



June 2014:

Above normal daytime highs and slightly below normal overnight lows continued throughout June. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for June returning the season accumulation to near normal values. Accumulated growing degree days remained less than 2012 and were similar to 2013 values. June rainfall totals averaged 192 % of normal across the appellation. Significant rainfall occurred on June 11-12 and 23-24 accounting with areas receiving 40-60 mm of rain in each period.

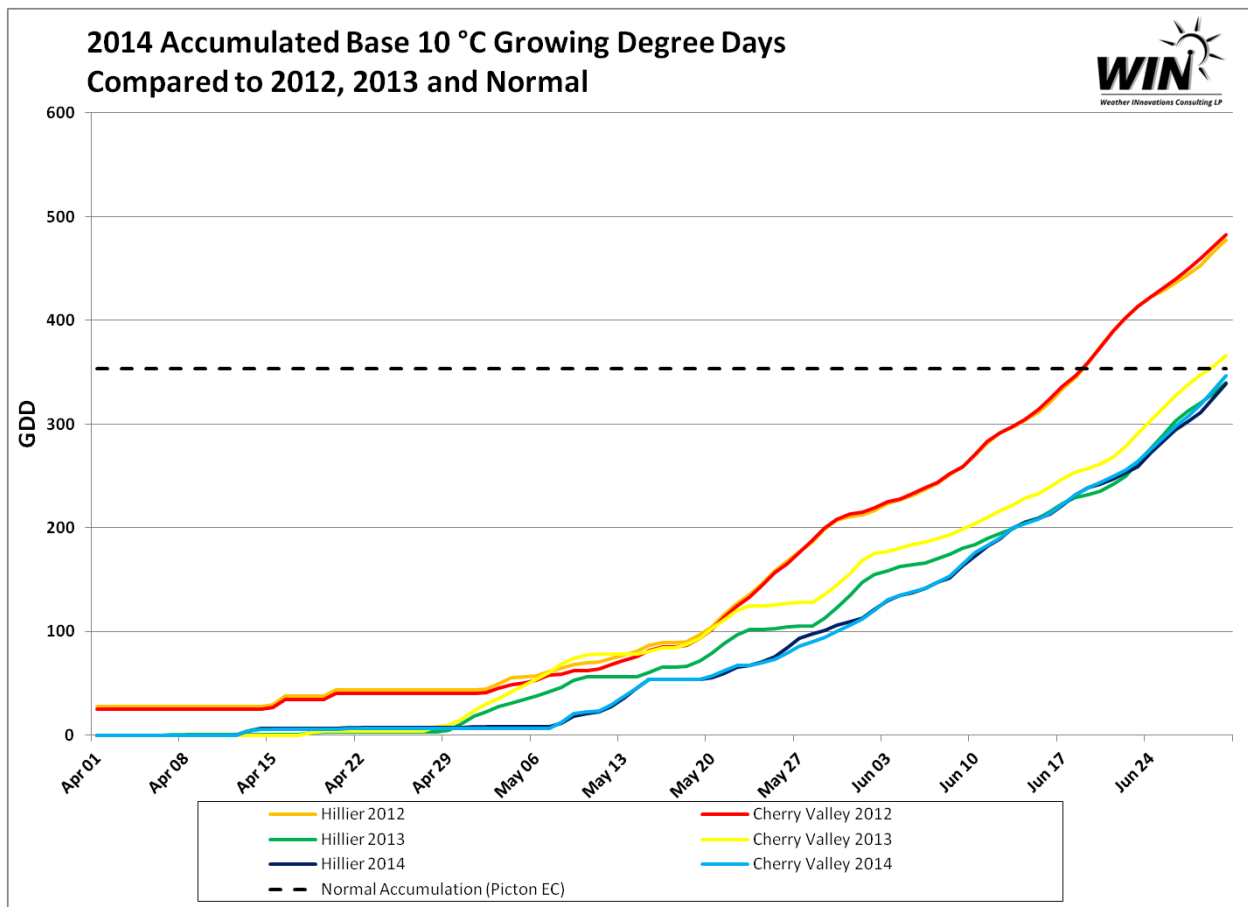


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

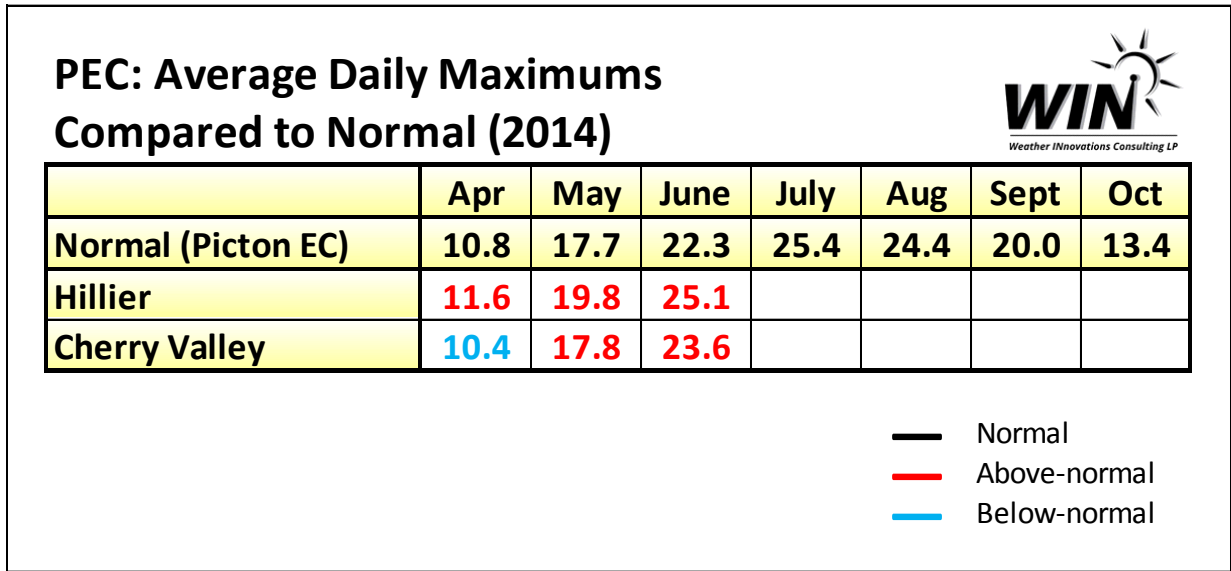


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

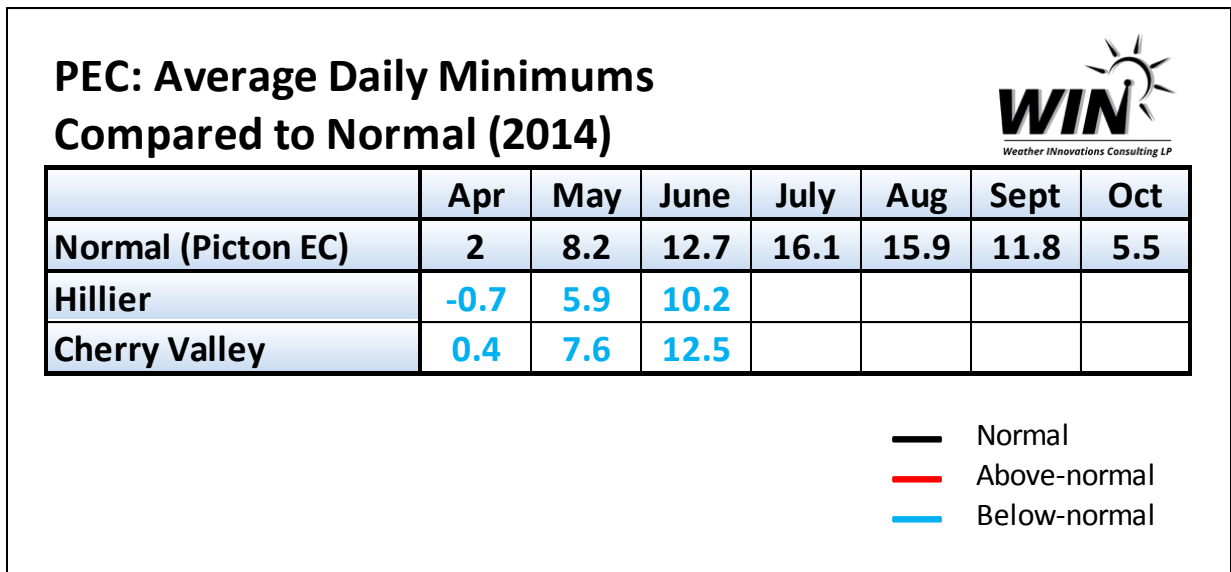


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

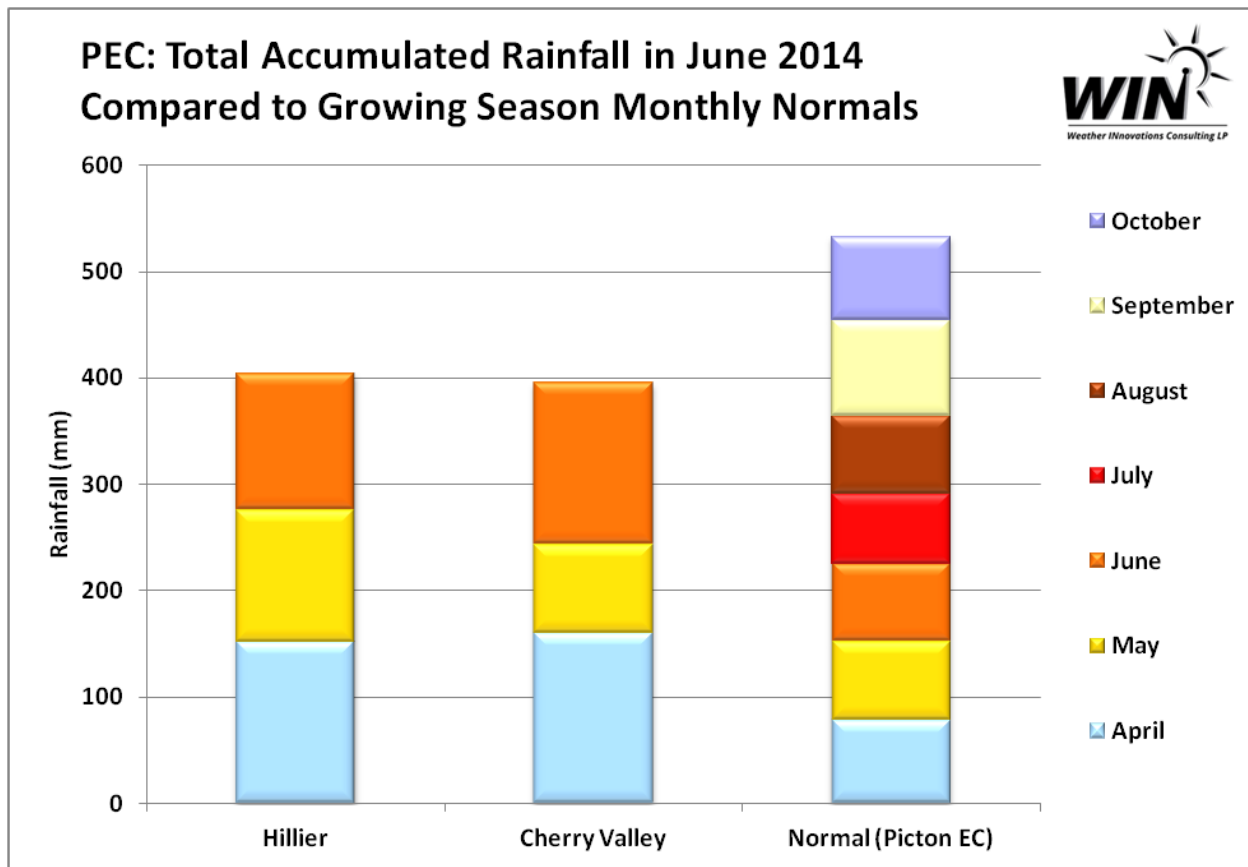


Figure 4: Rainfall
