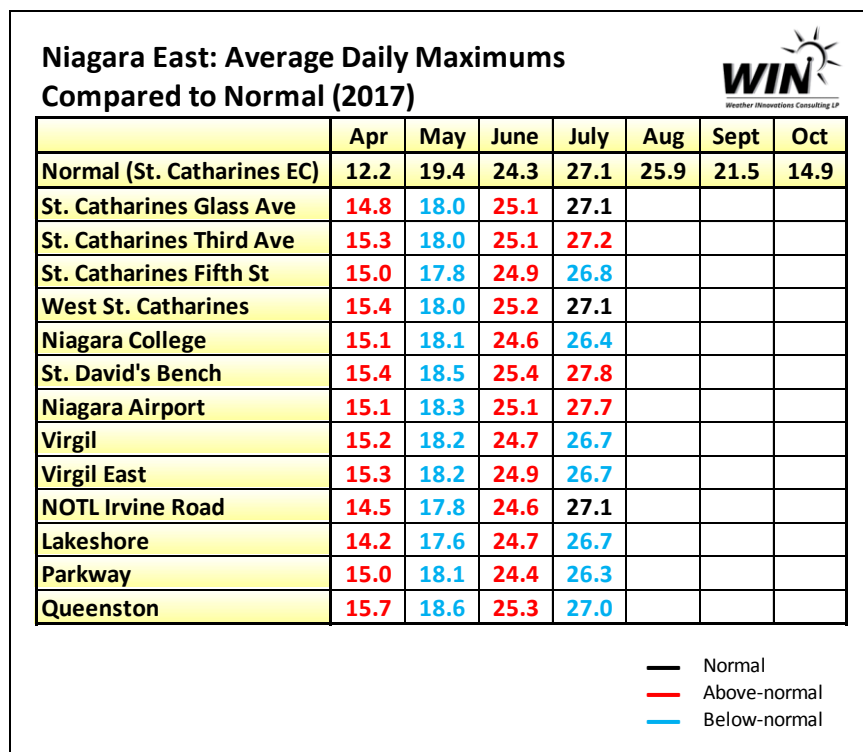


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

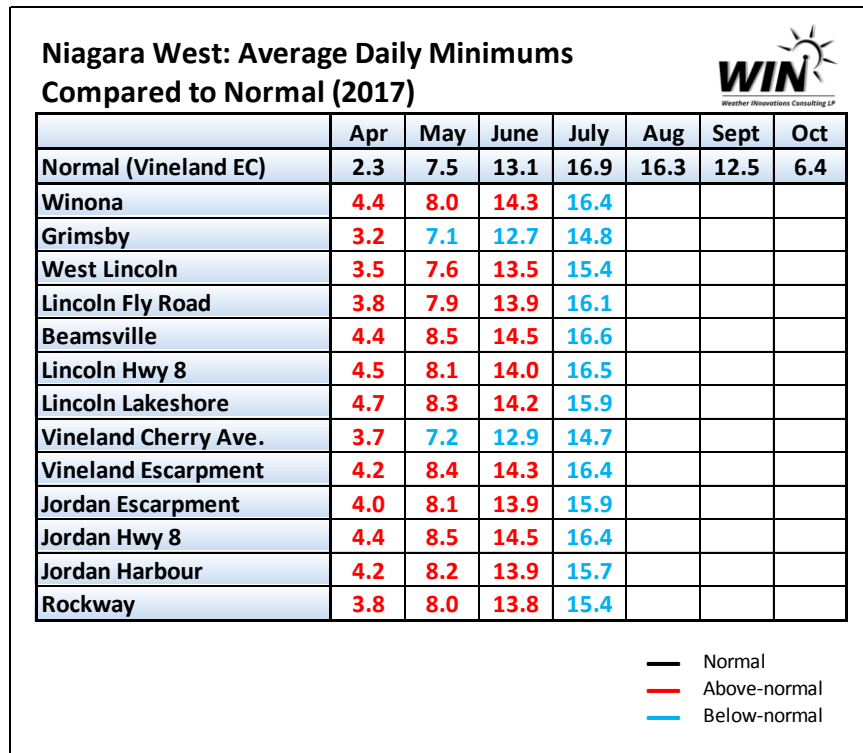


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

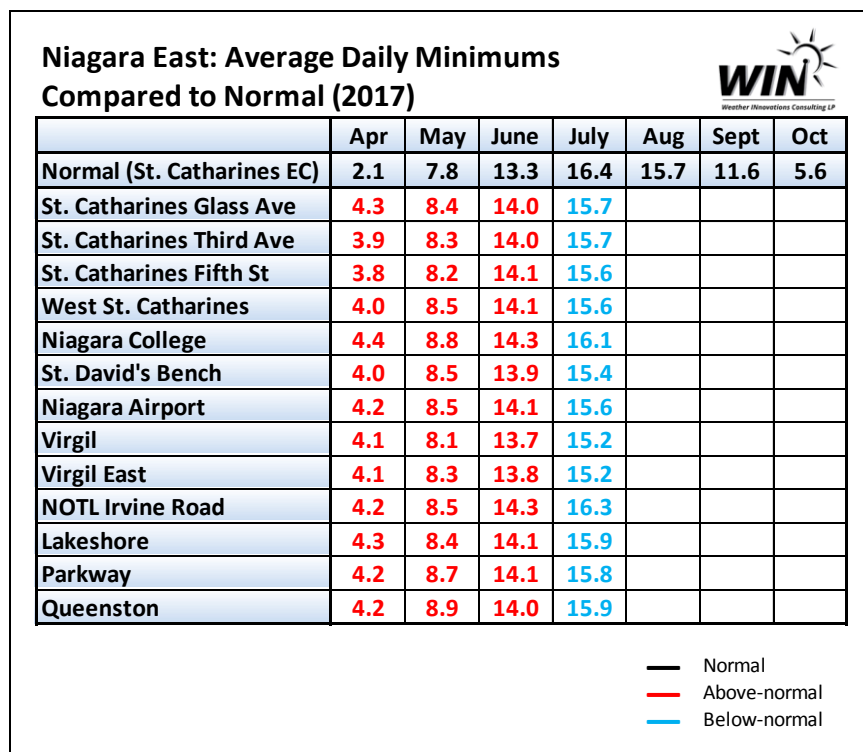


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

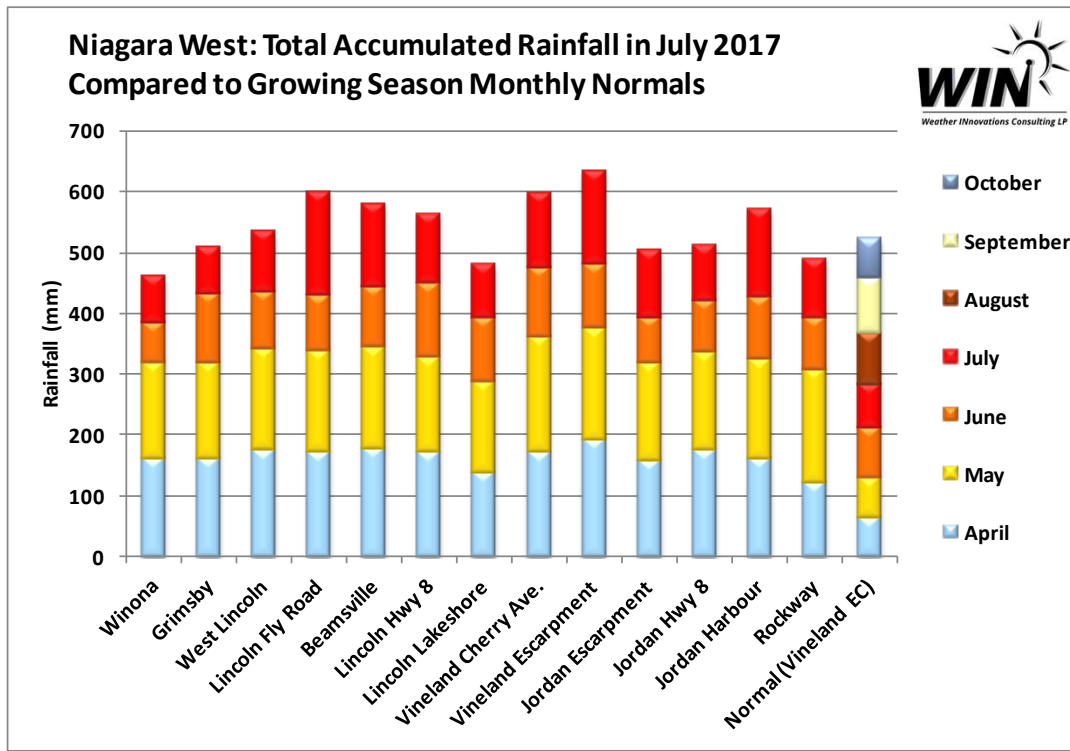


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

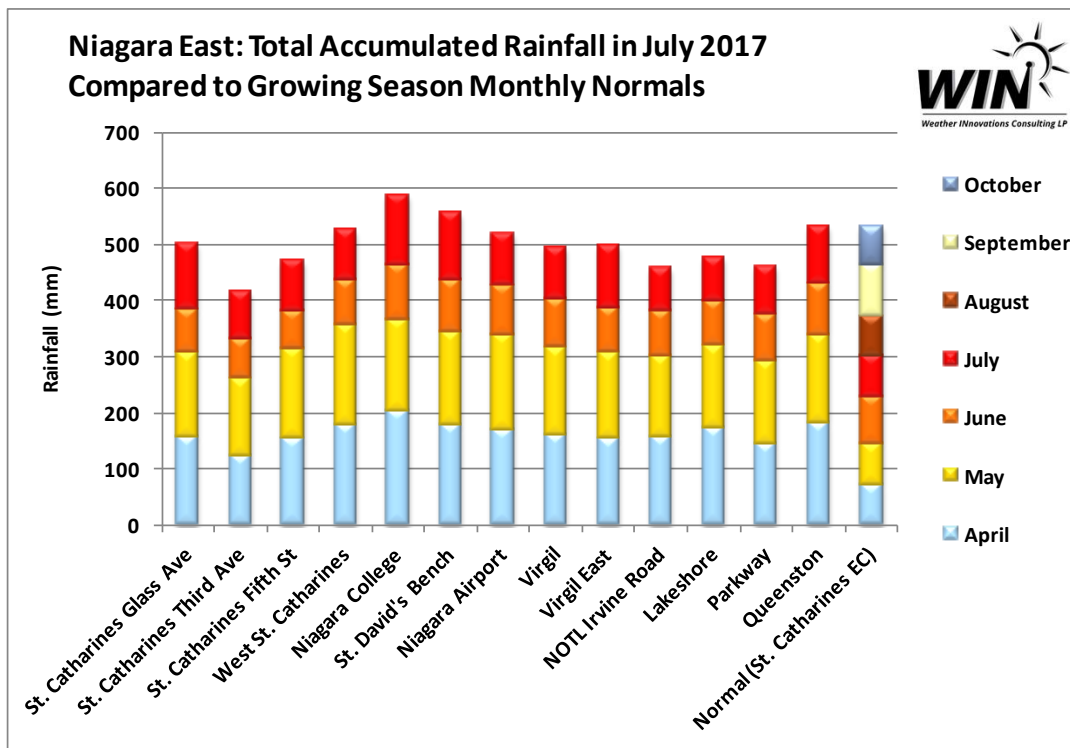


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
