



### April 2017:

In April, daytime highs and overnight lows averaged above normal across the appellation. Across the appellation, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for April and were also above 2015 and 2016 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 160 % of normal for April. Significant rain events occurred on April 4 and 6 with 55 % of the monthly accumulation falling over those two days.

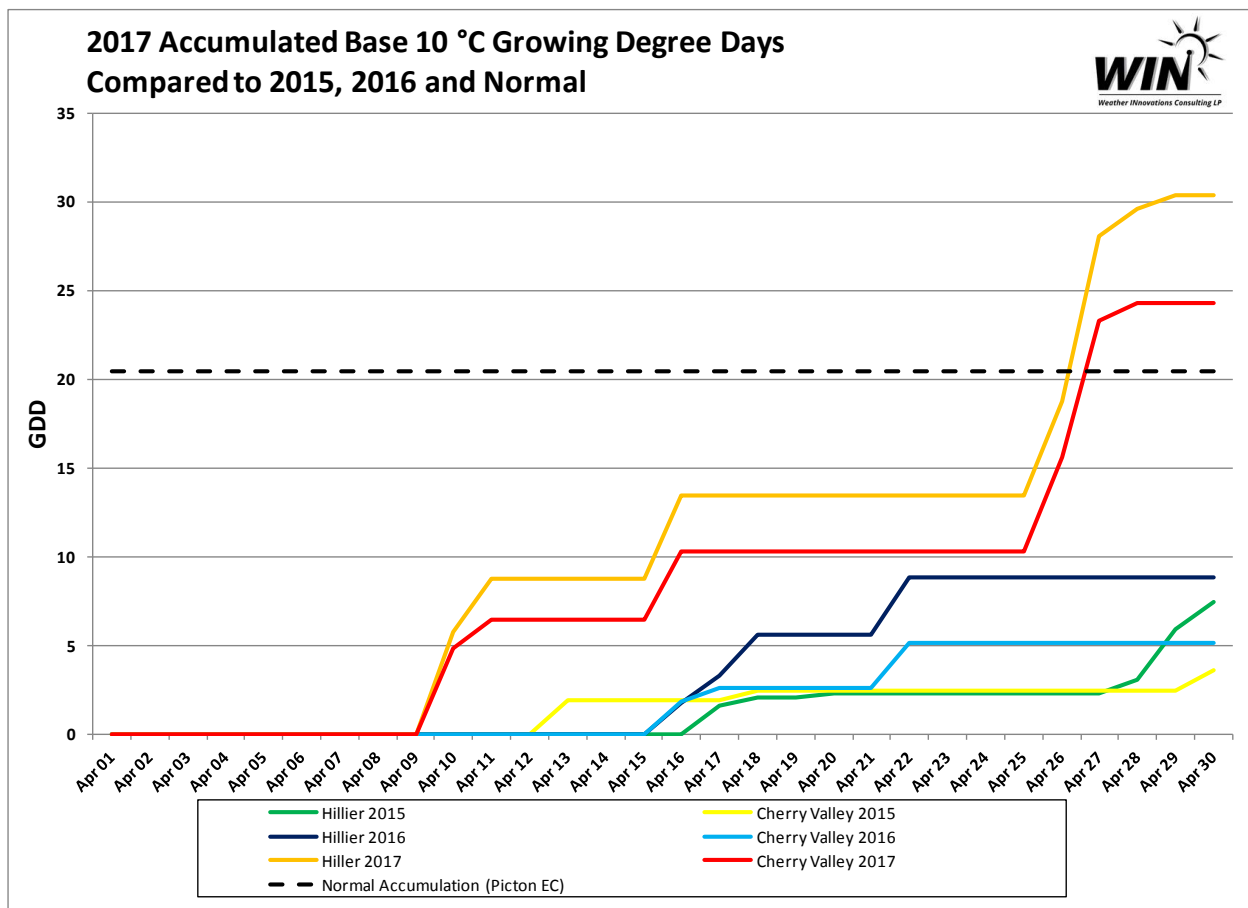


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

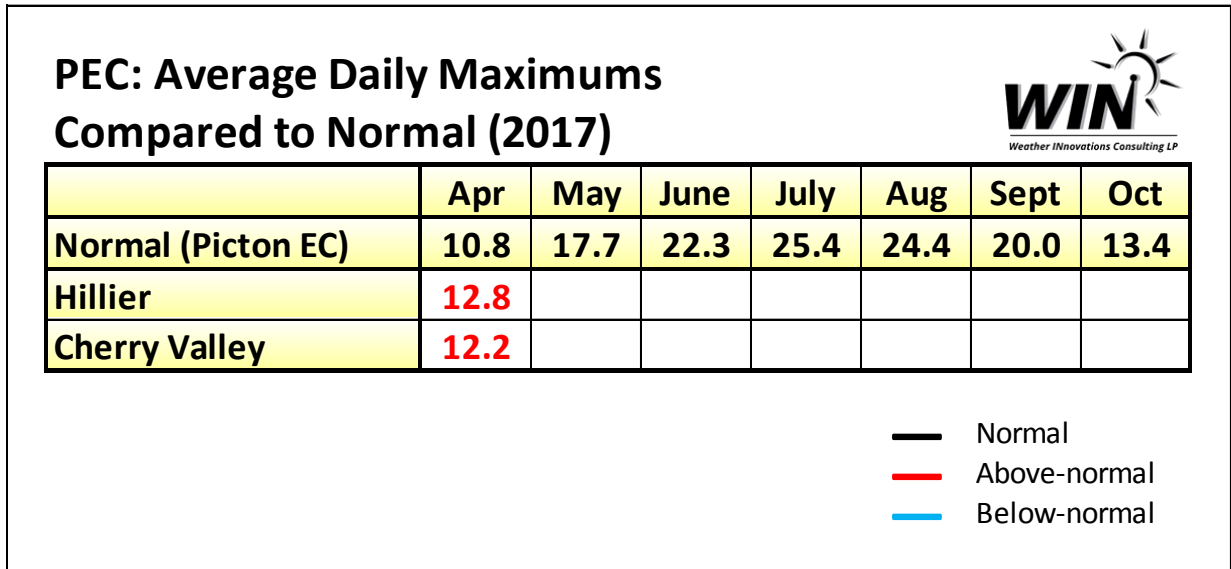


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

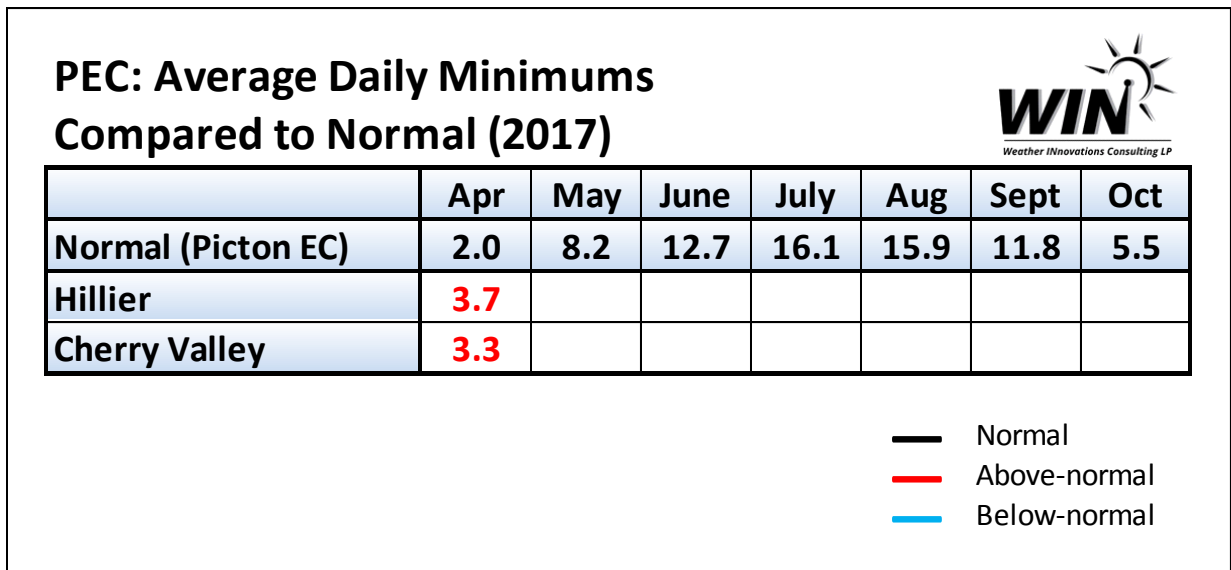


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

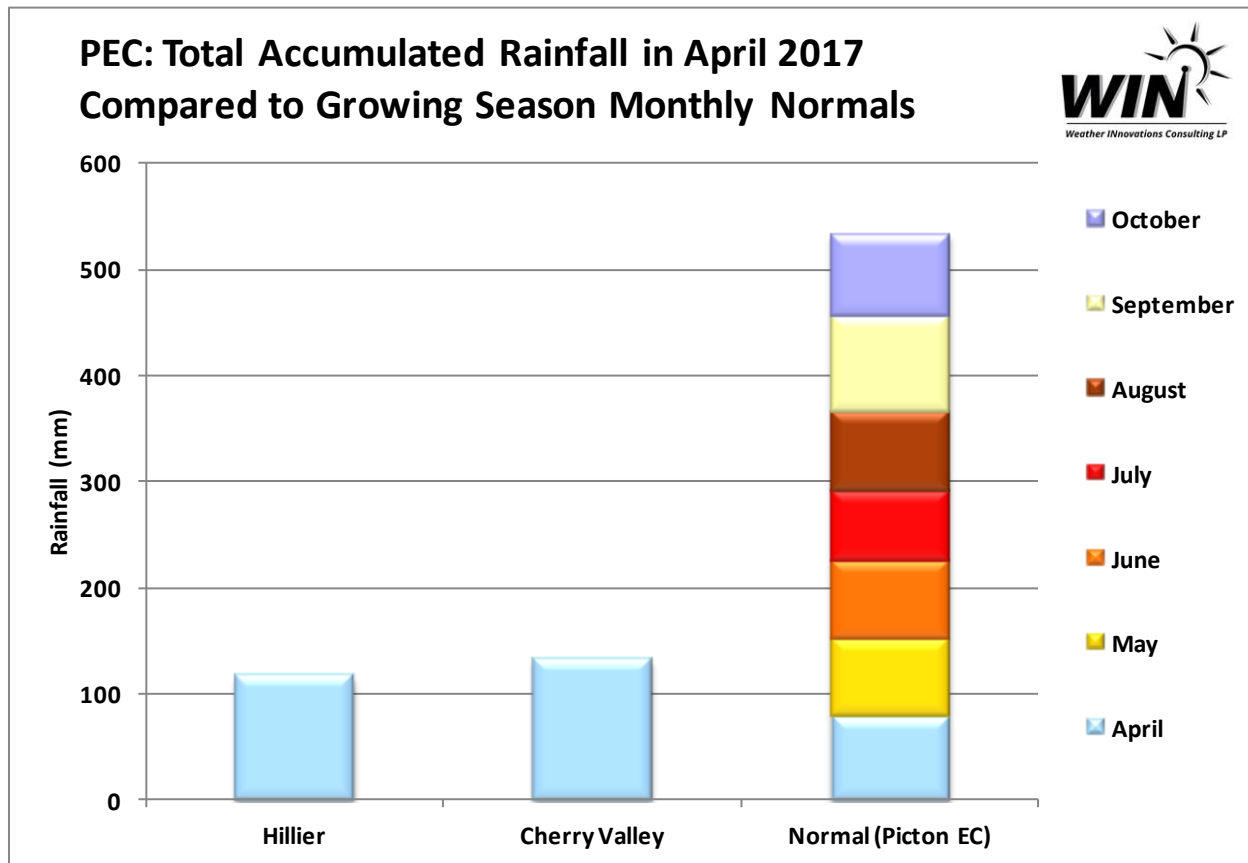


Figure 4: Rainfall
