



July 2017:

In July, daytime highs and overnight lows averaged below normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for July. Accumulated growing degree days were below 2016 values and near 2015 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 130 % of normal for July. Up to 67 mm of rain fell over the appellation over July 12 – 14.

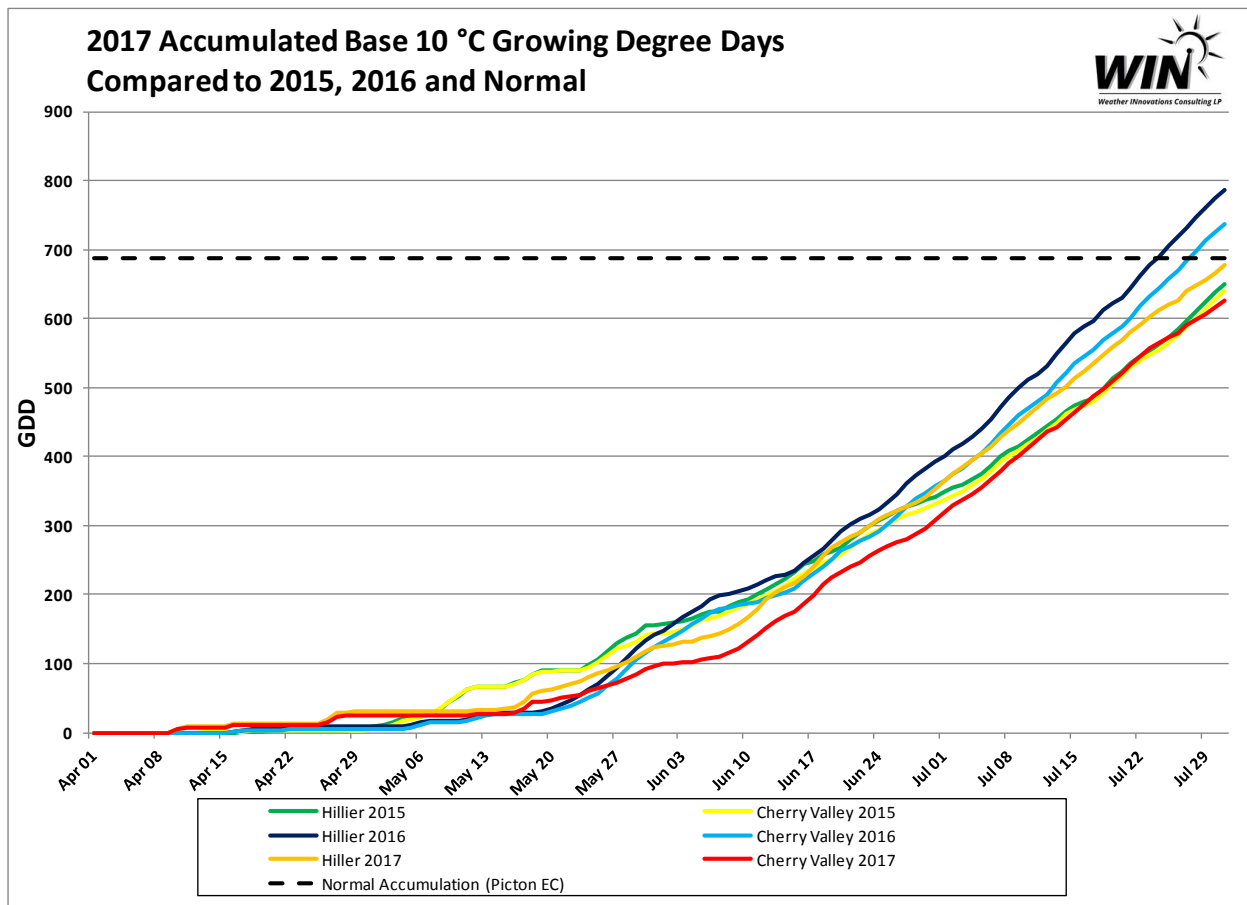


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

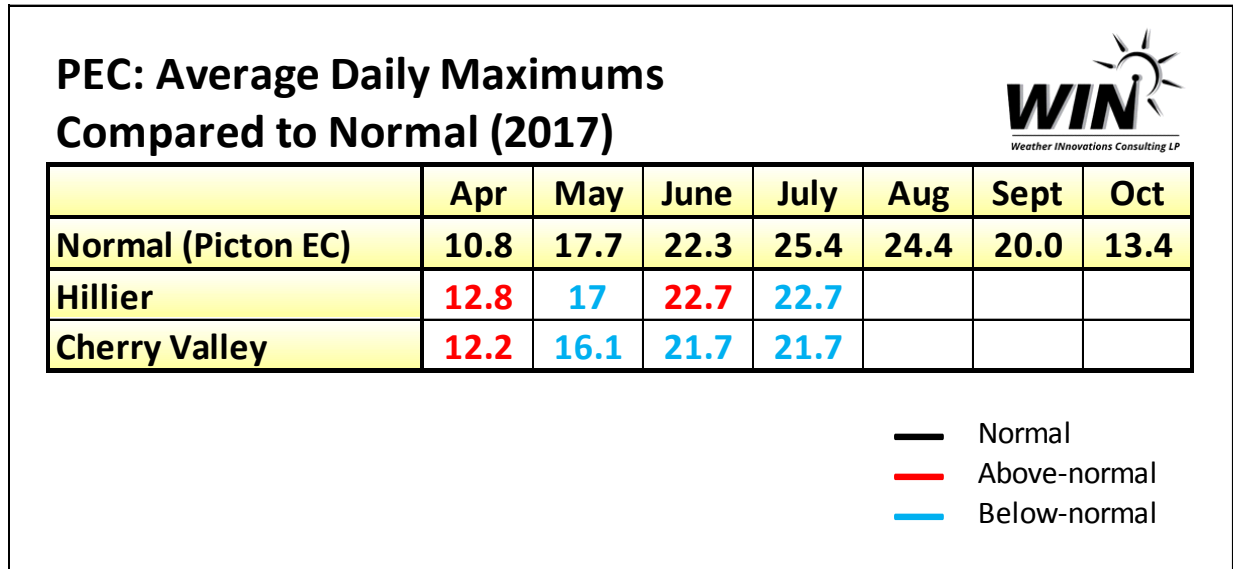


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

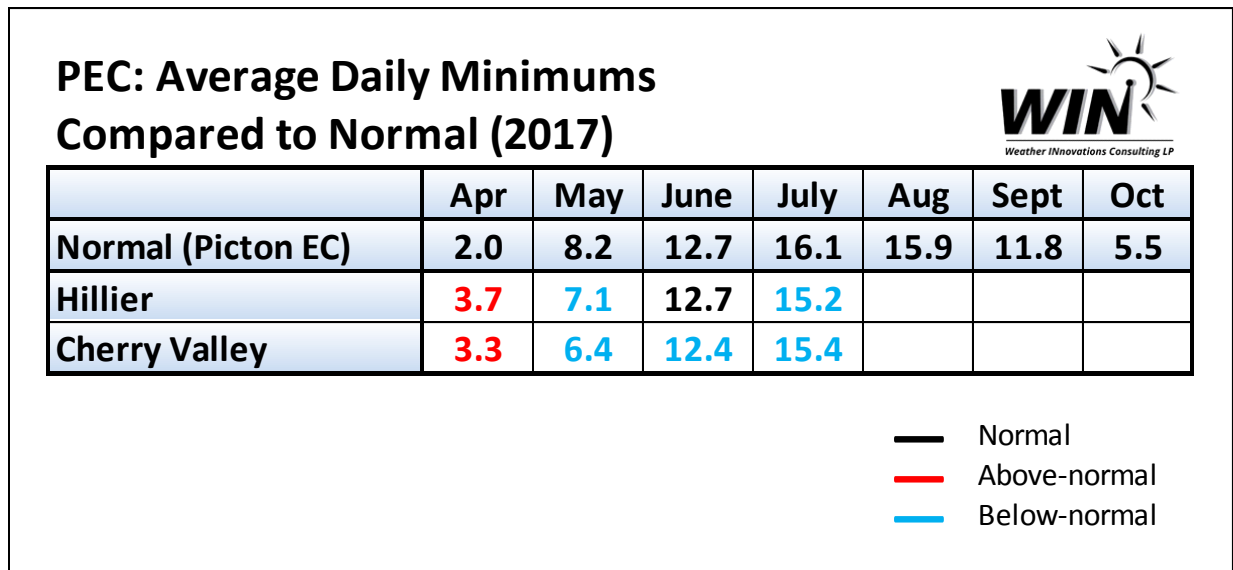


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

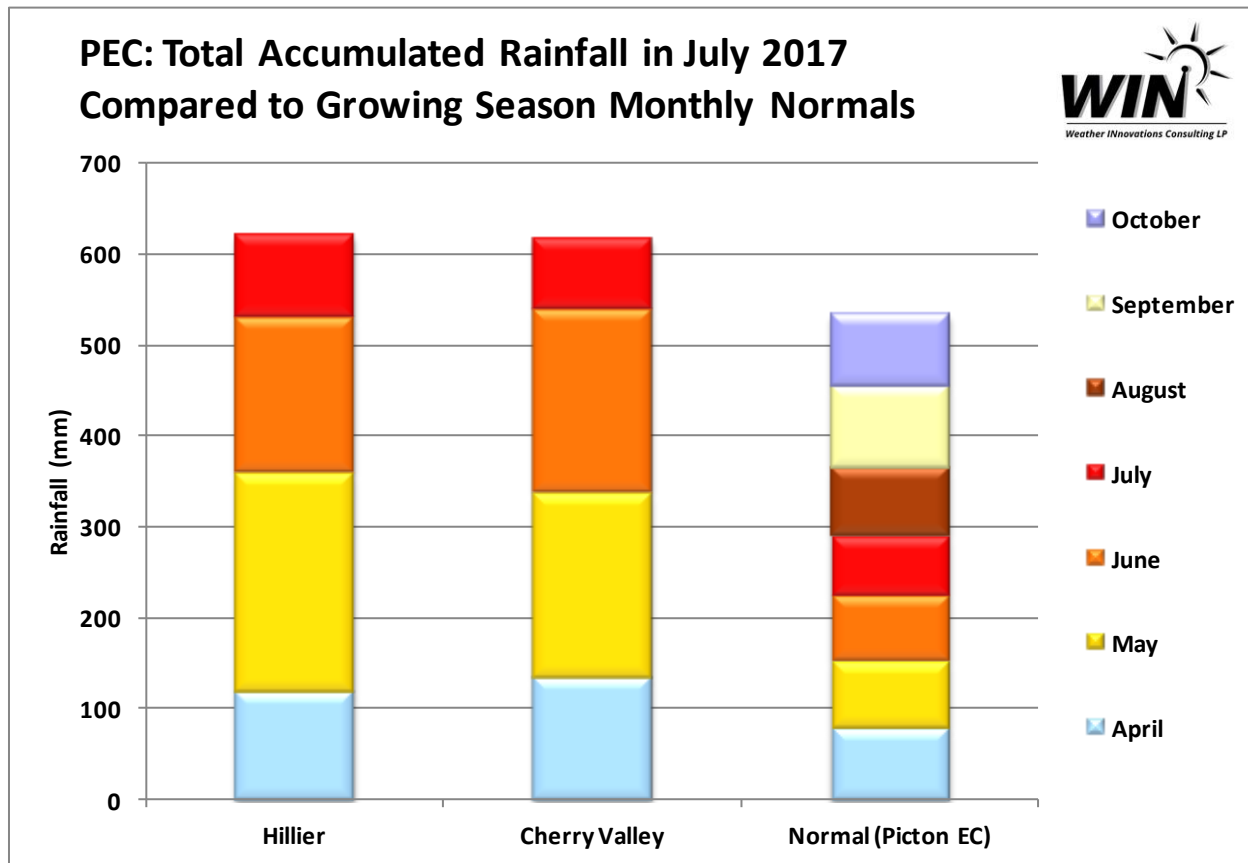


Figure 4: Rainfall
