



June 2015:

In June, daytime highs were near normal across the appellation. Overnight lows continued to average below normal. Resulting from the near normal daytime high temperatures and below normal overnight low temperatures, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were slightly below normal for June. Accumulated growing degree days were similar to 2013 and 2014 values at Hillier and slightly below 2013 and 2014 values at Cherry Valley. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 280 % of normal for June. Each site recorded four days of at least 20 mm of rainfall and one day of at least 40 mm of rainfall over the month.

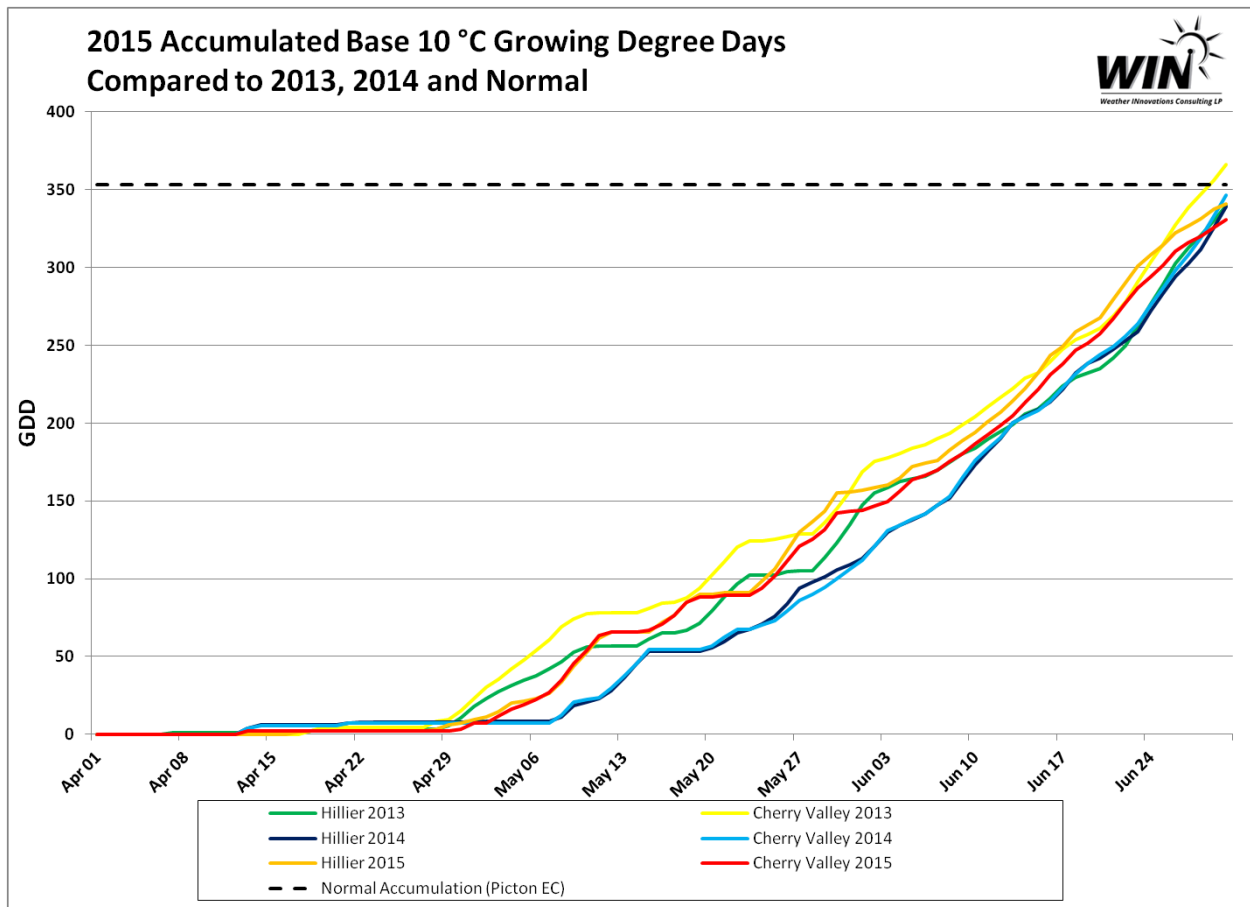


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

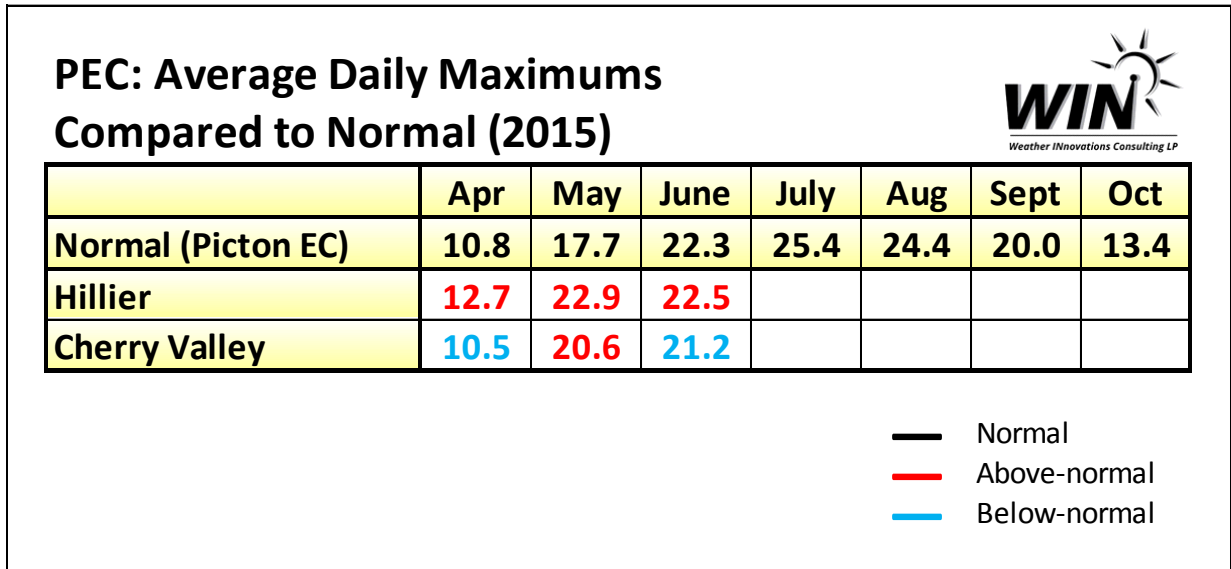


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

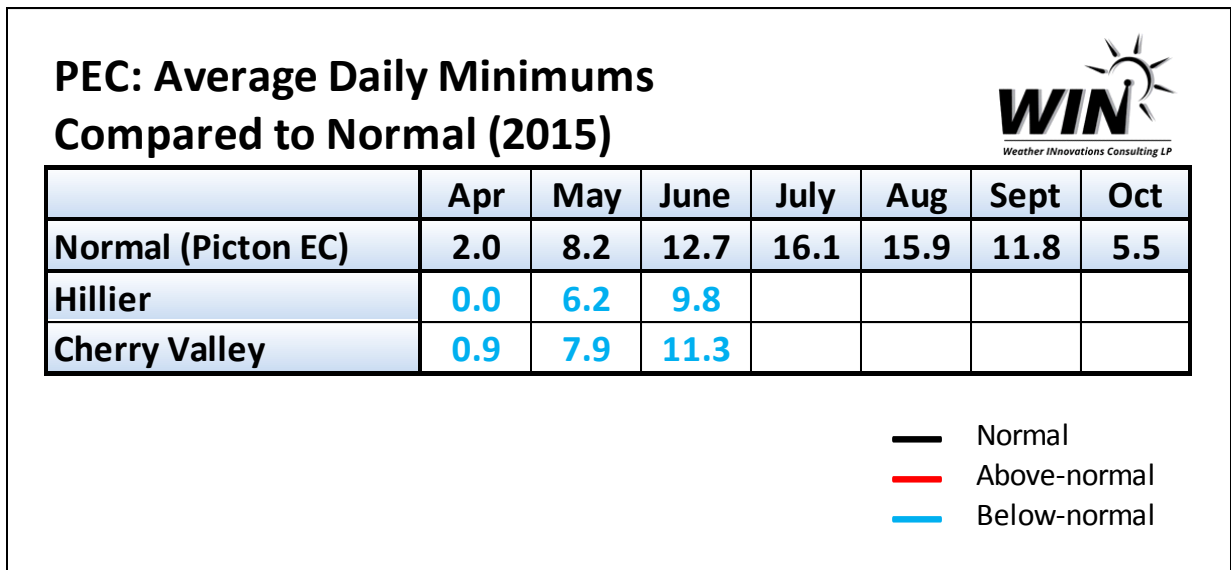


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

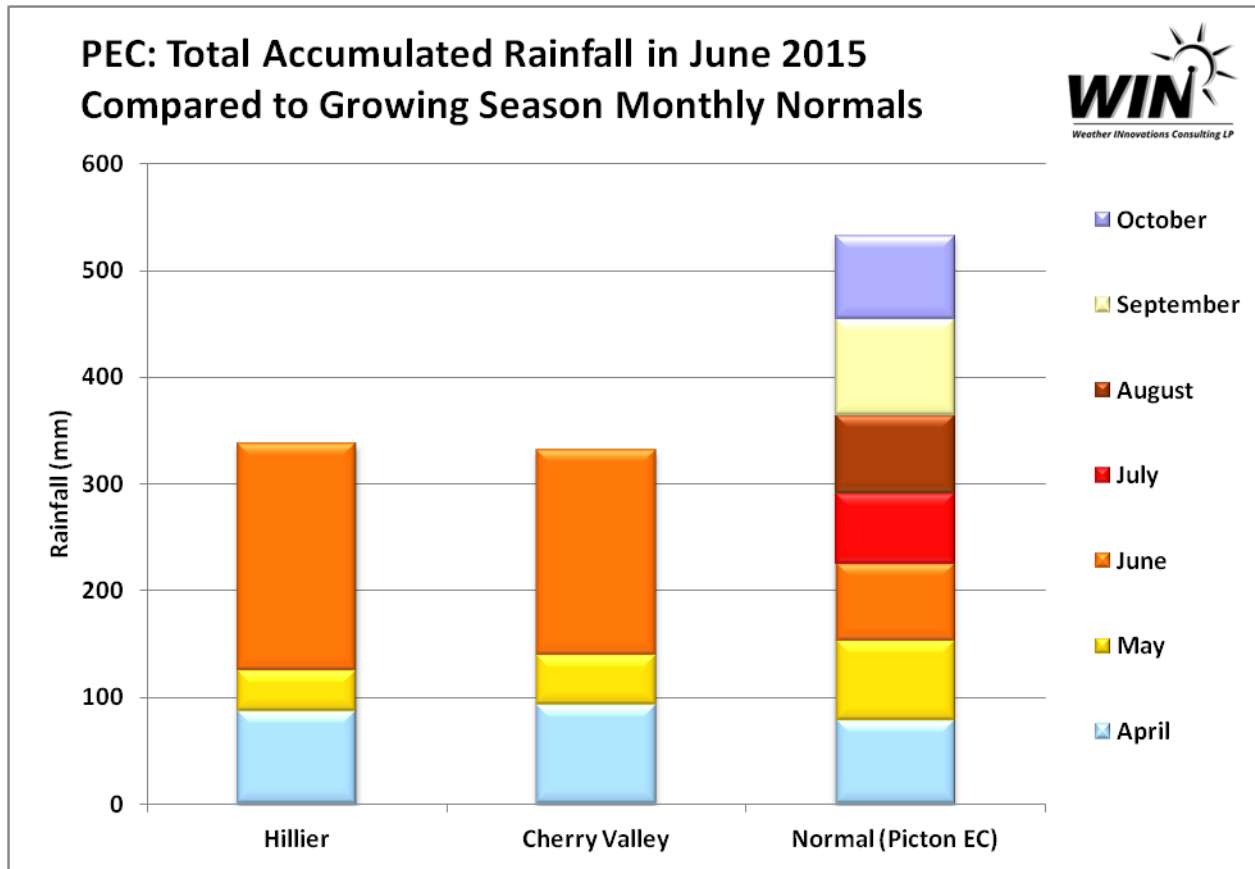


Figure 4: Rainfall
