



### October 2016:

October daytime high and overnight low temperatures were above normal across the appellation. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for October. The growing degree day accumulation is above both 2014 and 2015 values at Vineland and Virgil. The appellation received an average of 115 % of normal precipitation during October. Up to 40 mm of rain fell over October 20-21.

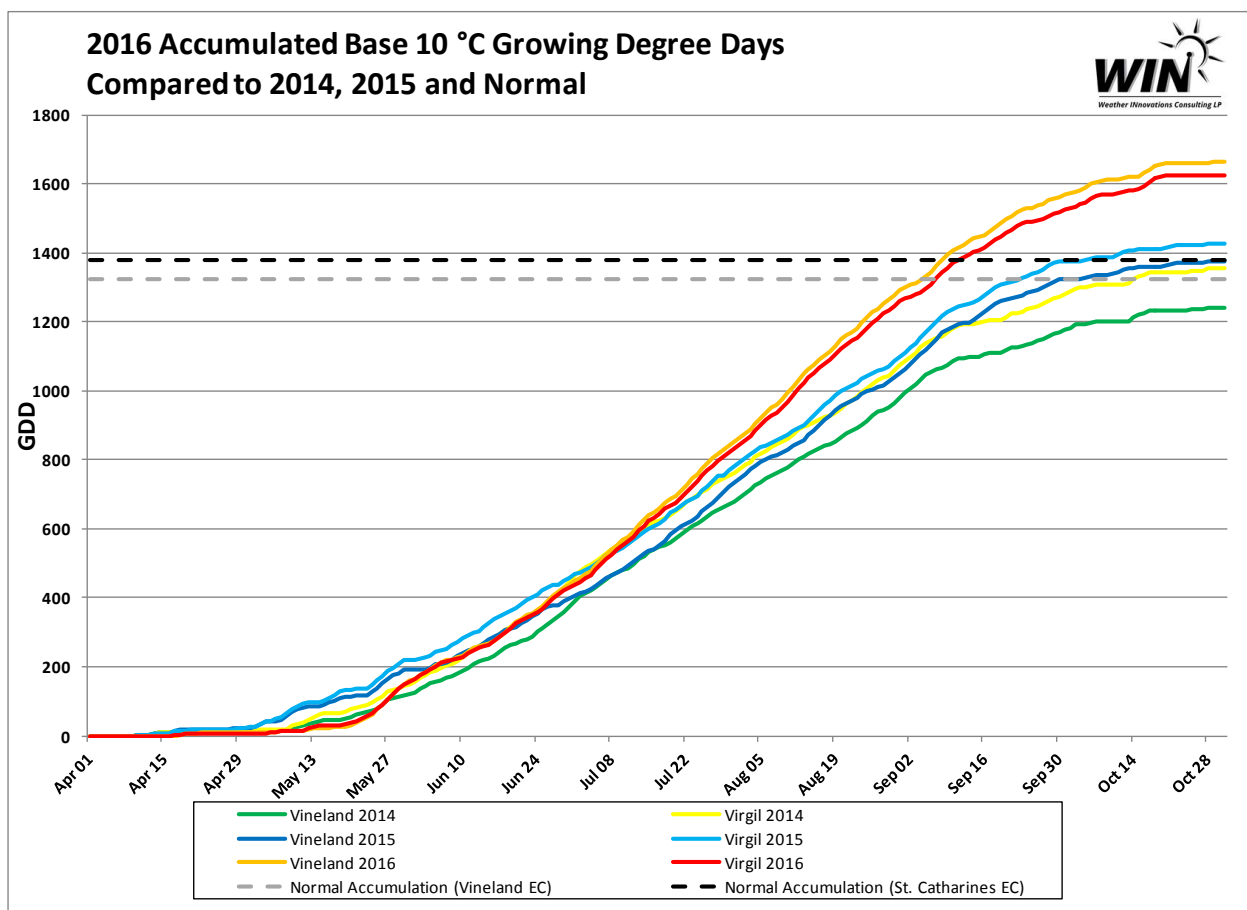


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

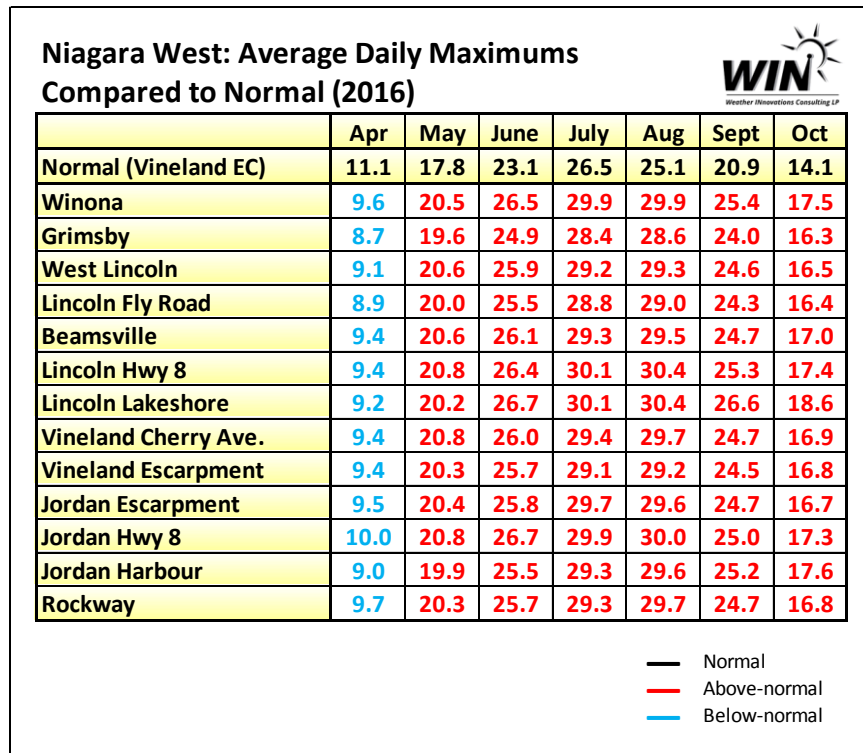


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

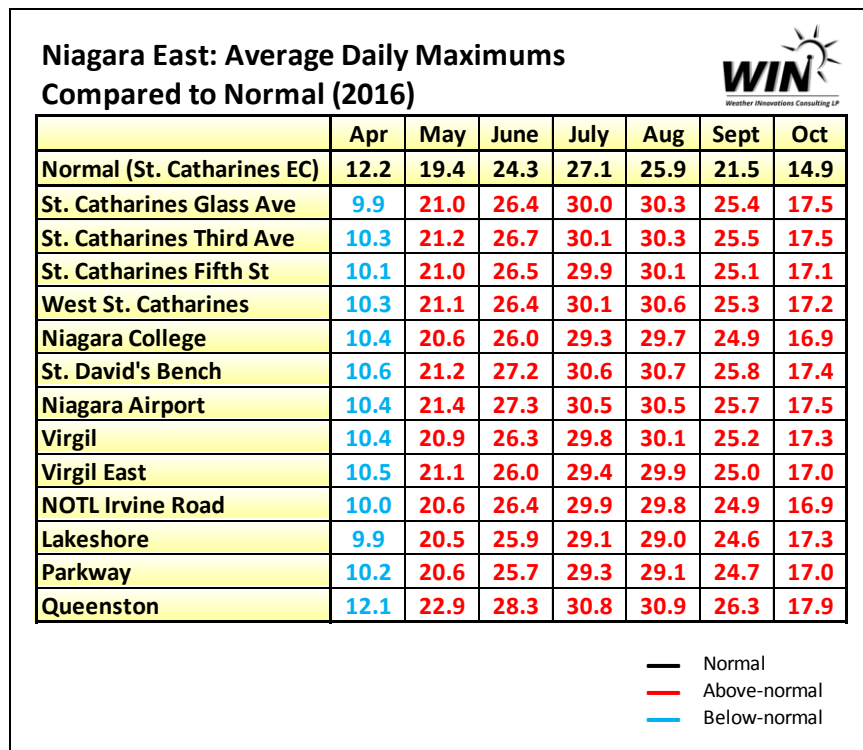


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

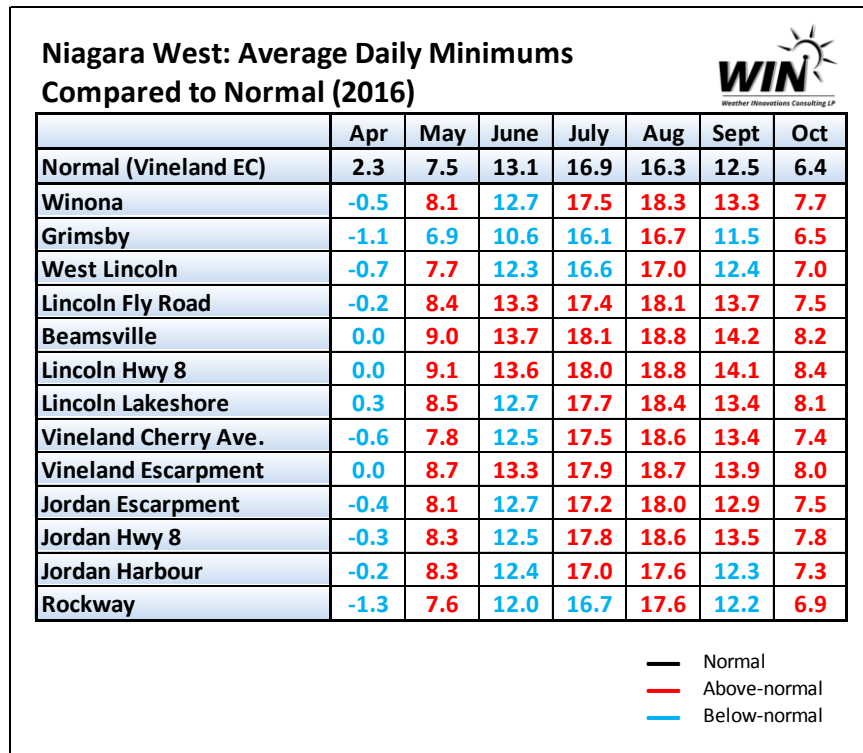


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

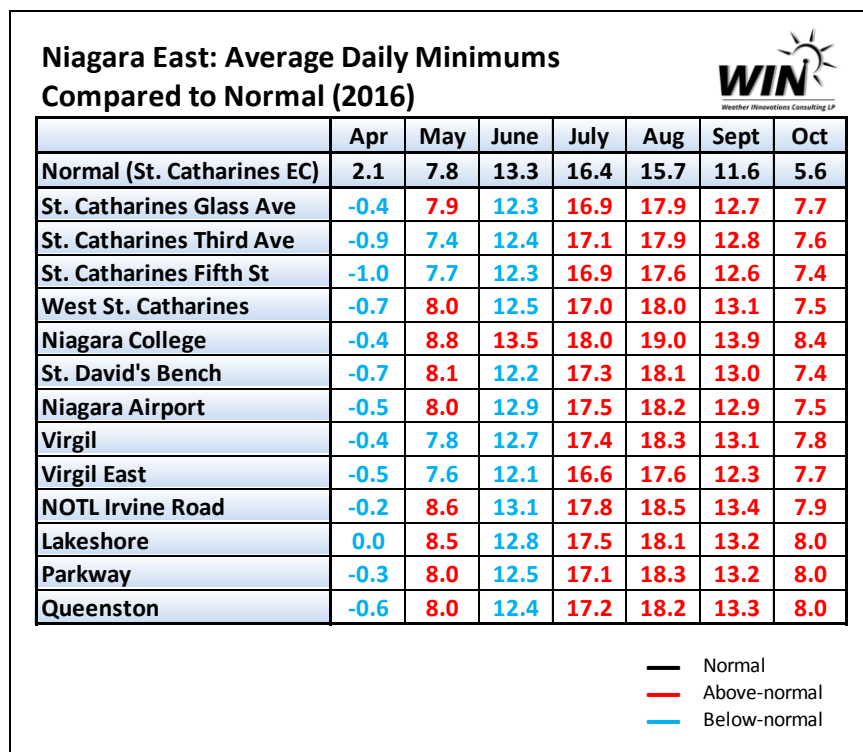


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

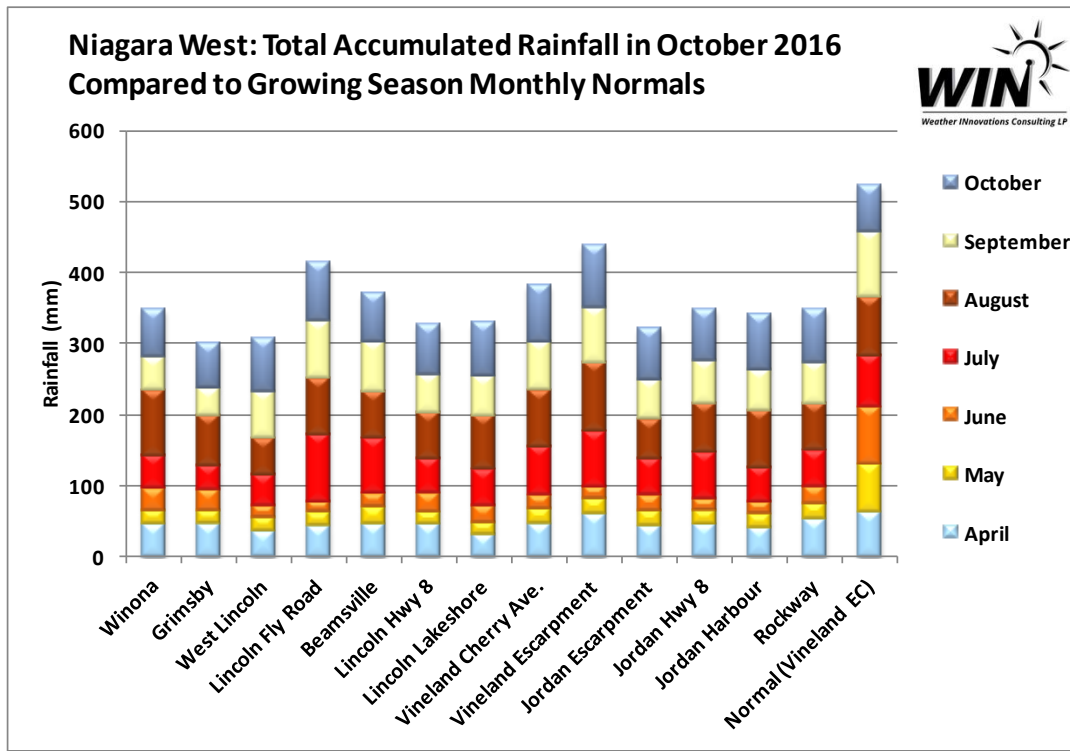


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

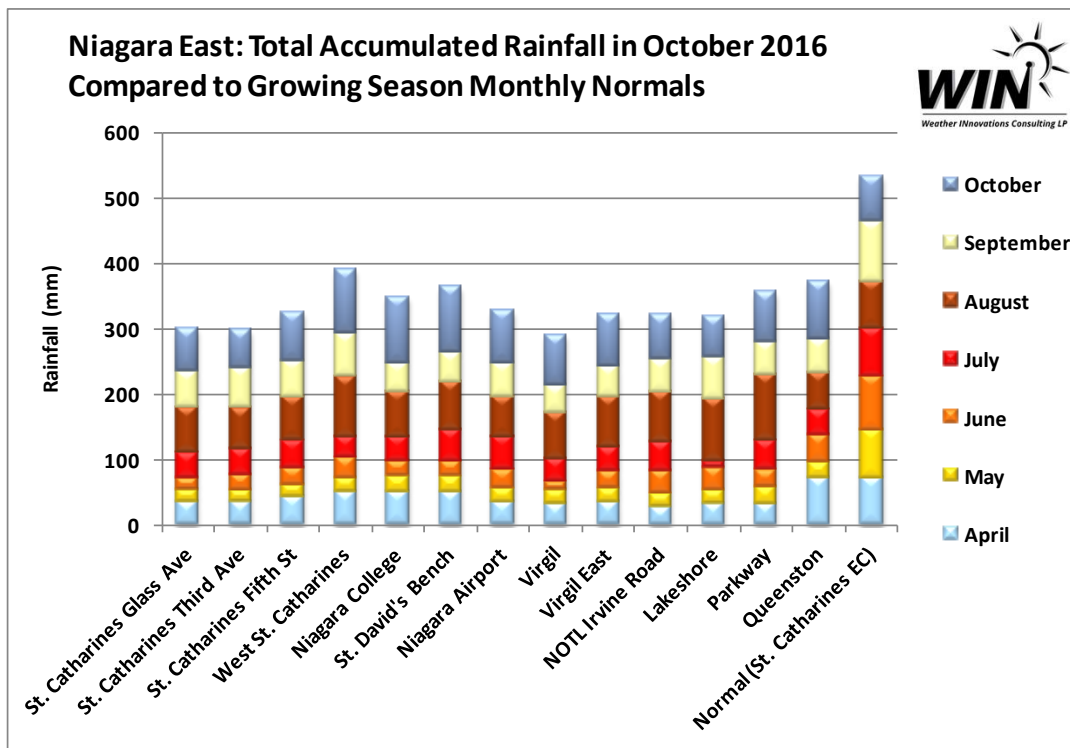


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
