



September 2017:

September daytime high temperatures were above normal across the appellation. Overnight low temperatures were below to near normal across most of the appellation. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for September. The growing degree day accumulation is below both 2016 and 2015 values at Vineland and Virgil. Niagara west received an average of 33 % of normal precipitation in September while Niagara East received 34 % of normal precipitation. Up to 24 mm of rainfall fell on September 2 - 3.

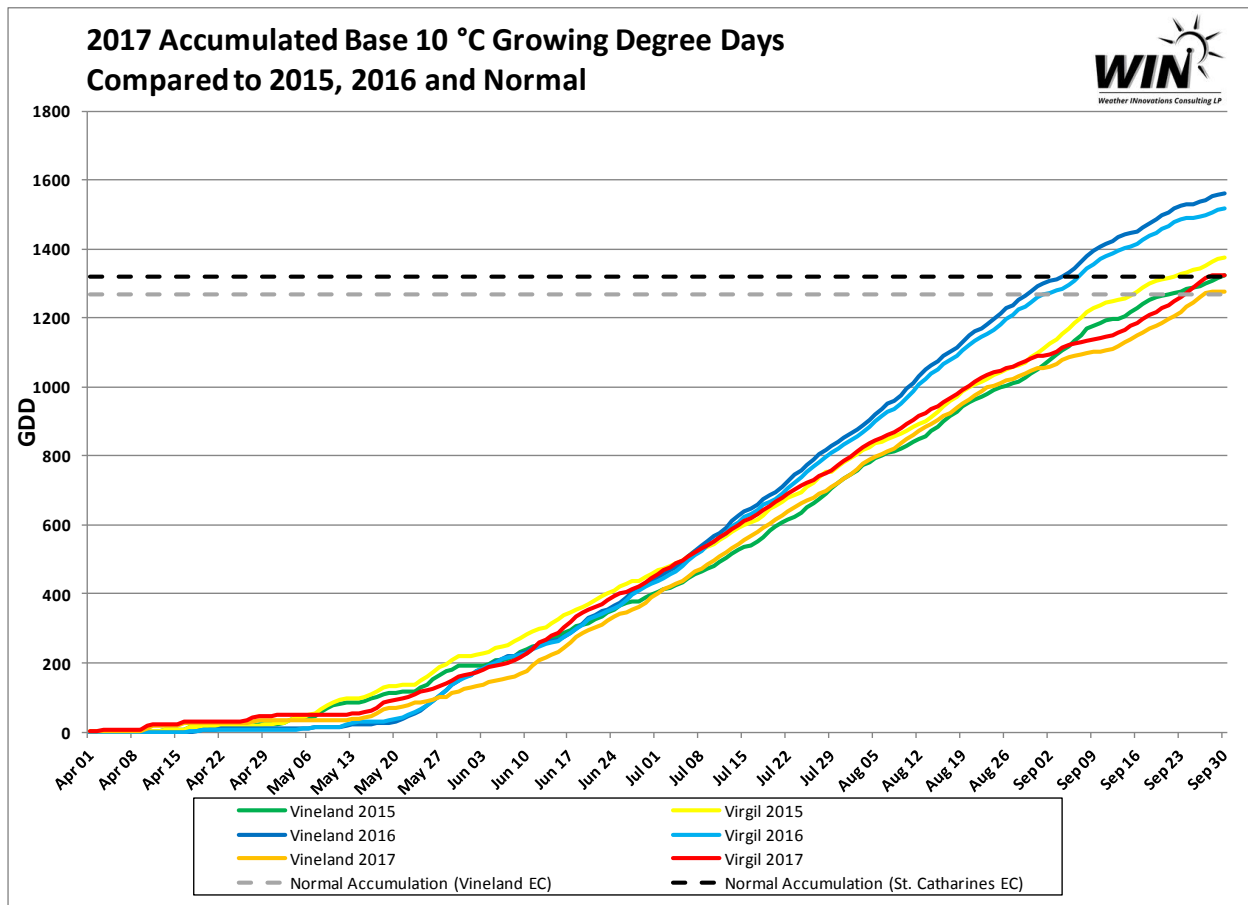


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

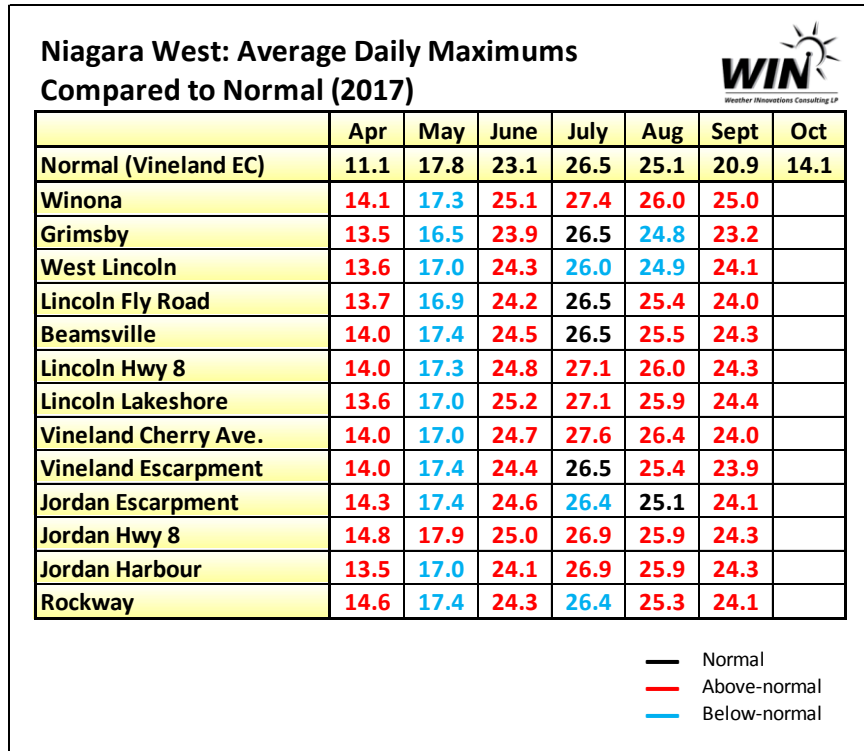


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

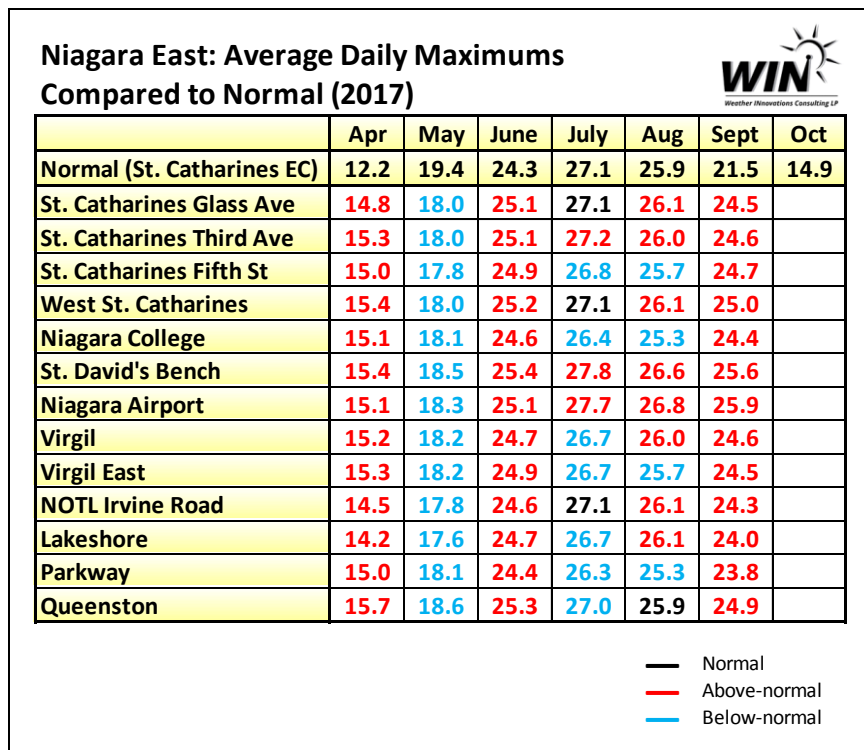


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

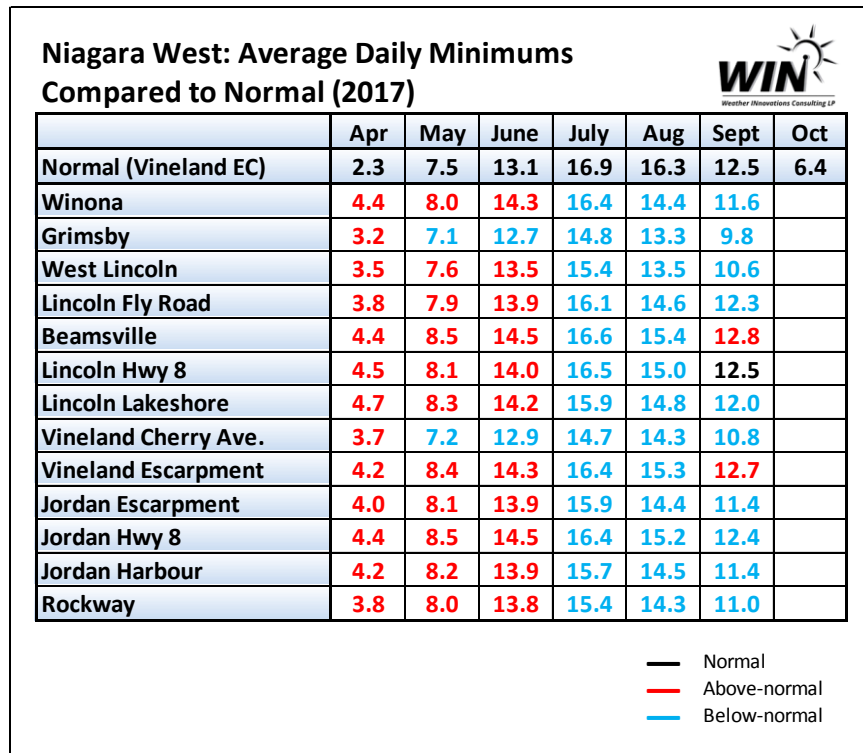


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

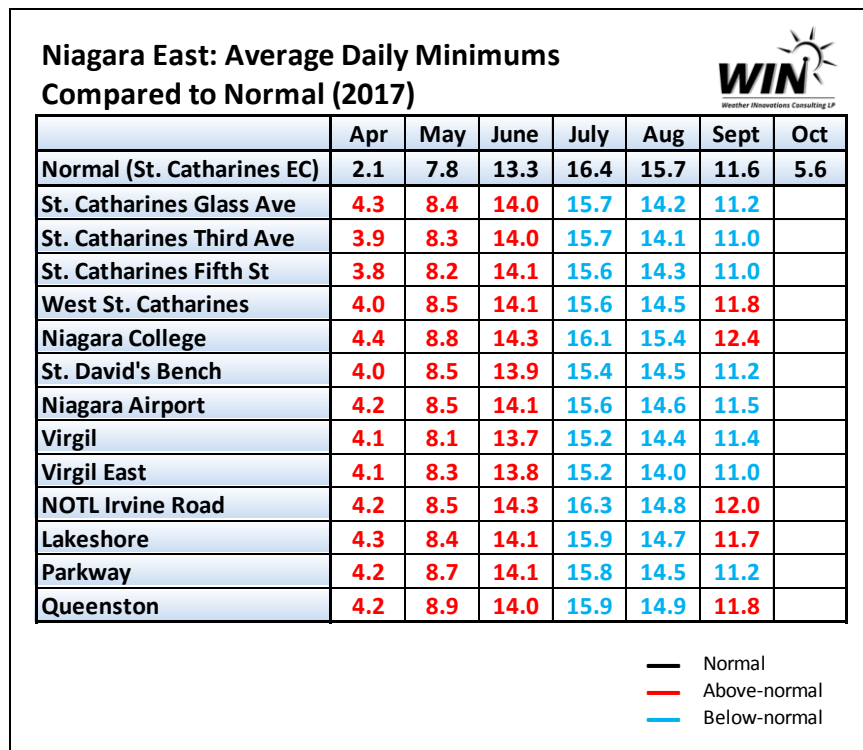


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

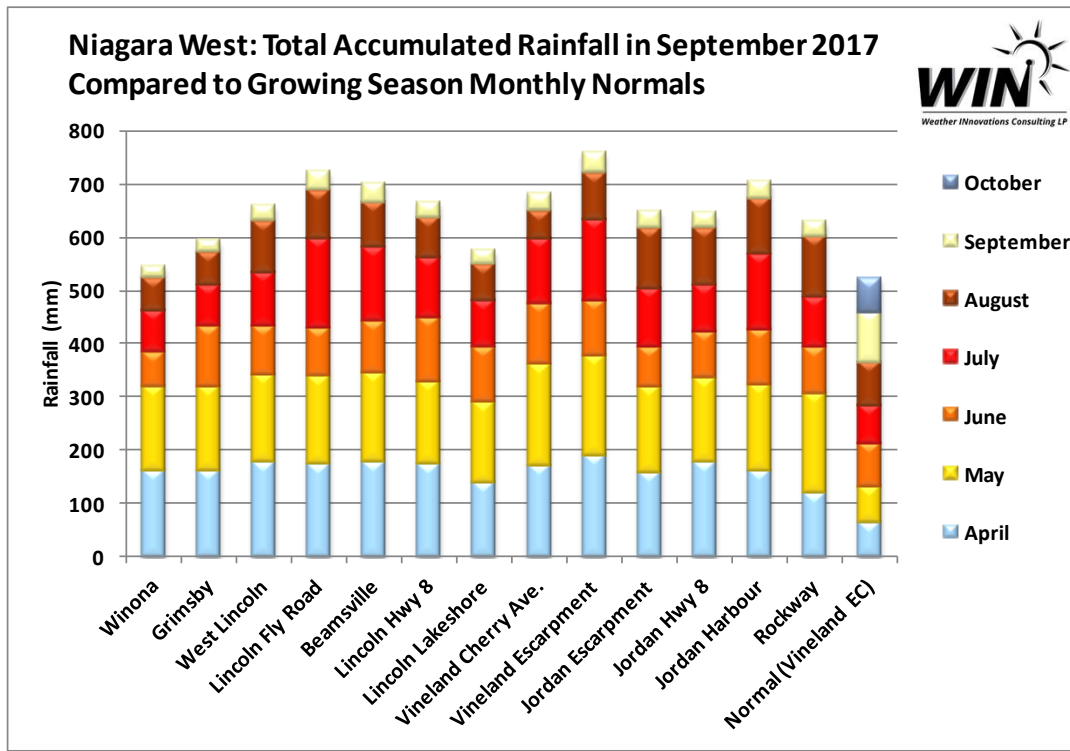


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

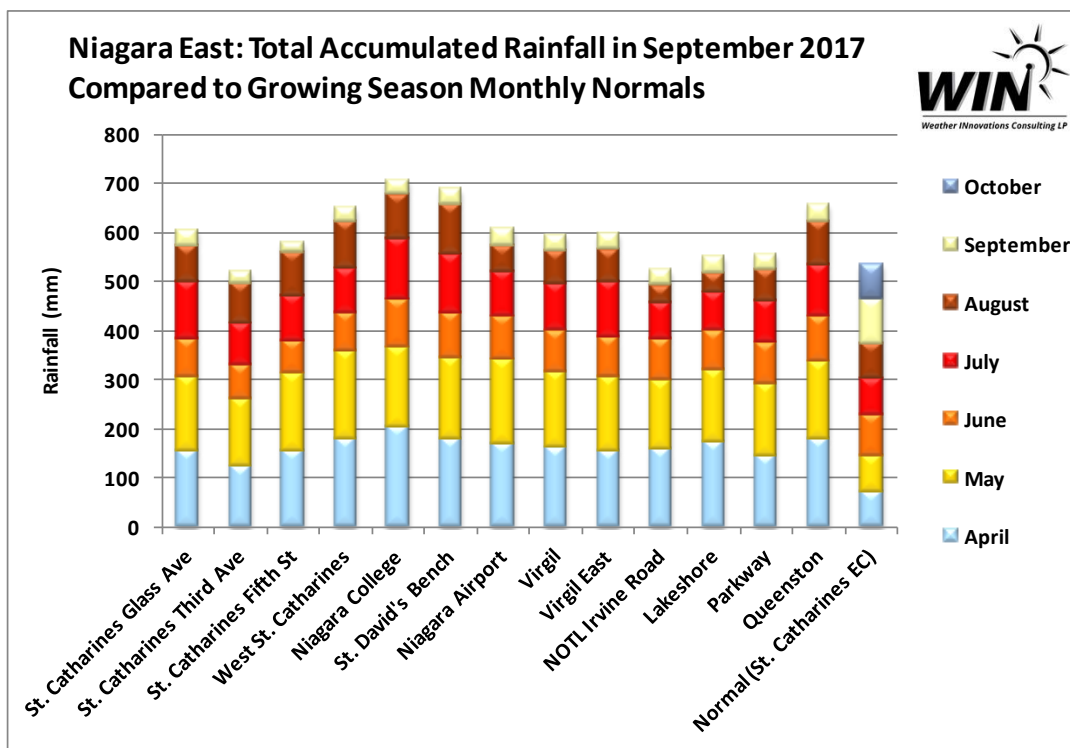


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
