



August 2014:

August brought slightly above normal daytime highs and below normal overnight lows to Prince Edward County. Accordingly, the accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days was less than normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days remained below normal and below 2012 and 2013 values. August rainfall ranged from below normal to above normal for an average of 99 % of normal. Cherry Valley received over 50 mm of rain on August 12.

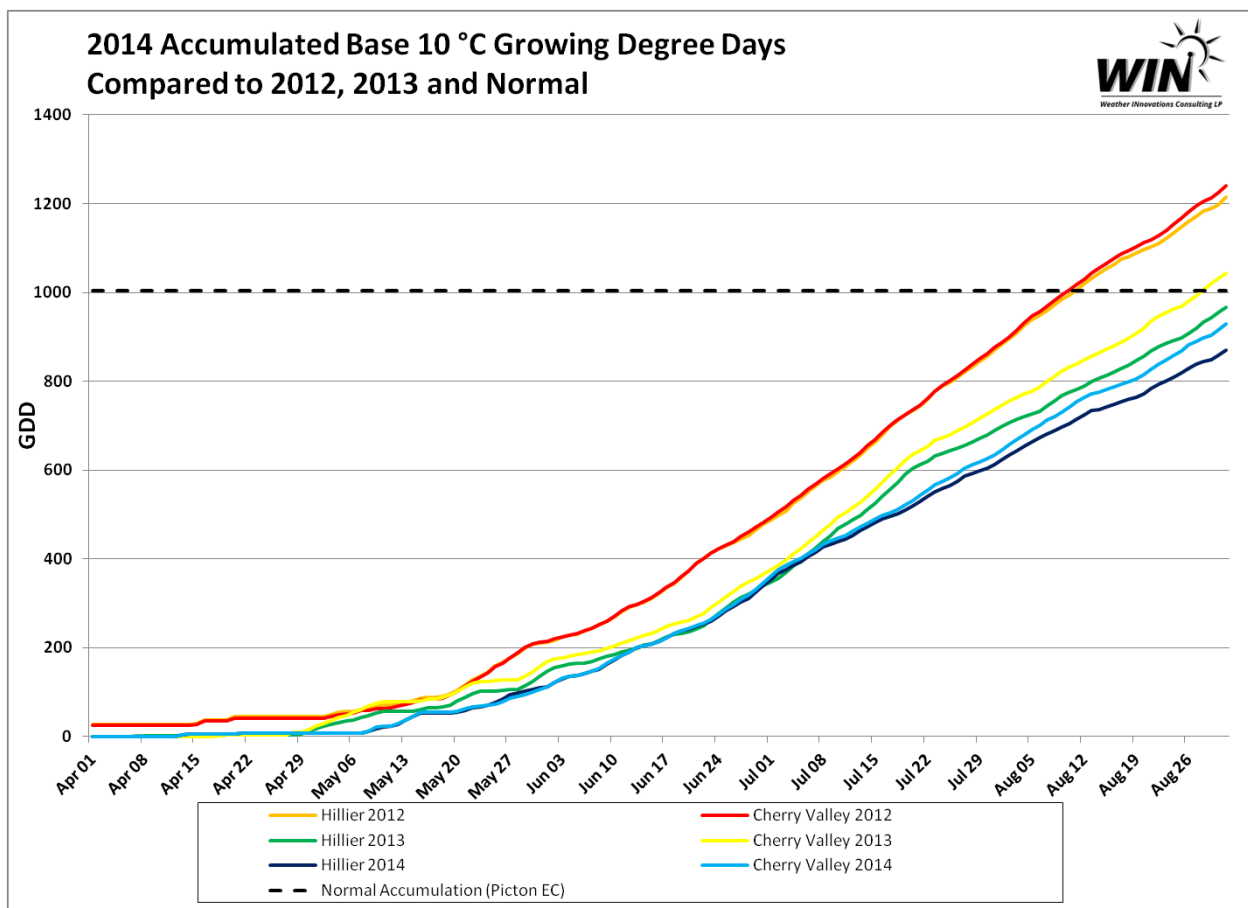


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

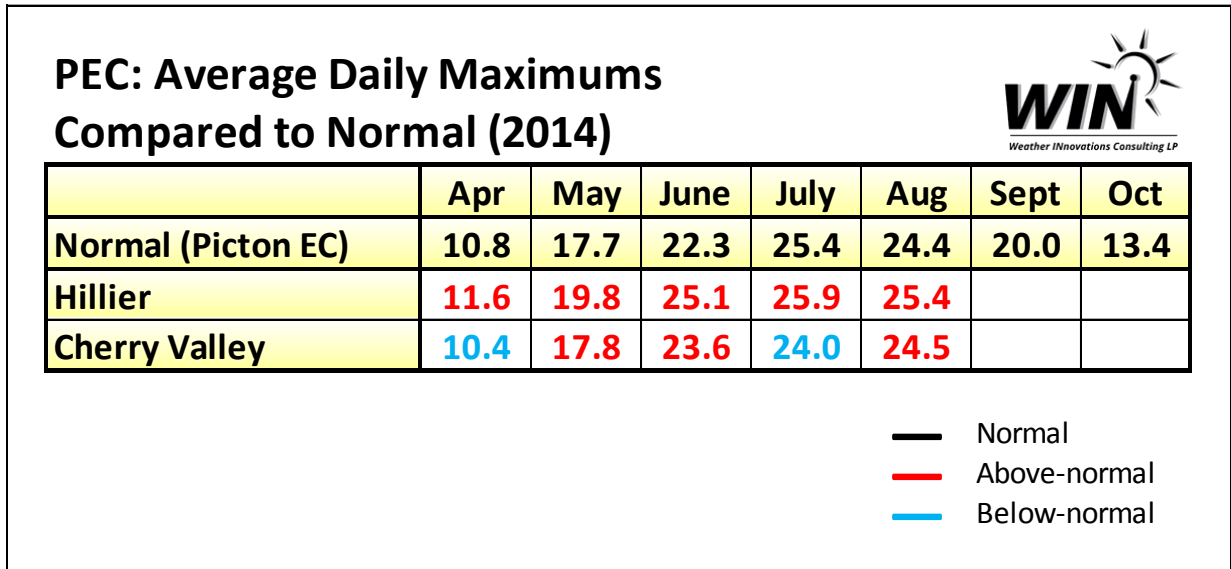


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

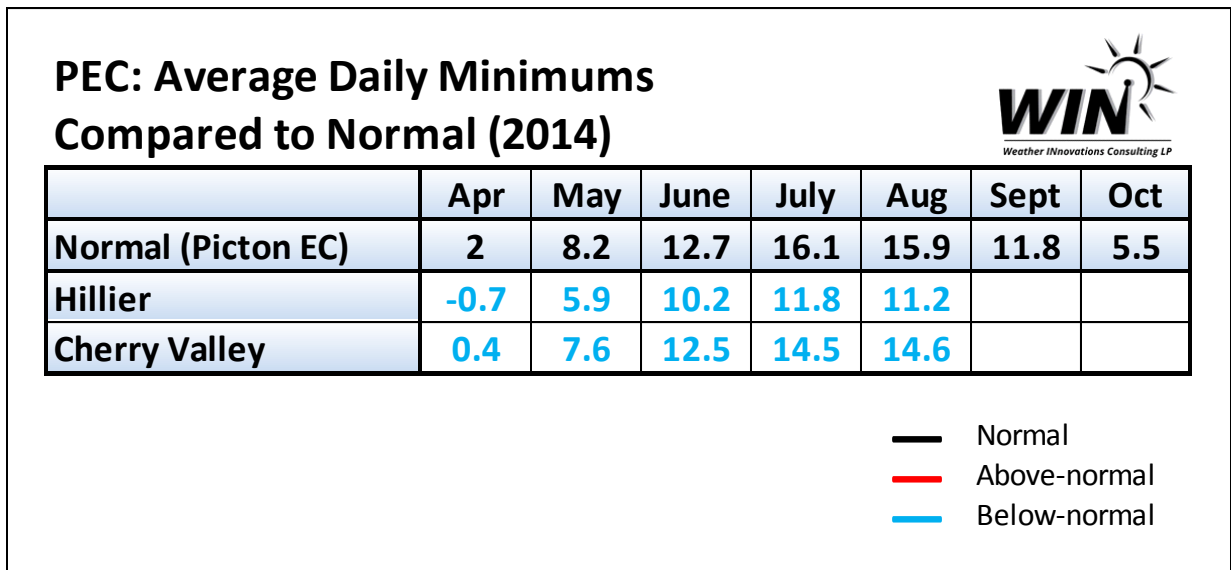


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

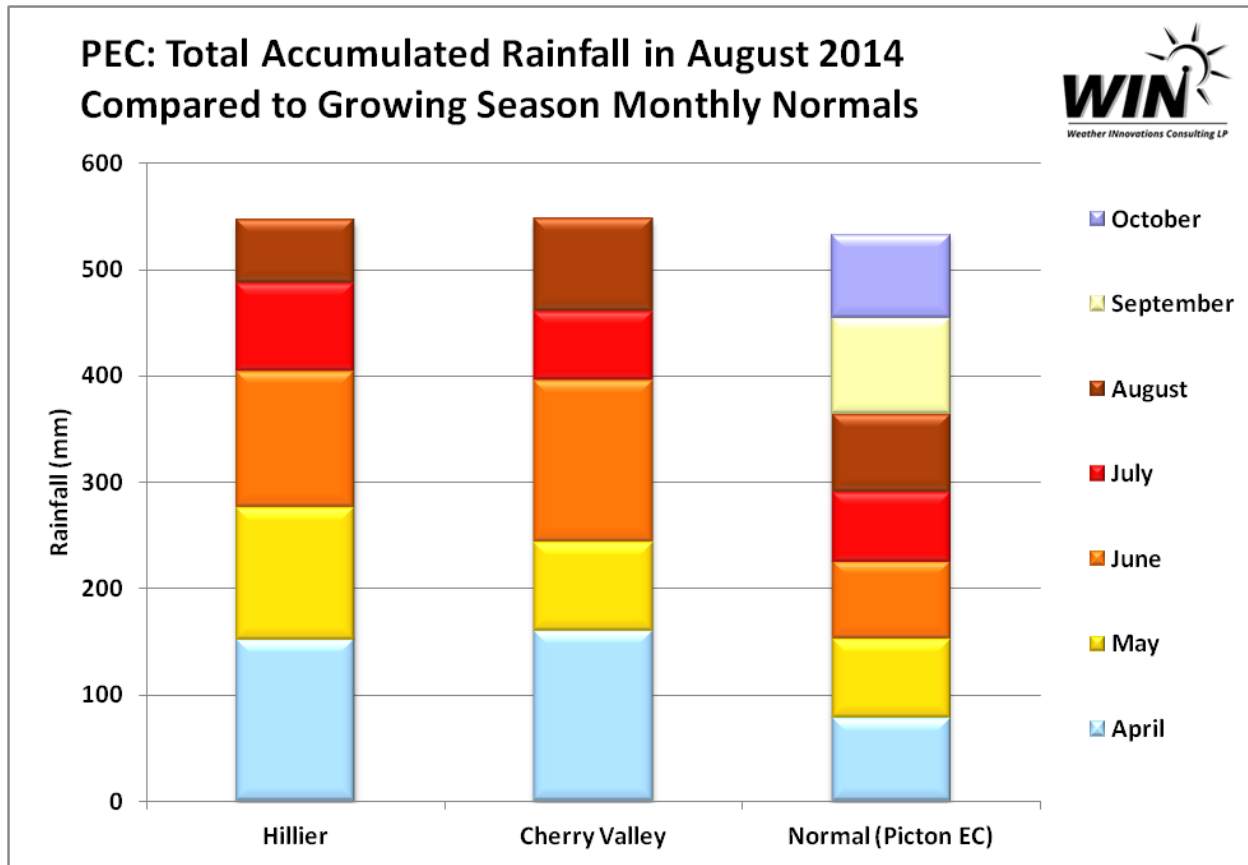


Figure 4: Rainfall
