



October 2016:

In October, daytime highs and overnight lows were above normal across the appellation. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for October. Accumulated growing degree days were above both 2014 and 2015. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 164 % of normal for October. The majority of rainfall occurred during October 20-21. Up to 70 mm of rainfall was recorded in the appellation during this two day period.

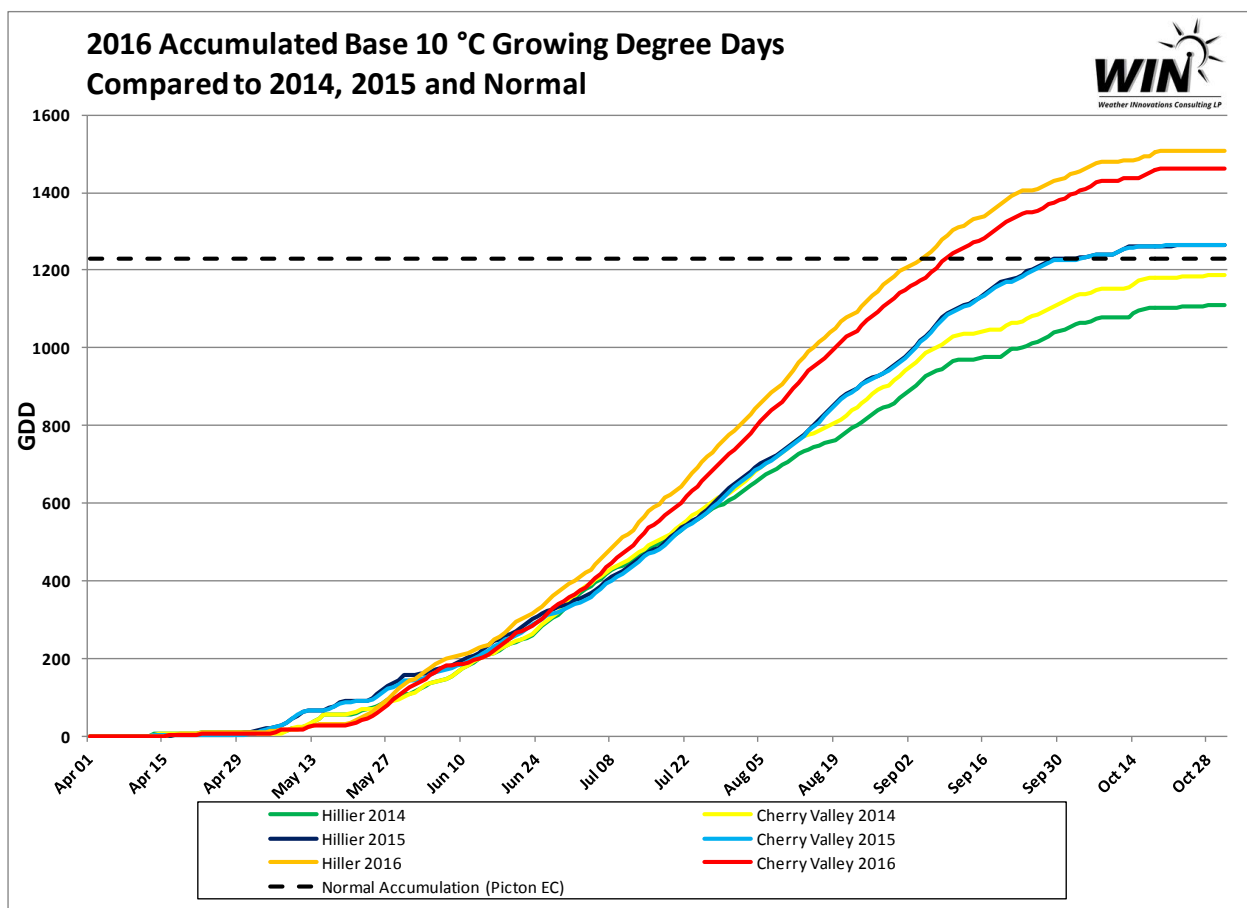


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

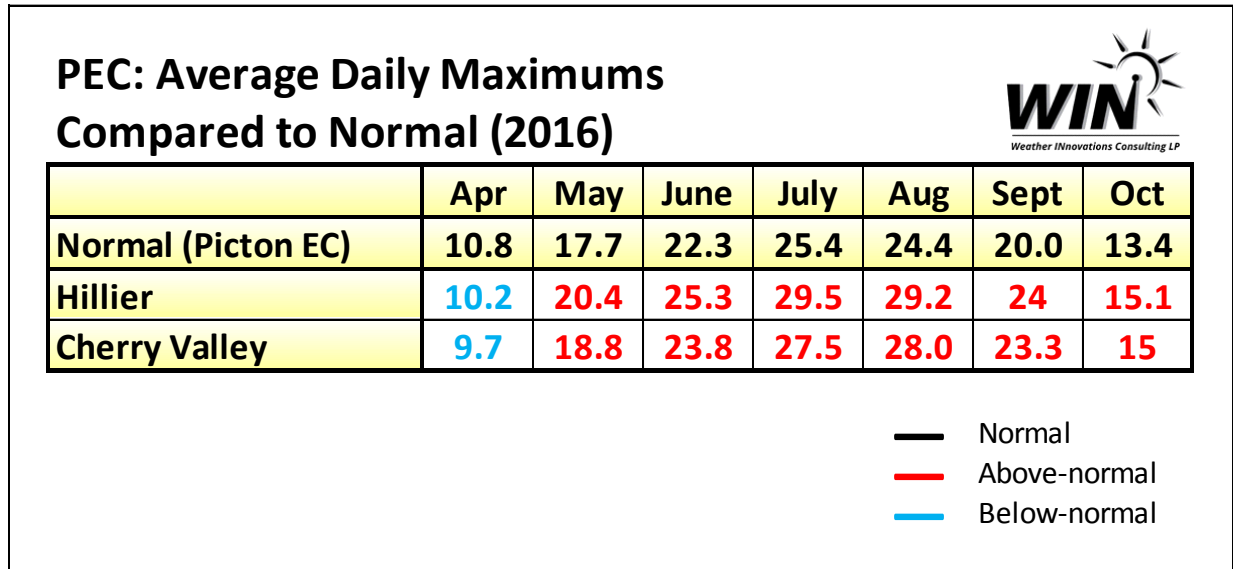


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

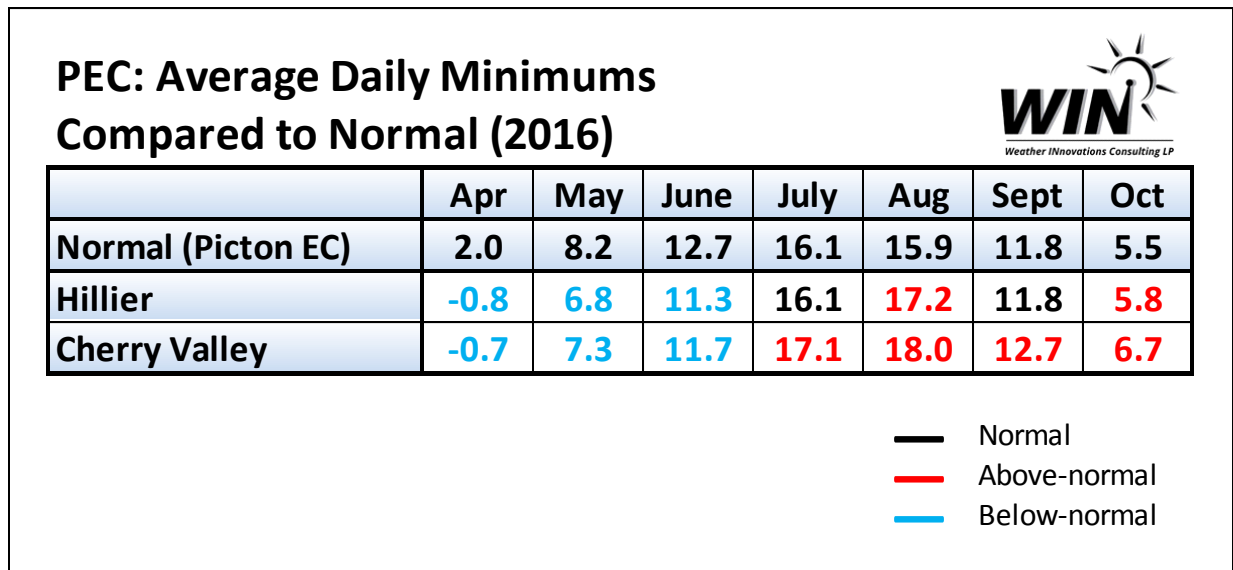


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

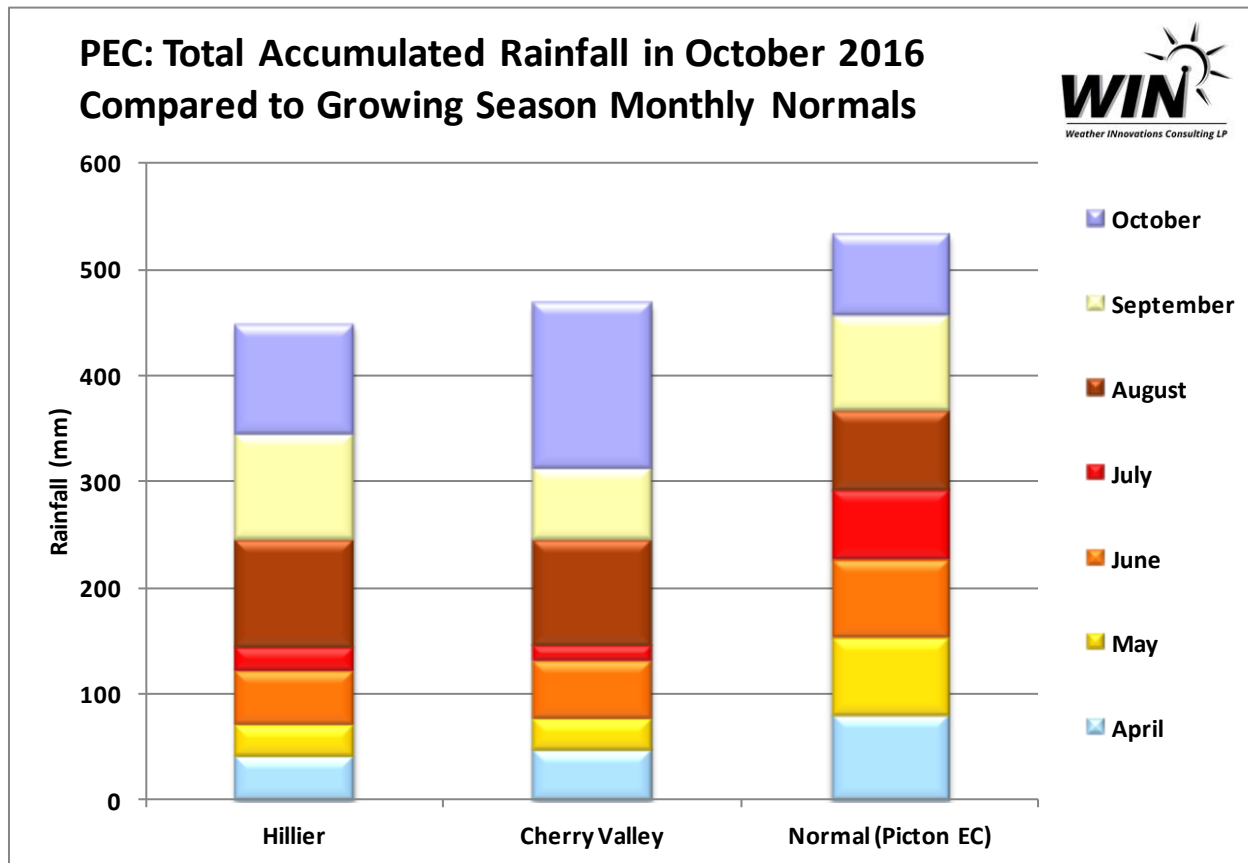


Figure 4: Rainfall
