



June 2017:

June daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation while overnight low temperatures were near to above normal. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for June. The growing degree day accumulation remains behind the 2015 and 2016 growing seasons at Virgil but remains above the 2016 and 2015 growing seasons at Vineland. Normal rainfall amounts fell during June. An average of 109 % of the monthly precipitation total was recorded across the appellation. Up to 44 mm of rain fell on June 23, accounting for 54 % of the monthly normal.

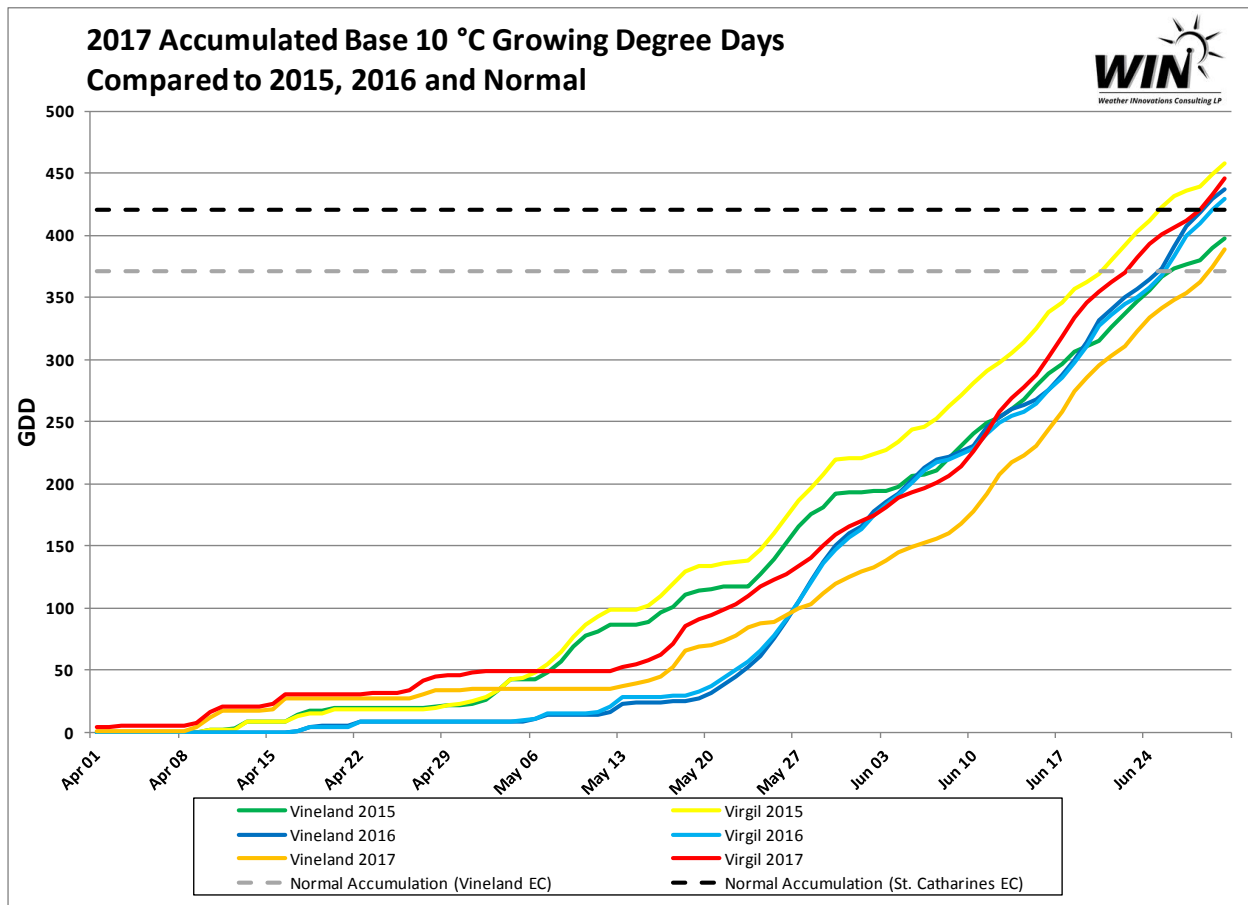


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

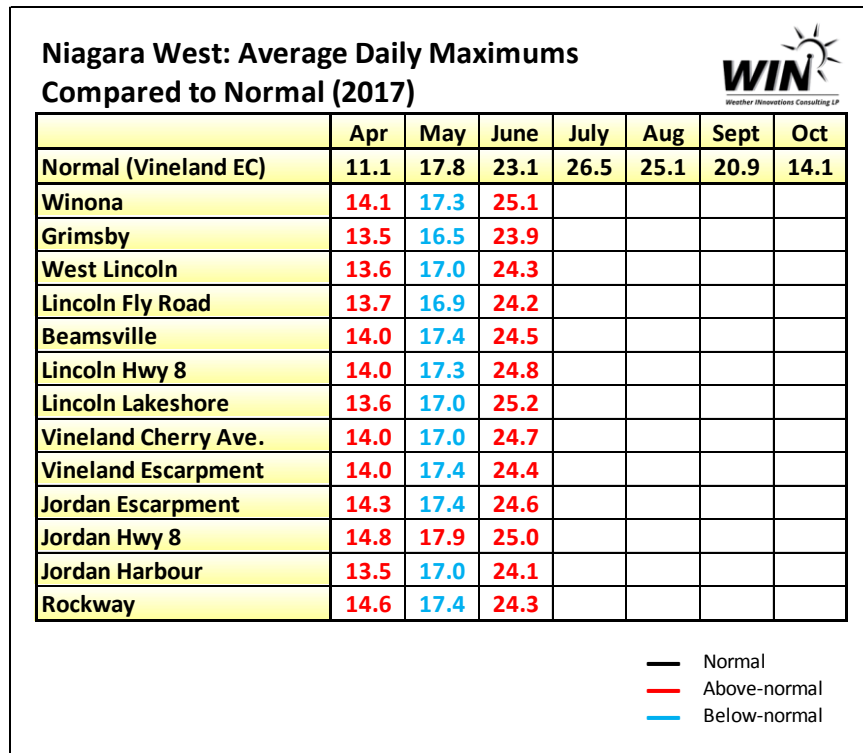


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

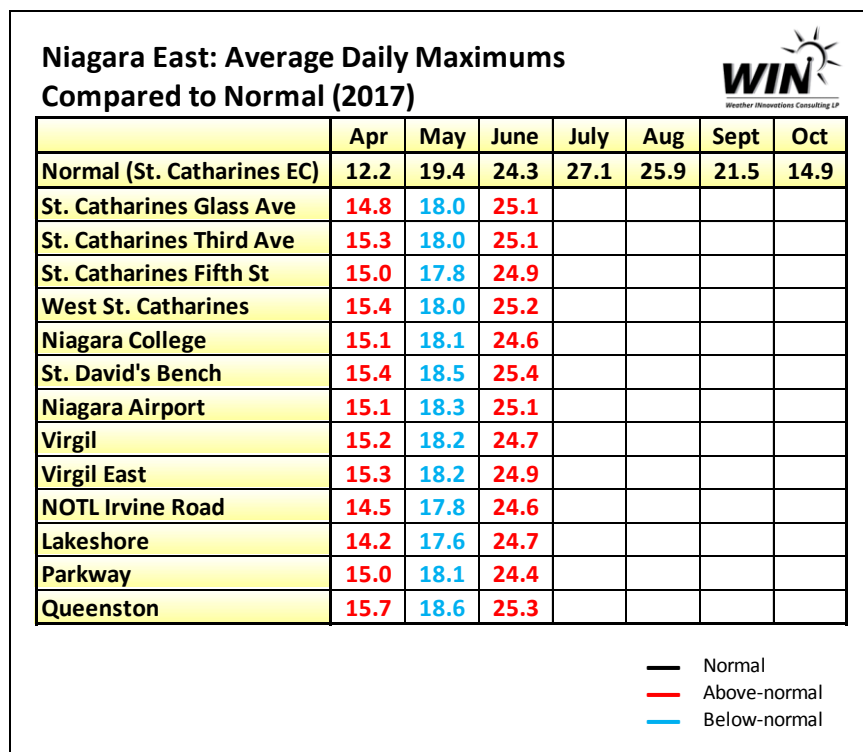


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

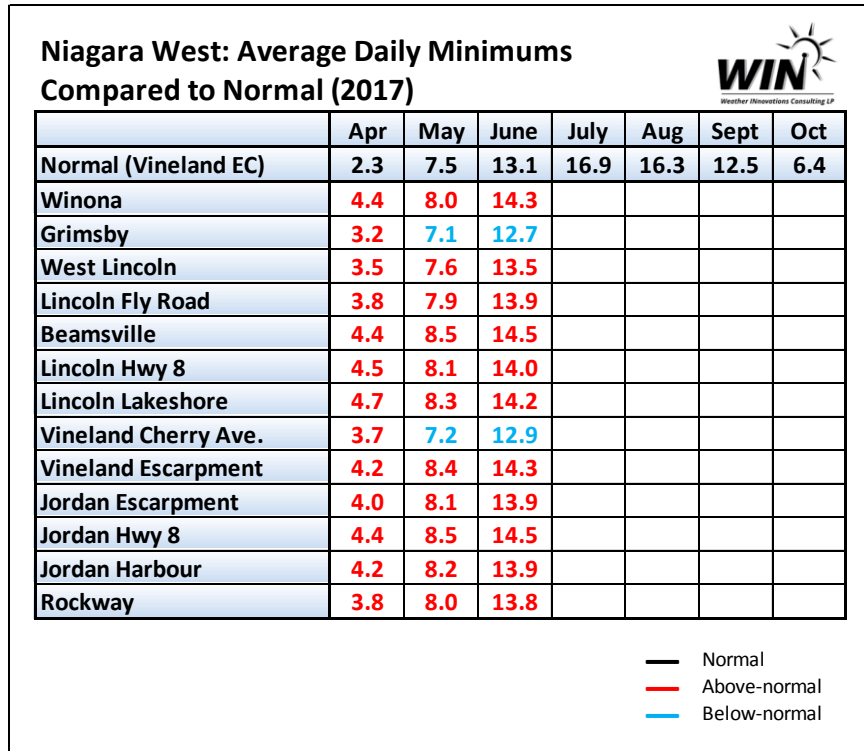


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

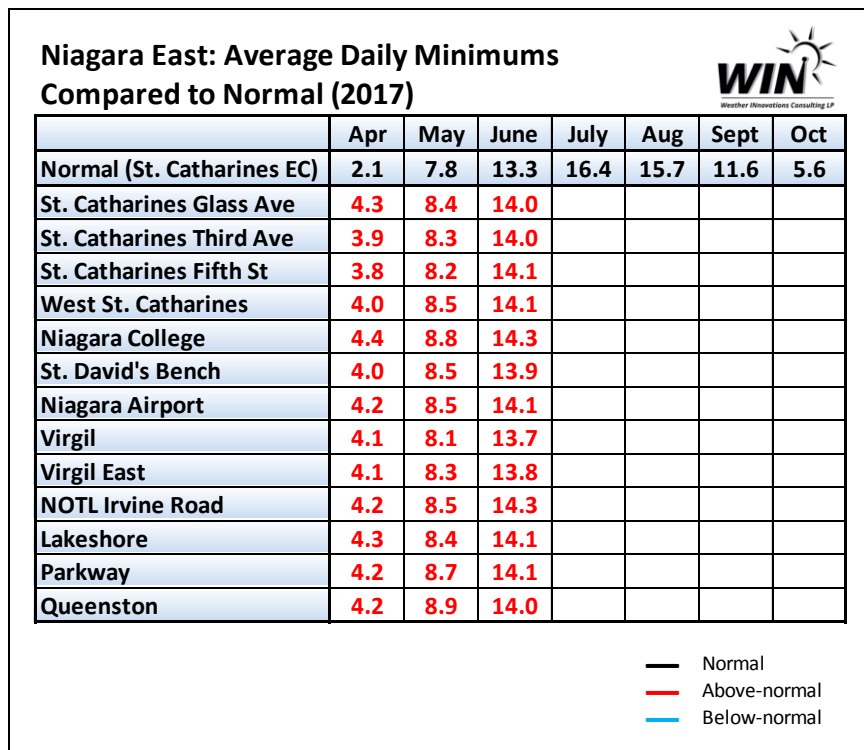


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

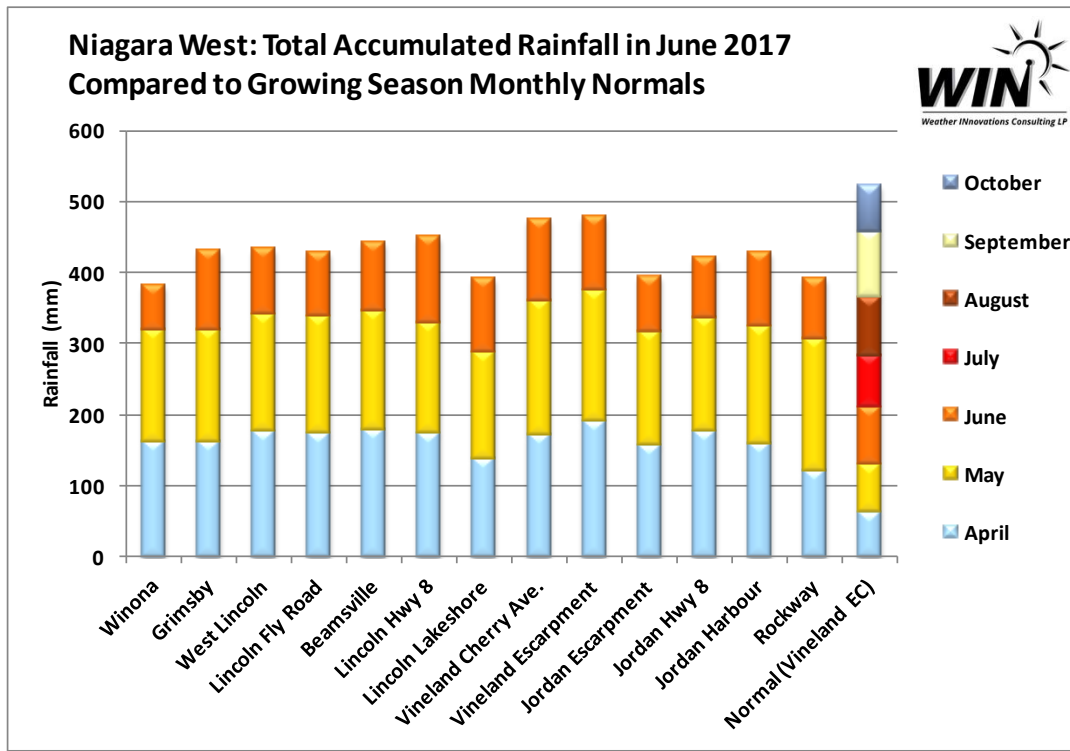


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

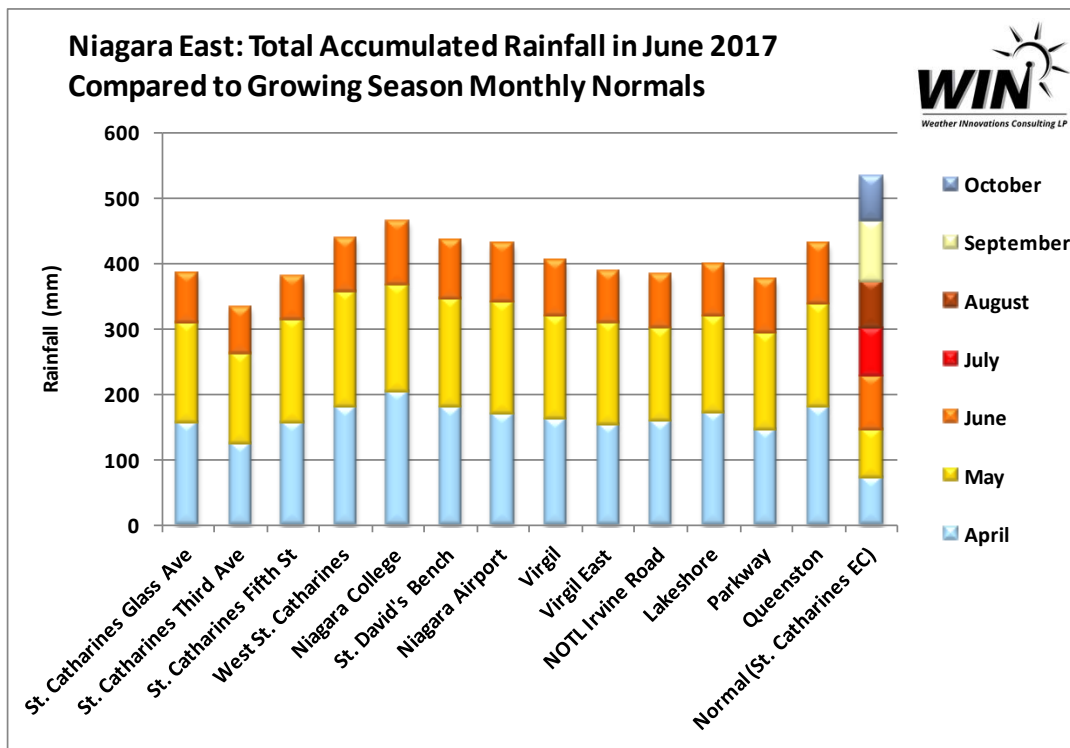


Figure 6: Niagara East - Rainfall
