



August 2018:

In August, daytime high and overnight low temperatures averaged above normal across the appellation. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for August. Accumulated growing degree days were near 2016 values and above 2017 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 116 % of normal for August. Up to 73 mm of rainfall was recorded in the appellation over August 7 through 8.

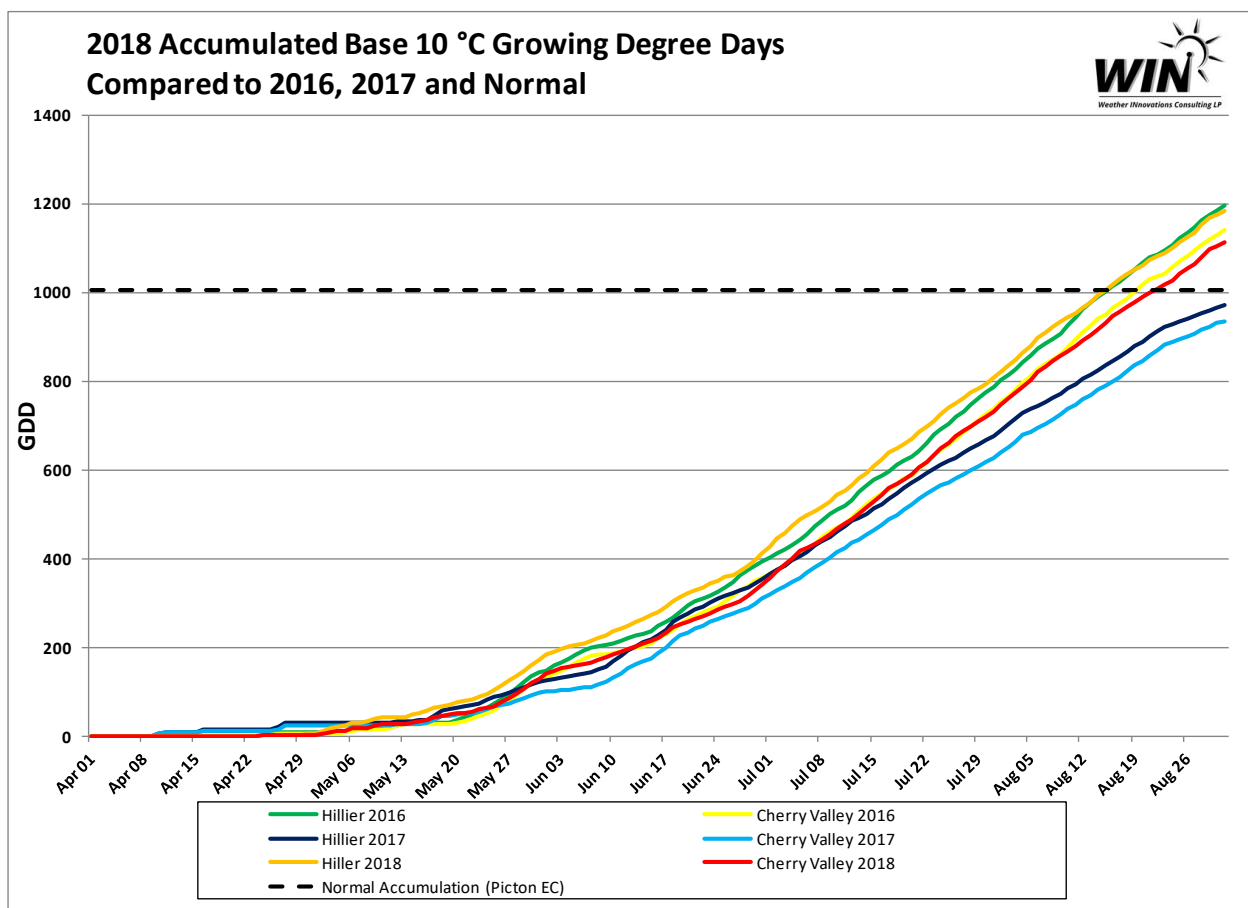


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

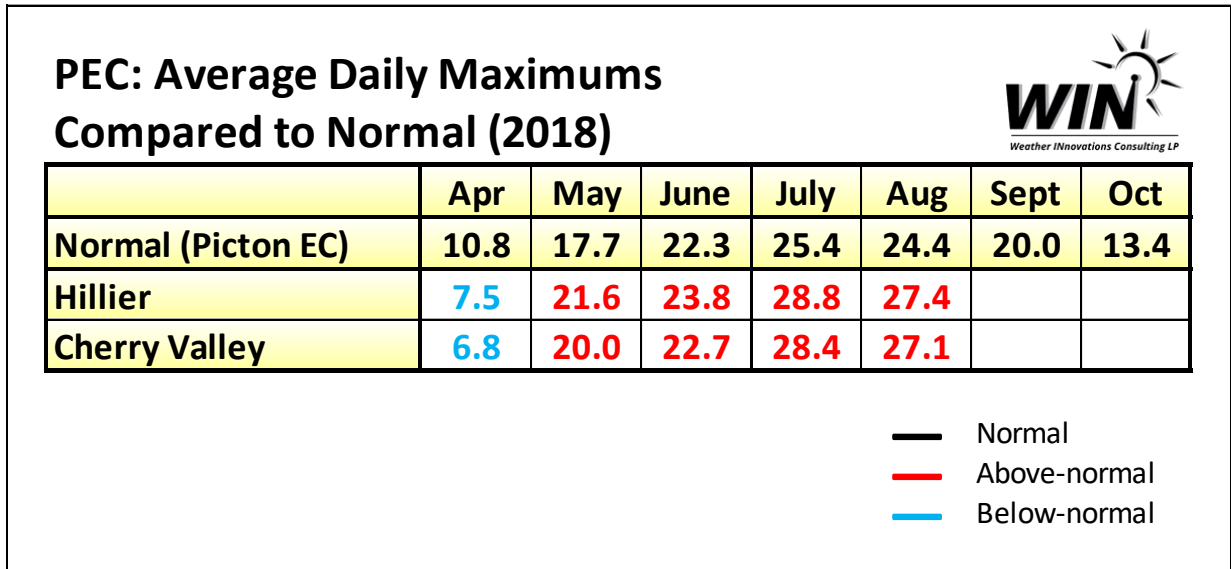


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

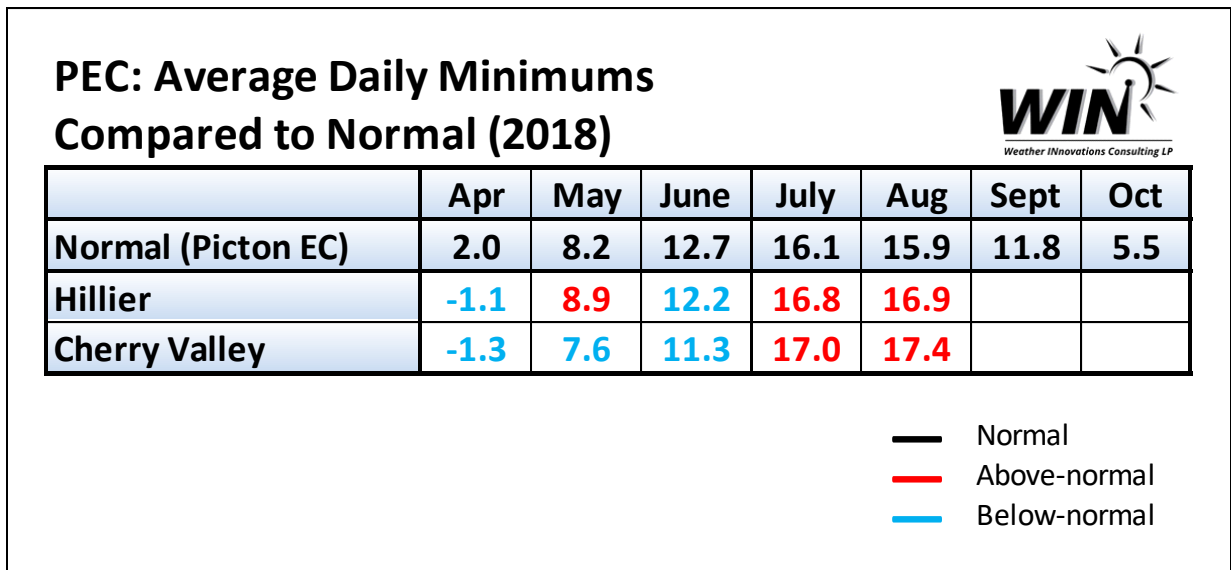


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

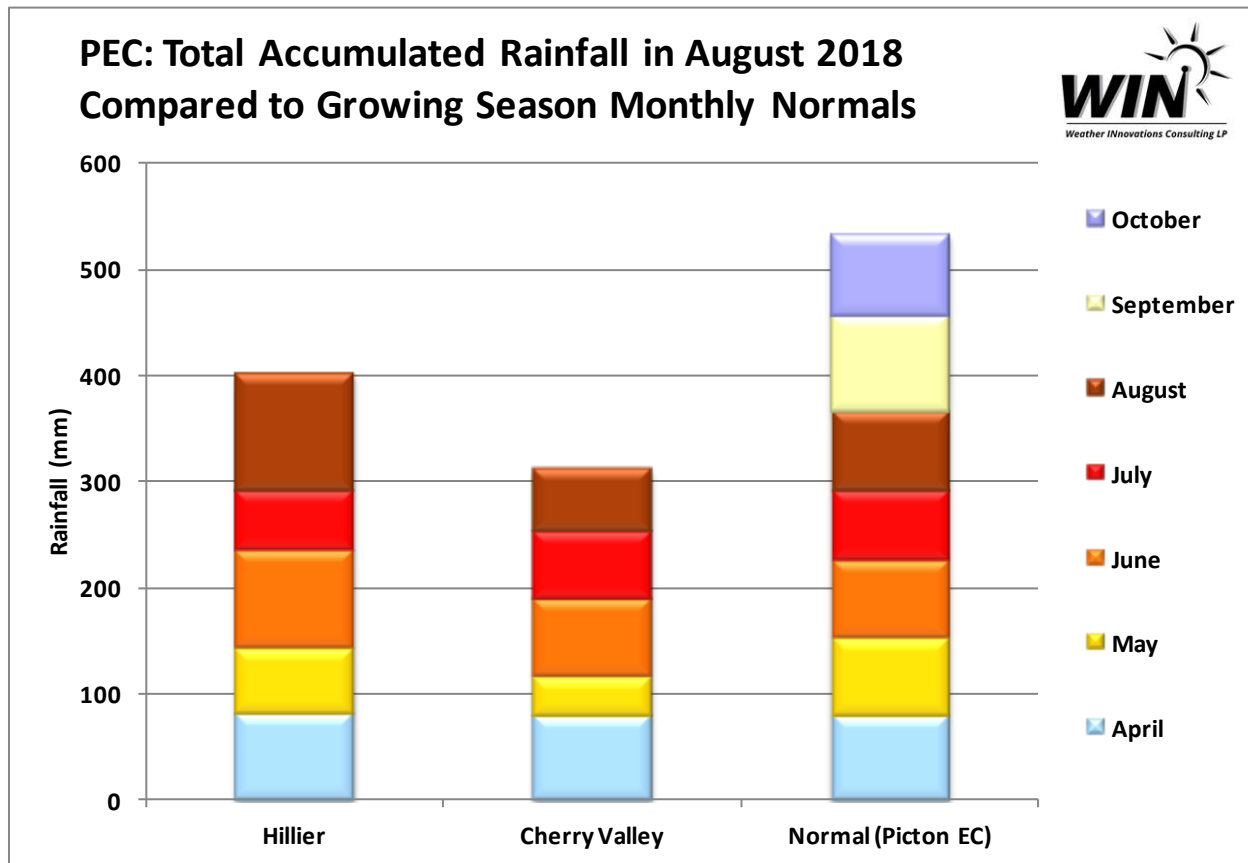


Figure 4: Rainfall
