



## October 2015:

October daytime highs were above normal while overnight low temperatures were below normal across the appellation. As a result, accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were below normal for October. Accumulated growing degree days were similar to 2013 values at Cherry Valley and above 2013 values at Hillier. Rainfall across Prince Edward County was on average 107 % of normal for the month. On October 28, areas around Hiller 61 mm of rain, while areas around Cherry Valley received up to 43 mm of rain.

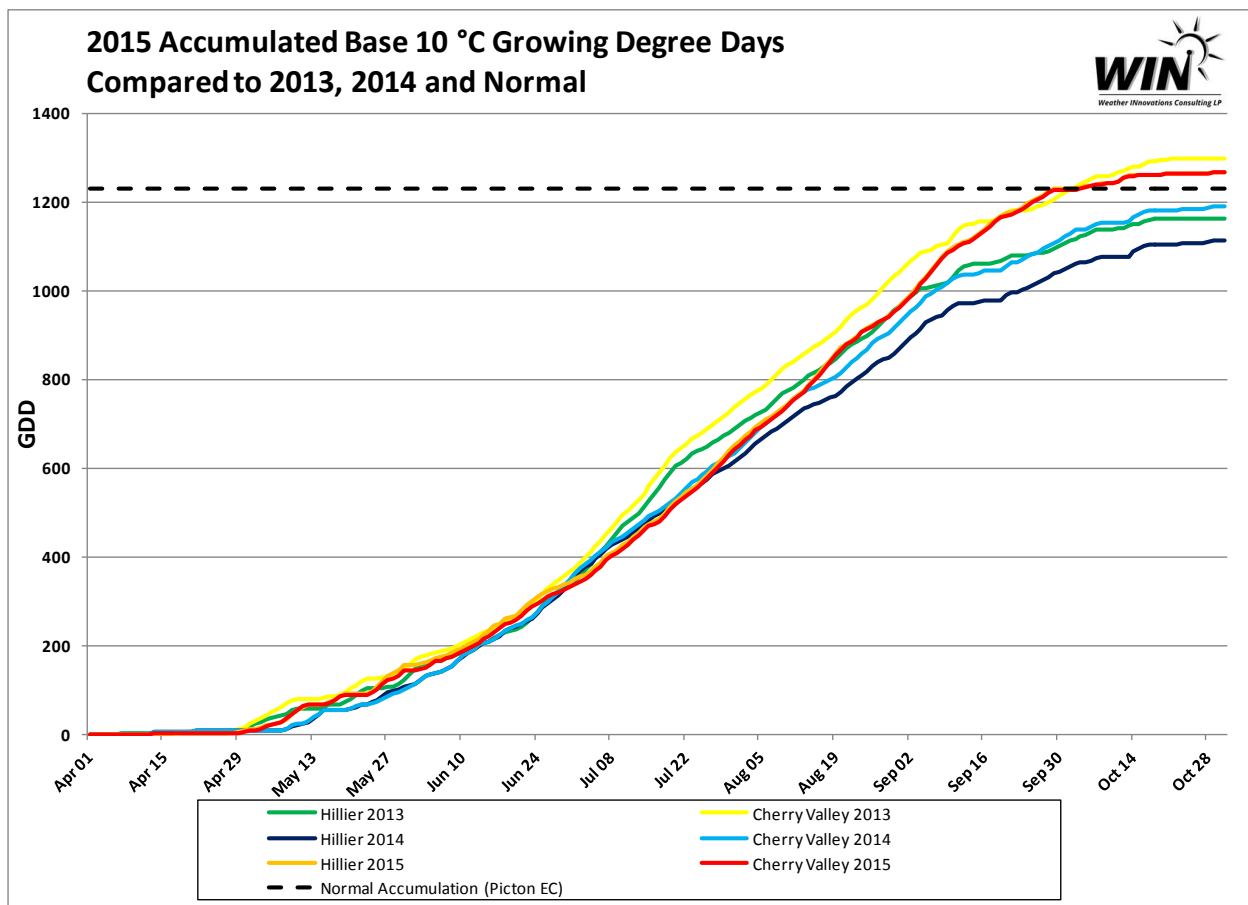


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

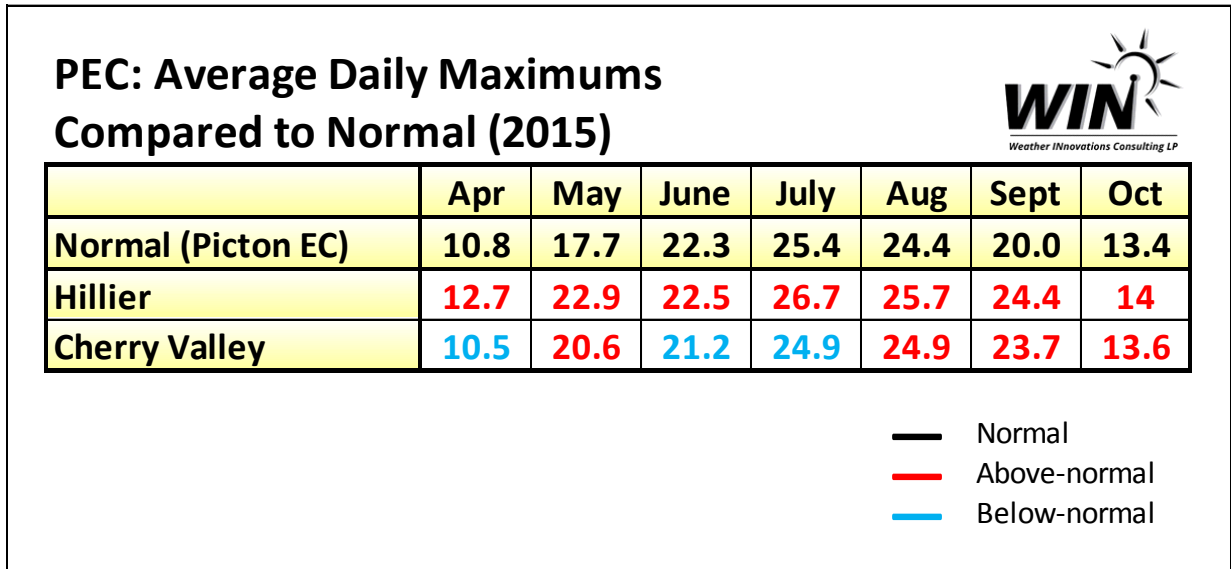


Figure 2: Maximum Temperatures

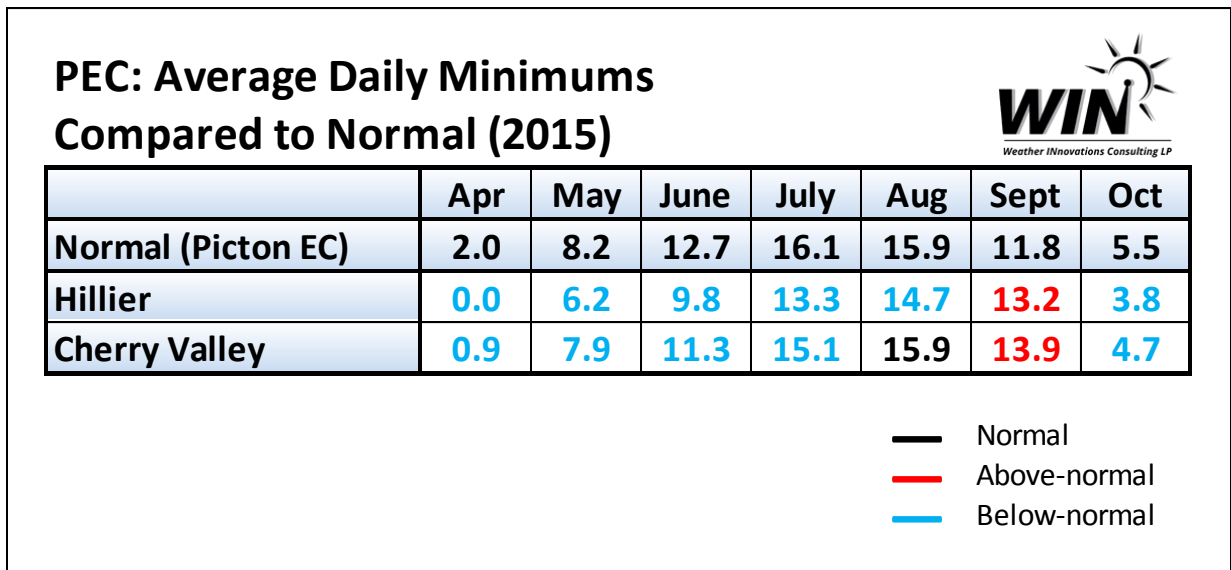


Figure 3: Minimum Temperatures

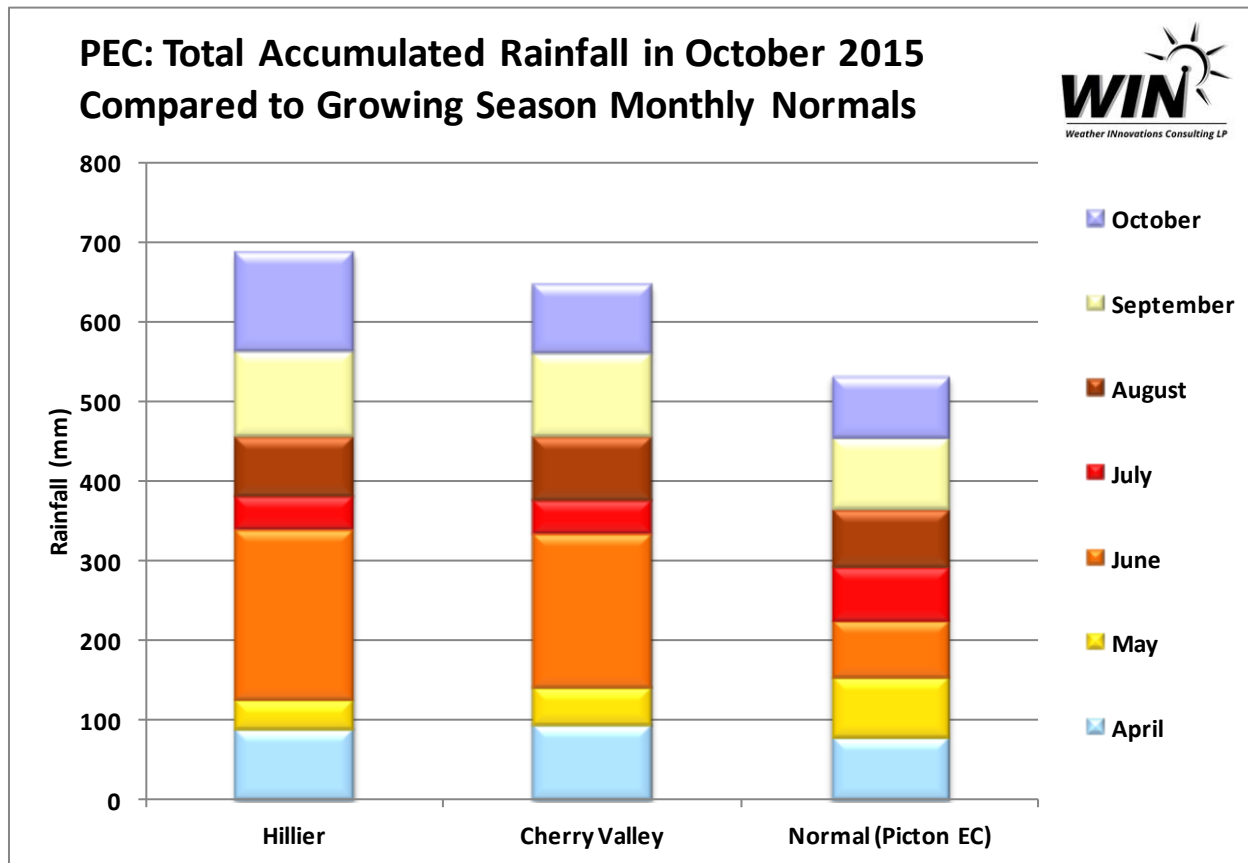


Figure 4: Rainfall
