



July 2014:

July brought slightly above normal to below normal daytime high temperatures and below average overnight low temperatures to the appellation. Accordingly, July accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were less than normal accumulation for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days fell below normal and continued to remain below 2012 and 2013 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County ranged from normal to above normal with an average of 113 % of normal rainfall.

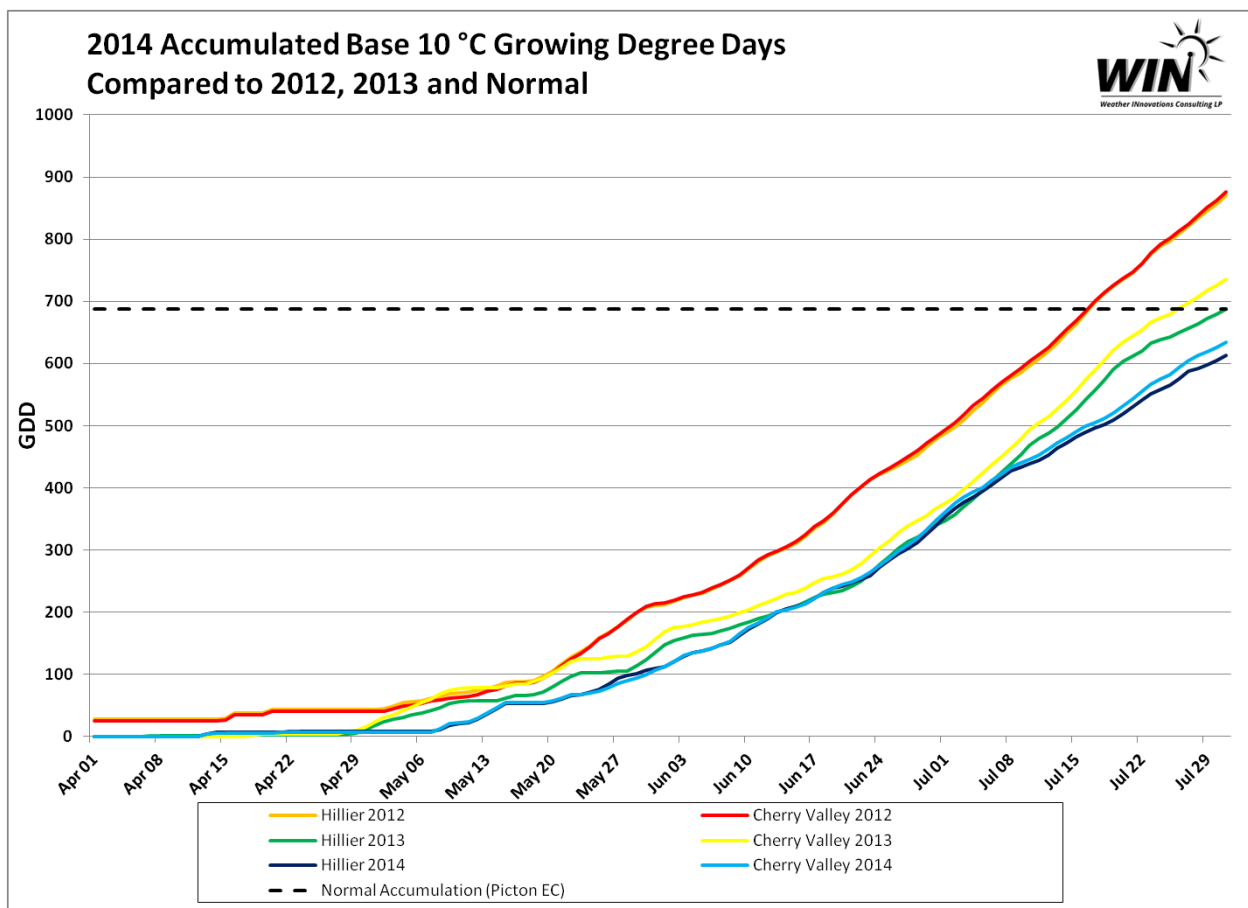


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

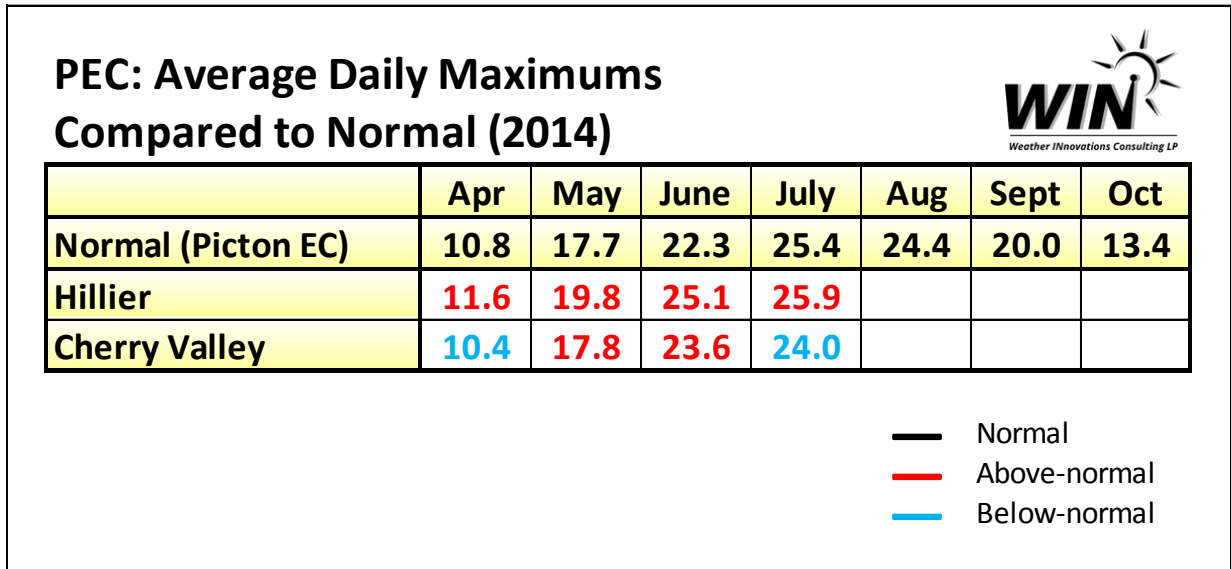


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

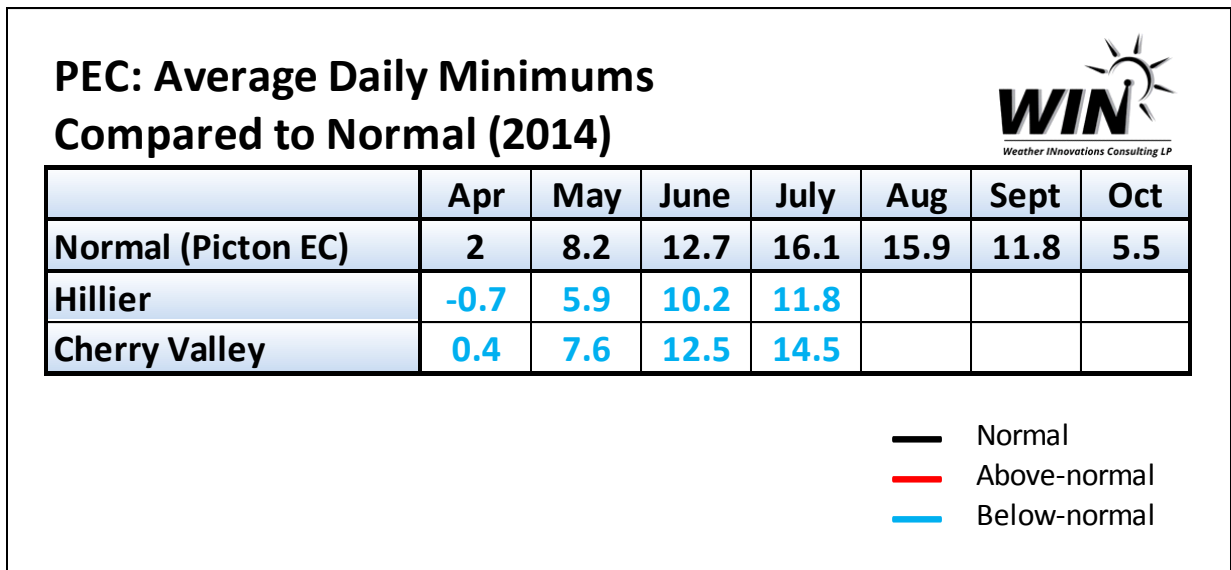


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

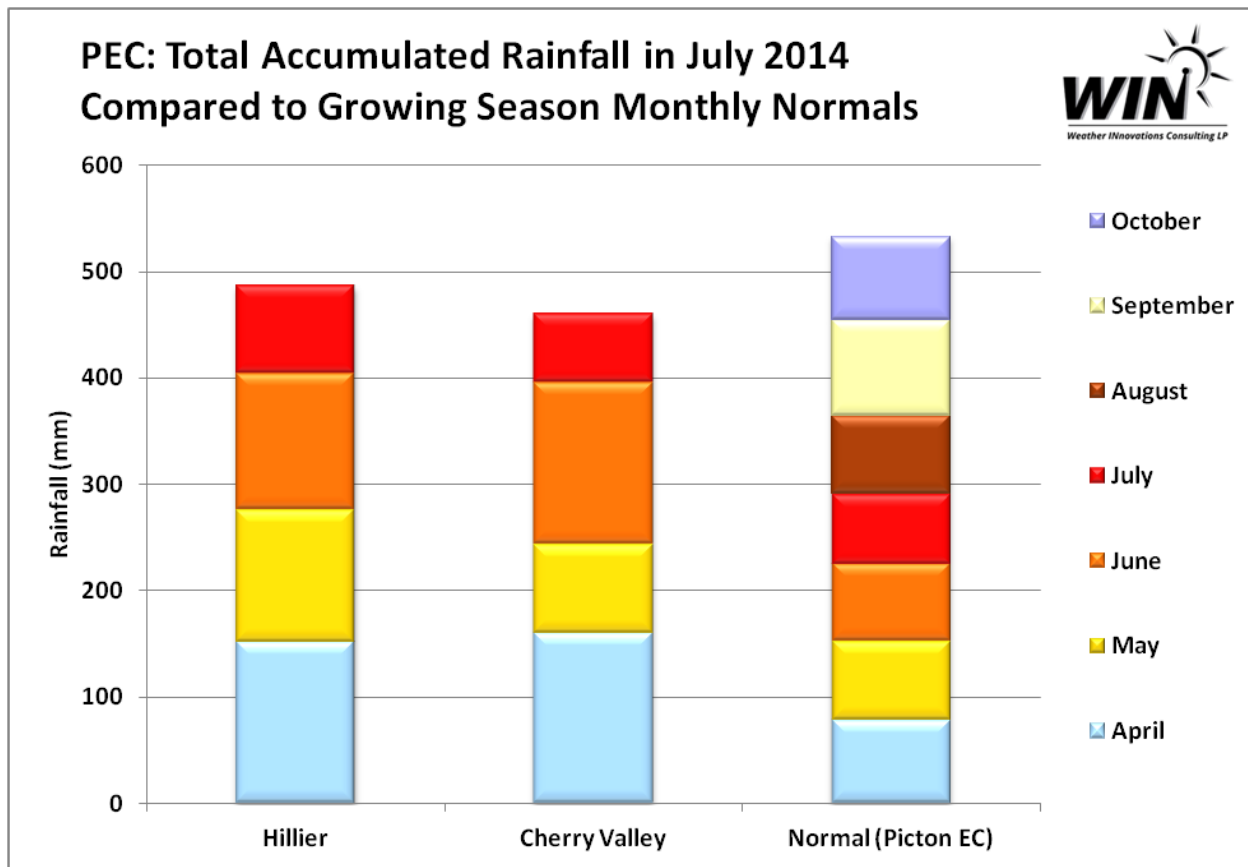


Figure 4: Rainfall
