



May 2014:

Similar to April, daytime highs averaged above normal and overnight lows averaged below normal across the appellation. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days remained below normal for May. Season accumulated growing degree days continued to lag behind normal values and remained lower than 2012 and 2013 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 140 % of normal for May. Most of the rain occurred during the first 16 days of the month with little rain falling in the second half of May.

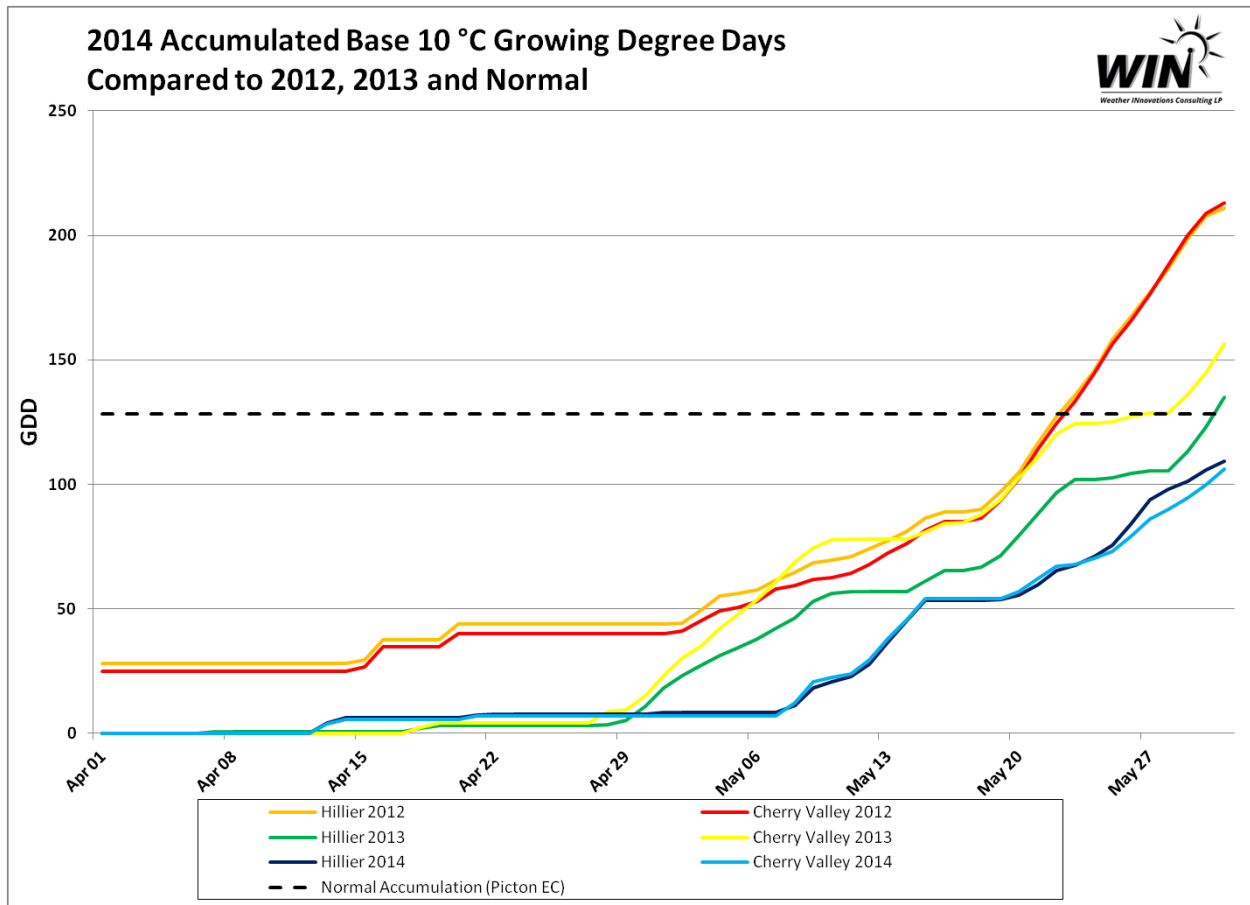


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

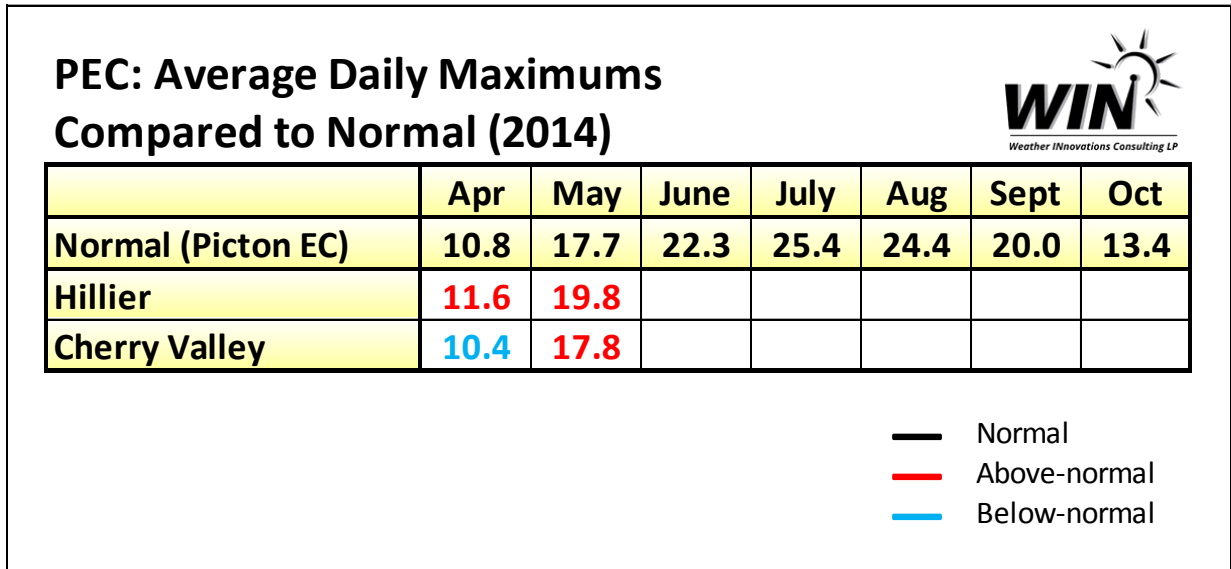


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

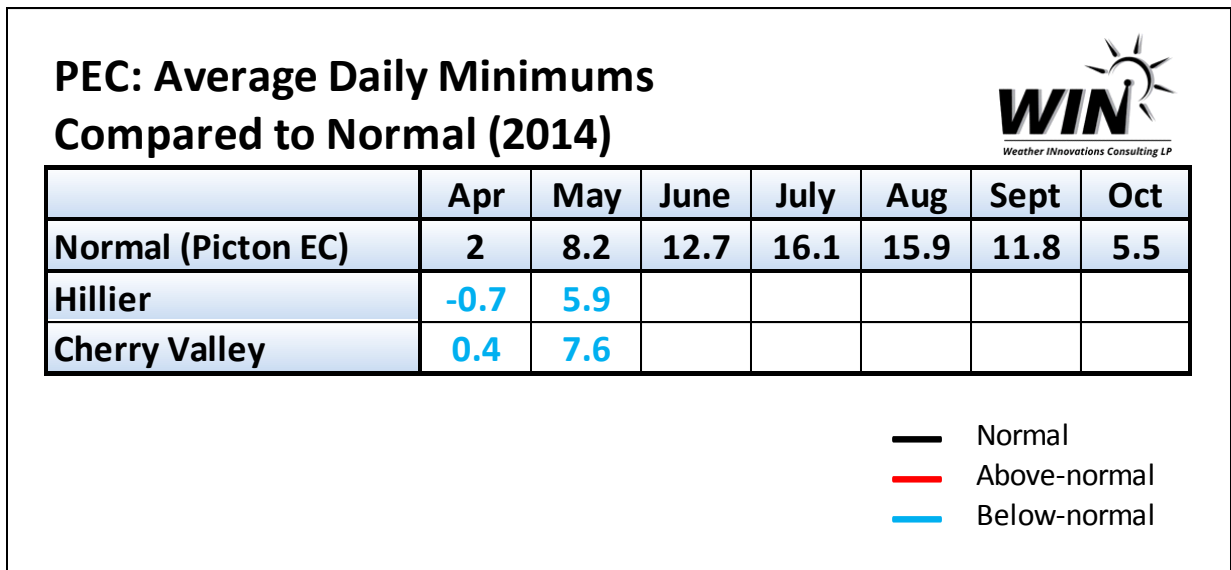


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

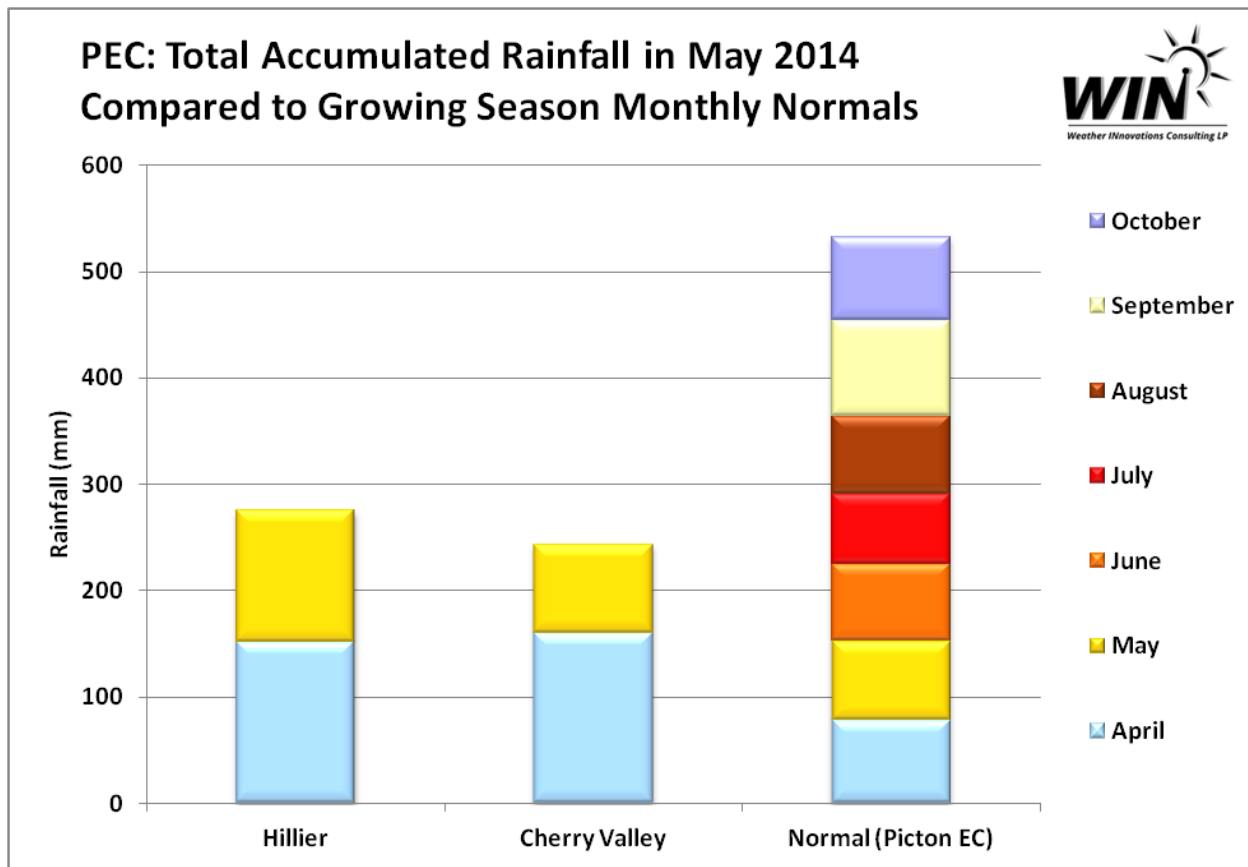


Figure 4: Rainfall
