



## June 2014:

June temperatures trended similarly to May temperatures with above normal daytime high temperatures and near normal overnight lows. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days for the month edged slightly above normal. The growing degree day accumulation continues to lag behind both 2012 and 2013. June 11 saw significant rainfall across the regions with some areas receiving 50+ mm of rain. Thus, the resulting June rainfall totals averaged 117 % of normal for Niagara West and 136 % of normal for Niagara East. However, Winona, Grimsby, Lincoln Highway 8, Lincoln Lakeshore, and Queenston received below average rainfall for the month.

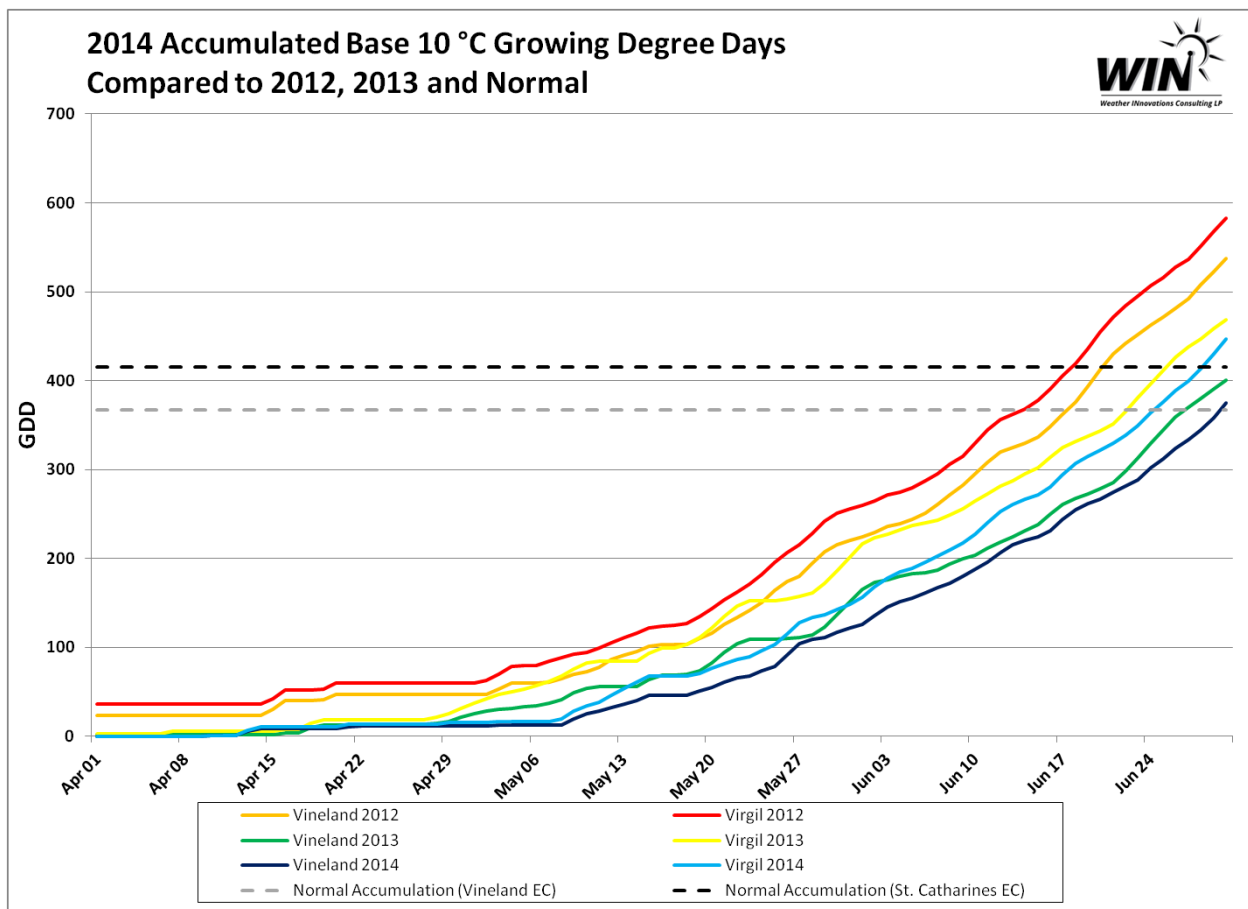


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

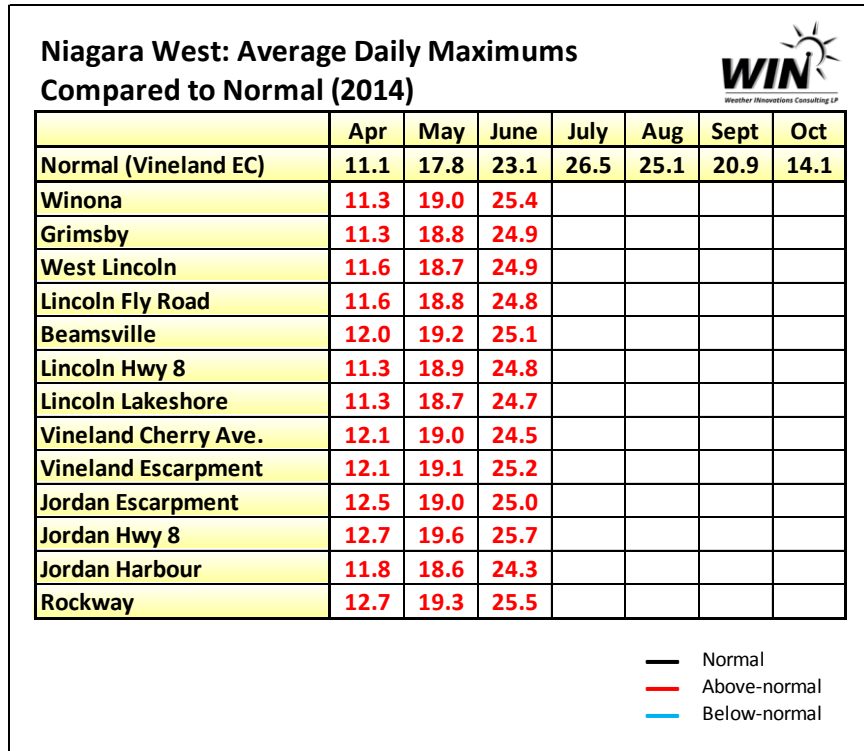


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

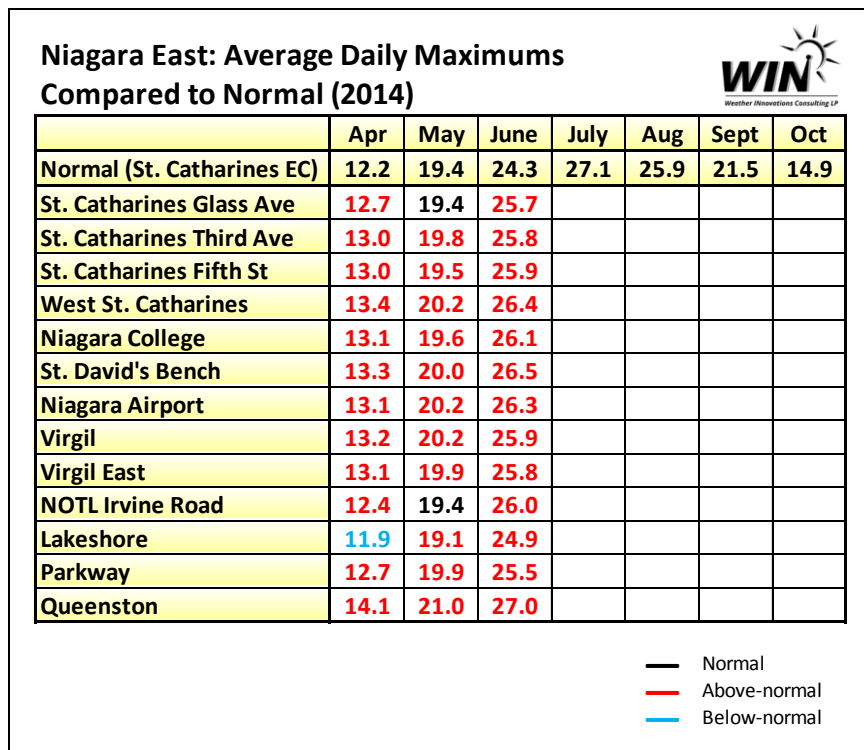


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

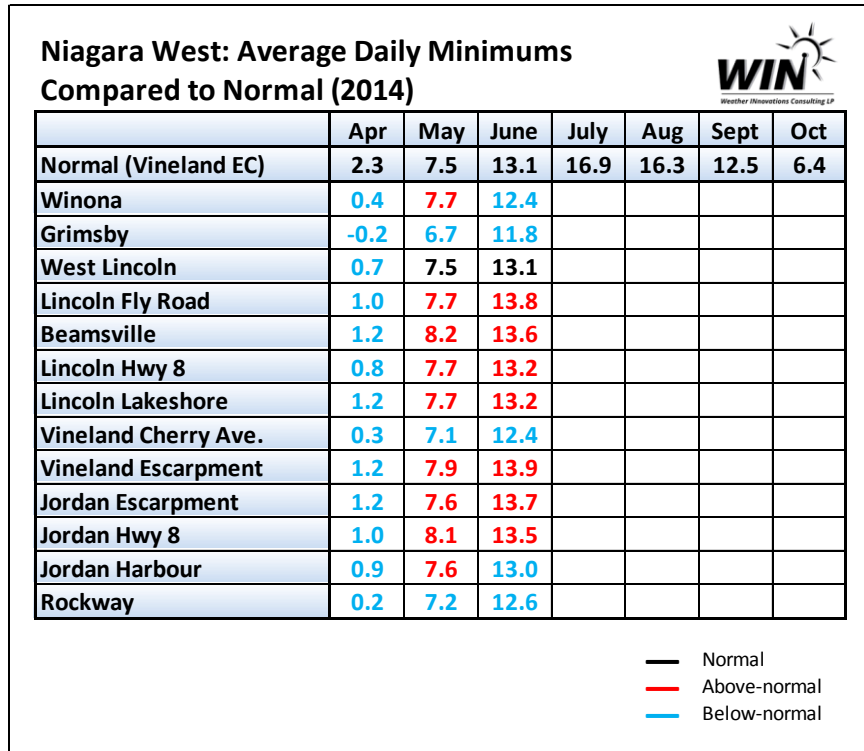


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

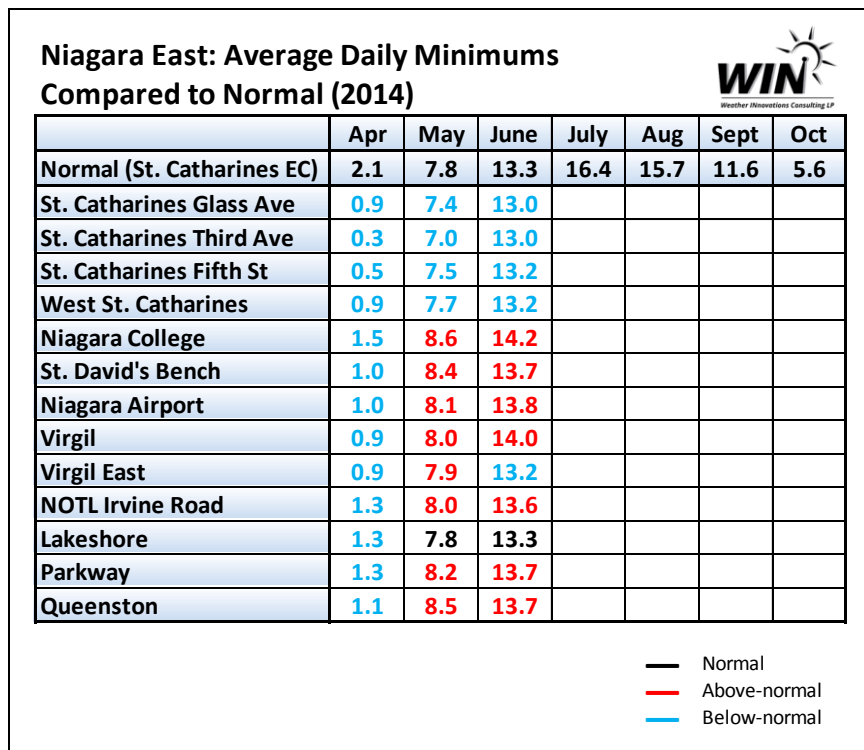


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

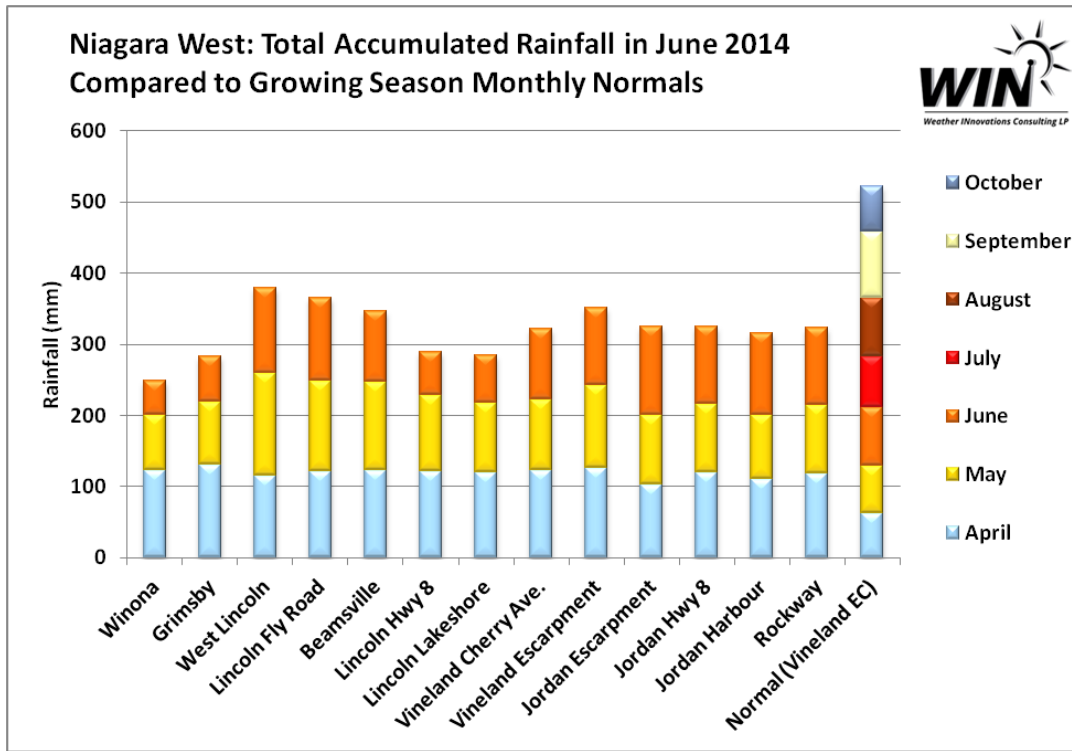


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

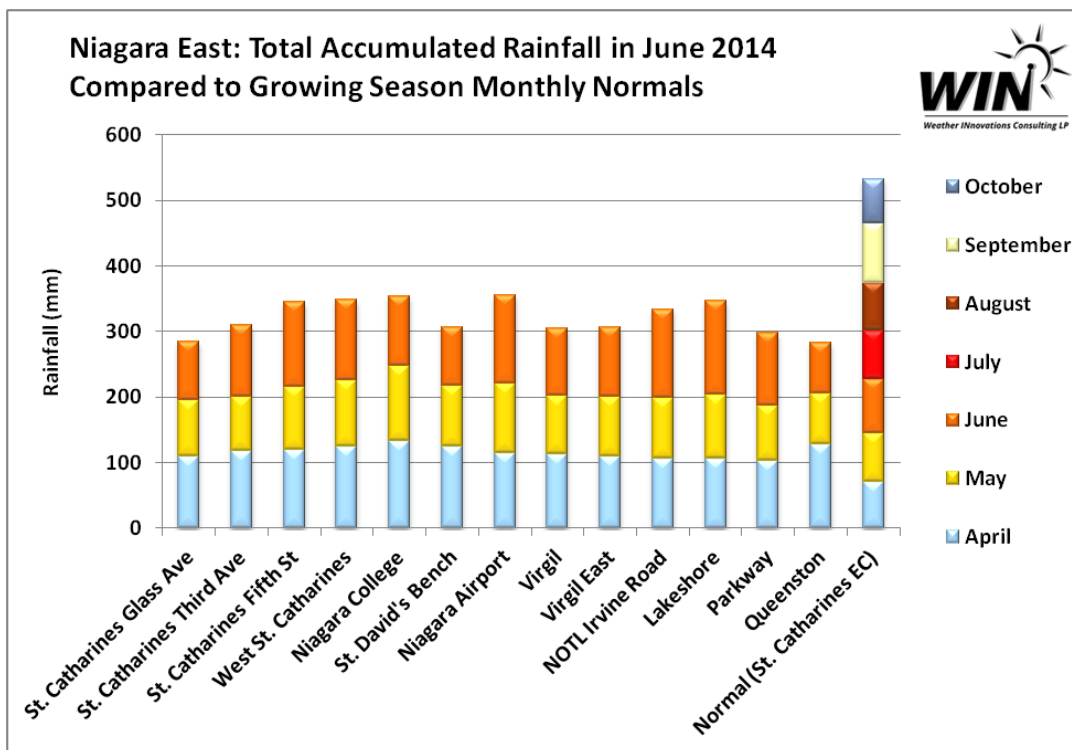


Figure 6: Niagara East - Rainfall
