



May 2016:

May daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation while overnight low temperature hovered near normal. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for May. The growing degree day accumulation remains behind the 2015 growing season and rose above the 2014 growing season. Little rainfall fell during May with an average of 30 % of the monthly precipitation total falling across the appellation over the month.

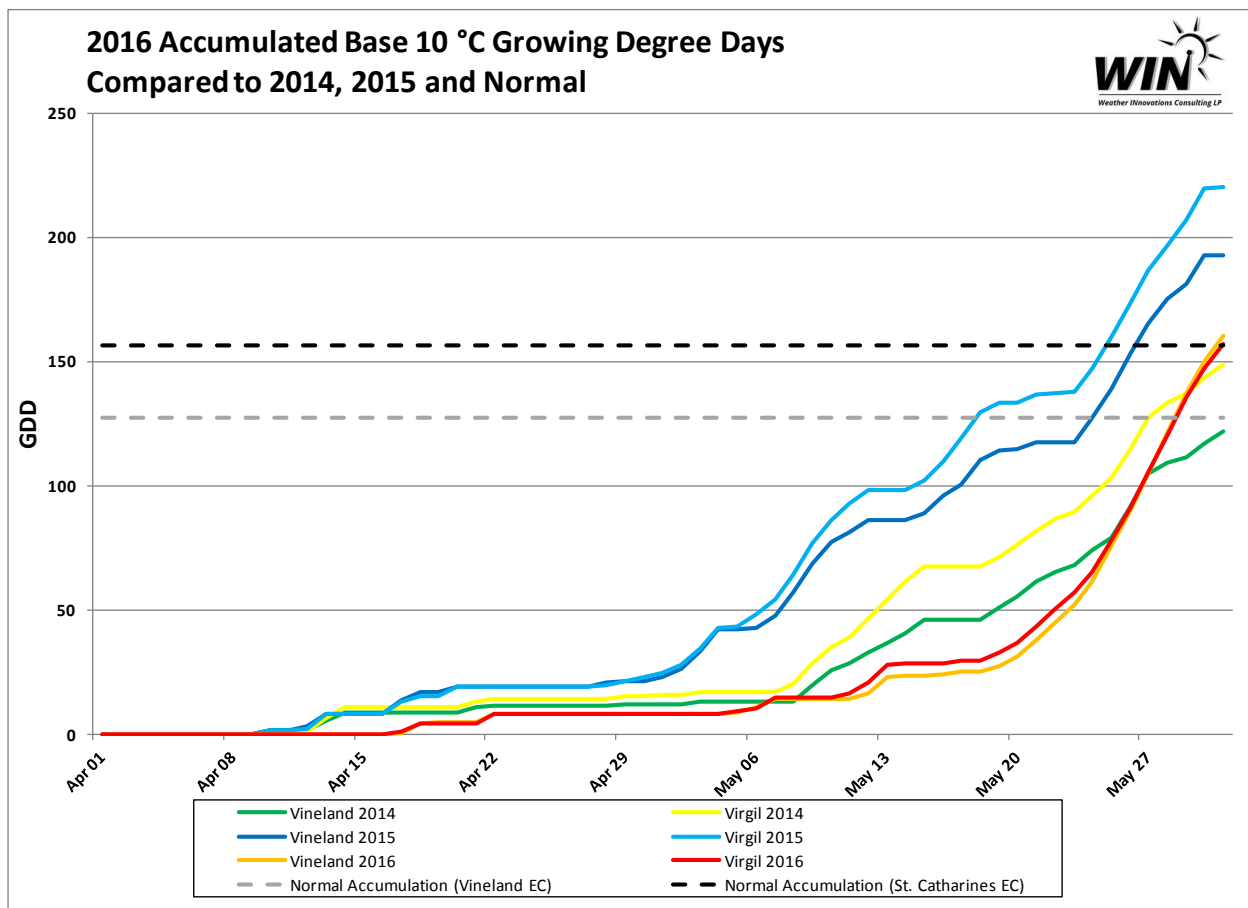


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

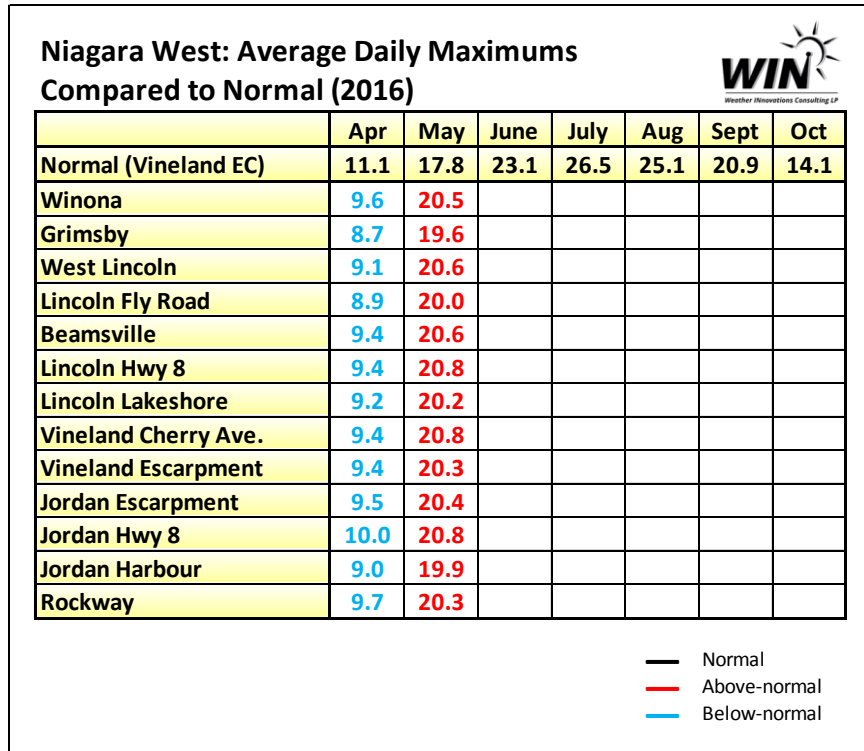


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

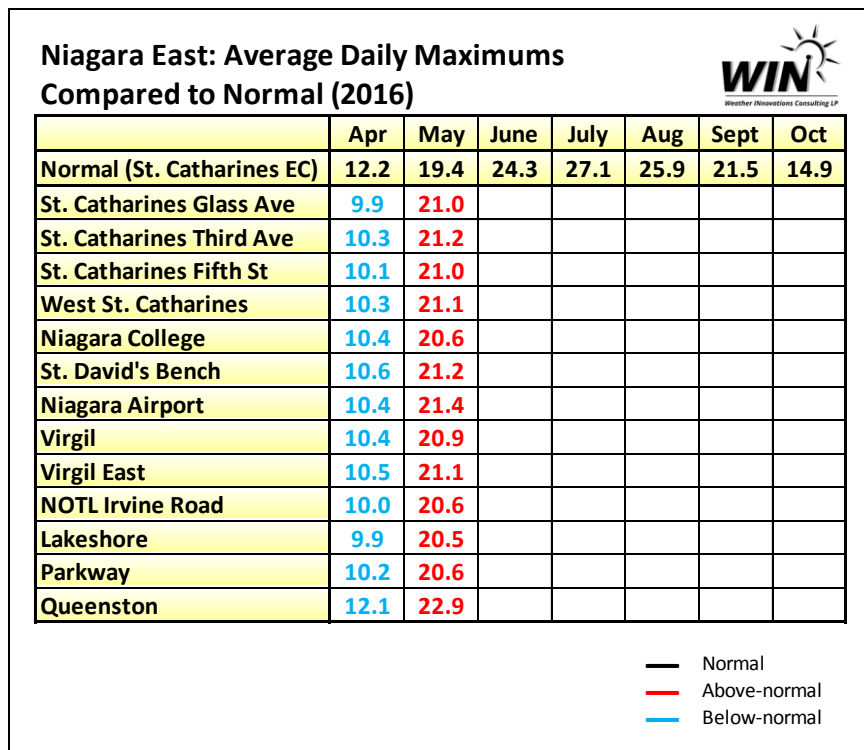


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

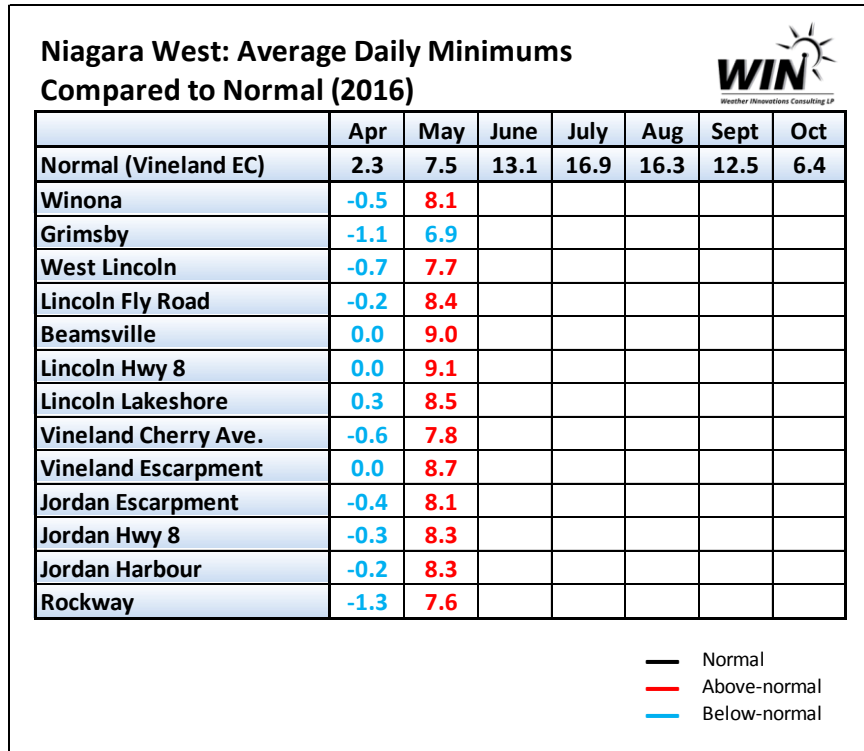


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

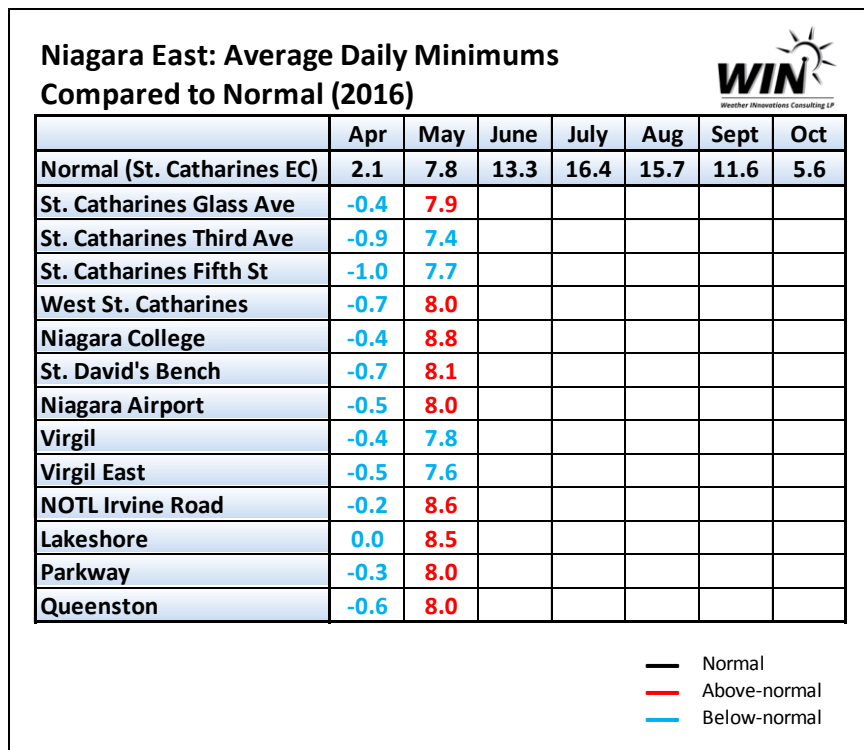


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

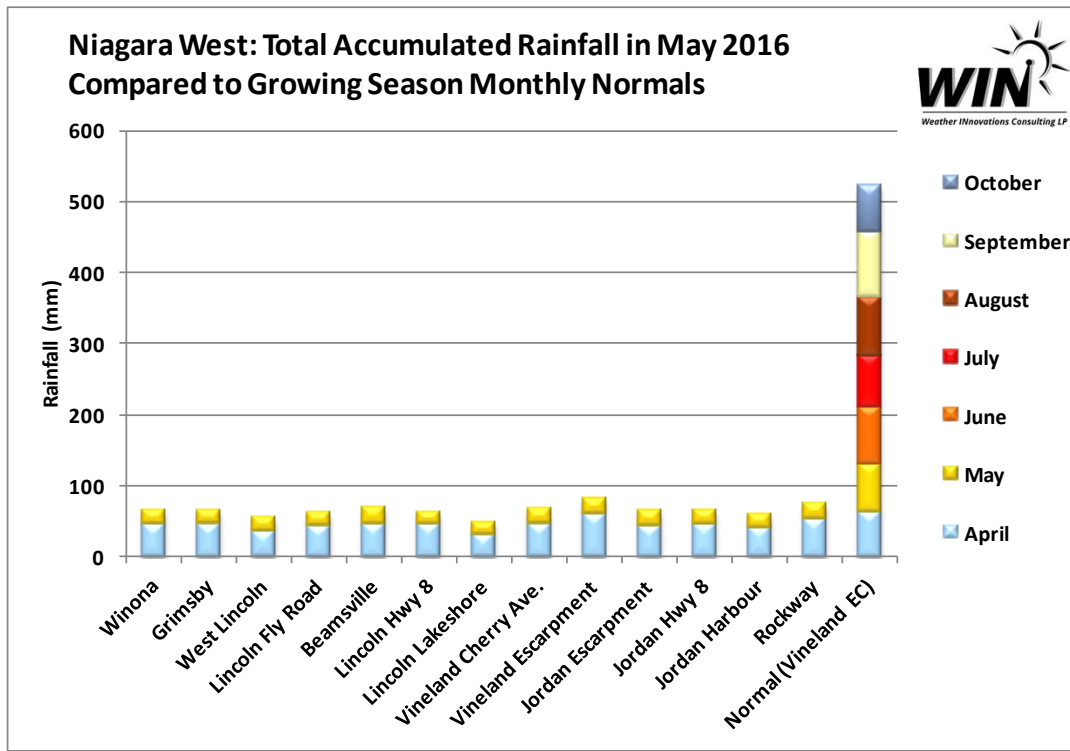


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

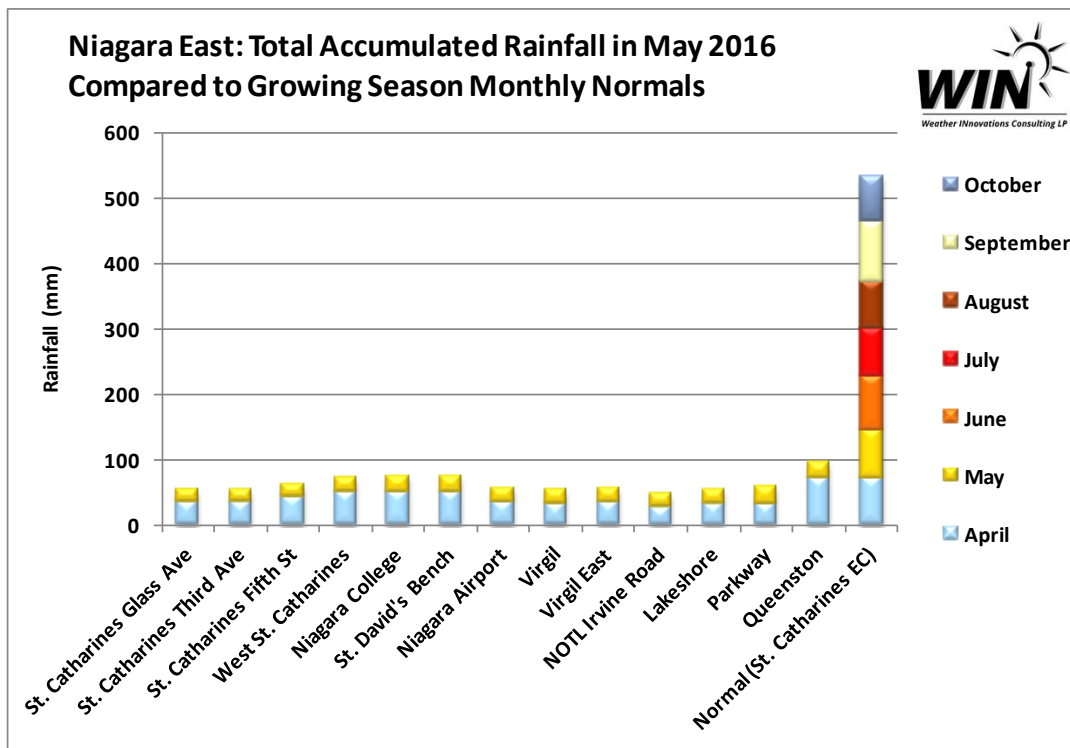


Figure 6: Niagara East - Rainfall
