



October 2014:

Above normal daytime highs continued into October. Overnight lows ranged from slightly below normal to above normal across the appellation. As a result, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for the month. Season accumulated growing degree days returned to near normal values at Cherry Valley while remaining below normal at Hillier. Growing degree days remained below 2012 and 2013 values. October rainfall was 110 % of normal on average across Prince Edward County.

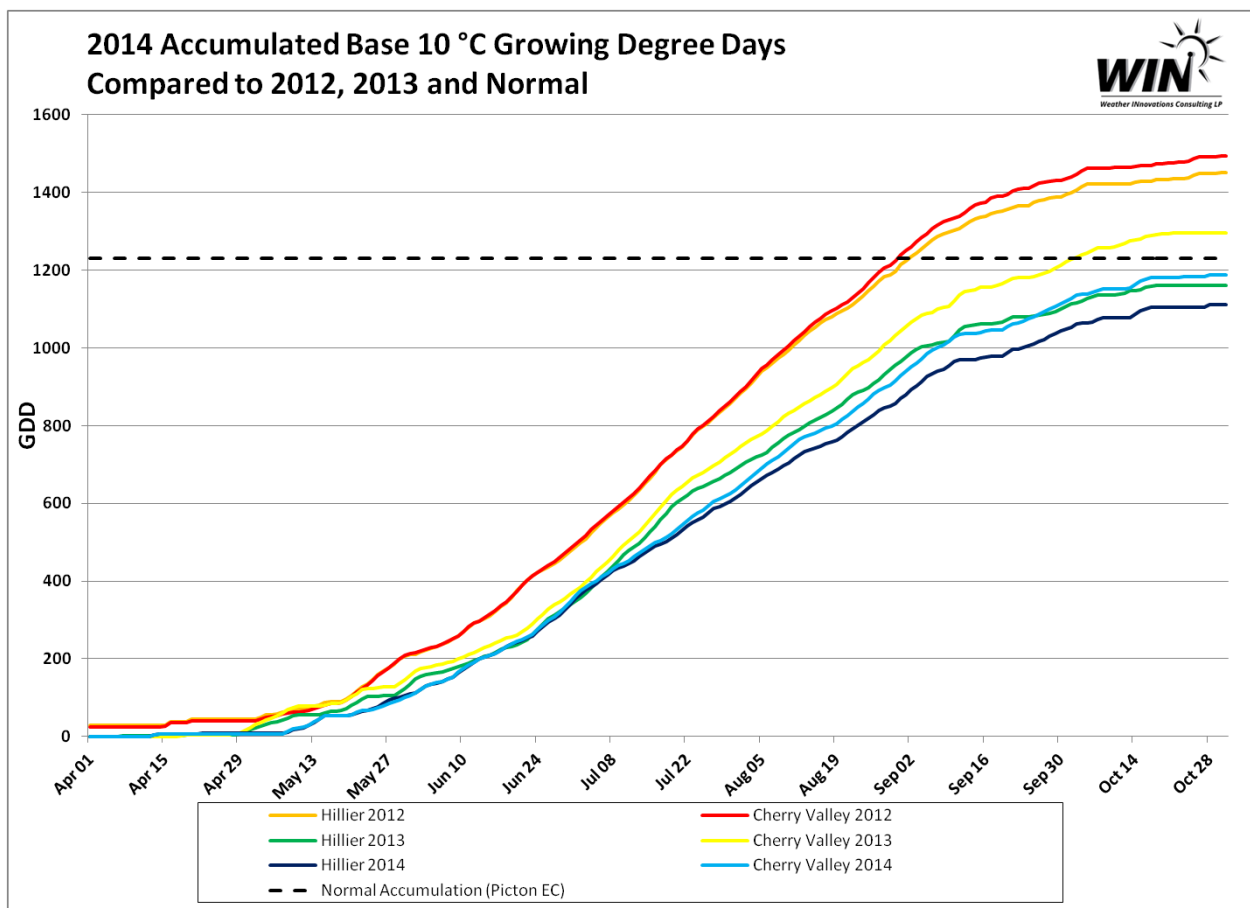


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

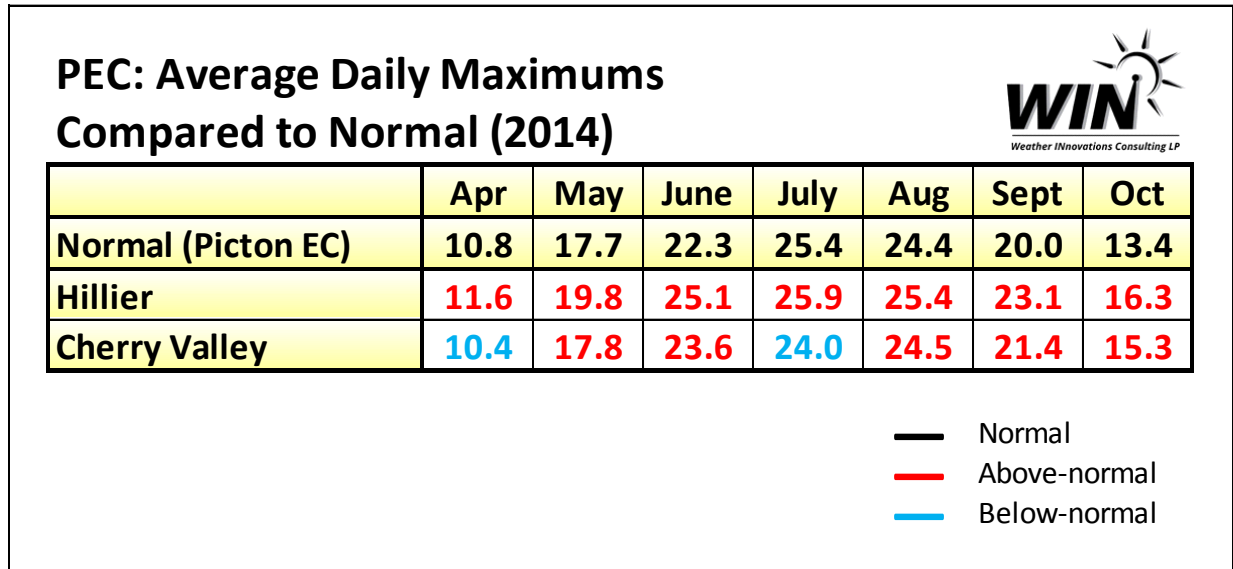


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

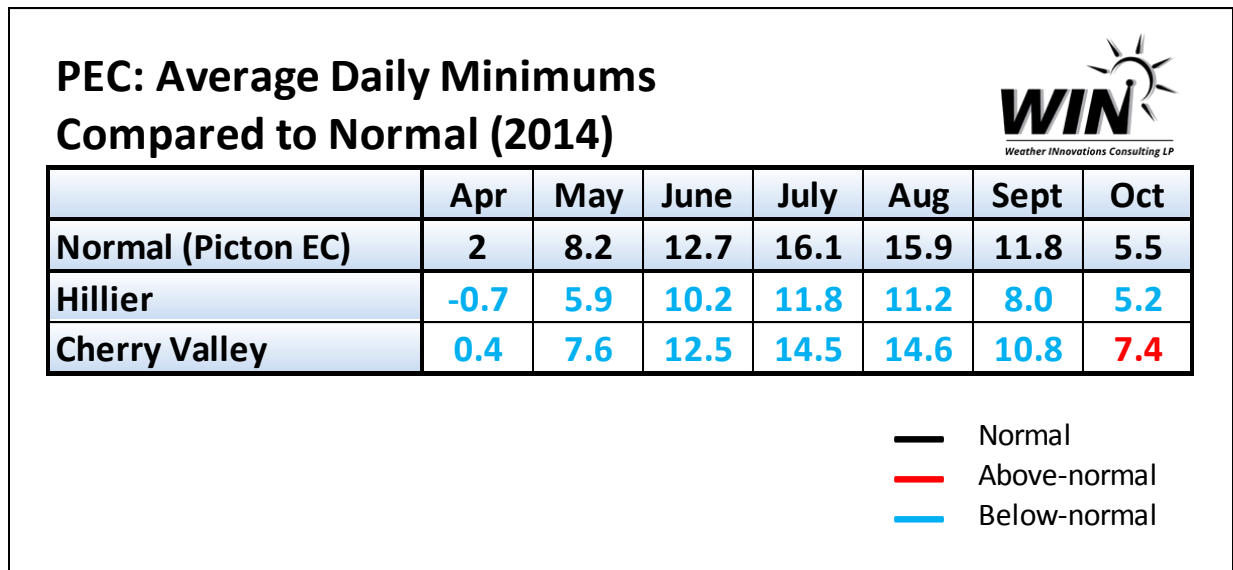


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

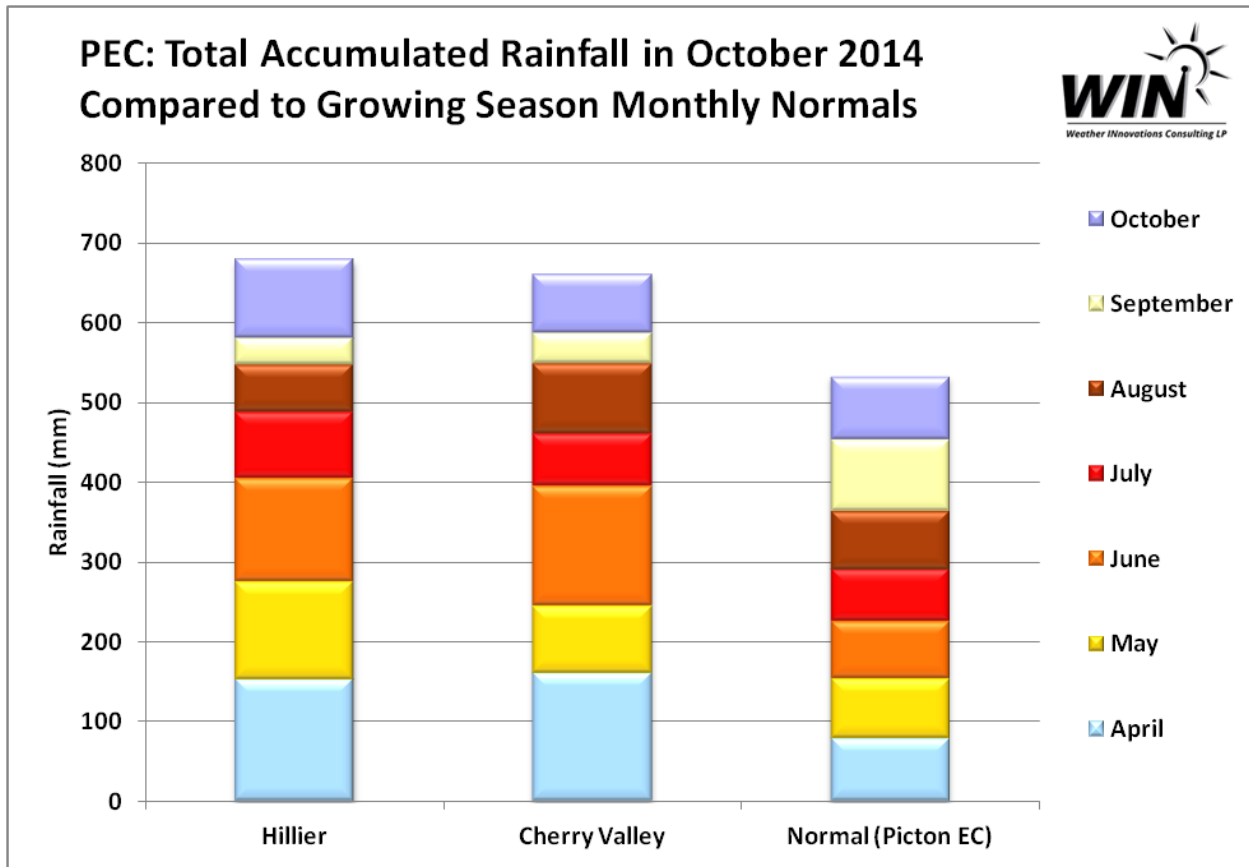


Figure 4: Rainfall
