



August 2017:

In August, daytime highs averaged above normal while overnight lows were below normal across the appellation. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for August. Accumulated growing degree days were below 2016 values and above 2015 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 50 % of normal for August. Up to 15 mm of rainfall was recorded in the appellation on August 4 and 11.

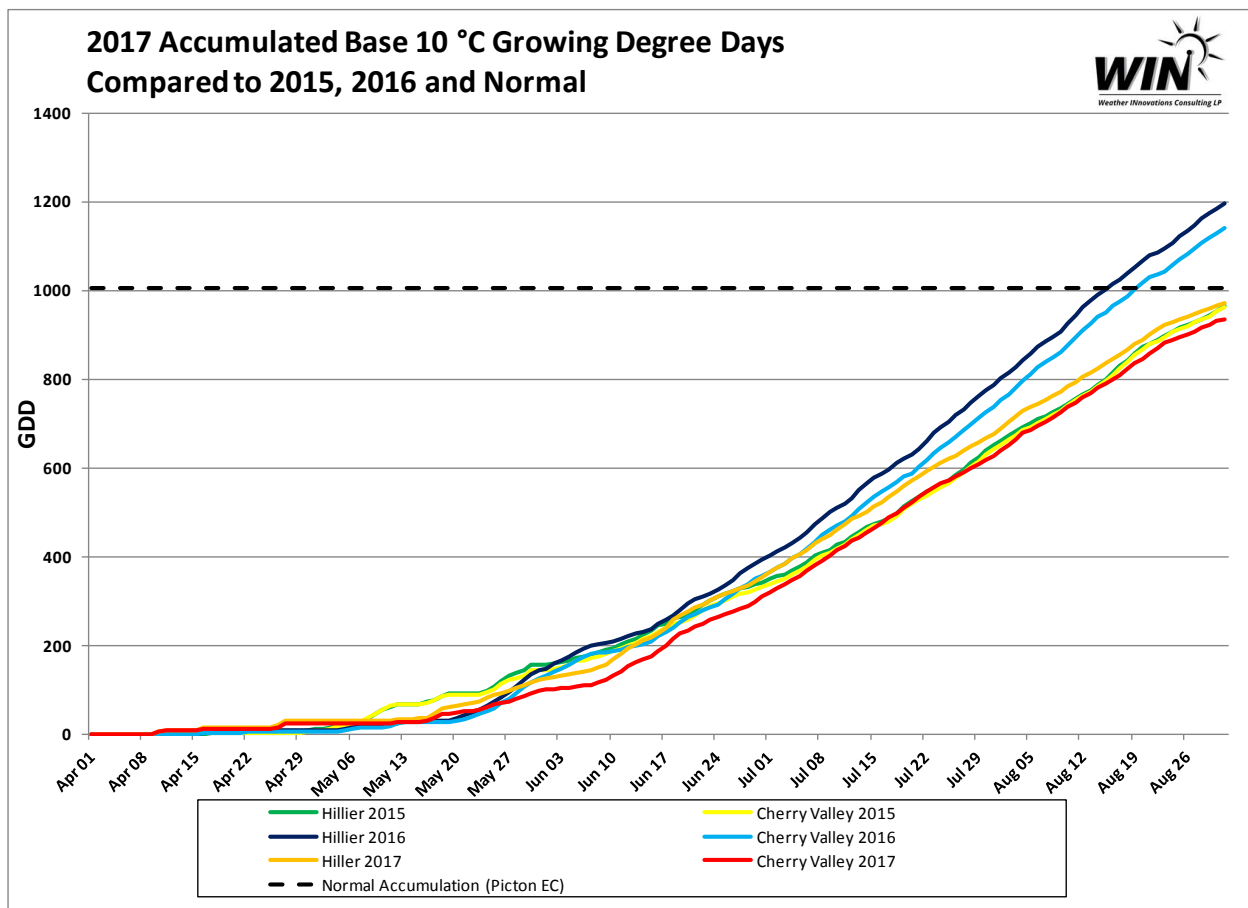


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

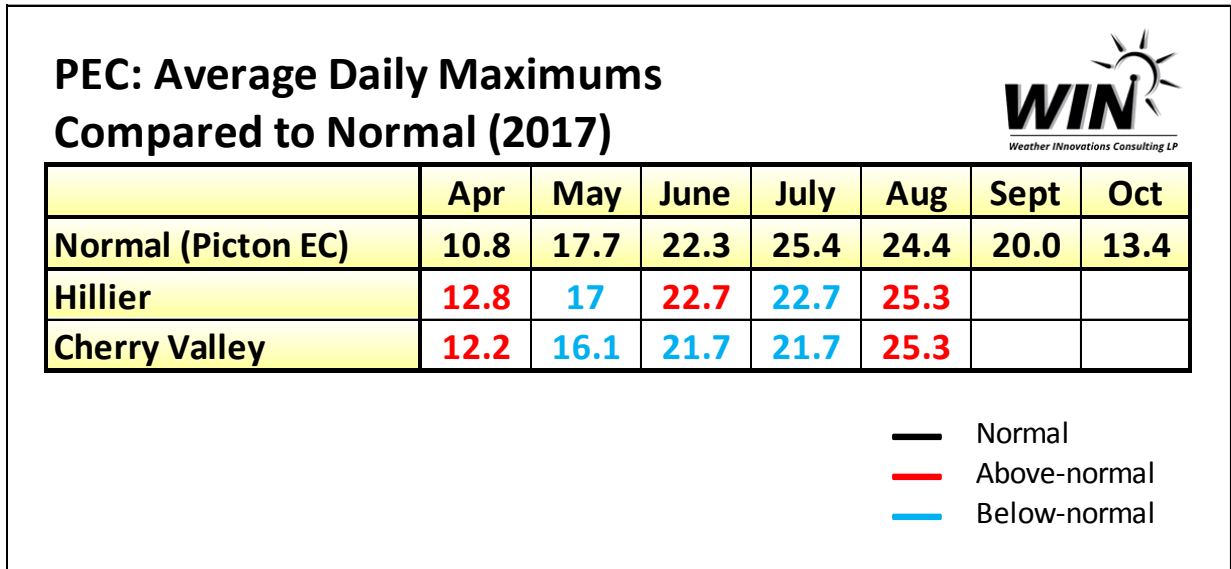


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

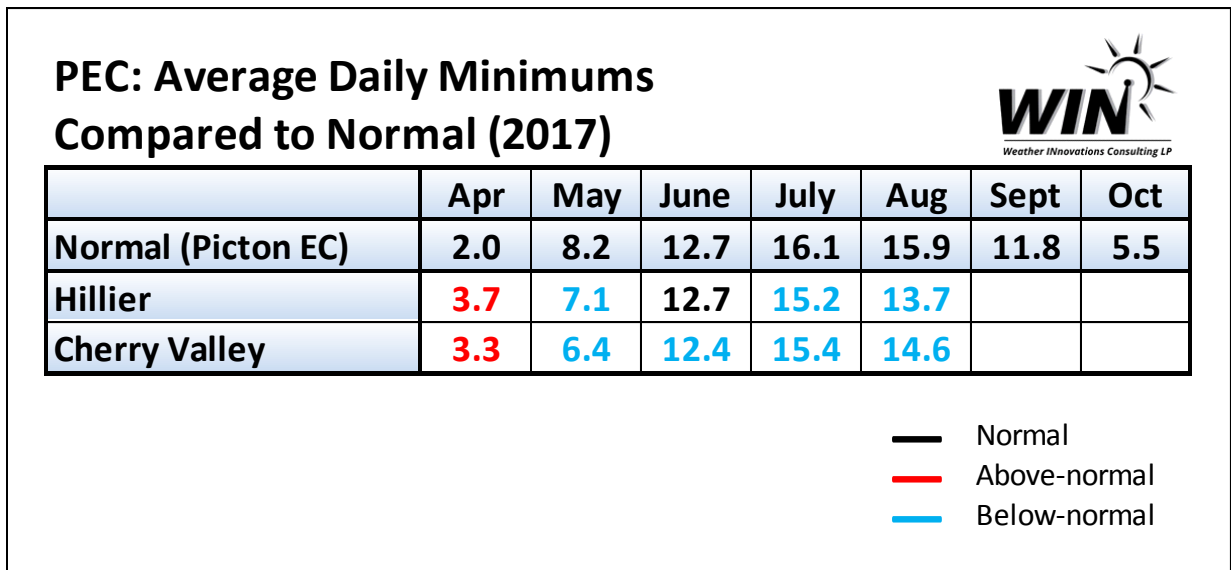


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

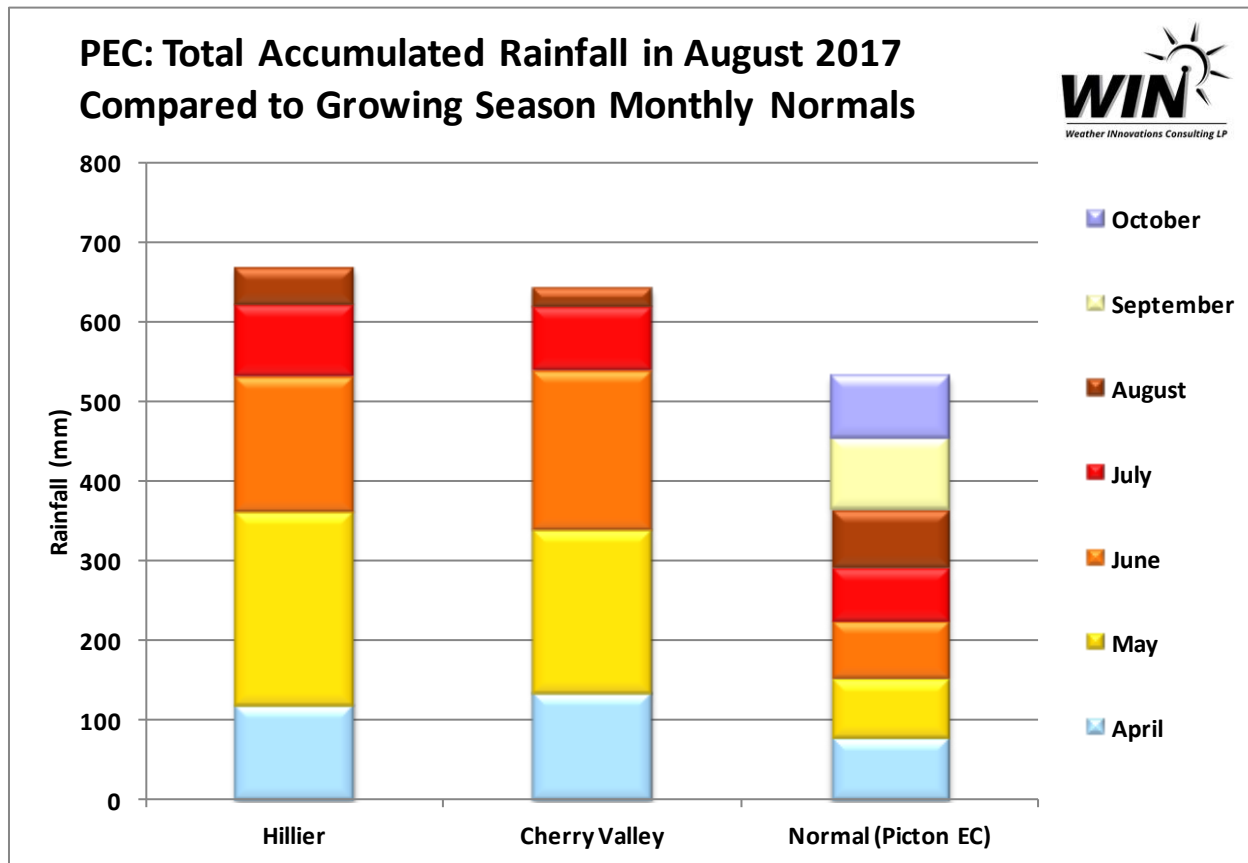


Figure 4: Rainfall
