



May 2016:

In May, daytime highs averaged above normal across the appellation while overnight lows remained below normal. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for May. Accumulated growing degree days were above 2014 but below 2015 values at both Hillier and Cherry Valley. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 39 % of normal for May. Rain events totaling less than 11 mm per day occurred mainly on May 1 and over the period of May 13 through 15.

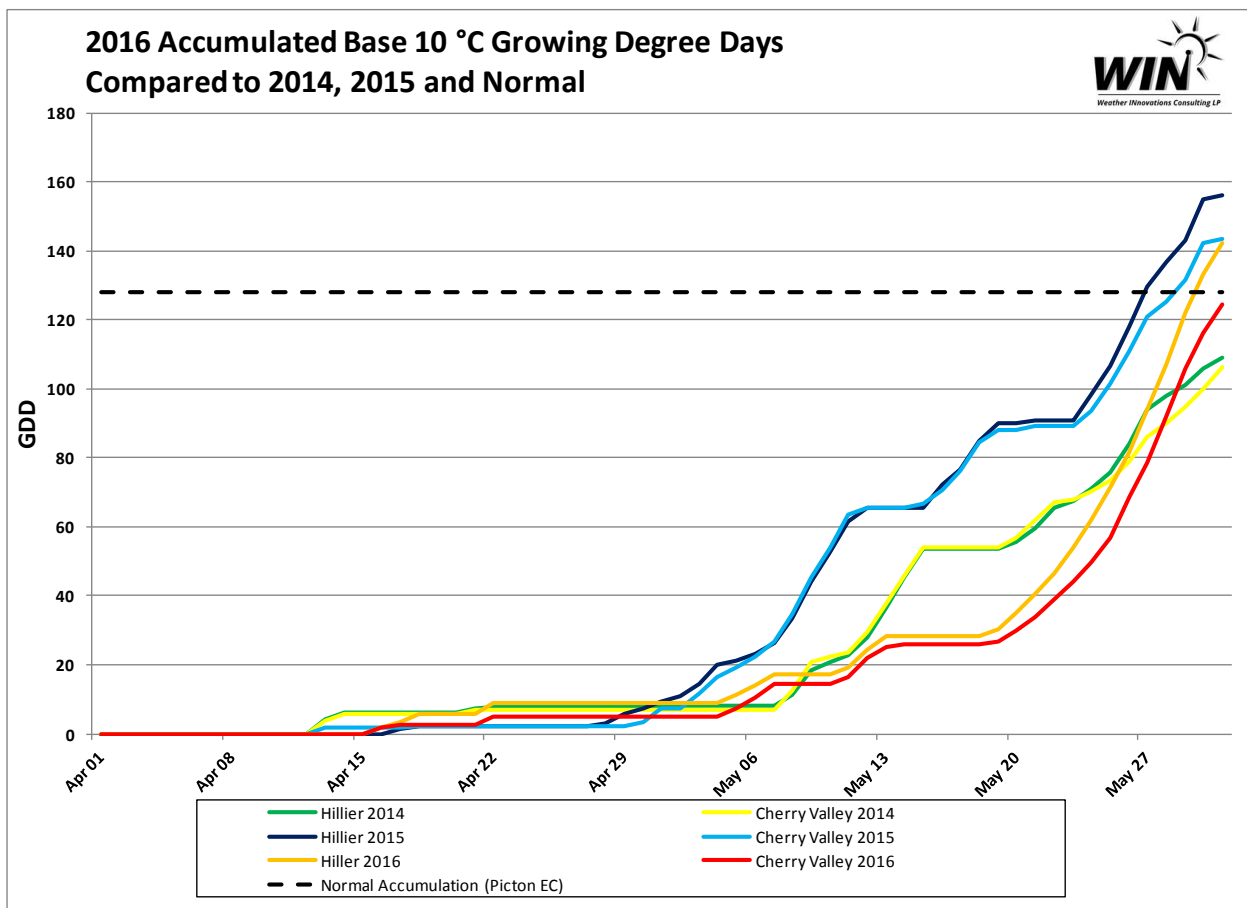


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

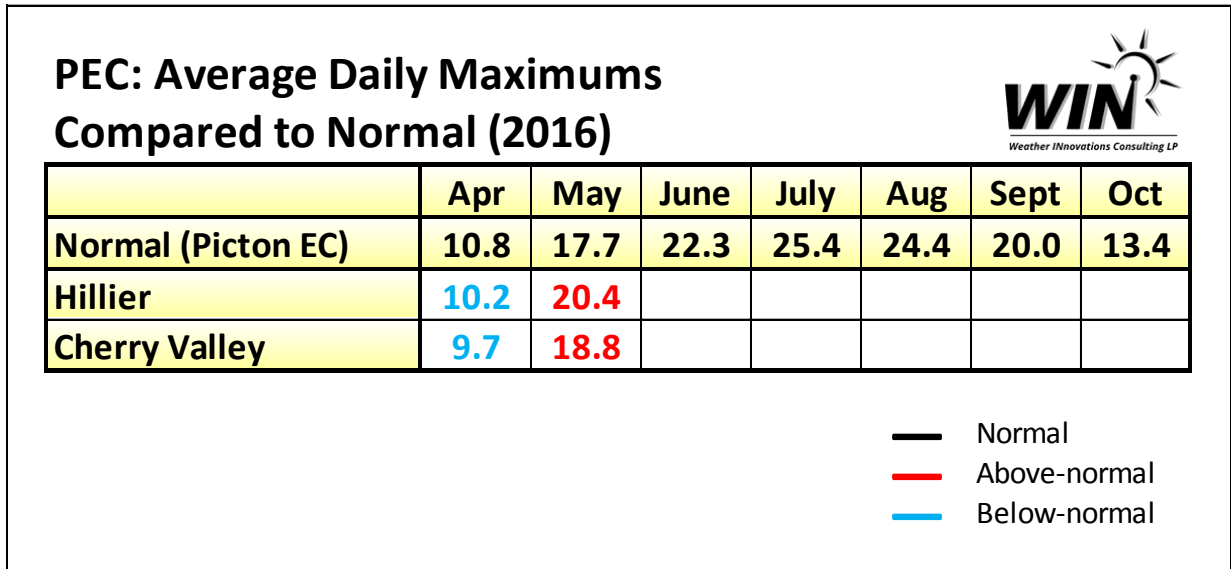


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

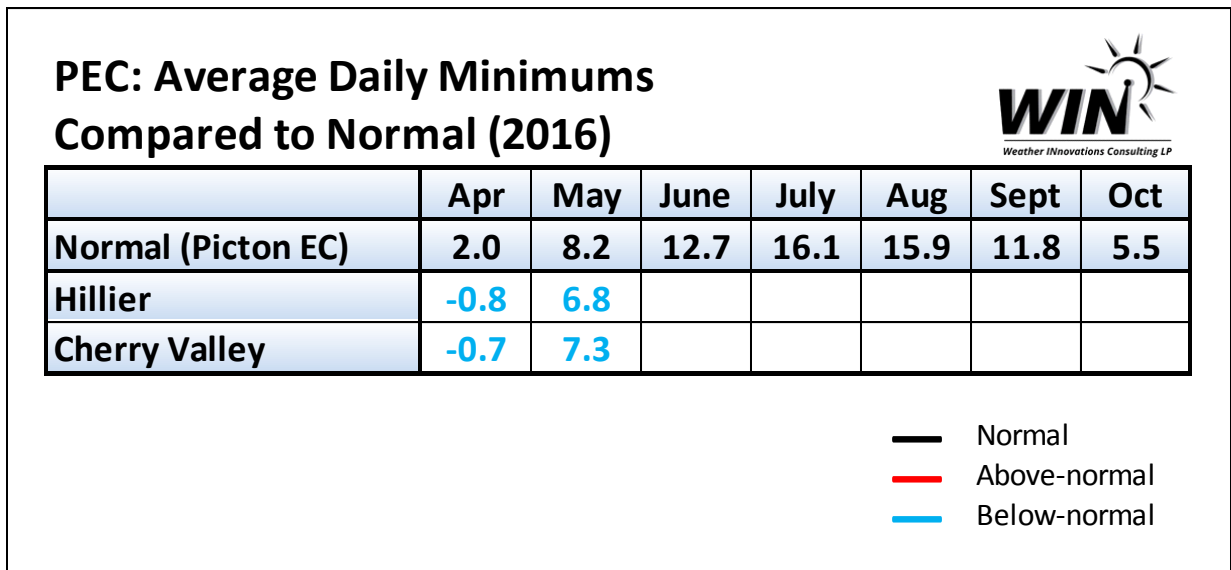


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

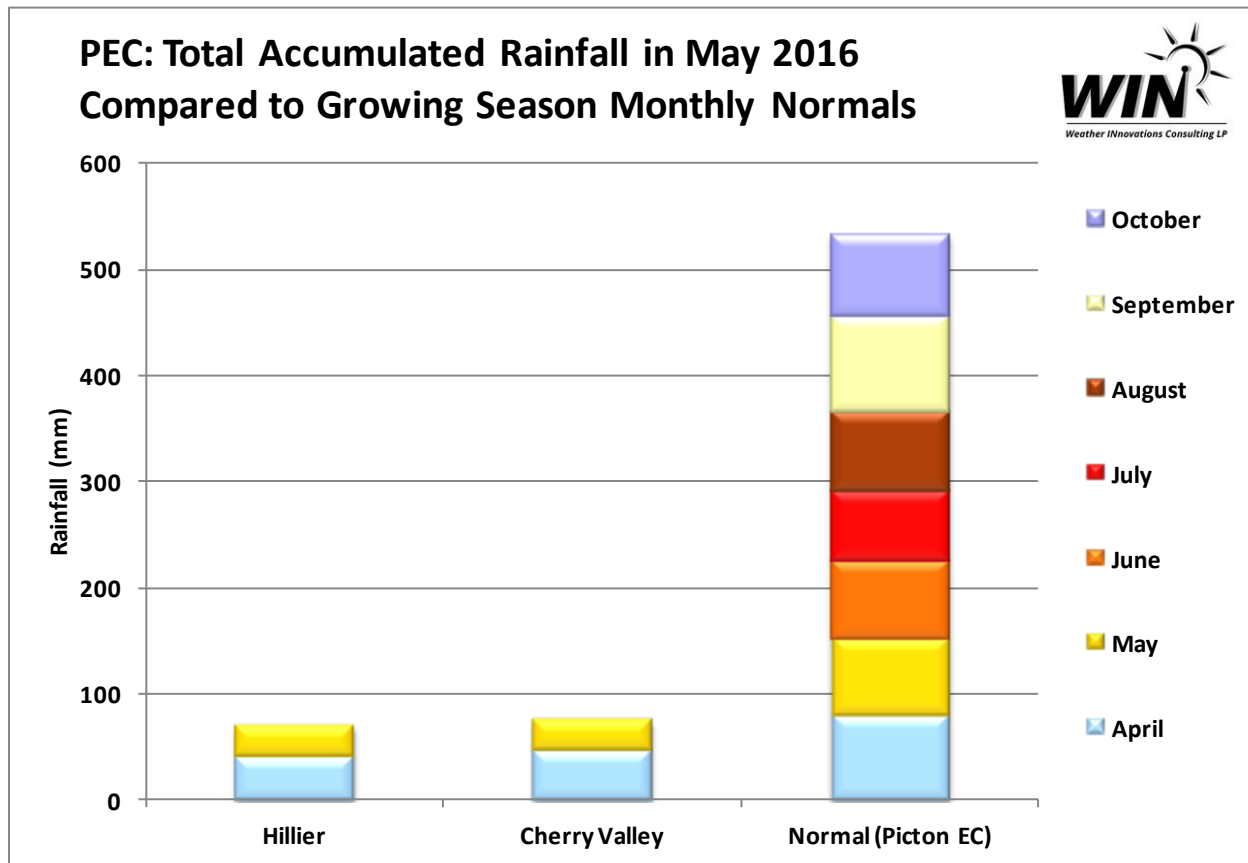


Figure 4: Rainfall
