



April 2018:

In April, daytime highs and overnight lows averaged below normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for April and were also below 2016 and 2017 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 102 % of normal for April. Up to 27.2 mm of rain fell across the appellation on April 3 and 4.

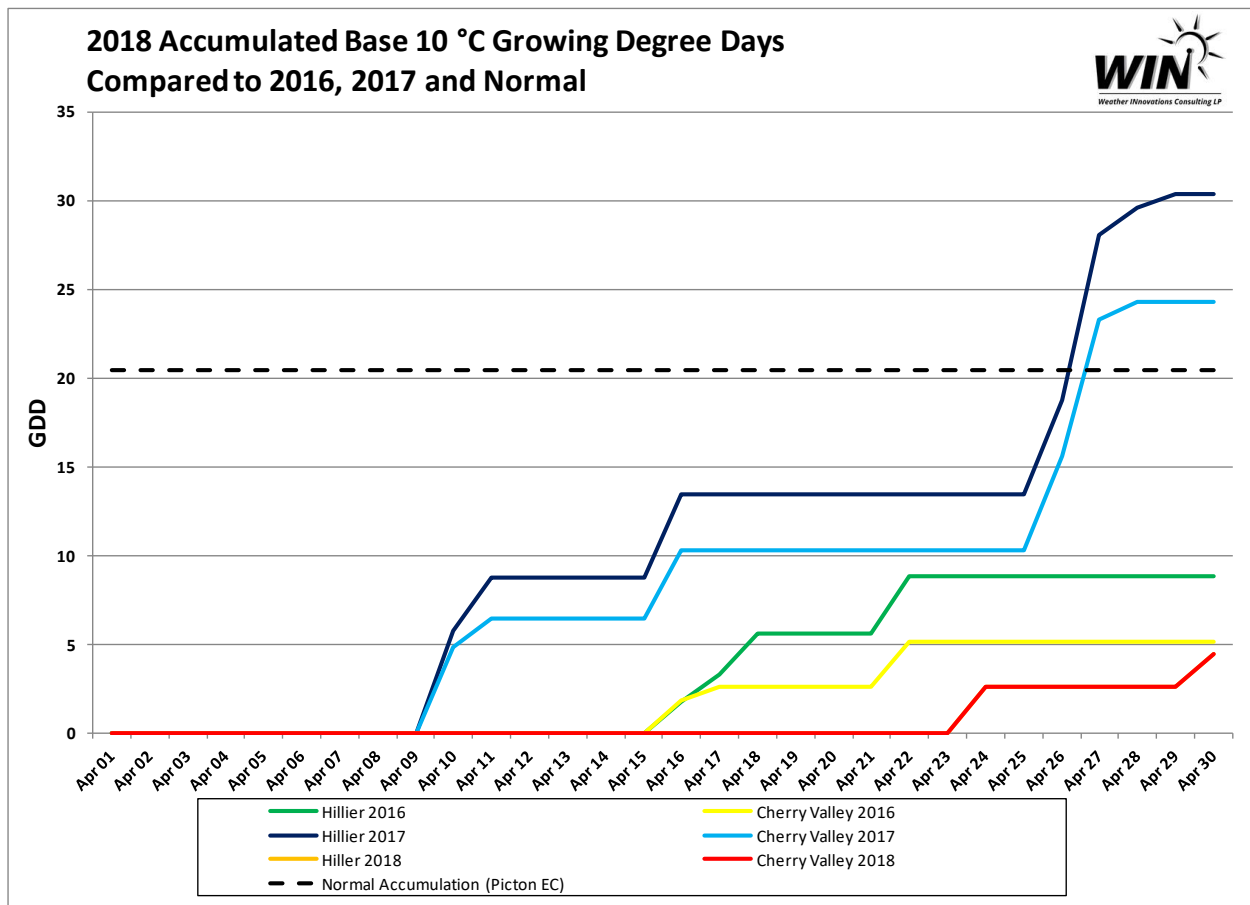


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

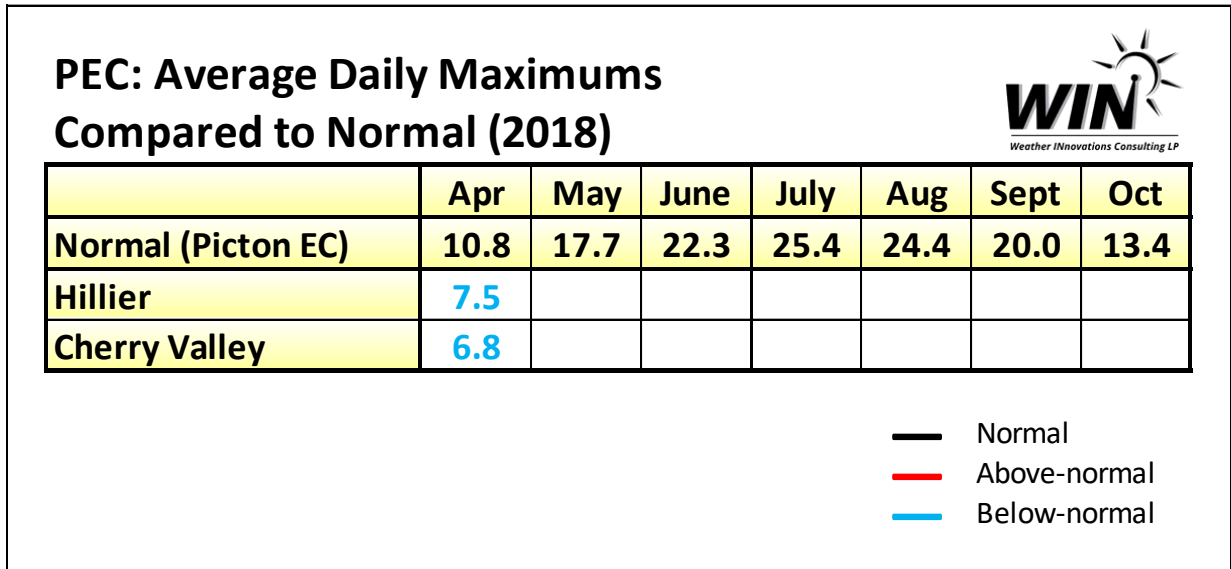


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

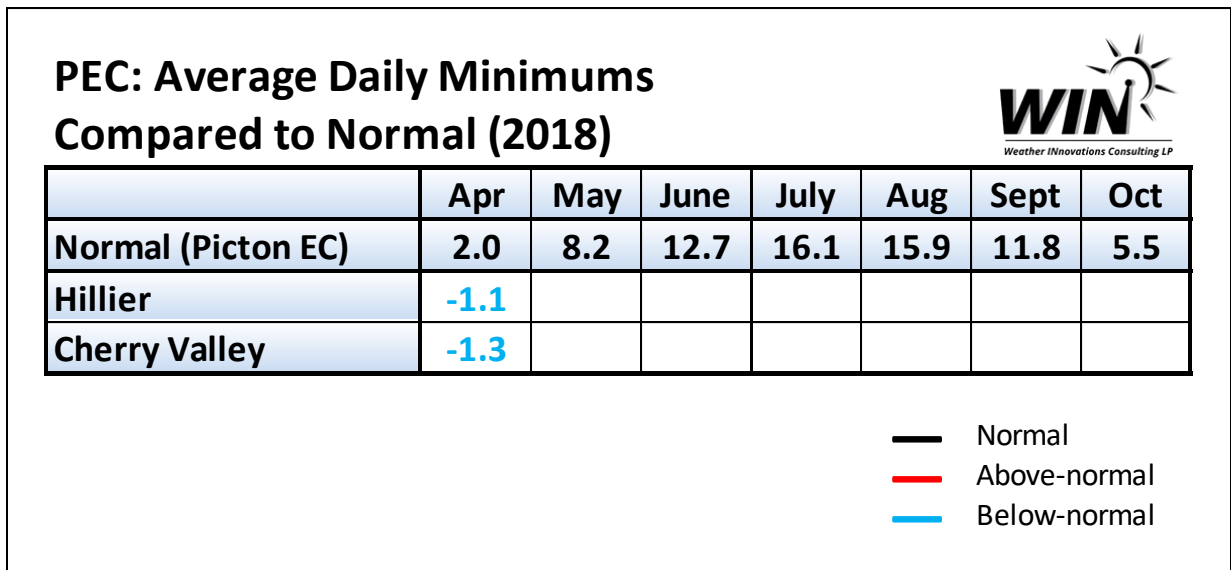


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

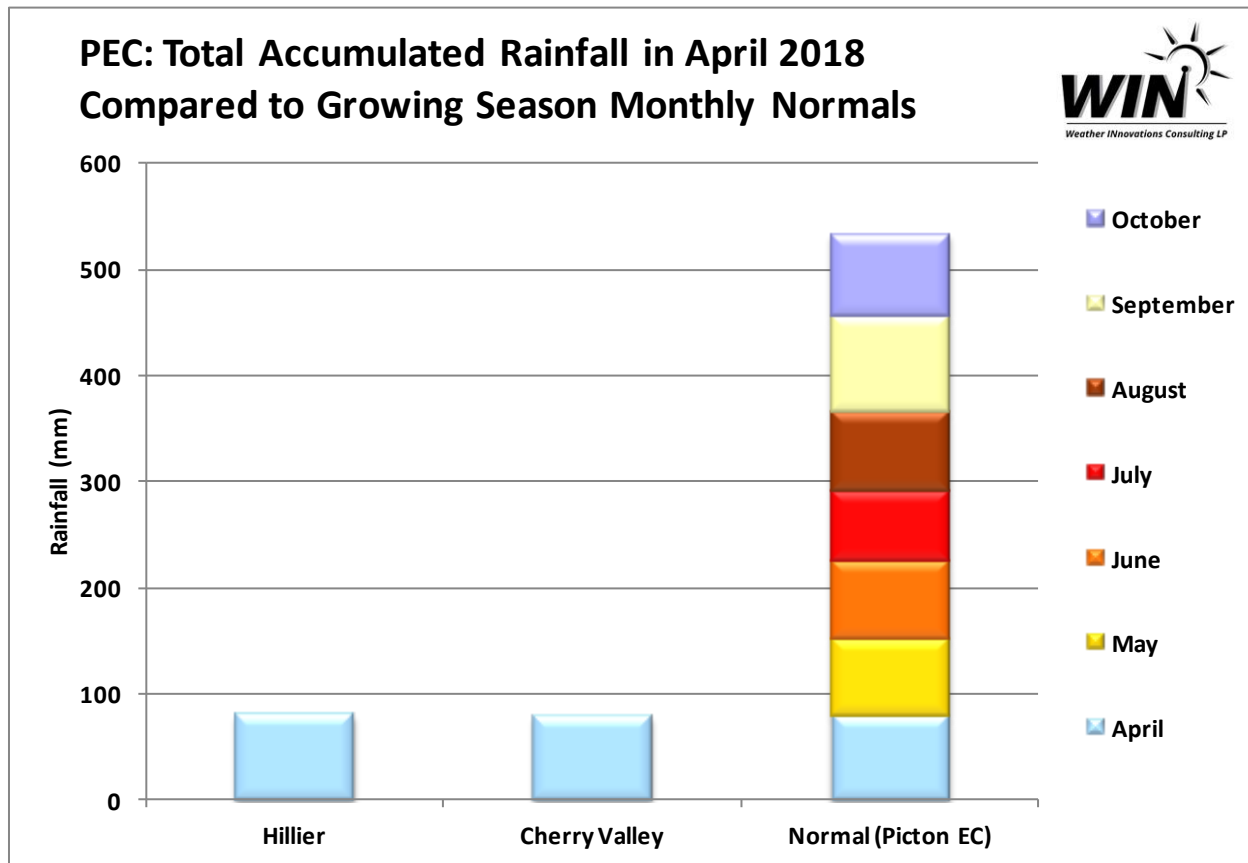


Figure 4: Rainfall
