



## June 2016:

In June, daytime highs averaged above normal across the appellation while overnight lows remained below normal. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for June. Accumulated growing degree days were above both 2014 and 2015. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 74 % of normal for June. Up to 23.8 mm of rain fell over the appellation on June 5. Cherry Valley received an additional 18.6 mm of rain on June 27, while Hiller received smaller precipitation amounts over the month.

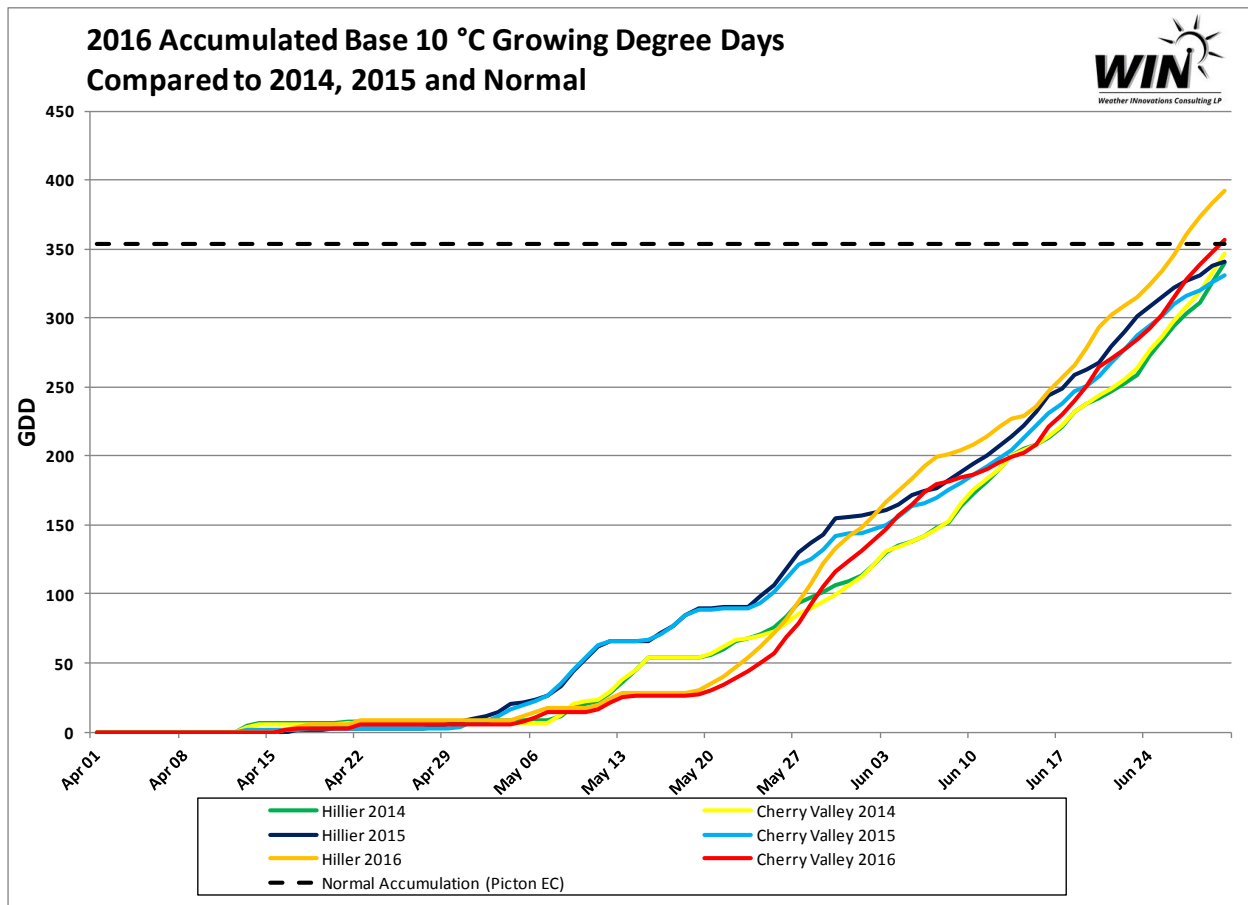


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

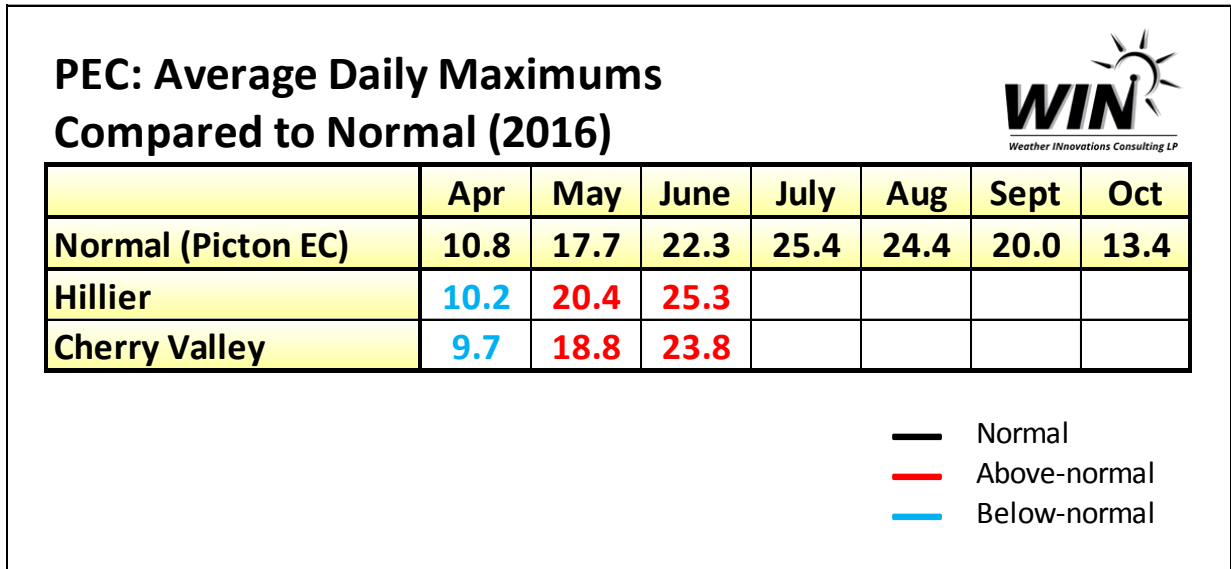


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

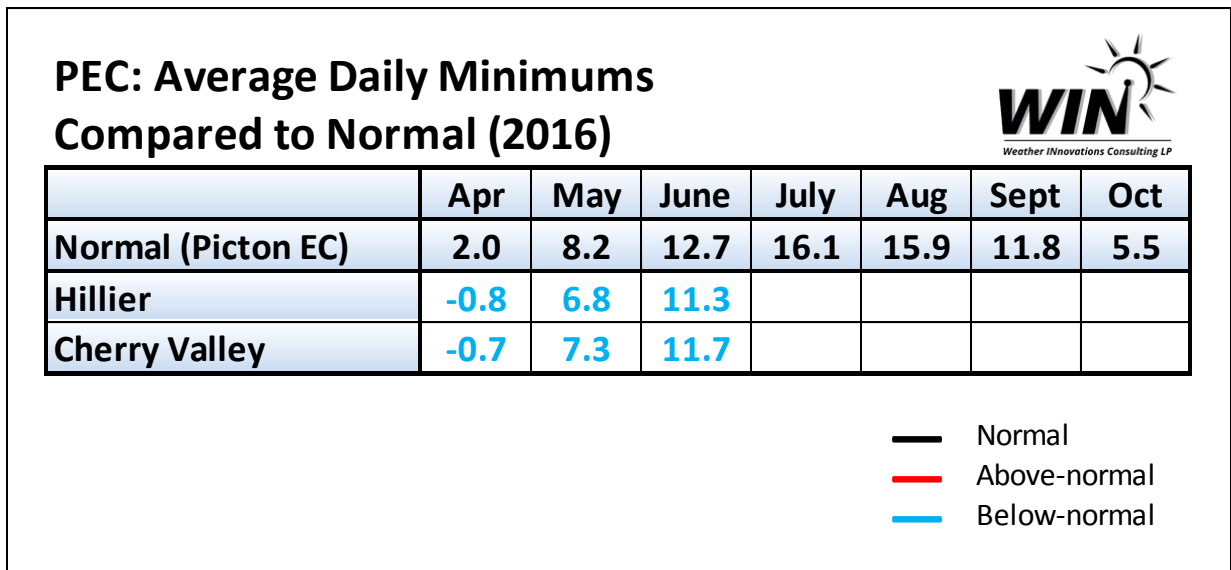


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

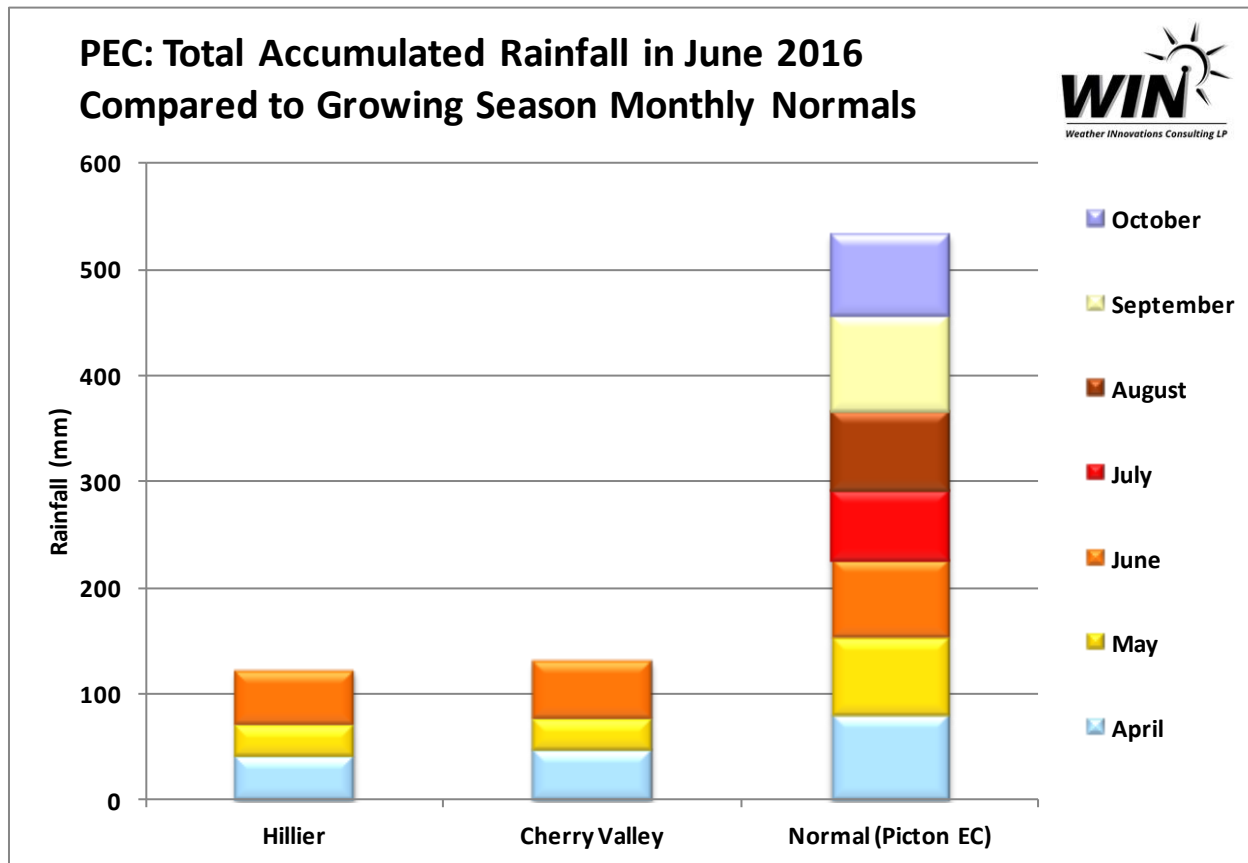


Figure 4: Rainfall
