



October 2017:

In October, daytime highs and overnight lows were above normal across the appellation. Accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for October. Accumulated growing degree days were above 2015 values and below 2016 values. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 236 % of normal for October. Up to 86 mm of rainfall was recorded in the appellation on October 9 and up to 66 mm fell during October 29-30.

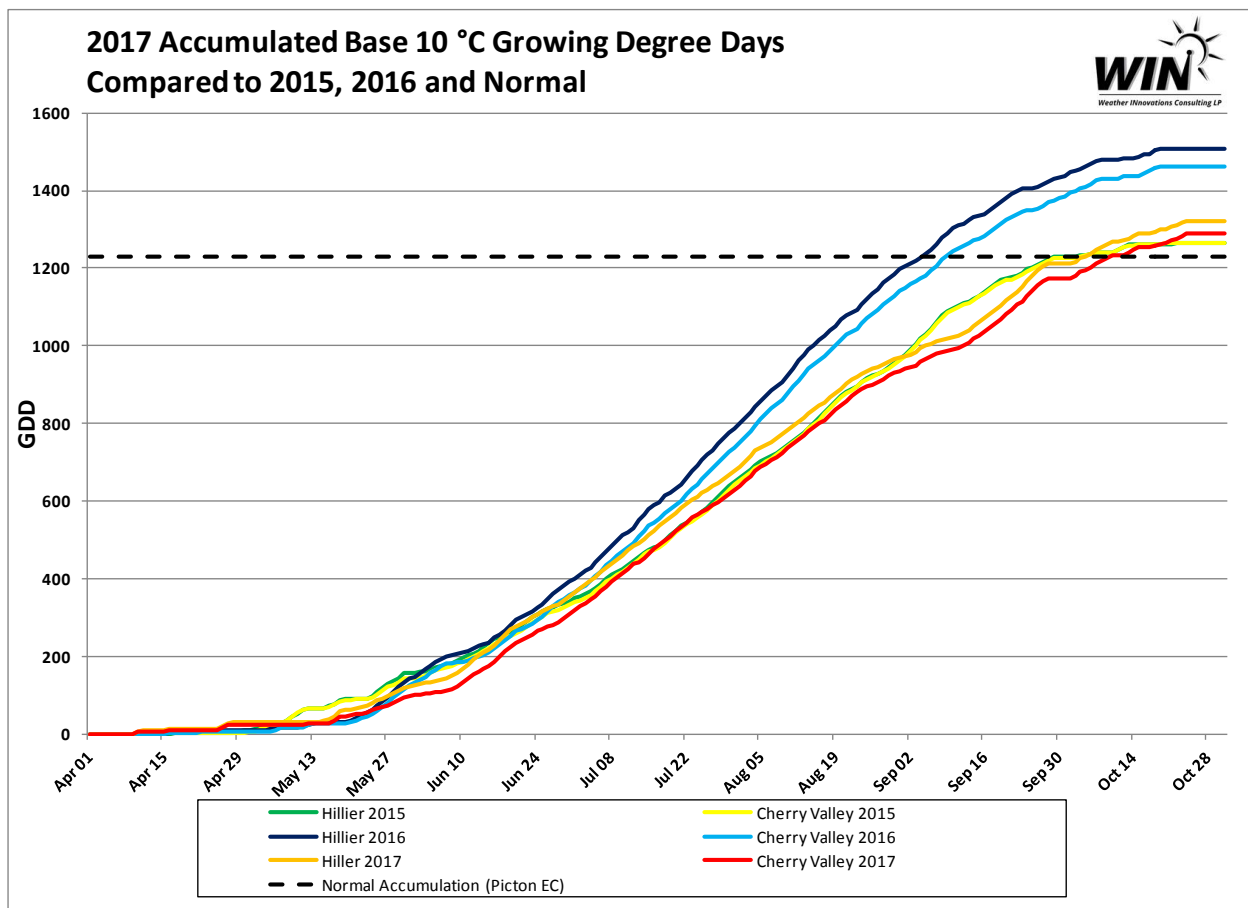


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

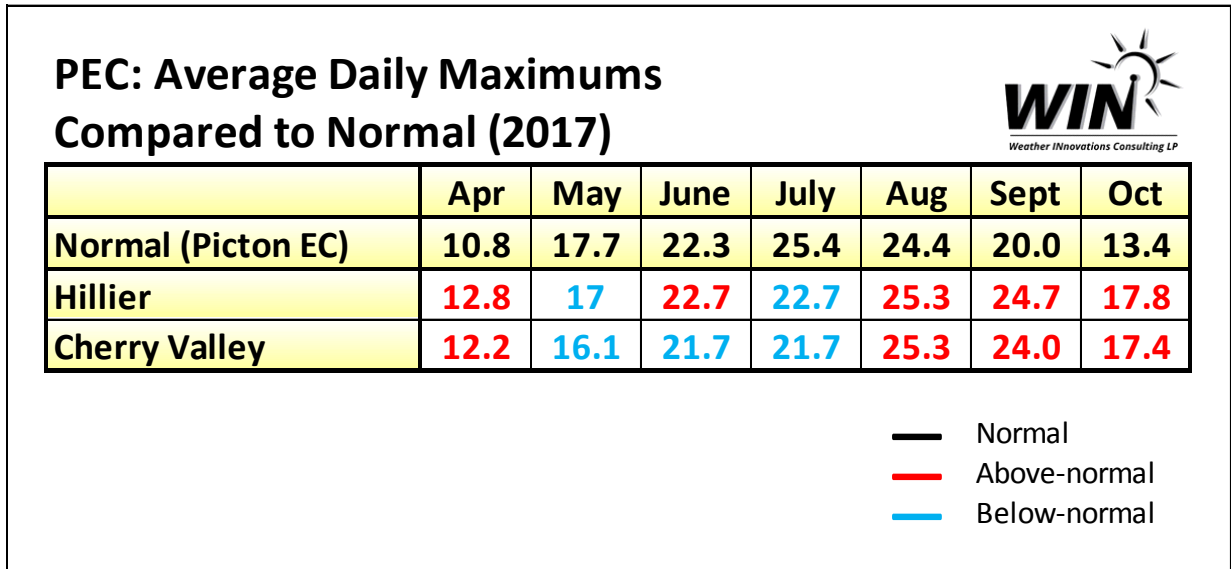


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

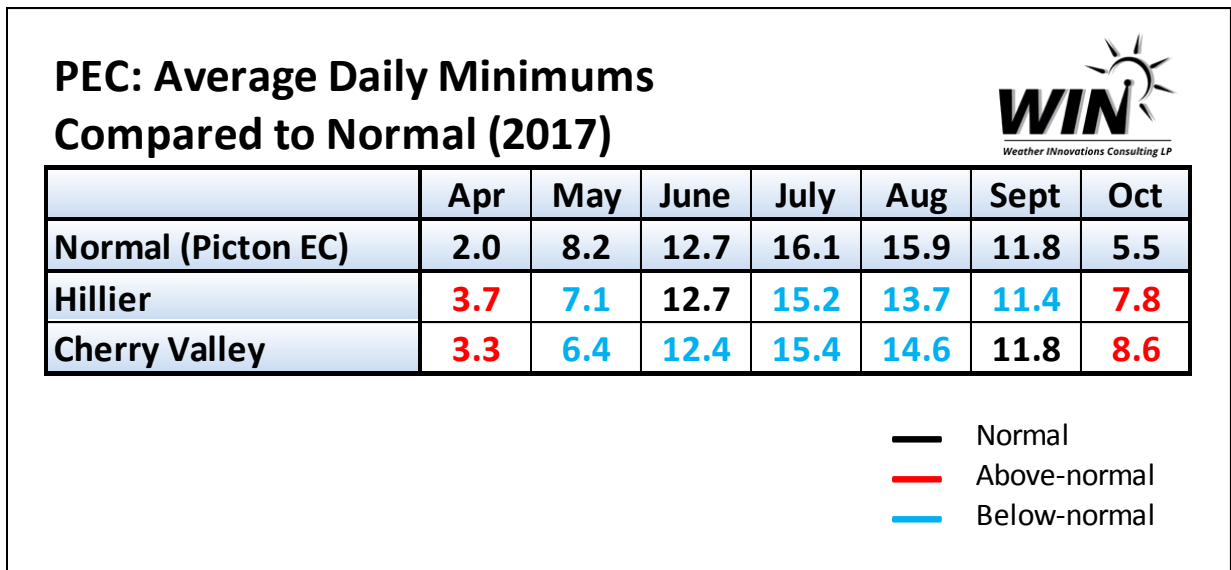


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

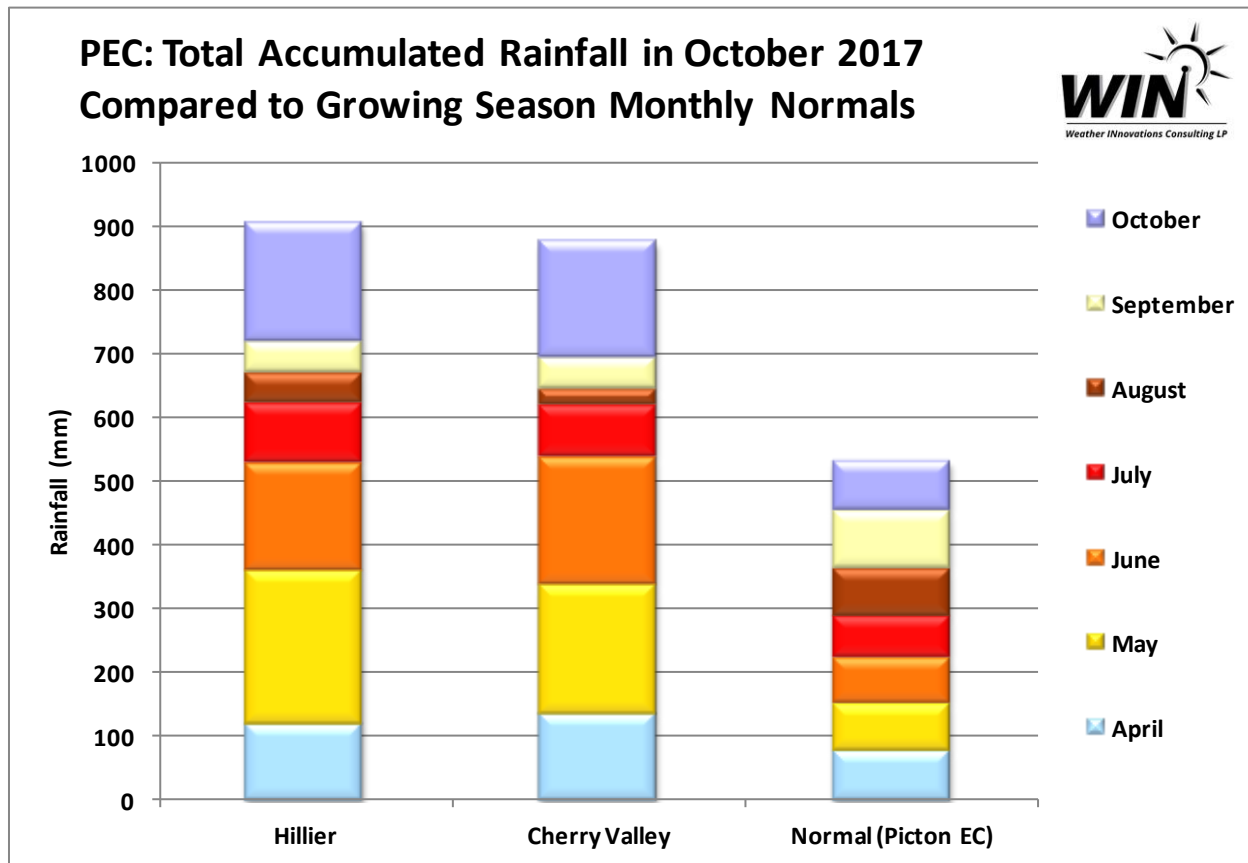


Figure 4: Rainfall
