



### October 2017:

October daytime high and overnight low temperatures were above normal across the appellation. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for October. The growing degree day accumulation is above 2015 and below 2016 values at Vineland and Virgil. During October, Niagara West received an average of 174 % of normal precipitation while Niagara East received 150 % of normal precipitation. Up to 94 mm of rain fell on October 9.

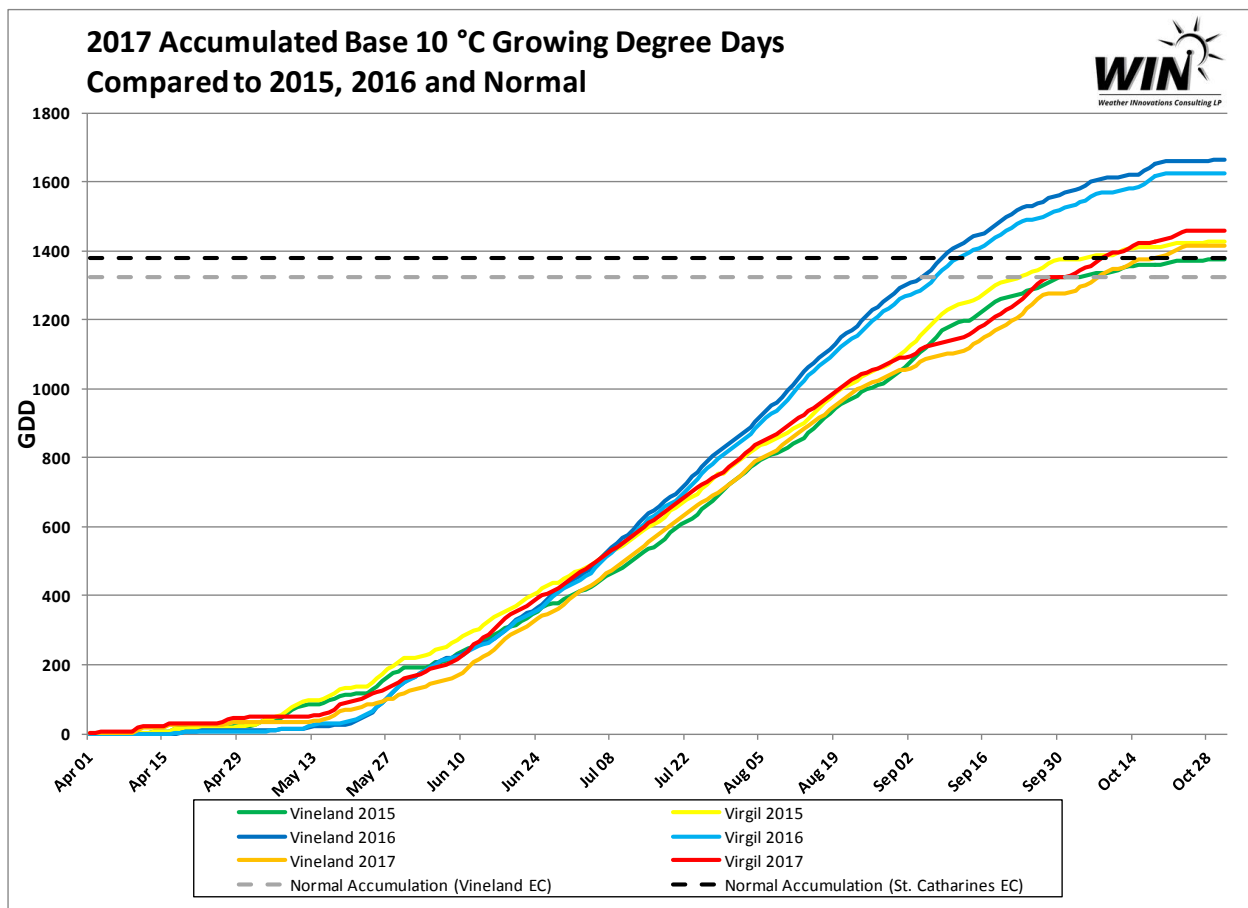


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

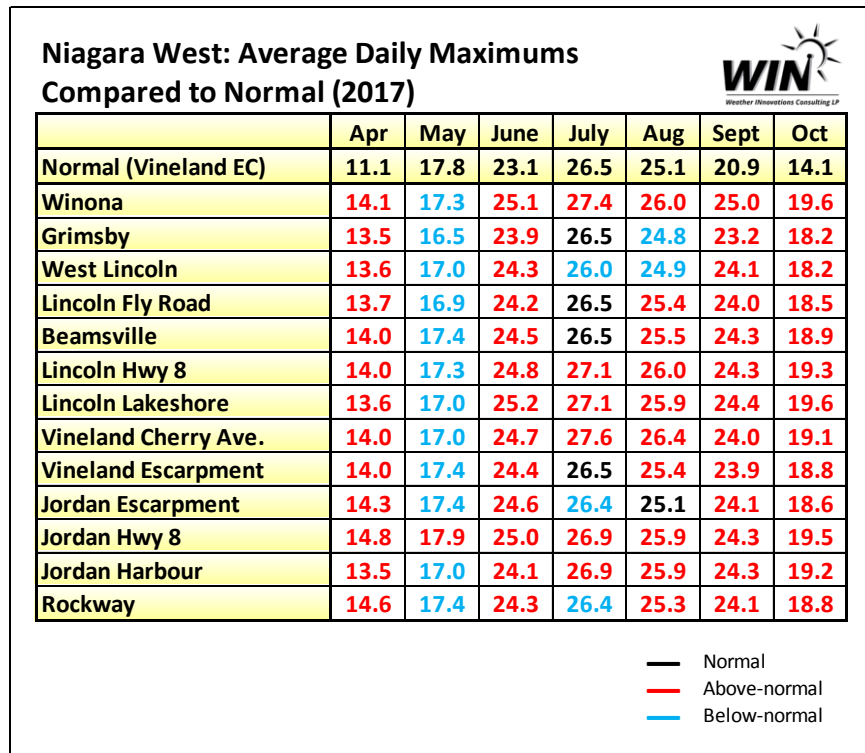


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

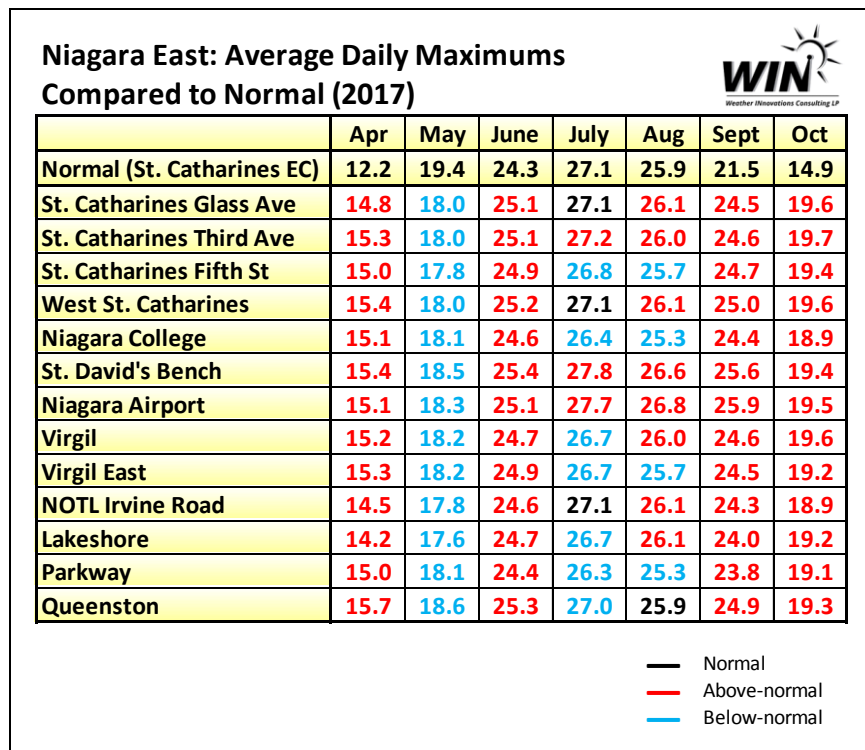


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

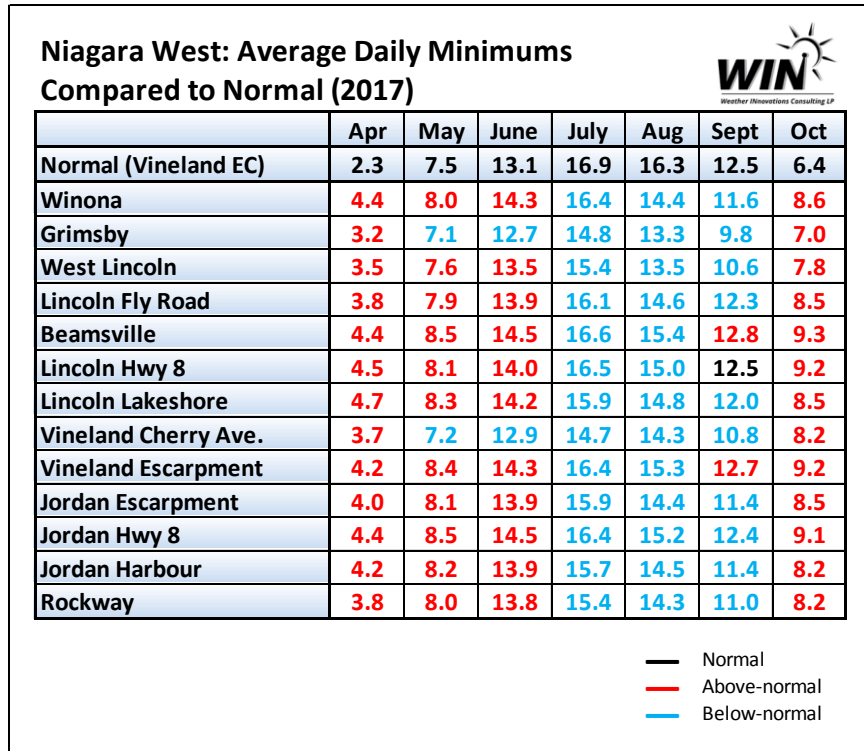


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

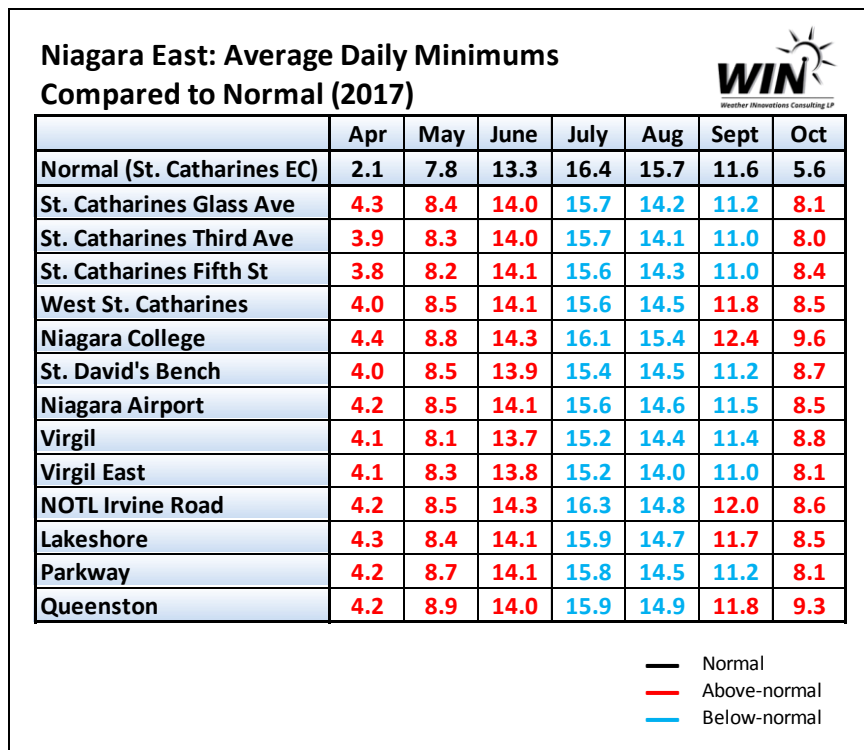


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

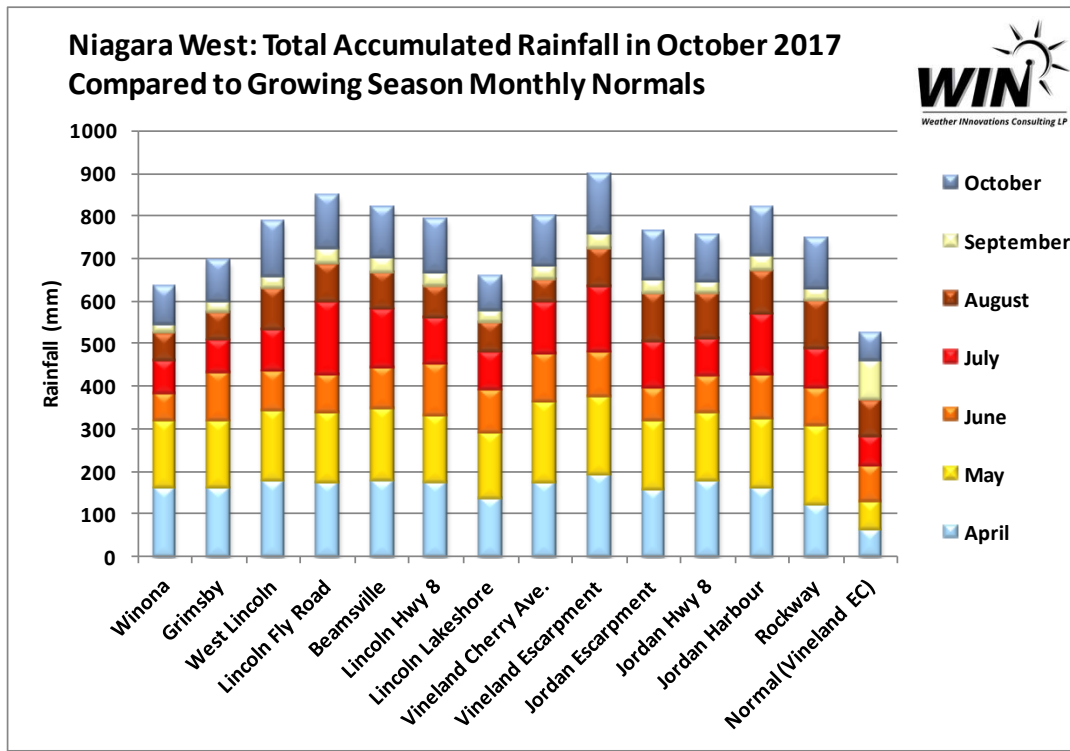


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

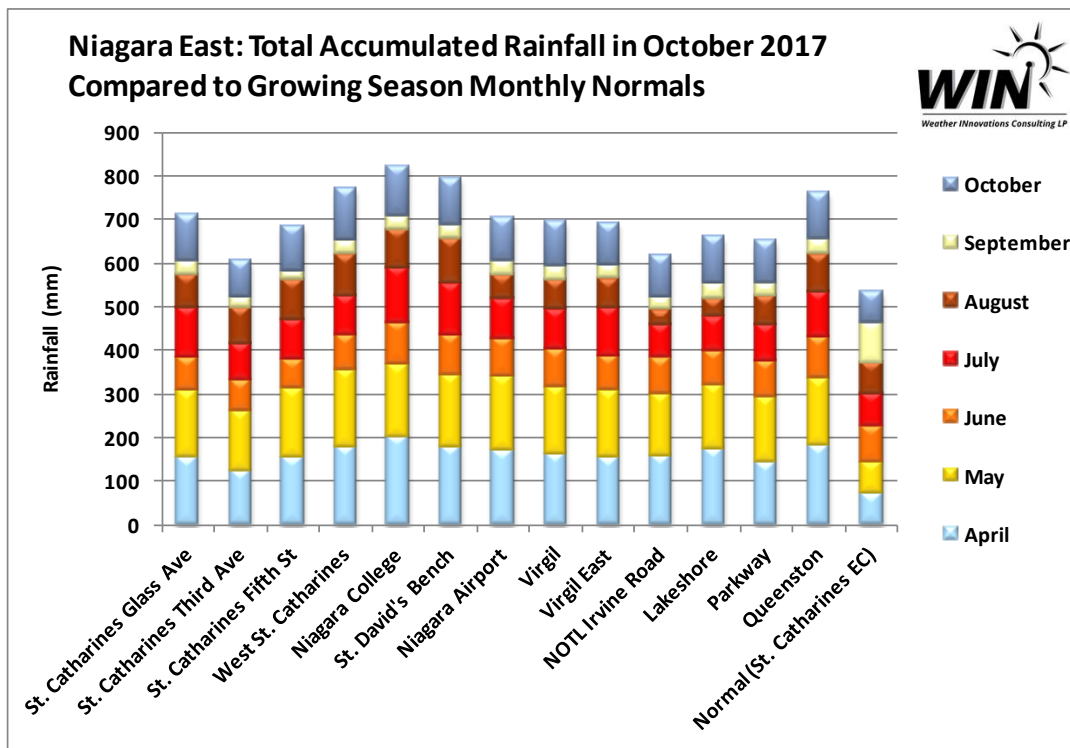


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
