



June 2016:

June daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation while overnight low temperatures were below to near normal. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for June. The growing degree day accumulation remains behind the 2015 growing season at Virgil but rose above the 2014 and 2015 growing seasons at Vineland. Little rainfall fell during June with an average of 33 % of the monthly precipitation total falling across the appellation over the month.

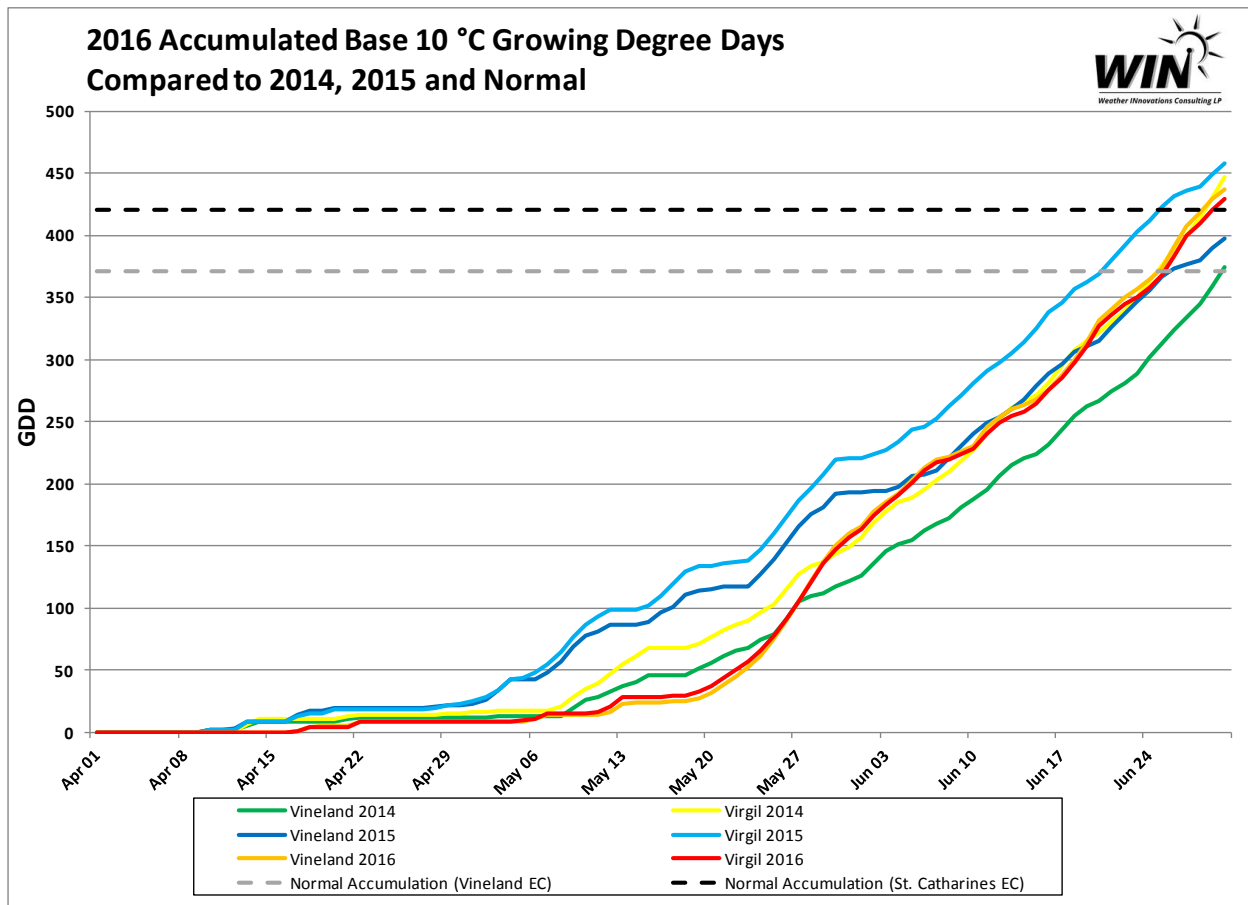


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

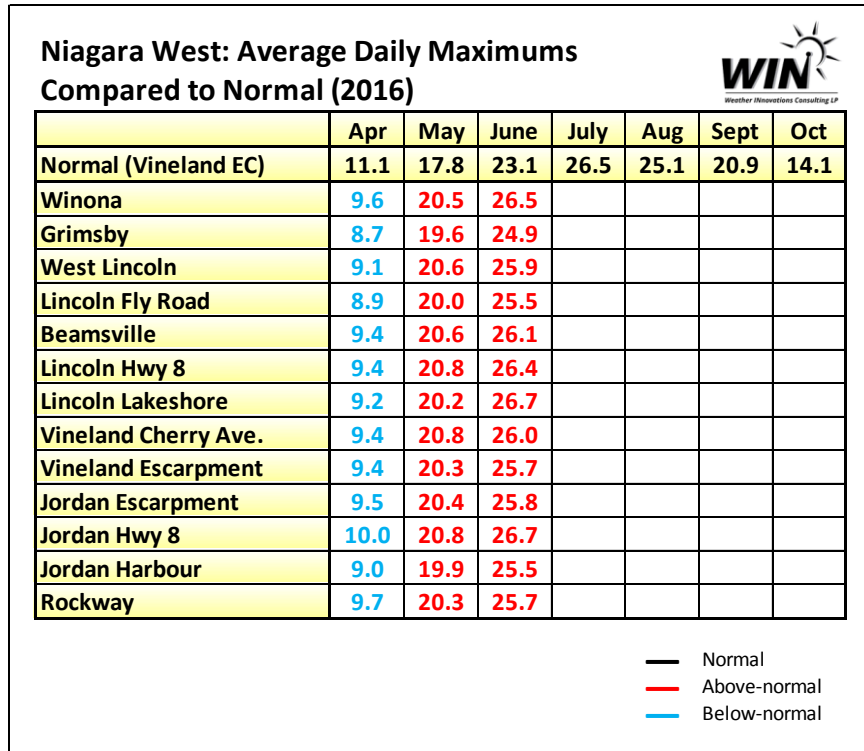


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

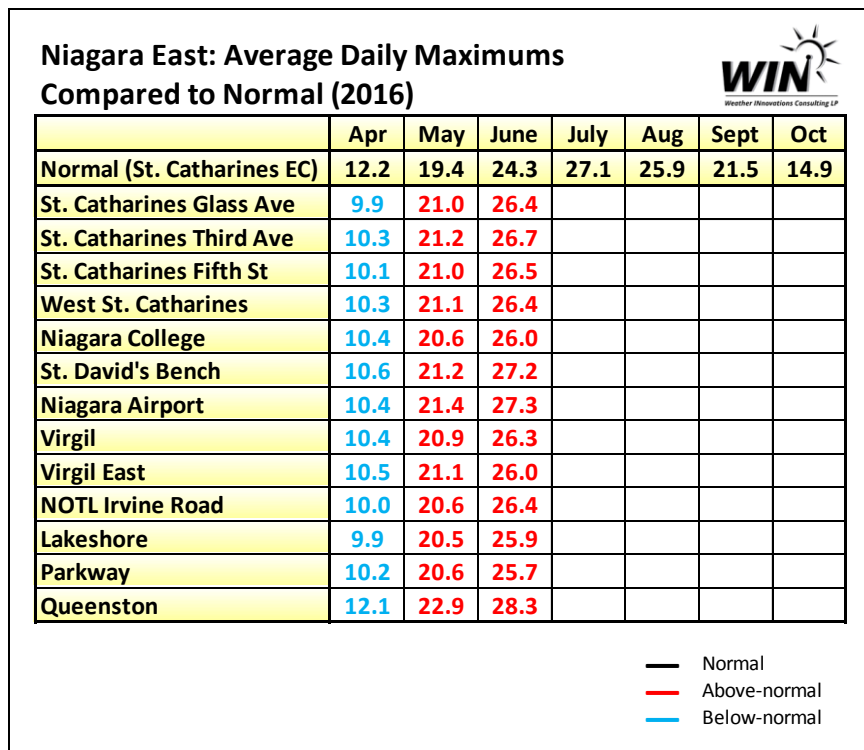


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

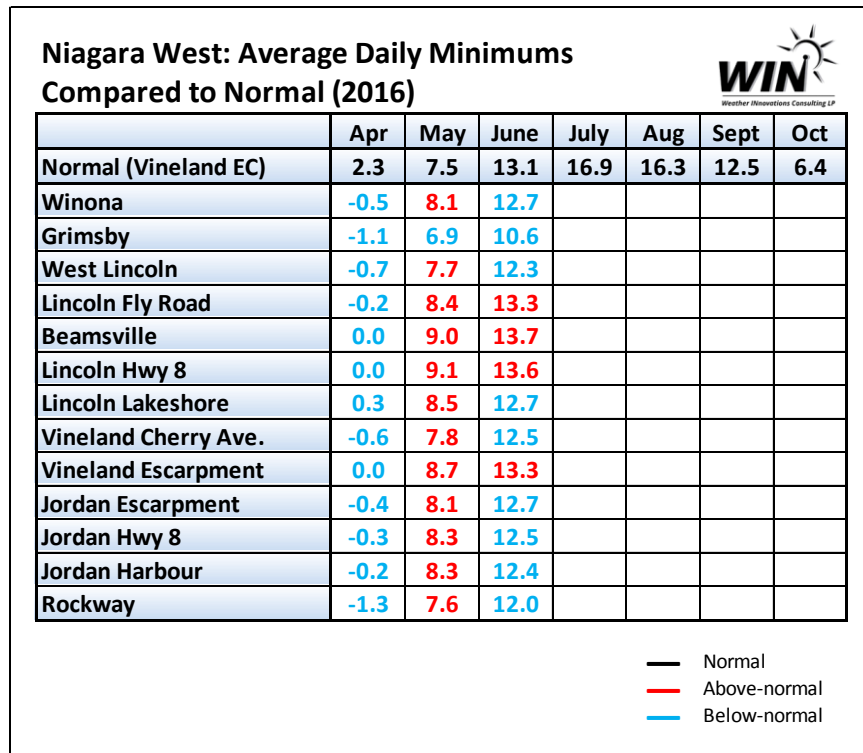


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

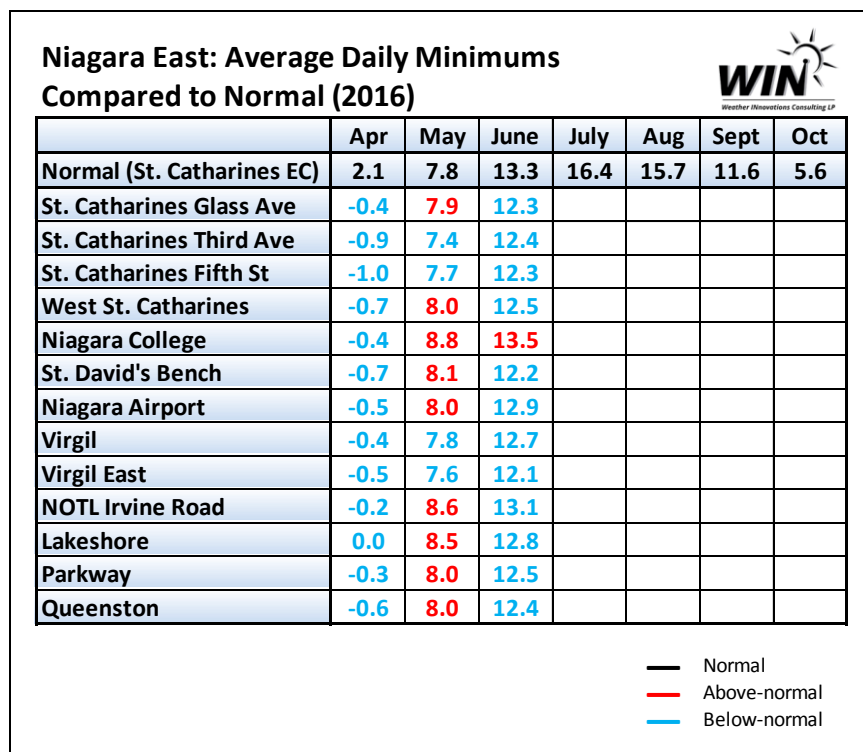


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

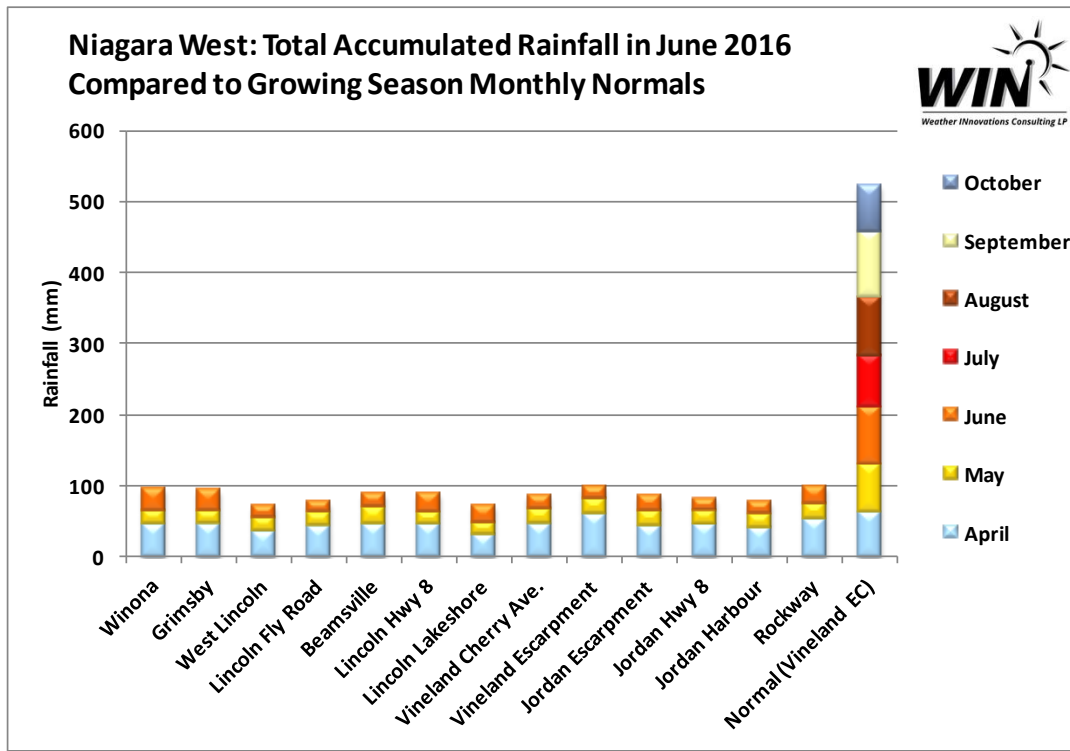


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

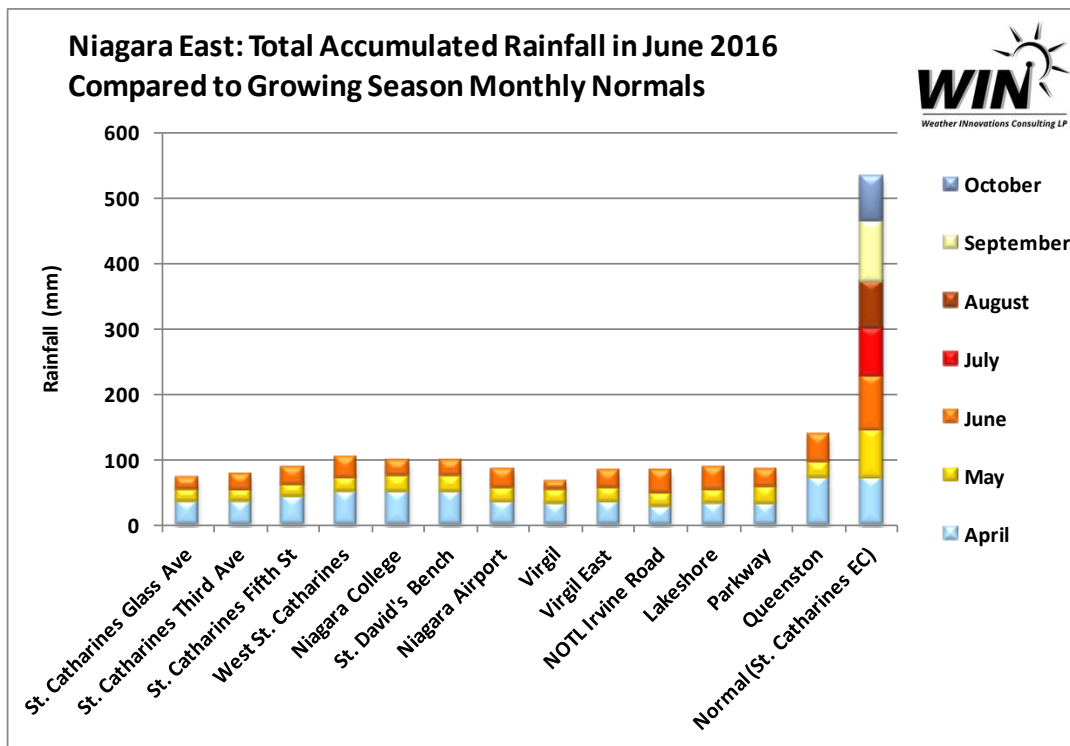


Figure 6: Niagara East - Rainfall
