



July 2018:

In July, daytime highs and overnight lows averaged above normal across the appellation. Accordingly, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for July. Accumulated growing degree days were above 2017 values and near 2016 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 92 % of normal for July. Up to 33 mm of rain fell across the appellation on July 25.

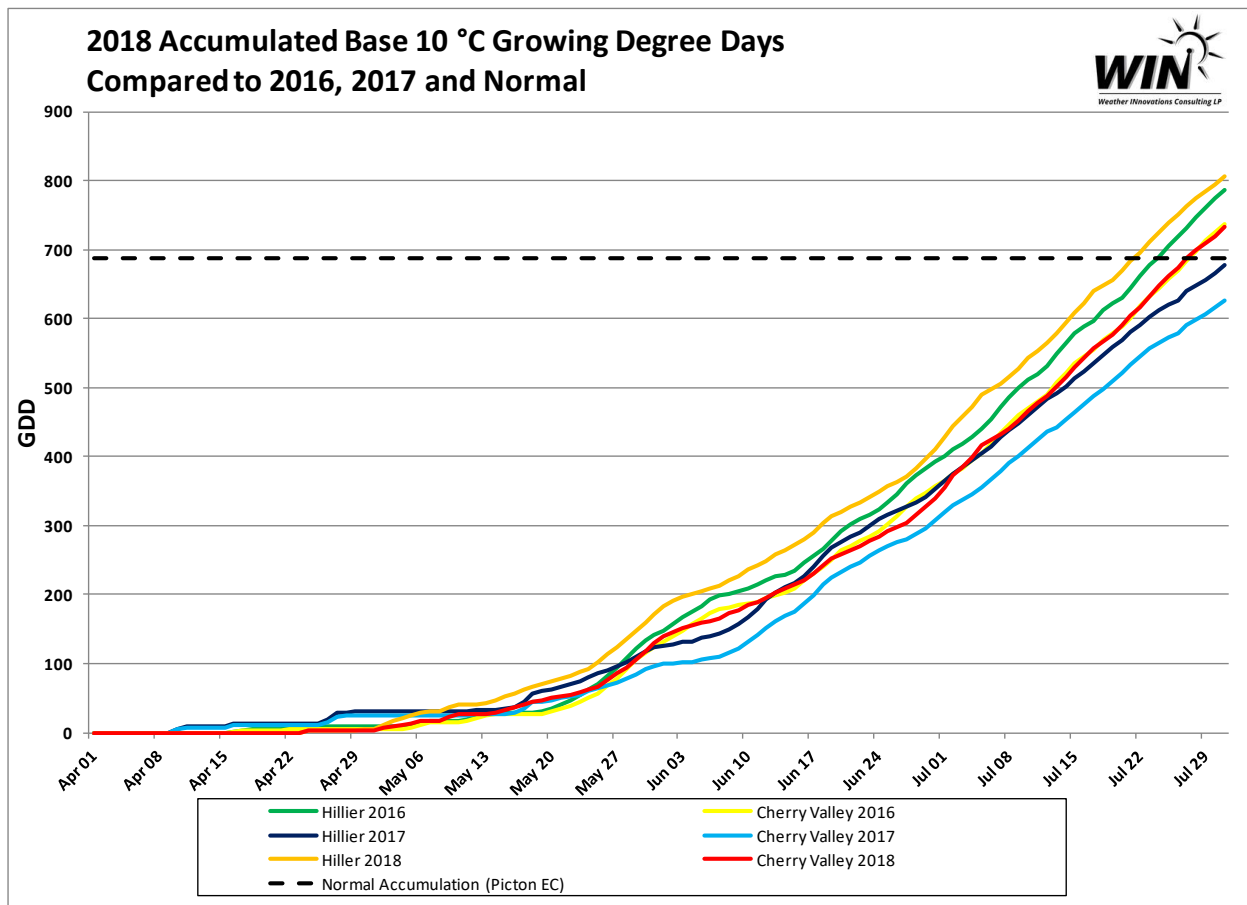


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

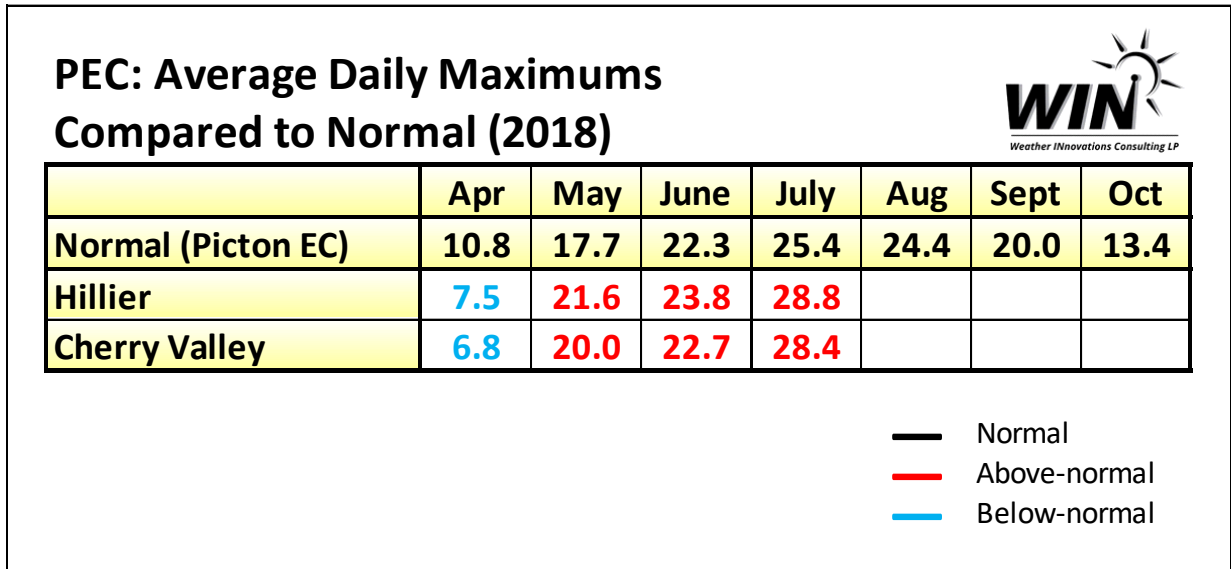


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

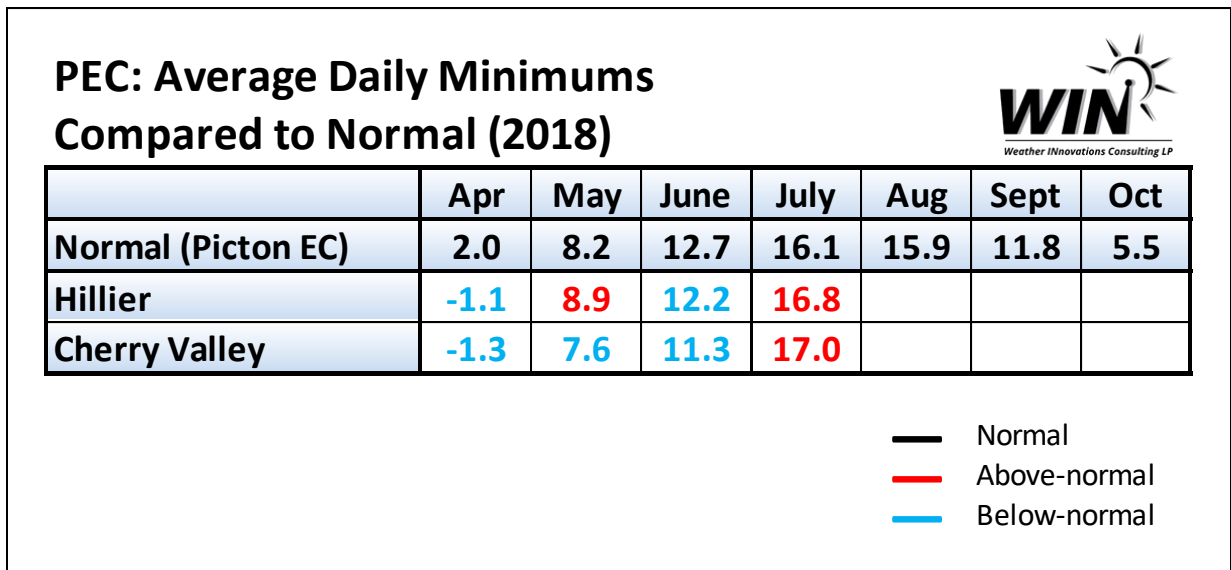


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

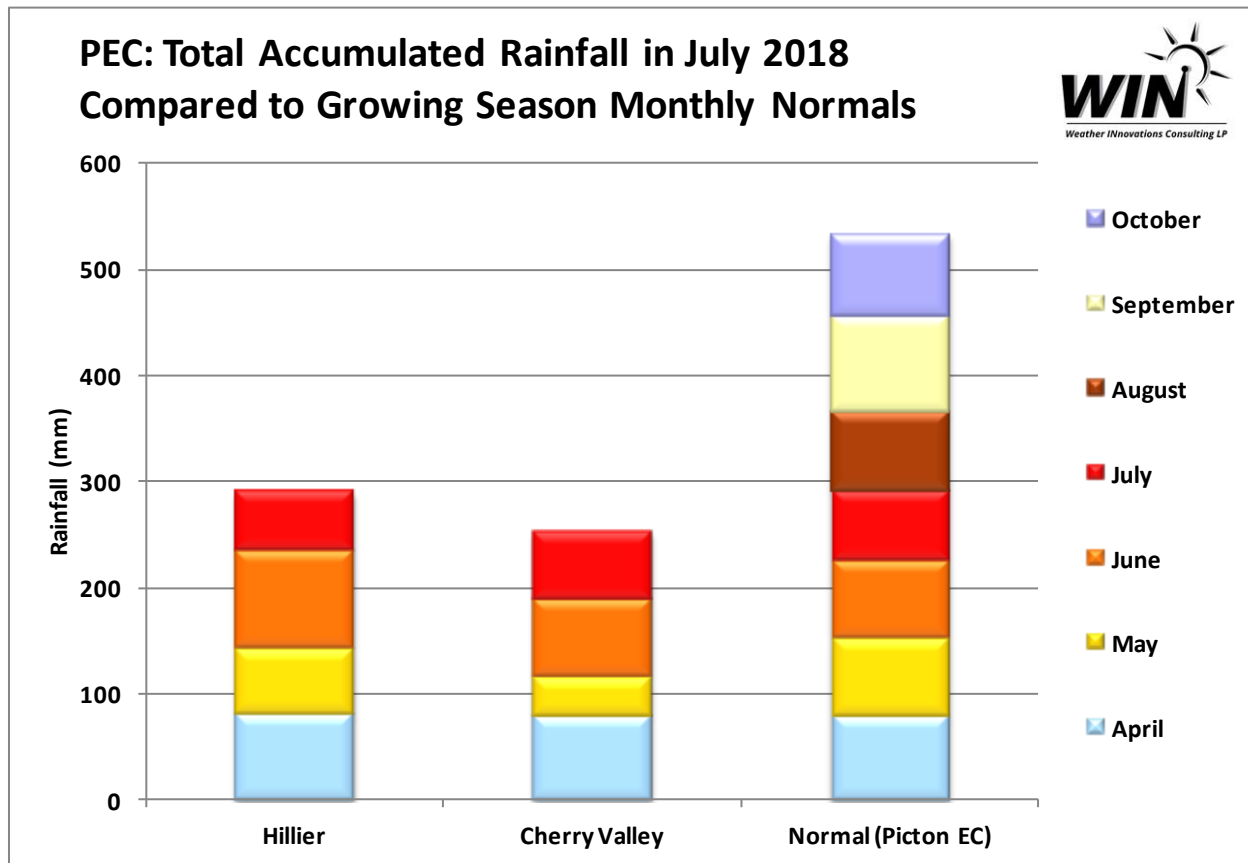


Figure 4: Rainfall
