



### August 2015:

August daytime highs were above normal across the appellation. Overnight lows continued to average below normal at Hillier but returned to average at Cherry Valley. As a result, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were near normal for August. Accumulated growing degree days were similar to 2013 values at Hillier and slightly above 2014 values at Cherry Valley. Growing degree day totals remained below 2013 values at Cherry Valley and above 2014 values at Hillier. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 105 % of normal for August. The appellation received between 10 mm and 22 mm of rain on August 10 and up to 42 mm of rain on August 20.

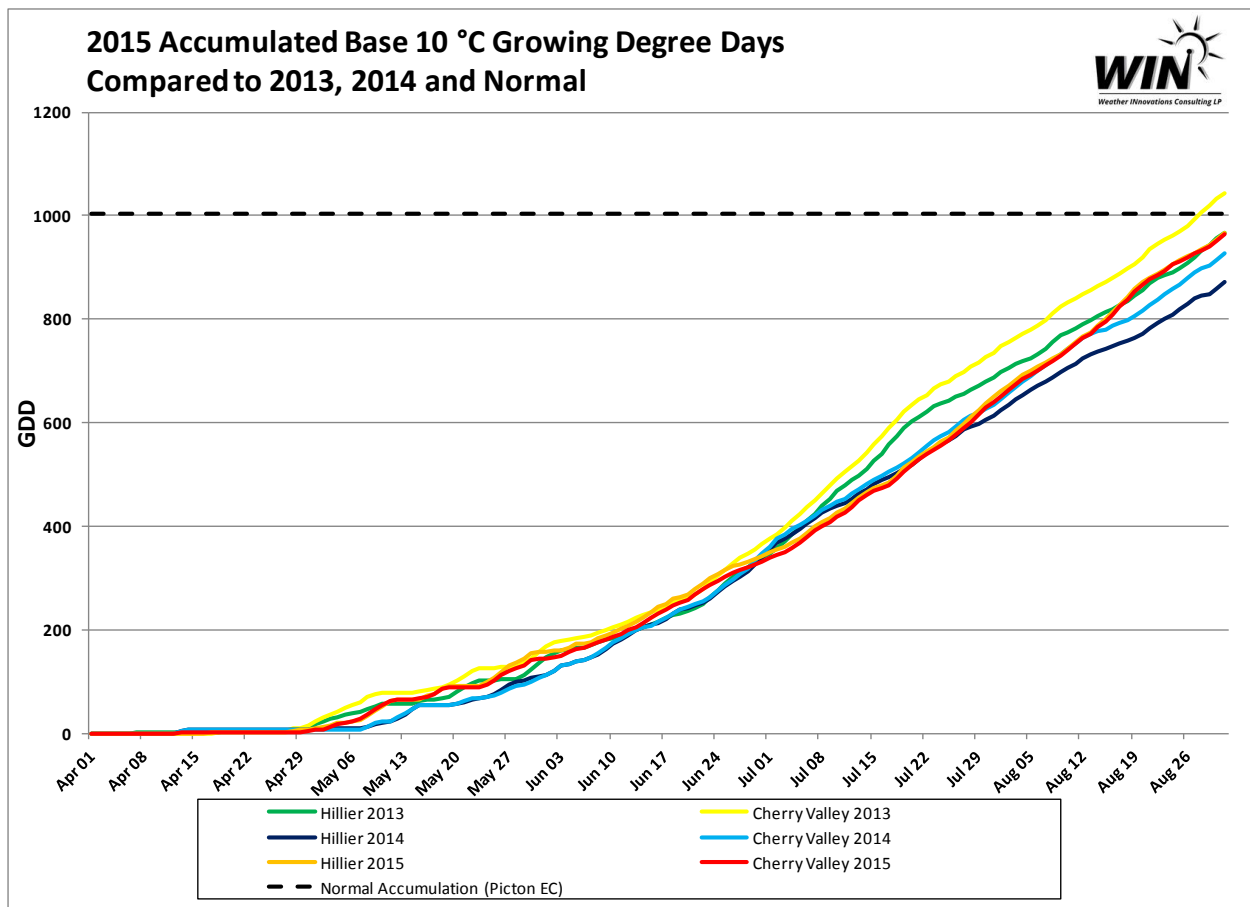


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

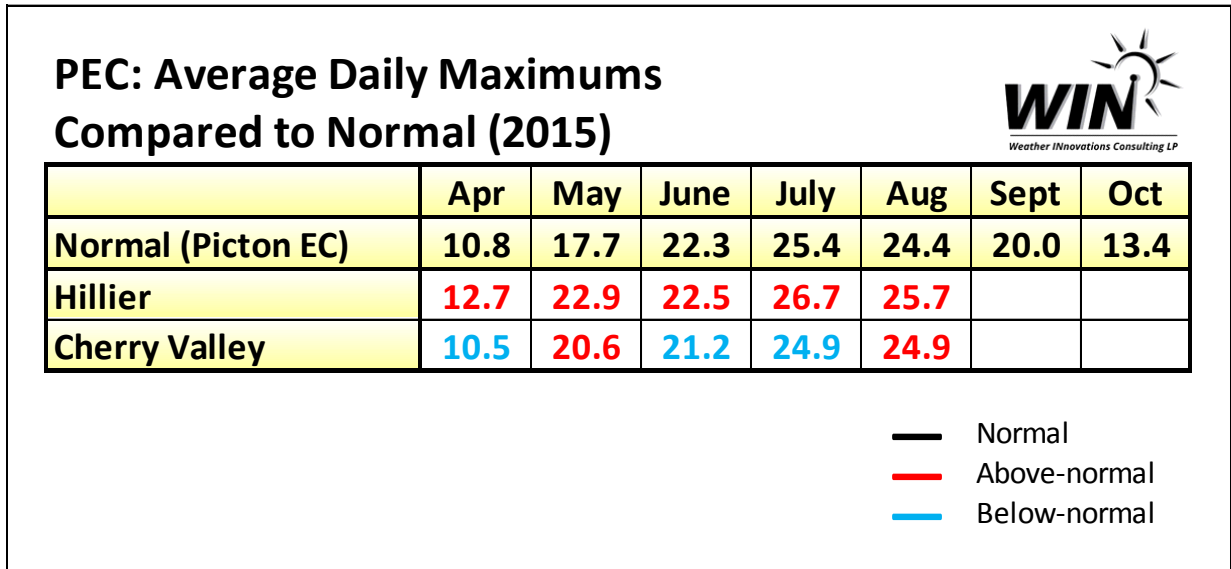


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

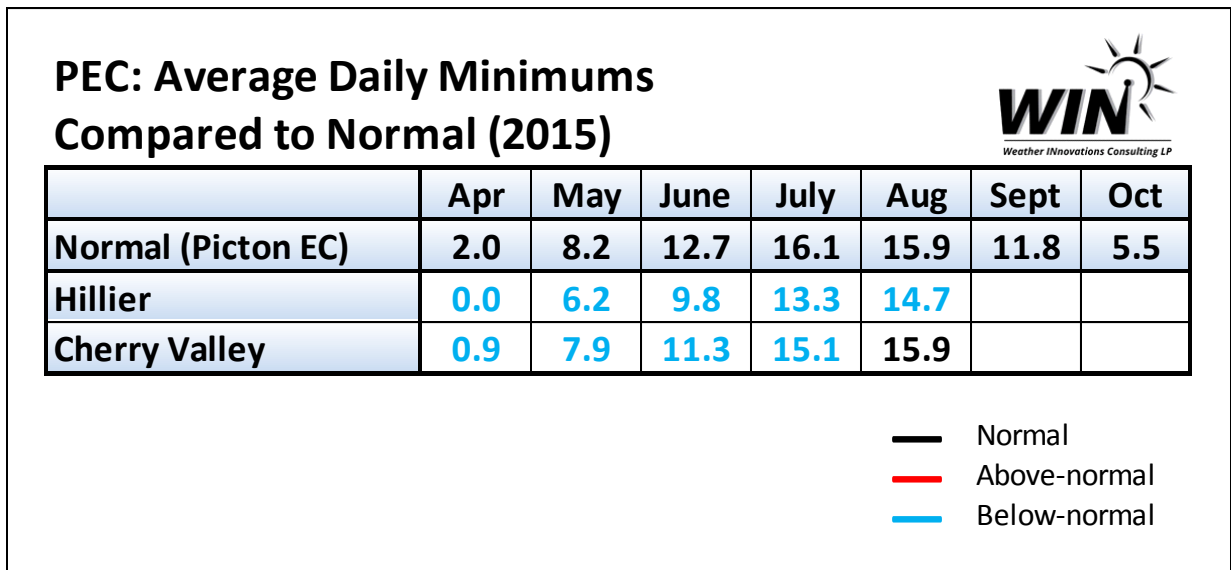


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

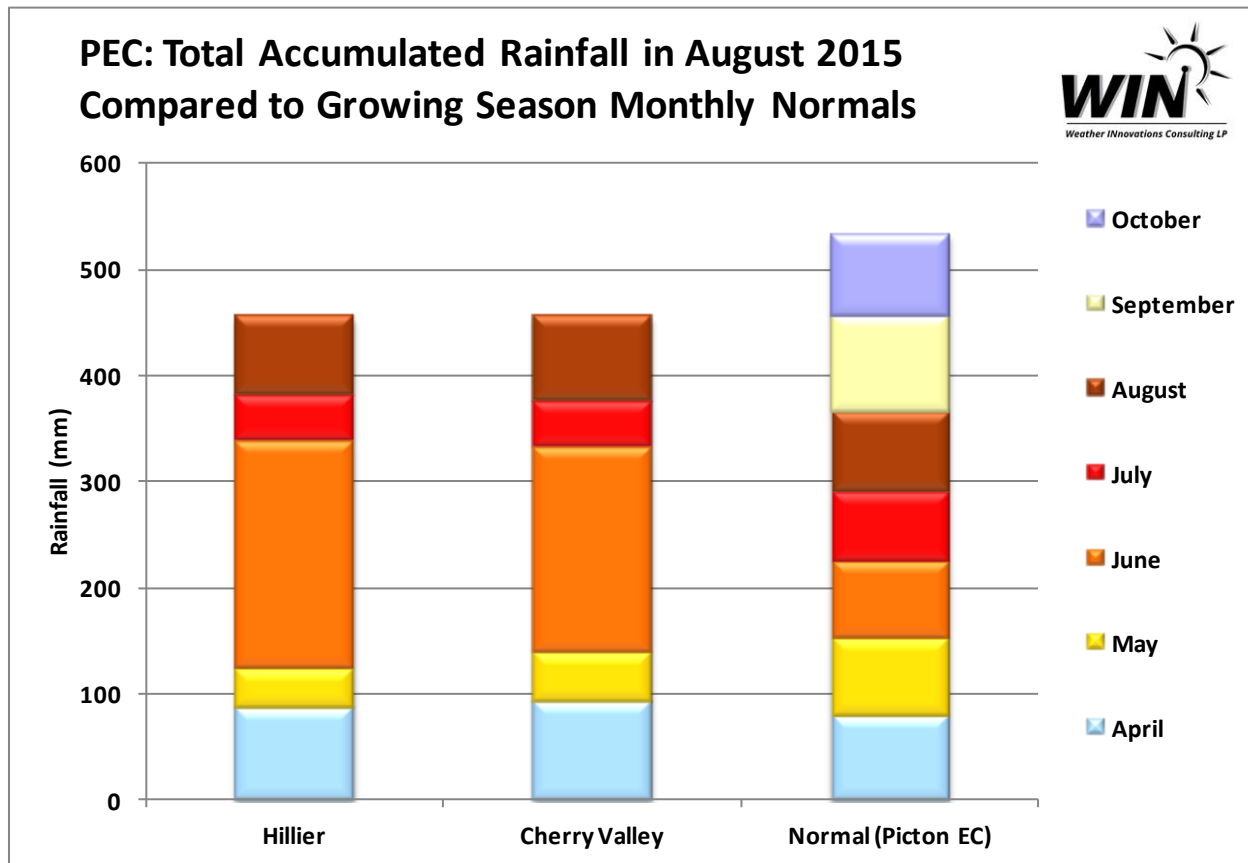


Figure 4: Rainfall
